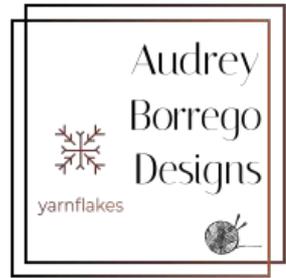


Poecile



Notes

Poecile is a light V-neck raglan cardigan knitted from the top down with lace sleeves, sewn pockets and garter edges.

Its flowy loose sleeves and airy feel plays with the geometric twisted stitches motif in the lace and adds a classic feel to a spring outfit.

The pattern includes fully charted Raglan instructions, individual sleeve charts per size for the lace, optional short-row bust darts as well as a video tutorial showing you how to sew the pockets onto the cardigan's fronts.

Yarn :

You will need

1050 (**1100** / 1200 / **1250** / 1325), **1400** (1500 / **1650** / 1725 / **1850**) meters
1150 (**1205** / 1315 / **1370** / 1450), **1535** (1640 / **1805** / 1890 / **2025**) yards
of fingering or sport weight yarn.

The brown sample is knit with Schoppel-Wolle Alb Lino in 7490 Ocker.

The red sample is knit with Nice Yarns in Dirty District.

For full length sleeves, add about 7% to those estimates.

Needles :

Main Fabric : 3.25 mm (US 3) circular needles with appropriate length to knit in the round and magic loop or DPNs.

Garter edges : 2.5 mm (US 1.5) circular needles with appropriate length to knit in the round and magic loop or DPNs.

or size required to get gauge

Gauge :

25 sts x 34 rows per 10 cm – 4" with larger needles in stockinette after blocking

25 sts x 42.5 rows per 10 cm – 4" with larger needles in lace motif after blocking

Use a pocket to swatch in lace motif.

Notions :

Stitch markers, tapestry needle and scissors

Scrap yarn to place sts on hold

Minimum of 4 buttons (sample size 22 mm – ¾")

Row counter recommended

Techniques used :

Top down raglan cardigan

V-neck shaping

Garter edges and raglan lines

Loose lace sleeves knitted in the round that can be knitted short, elbow length or long

Lace with twisted stitches, eyelets, simple and centered decreases, worked flat with rest WS rows and in the round

Slipped stitches

Picked up neckband with buttonholes

Sewn lace pockets (video tutorial included)

Optional German short-rows bust darts (based on Cup size)

Pattern includes charted instructions

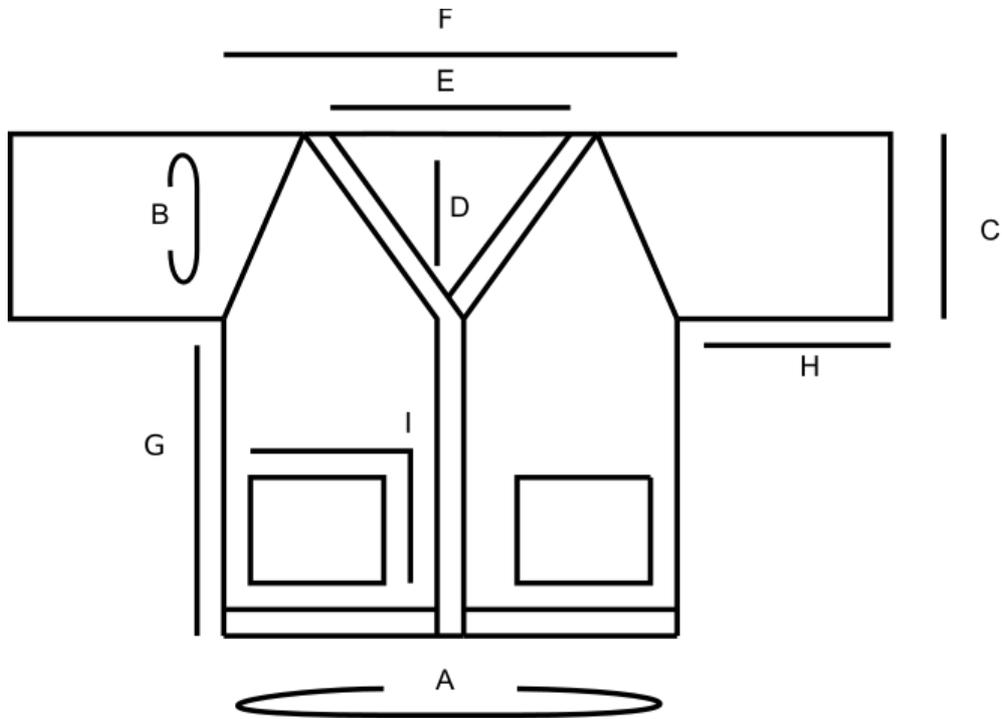
Sizes : 1 (**2** / 3 / **4** / 5), **6** (7 / **8** / 9 / **10**)

All measurements are those of the finished cardigan.

Choose a size with up to 10 cm – 4" positive ease at bust. Shown in size 3 on a 90 cm – 35 ½" bust.

Bust circ. includes 3 cm – 1 ¼" for the neckband when closed.

Red version : Shown in size 4 on a 96 cm – 37 ¾" bust.

Abbreviations :

- CO : cast-on / st(s) : stitch(es) / rnd(s) : round(s)
- BOR : beginning of round / RS : right side / WS : wrong side
- m : marker / pm : place marker / sm : slip marker / rm : remove marker
- dec : decrease / inc : increase
- k : knit stitch / p : purl stitch
- ktbl : knit the st through its back loop / ptbl : purl the st through its back loop
- yo : yarn over
- s2kp : slip the next 2 sts together knitwise, k1, then pass slipped sts over (2 dec)
- sl1wyib : slip the st purlwise with yarn in back
- sl1wyif : slip the st purlwise with yarn in front
- m1L : make 1 left, lift the bar between the stitches onto the left needle from front to back, knit through the back loop (1 inc)
- m1R : make 1 right, lift the bar between the stitches onto the left needle from back to front, knit through the front loop (1 inc)
- k2tog : knit the next 2 sts together (1 dec)
- p2tog : purl the next 2 sts together (1 dec)
- ssk : slip the next two sts knitwise separately then knit them together through their back loop (1 dec)
- DS : double stitch for German short rows (counts as only 1 st)
- *-* : repeat instructions between asterisks

Reading the Charts :

When knitting in the round, always read the Charts from right to left.

When knitting flat, read the Charts back and forth : RS rows from right to left and WS rows from left to right.

Some charts have a section for repeats marked in red. Work as follows :

- firstly work the stitches placed before the repeat,
- work the repeat in red as many times as possible,
- finally work the stitches placed after the repeat.

Pockets

CO 43 (**43** / 43 / **43** / 43), **61** (61 / **61** / 61 / **61**) sts with main needles, using the [German Twisted Cast-on](#) and keeping a 60 cm – 23 ¾" extra tail from the cast-on to seam the pocket edges later.

(*German Twisted Cast-on tutorial by Very Pink Knits*)

set-up row (WS) : knit

Work the Pocket Chart from pages 9-10 1 (**1** / 1 / **1** / 1), **2** (2 / **2** / 2 / **2**) times completely. Sizes 1 to 5 ONLY : work rows 1 to 16 once more.

Switch to smaller needles.

garter row 1 (RS) : sl1wyib, knit to end

garter row 2 (WS) : sl1wyif, knit to 1 st before end, p1

Work garter rows 1-2 twice more.

Loosely bind-off all sts knitwise, keeping a 30 cm – 11 ¾" tail to seam the pocket edges later.

Repeat for second pocket.

Back neck

With larger needles, CO 56 (**58** / 60 / **62** / 64), **66** (66 / **68** / 70 / **72**) sts using the [German Twisted Cast-on](#).

set-up row (WS) : p2, pm, k2, pm, p5, pm, k2, pm, p34 (**36** / 38 / **40** / 42), **44** (44 / **46** / 48 / **50**), pm, k2, pm, p5, pm, k2, pm, p2

Fronts : 2 sts each

*Back : 34 (**36** / 38 / **40** / 42), **44** (44 / **46** / 48 / **50**) sts*

Sleeves : 5 sts each

Raglans : 2 sts each, 8 total

*Total : 56 (**58** / 60 / **62** / 64), **66** (66 / **68** / 70 / **72**) sts*

Raglan

The cardigan now has five main sections : the two fronts, the back and the two sleeves. These sections are separated by the raglan lines.

Part 1 :

You will be increasing along the raglan lines on the body as well as on the sleeves every other row and on the neck edges every 4th row.

On the sleeves, work the Raglan Chart A from pages 11-13 between the markers.

The Chart is divided into 3 parts for an easier reading.

row 1 (RS) : k1, m1L, (knit to m, m1R, sm, k2, sm, Raglan Chart A to m, sm, k2, sm, m1L) x 2, knit to 1 st before end, m1R, k1 (*10 inc*)

rows 2, 4 (WS) : (purl to m, sm, k2, sm, Raglan Chart A to m, sm, k2, sm) x 2, purl to end

row 3 (RS) : (knit to m, m1R, sm, k2, sm, Raglan Chart A to m, sm, k2, sm, m1L) x 2, knit to end (*8 inc*)

Work rows 1 to 4 a total of 11 (**12** / 14 / **16** / 17), **18** (20 / **21** / 22 / **23**) times, ending with row 44 (**48** / 56 / **64** / 68), **72** (80 / **84** / 88 / **92**) of the Raglan Chart A.

*Fronts : 35 (**38** / 44 / **50** / 53), **56** (62 / **65** / 68 / **71**) sts each*

*Back : 78 (**84** / 94 / **104** / 110), **116** (124 / **130** / 136 / **142**) sts*

*Sleeves : 49 (**53** / 61 / **69** / 73), **77** (85 / **89** / 93 / **97**) sts each*

Raglans : 2 sts each, 8 total

*Total : 254 (**274** / 312 / **350** / 370), **390** (426 / **446** / 466 / **486**) sts*

Sizes 1 to 6 ONLY :

Part 2 :

You will be increasing along the raglan lines on the body, sleeves and on the neck edges every 4th row.

Continue with the corresponding Raglan Chart B from pages 14-17 for your size.

row 1 (RS) : k1, m1L, (knit to m, m1R, sm, k2, sm, Raglan Chart B to m, sm, k2, sm, m1L) x 2, knit to 1 st before end, m1R, k1 (10 inc)

rows 2, 4 (WS) : (purl to m, sm, k2, sm, Raglan Chart B to m, sm, k2, sm) x 2, purl to end

row 3 : (knit to m, sm, k2, sm, Raglan Chart B to m, sm, k2, sm) x 2, knit to end

Work rows 1 to 4 a total of 5 (5 / 3 / 2 / 2), 2 (- / - / - / -) times (end of Raglan Chart B).

Fronts : 45 (48 / 50 / 54 / 57), 60 (- / - / - / -) sts each

Back : 88 (94 / 100 / 108 / 114), 120 (- / - / - / -) sts

Sleeves : 59 (63 / 67 / 73 / 77), 81 (- / - / - / -) sts each

Raglans : 2 sts each, 8 total

Total : 304 (324 / 342 / 370 / 390), 410 (- / - / - / -) sts

ALL SIZES RESUME

Separate body and sleeves

You will now place the sleeve sts on hold, casting on new sts for each underarm. To do so, you can use the [backwards loop cast-on](#).

(Backwards Loop Cast-on tutorial by Very Pink Knits)

next row (RS) : (knit to m, rm, k2, rm, place next 59 (63 / 67 / 73 / 77), 81 (85 / 89 / 93 / 97) sts on hold, CO 10 (14 / 19 / 23 / 29), 35 (43 / 49 / 55 / 59) sts, rm, k2, rm) x 2, knit to end

206 (226 / 246 / 270 / 294), 318 (342 / 366 / 390 / 410) body sts

Body

Bust darts

If you wear a cup size greater than B or your full bust measurement is more than 8 cm – 3 ¼" larger than your upper chest measurement, consider adding bust darts on the body. See instructions on page 9.

body row 1 (WS) : purl all sts

body row 2 (RS) : knit all sts

Work body rows 1-2 until the body measures about 30 cm – 11 ¾" from the underarm or 3 cm – 1 ¼" less than desired length, ending with a WS row.

You may choose between a garter or a ribbed hem.

Garter Hem :

Switch to smaller needles.

hem row 1 (RS) : knit all sts

hem row 2 (WS) : p1, knit to 1 st before end, p1

Work hem rows 1-2 until the hem measures about 3 cm – 1 ¼" or desired length, ending with a WS row.

Loosely bind-off knitwise using a [simple stretchy bind-off](#), stopping when 1 st remains on your right needle. Do not cut yarn.

Ribbed Hem :

Switch to smaller needles.

set-up row (RS) : k1, p2tog, *k1, p1* to 1 st before end, k1 (1 dec)

205 (225 / 245 / 269 / 293), 317 (341 / 365 / 389 / 409) body sts

hem row 1 (WS) : *p1, k1* to 1 st before end, p1

hem row 2 (RS) : *k1, p1* to 1 st before end, k1

Work hem rows 1-2 until the hem measures about 3 cm – 1 ¼" or desired length, ending with a WS row.

Loosely bind-off knitwise using a [simple stretchy bind-off](#), stopping when 1 st remains on your right needle. Do not cut yarn.

Neckband

Note : the Red sample worked a 5 cm – 2" neckband without buttonholes.

Left and Right refer to the cardigan once worn.

With the last st from the hem bind-off still on your right needle, pick up and knit :
2 sts out of 3 along the right front,
every st from the shoulders and back neck cast-on,
and 2 out of 3 sts along the left front until the bottom of the hem.

Make sure to pick an odd number of sts.

You may choose between a garter or a ribbed neckband.

garter neckband row 1 (WS) : sl1wyif, knit to end
garter neckband row 2 (RS) : sl1wyif, knit to end

ribbed neckband row 1 (WS) : sl1wyif, *k1, p1* to end
ribbed neckband row 2 (RS) : sl1wyif, *p1, k1* to end

Work neckband rows 1-2 until the neckband measures 1.5 cm – ½" or half the desired length, ending with a WS row.

Buttonholes :

Place 4 markers spaced evenly on the right side of the neckband, between the bottom of the cardigan hem and the beginning of the body on the V-neck point.

Note : if you made the body longer or simply want more buttons, adjust the number of markers here.

buttons row 1 (RS) : sl1wyif, (work as established to button m, bind-off 2 sts removing marker) x 4, work as established to end

buttons row 2 (WS) : sl1wyif, (work as established to button hole, CO 2 sts with the [backwards loop cast-on](#)) x 4, work as established to end

Resume working neckband rows 1-2 until the neckband measures about 3 cm – 1 ¼" or desired length, ending with a WS row.
Loosely bind-off all sts knitwise using a [simple stretchy bind-off](#).

Sleeves

You will pick up sts and start working the Sleeve Chart for your size from pages 18-27 on the held sleeve sts.

With larger needles and starting to the right of the underarm CO sts, pick up and knit :
2 sts in the gap,
5 (7 / 9 / **11** / 14), **17** (21 / **24** / 27 / **29**) sts from the underarm CO,

PM for BOR,

5 (7 / 10 / **12** / 15), **18** (22 / **25** / 28 / **30**) sts from the underarm CO,
2 sts in the gap,
Knit the 59 (**63** / 67 / **73** / 77), **81** (85 / **89** / 93 / **97**) held sleeve sts following rnd 1 of the Sleeve Chart : start with st number 8 (**10** / 13 / **15** / 18), **21** (7 / **28** / 13 / **33**) of Chart and stop once all the held sts have been worked.

Join to work in the rnd and knit to BOR.

73 (**81** / 90 / **100** / 110), **120** (132 / **142** / 152 / **160**) sts

Continue the Chart normally from rnd 2.
sleeve rnd : Sleeve Chart to end

Repeat the sleeve rnd until the sleeve measures

Elbow length : 15 cm – 6" from the underarm or 1 cm – ½" less than desired length.

Long sleeves : 40 cm – 15 ¾" from the underarm or 5 cm – 2" less than desired length.

End after an even rnd of the Chart.

Cuff :

Switch to smaller needles.

Note : You generally don't have to work decreases for short / before elbow length sleeves. If you are making them pass the elbow or find them too loose (especially for sizes 6 to 10), decrease here before the cuff as follows :

k3 (1 / 0 / 0 / 0), 0 (0 / 0 / 0 / 0), *k2tog* to last 4 (2 / 0 / 0 / 0), 0 (0 / 0 / 0 / 0) sts, knit to end

40 (42 / 45 / 50 / 55), 60 (66 / 71 / 76 / 80) sts

Sizes 5 to 10 ONLY :

k- (- / - / - / 0), 0 (0 / 1 / 4 / 0), *k2tog, k- (- / - / - / 9), 4 (4 / 3 / 2 / 2)* to end

- (- / - / - / 50), 50 (55 / 57 / 58 / 60) sts

You may choose between a garter or a ribbed cuff.

garter cuff rnd 1 : knit all sts

garter cuff rnd 2 : purl all sts

ribbed cuff rnd 1 : *k1, p1* to end

Work garter cuff rnds 1-2 or ribbed cuff 1 until the cuff measures about 1 cm – 1/2" (long sleeves : 5 cm – 2") or desired length, ending with a rnd 2.

Loosely bind-off all sts knitwise using a [simple stretchy bind-off](#).

Repeat for second sleeve.

Finishing

Weave in all ends in the cardigan. Gently block the cardigan and the lace pockets.

Seaming the pockets :

Once dry, you can seam the lace pockets on the fronts.

The garter border is at the top.

Try on the cardigan to see where you'd like the pocket to sit. Preferably, the bottom of the pocket should rest just above the garter hem, and it should be closer to the side of the cardigan rather than near the neckband. Attach a locking stitch marker to a stitch on the cardigan to mark where one top corner of the pocket will be.

Seam the sides and bottom of the pocket.

Buttons :

Sew the buttons on the left side of the neckband in front of the button holes.

Bust darts instructions :

Left and Right refer to the cardigan once worn.

Work the body until it measures 2 cm – 3/4" from the underarm.

CUP C AND D ONLY

Full bust measurement at least 8 cm – 3 1/4" more than upper chest measurement.

Left Front :

short row 1 (RS) : k45 (50 / 54 / 62 / 68), 74 (80 / 86 / 90 / 96), turn

short row 2 (WS) : DS, purl to end

short row 3 : knit to 4 (4 / 5 / 5 / 6), 7 (7 / 8 / 8 / 8) sts before last DS, turn

Repeat short rows 2-3 two more times, then short row 2 once more.

next row (RS) : knit to end, closing the short-rows by knitting the DS normally.

Right Front :

short row 1 (WS) : p45 (50 / 54 / 62 / 68), 74 (80 / 86 / 90 / 96), turn

short row 2 (RS) : DS, knit to end

short row 3 : purl to 4 (4 / 5 / 5 / 6), 7 (7 / 8 / 8 / 8) sts before last DS, turn

Repeat short rows 2-3 two more times, then short row 2 once more.

next row (WS) : purl to end, closing the short-rows by purling the DS normally.

CUP E AND F ONLY

Full bust measurement at least 12 cm – 4 3/4" more than upper chest measurement.

Left Front :

short row 1 (RS) : k45 (50 / 54 / 62 / 68), 74 (80 / 86 / 90 / 96), turn

short row 2 (WS) : DS, purl to end

short row 3 : knit to 3 (3 / 4 / 4 / 5), 5 (6 / 6 / 7 / 7) sts before last DS, turn

Repeat short rows 2-3 three more times, then short row 2 once more.

next row (RS) : knit to end, closing the short-rows by knitting the DS normally.

Right Front :

short row 1 (WS) : p45 (50 / 54 / 62 / 68), 74 (80 / 86 / 90 / 96), turn

short row 2 (RS) : DS, knit to end

short row 3 : purl to 3 (3 / 4 / 4 / 5), 5 (6 / 6 / 7 / 7) sts before last DS, turn

Repeat short rows 2-3 three more times, then short row 2 once more.

next row (WS) : purl to end, closing the short-rows by purling the DS normally.

CUP G AND H ONLY

Full bust measurement at least 16 cm – 6 1/4" more than upper chest measurement.

Left Front :

short row 1 (RS) : k45 (50 / 54 / 62 / 68), 74 (80 / 86 / 90 / 96), turn

short row 2 (WS) : DS, purl to end

short row 3 : knit to 3 (3 / 3 / 3 / 4), 4 (5 / 5 / 6 / 6) sts before last DS, turn

Repeat short rows 2-3 four more times, then short row 2 once more.

next row (RS) : knit to end, closing the short-rows by knitting the DS normally.

Right Front :

short row 1 (WS) : p45 (50 / 54 / 62 / 68), 74 (80 / 86 / 90 / 96), turn

short row 2 (RS) : DS, knit to end

short row 3 : purl to 3 (3 / 3 / 3 / 4), 4 (5 / 5 / 6 / 6) sts before last DS, turn

Repeat short rows 2-3 four more times, then short row 2 once more.

next row (WS) : purl to end, closing the short-rows by purling the DS normally.

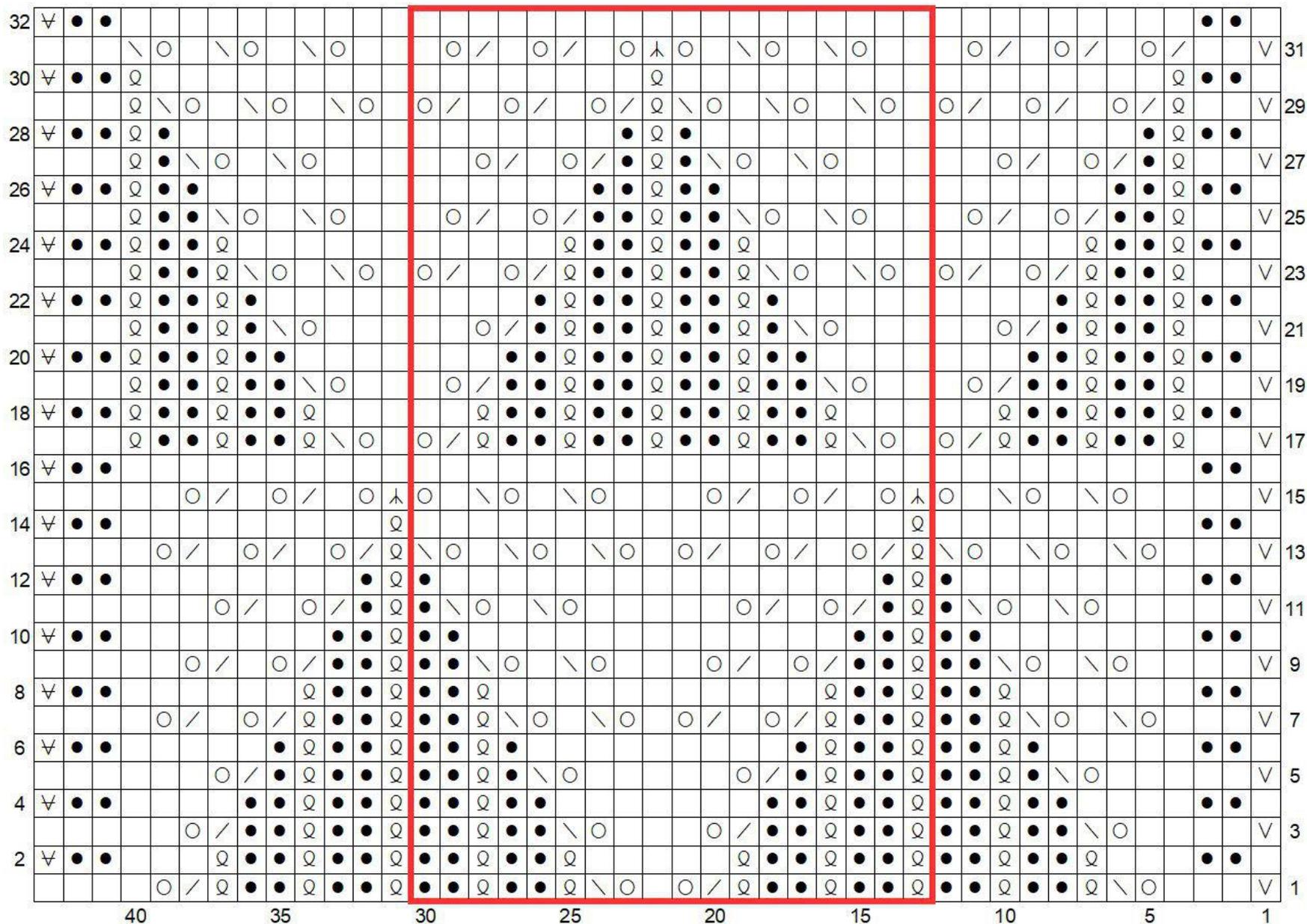

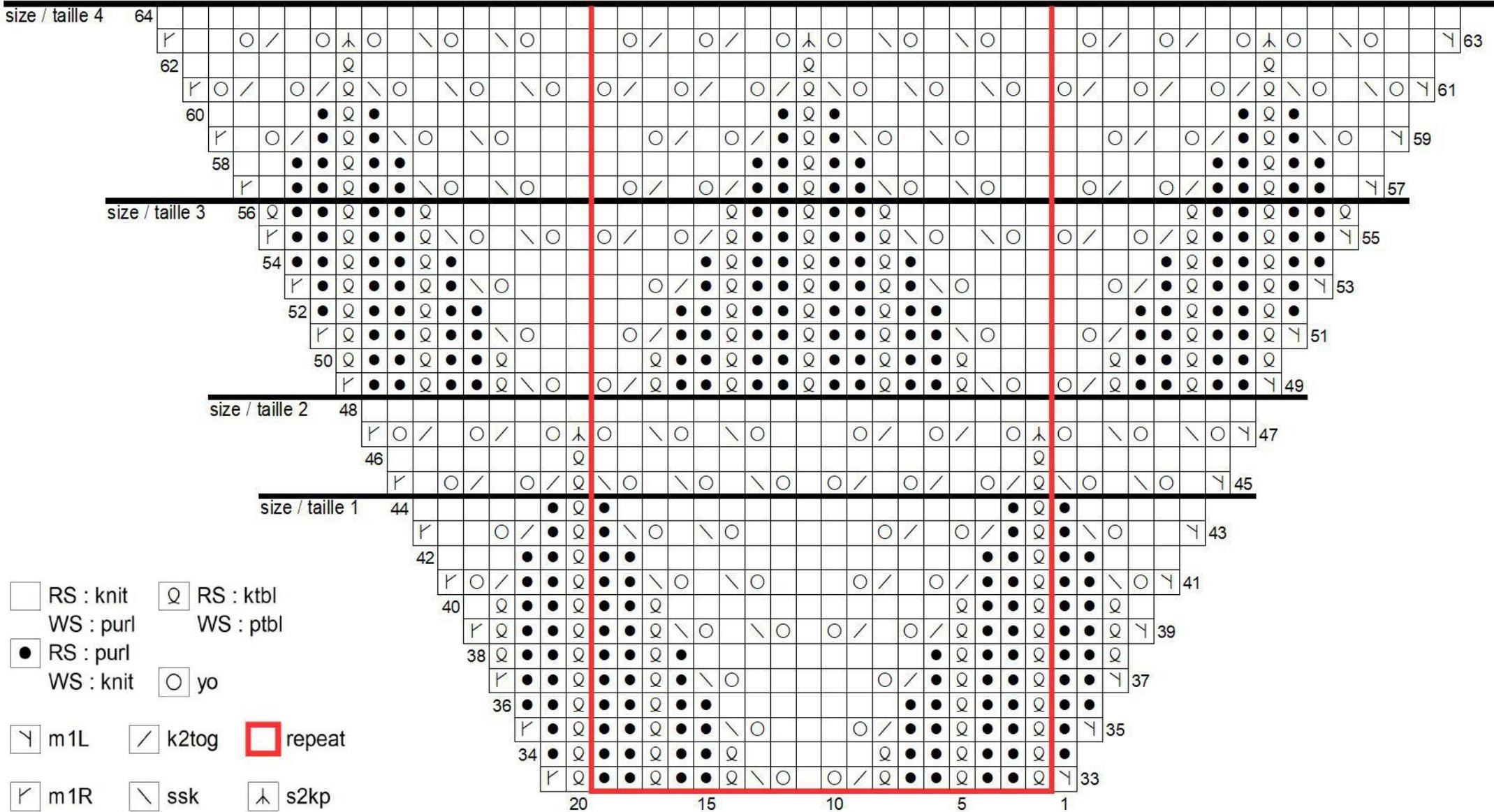

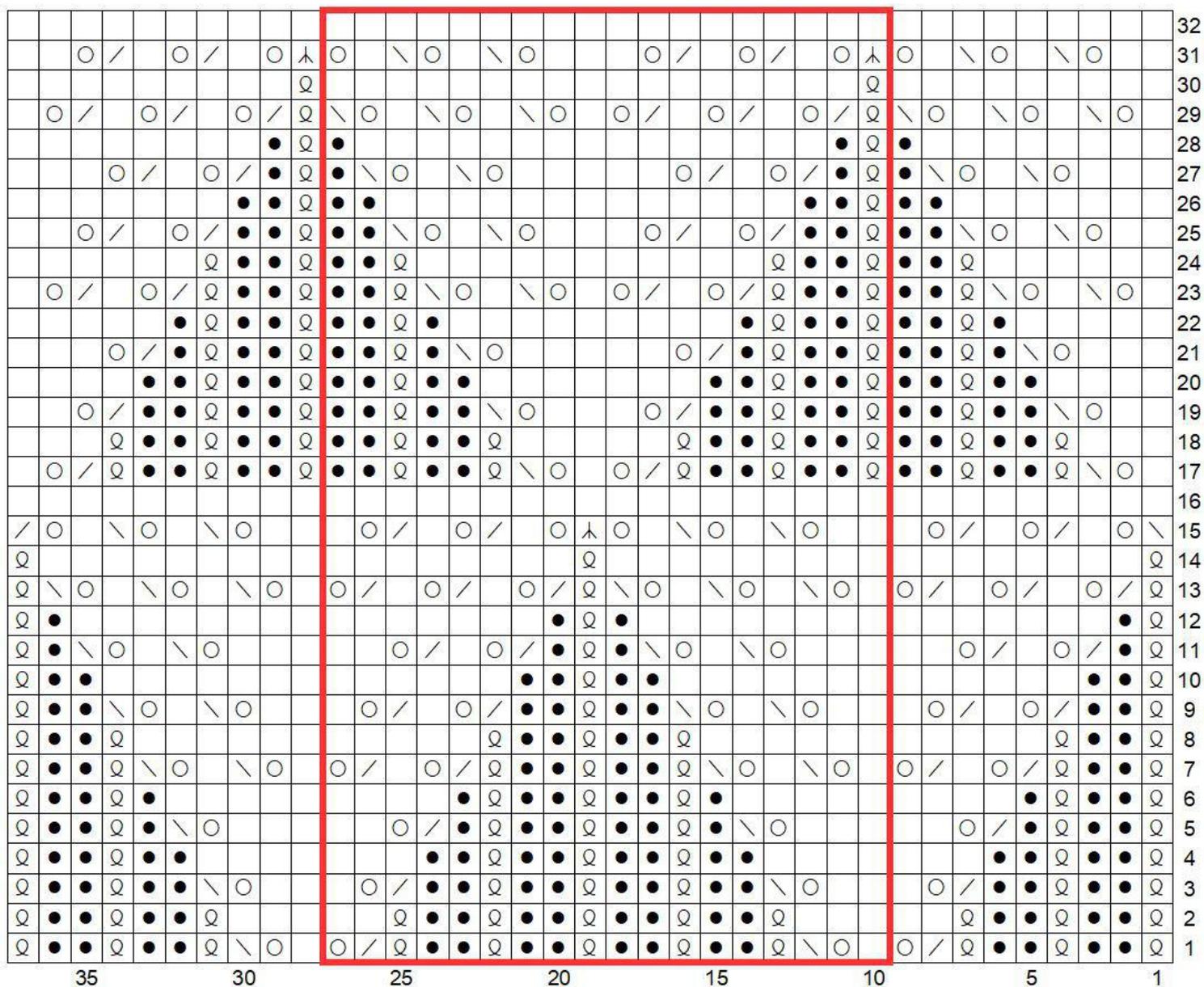
