



KNIT | SKILL LEVEL: INTERMEDIATE

## ABBREVIATIONS

<b>Approx</b> =	<b>K</b> = Knit	<b>St(s)</b> = Stitch(es)
Approximately	<b>P</b> = Purl	<b>Tog</b> = Together
<b>Beg</b> = Beginning	<b>Rep</b> = Repeat	<b>WS</b> = Wrong side
<b>Cont</b> = Continue(ity)	<b>RS</b> = Right side	

## MEASUREMENTS

Approx 50" [127 cm] x 58" [147.5 cm].

## GAUGE

17 sts and 23 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st with larger needles.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Notes:

- When working from chart in color block technique, wind small balls of the colors to be used, one for each separate area of color in the design. Start new colors at appropriate points. To change colors, twist the 2 colors around each other where they meet, on WS, to avoid a hole.

### Strip 1 (make 2)

See Chart on page 3.

With Color 2, cast on 35 sts. With Color 1, cast on 35 sts. 70 sts.

**Note:** Use Diagram on page 2 for color placement, having A as Color 1, B as Color 2, C as Color 3, D as Color 4.

Work in Chart to end of chart, reading **RS** rows from **right to left** and **WS** rows from **left to right** as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). With Color 1, K35. With Color 2, K35.

**2nd row:** With Color 2, K1. P34. With Color 1, P34. K1.

First 2 rows of Chart are complete, cont in chart until all 92 rows of chart are complete.

Work 1st to 92nd rows of chart twice more.

**Next row:** (RS). With Color 1, K35. With Color 2, K35.

## MATERIALS

**Red Heart® Super Saver®** (7 oz/198 g; 364 yds/333 m)

**Contrast A** Shocking Pink (0718)      **2 balls or 530 yds/480 m**

**Contrast B** Pretty'n Pink (0722)      **2 balls or 530 yds/480 m**

**Contrast C** Persimmon (0220)      **2 balls or 530 yds/480 m**

**Contrast D** Coral (0726)      **2 balls or 620 yds/560 m**

Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® knitting needles. Size U.S. 6 (4 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® circular knitting needle 36" [90 cm] long **or size needed to obtain gauge.** Susan Bates® yarn needle.

**Next row:** With Color 2, K1. P34. With Color 1, P34. K1. Rep last 2 rows 22 times more (46 rows total). Cast off knitwise.

**Strip II** (make 1)

See Chart on page 3.

With Color 3, cast on 35 sts. With Color 4, cast on 35 sts. 70 sts.

**Next row:** (RS). With Color 4, K35. With Color 3, K35.

**Next row:** With Color 3, K1. P34. With Color 4, P34. K1.

Rep last 2 rows 22 times more (46 rows total).

Use Diagram for color placement, having A as Color 1, B as Color 2, C as Color 3, D as Color 4.

Work in Chart to end of chart, reading **RS** rows from **right to left** and **WS** rows from **left to right** as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). With Color 2, K35. With Color 1, K35.

**2nd row:** With Color 1, K1. P34. With Color 2, P34. K1.


First 2 rows of Chart are complete, cont in chart until all 92 rows of chart are complete.

Work 1st to 92nd rows of chart twice more.

Cast off knitwise.

**FINISHING**

Following diagram, sew Strips tog using Mattress stitch.



MATTRESS STITCH


**Edging**

**Side edging:** With RS facing, color of choice and circular needle, pick up and knit 238 sts along side edge of Blanket.

Knit 8 rows. Cast off knitwise (WS). Rep for other side.

**Top and bottom edging:** With RS facing, color of choice and circular needle, pick up and knit 218 sts across top edge of Blanket.

Knit 8 rows. Cast off knitwise (WS). Rep for bottom edge.
