Tension

24sts and 28 rows over 4x4ins/10x10cm worked in st st using 3.5mm circular needles.

Materials

Armscote Manor (100% Portland Wool, 350m/100g)

Pale Grey x 1 (1, 2) skeins

Natural Black x 3 (4, 4) skeins

Tools

3mm 80cm circular needles

3.5mm 80cm circular needles

1 large marker

6 (7, 8) small markers

Notes

This jumper is worked top-down in the round. Short rows are worked after the collar to raise the back of the neck.

The pattern has large one-colour spaces within the colourwork. To create an even tension, catch the unworked yarn every 3-5sts in a random pattern to carry it along the row.

Where instructions are split into different sizes, work only the instructions relating to the size you are knitting. You may find it helpful to highlight them before beginning.

PATTERN

Using Yarn A and 3mm needles, cast on 100 (102, 102), place Large Marker, join to work in round.

Rounds 1-8 *K1 p1; repeat to end.

Round 9 Change to 3.5mm needles. *k5(3, 2), m1; repeat from * to end. [119 (136, 153)sts]

Neckline shaping

Row 1 (RS) k18 (21, 23)sts, wrap and turn.

Row 2 (WS) Purl to Large marker, slip marker, p18 (21, 23)sts, w&t.

Row 3 Knit to wrapped stitch, knit wrap with stitch, k2, w&t

Row 4 Purl to wrapped stitch, purl wrap with stitch, p2, w&t.

Rows 5-6 Repeat rows 3-4 once more.

Yoke

Size S only

Processing remaining wrapped sts as before, *k17, place Small Marker; repeat from * to end.

Work 3 rnds st st.

Size M only

Remove Large marker, k8, replace Large Marker. This is your new beginning of round.

Processing remaining wrapped sts as before, *k17, place Small Marker; repeat from * to end.

Work 6 rnds st st.

Size L only

Processing remaining wrapped sts as before, *k17, place Small Marker; repeat from * to end.

Work 8rnds st st.

Next Round *m1L, k4, (m1L, k1) three times, k5, (m1L, k1) three times, k2, slip marker; repeat from * to end. [168 (192, 216)sts, 24sts between each marker]

Next Round knit all sts.

You will now begin the colourwork portion of the yoke, starting with the moons.

Size S only

*k9, work Chart A across next 7sts, k8, slip marker; repeat from * once more.

k9, work Chart B across next 7sts, k8, slip marker,

k9, work Chart A across next 7sts, k8, slip marker,

K9, work chart C across next 7sts, k8, slip marker,

*k9, work Chart A across next 7sts, k8, slip marker; repeat from * once more.

Size M only

k9, work Chart C across next 7sts, k8, slip marker,

k9, work Chart A across next 7sts, k8, slip marker,
k9, work Chart B across next 7sts, k8, slip marker,
k9, work Chart A across next 7sts, k8, slip marker,
k9, work chart C across next 7sts, k8, slip marker,
k9, work Chart A across next 7sts, k8, slip marker,
k9, work Chart B across next 7sts, k8, slip marker,
k9, work Chart A across next 7sts, k8, slip marker,

Size L only

*k9, work Chart A across next 7sts, k8, slip marker; repeat from * twice more,
k9, work Chart B across next 7sts, k8, slip marker,
k9, work Chart A across next 7sts, k8, slip marker,
K9, work chart C across next 7sts, k8, slip marker,
*k9, work Chart A across next 7sts, k8, slip marker; repeat from * twice more.

Continue as established until all 8 rows of the Moon Charts have been worked.

Round 9 knit.

Round 10 *k5, m1R, (k2, m1R) twice, k7, (m1R, k2) three times, knit to marker, slip marker;
repeat from * to end. [210 (240, 270) sts, 30sts between markers]

Work Chart D 7 (8, 9) times, slipping the markers between each repeat. [294 (336, 378) sts,
42sts between markers]

Break Yarn A. Continuing in Yarn B only and removing all Small Markers, work 1 (4, 8) rounds
st st.

Split arms and body

Knit 47 (34, 60) sts, move 53 (58, 67) sts to holder for right sleeve, cast on 14sts, knit 95 (110,
121)sts across front, move 53 (58, 67) sts to holder for left sleeve, cast on 14 sts, knit to end of
round. [216 (248, 272) sts]

Your jumper should now have one full moon centred in the front of the body, and two crescent
moon repeats either side, with the raised neck centred in the back.

Knit st st until body is 12ins long, or 5cm/2ins short of desired length. Change to 3mm needles,
*k1, p1; repeat from * to end of round. Repeat this round for 5cm/2ins and cast off.

Sleeves

Beginning at the centre of the cast on sts, pick up and knit 7 sts, pick up and knit 1 st between
cast on sts and held sts, knit 53 (58, 67) held sts, pick up and knit 1s st between cast on sts and
held sts, pick up and knit remaining 7 cast on sts, place Large Marker. [69 (74, 83) sts]

Work 42 rounds in st st.

***Next round** k1, ssk, knit to 3sts before marker, k2tog, k1. Knit 13 rounds st st; Repeat from * twice more. [63 (68, 77) sts]

****Next round** k1, ssk, knit to 3sts before marker, k2tog, k1. Knit 6 rounds st st; repeat from ** 5 more times. [51 (56, 65) sts]

Work 2 (3, 2) rounds in st st.

Size S&L only k1, ssk, knit to end. [50 (64) sts]

Change to 3mm needles, *k1, p1; repeat from * to end of round. Repeat this round for 5cm/2ins and cast off. Repeat for second sleeve.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends. Block using preferred method.








M make 1 – insert needle under bar between sts from back to front and knit it through front loop
 Grey boxes indicate no stitch present; skip these sts on each round.
