Sizes

1 (2, 3, 4) (5, 6, 7) (8, 9, 10) with finished busts:

92 (96, 98, 104.5) (113, 120, 131) (140.5, 154, 160.5)cm /
36.25 (37.75, 38.5, 41.25) (44.5, 47.25, 51.5) (55.25, 59.75, 63.25)".

Sample shown is size 3 on an 89cm / 35" bust, corresponding to 9 cm / 3.5" positive ease. Intended to be worn with 7 to 13 cm / 2.75" to 5" positive ease at bust. A schematic and list of measurements are provided on page 4.

Yarn

Sunday Knits 3 ply (50 grams in 225 metres / 246 yards): Nirvana (90% select fine Australian merino, 10% premium Mongolian cashmere) in main colour Sand (MC) and contrast colours Charcoal (CC1), Cedar (CC3), Delft (CC4), Rain (CC5), Dill (CC6), and Coral (CC12); Brigadoon (100% extra-fine Australian merino tweed) in contrast colour Centro (CC2); Angelic (75% extra-fine Australian merino, 25% ultra soft French angora) in contrast colour Grape (CC8); Eden (100% extra-fine Australian merino) in contrast colours Raisin (CC7), Bay (CC9), Fawn (CC10), and Turquoise (CC11). The number of full skeins and mini skeins of Sunday Knits yarn for each size is listed below. Also provided is the corresponding approximate yardage.

Gauge

Stockinette

28 sts and 35 rows to 10cm / 4" with size A needles after blocking (or needle size required to match gauge).

Stranded colourwork

28 sts and 34 rnds to 10cm / 4" of stranded colourwork pattern using size B needles after blocking (or needle size required to match gauge).

Needles and Notions

Gauge was achieved with the following needle sizes. Many knitters find that they need to use smaller needles for single colour stockinette to achieve the same gauge as the colourwork; you may or may not need smaller size needles for the stockinette stripes than what you need to use for the colourwork. You must swatch and always use a needle size that will result in the correct gauge after blocking.

Size A: 3mm (US 2.5) 24" for MC body and hem cast on for stranded colourwork band; 40" for single-colour stockinette rounds in stranded colourwork band and for sleeves if using magic loop; if preferred, DPNs for sleeves

Size B: 3.5mm (US 4) 40" for stranded colourwork band and for sleeves if using magic loop; if preferred, DPNs for sleeves

Removable markers; stitch markers; scrap yarn or spare needles or interchangeable cables to hold stitches; spare needles or interchangeable cables for the provisional cast on

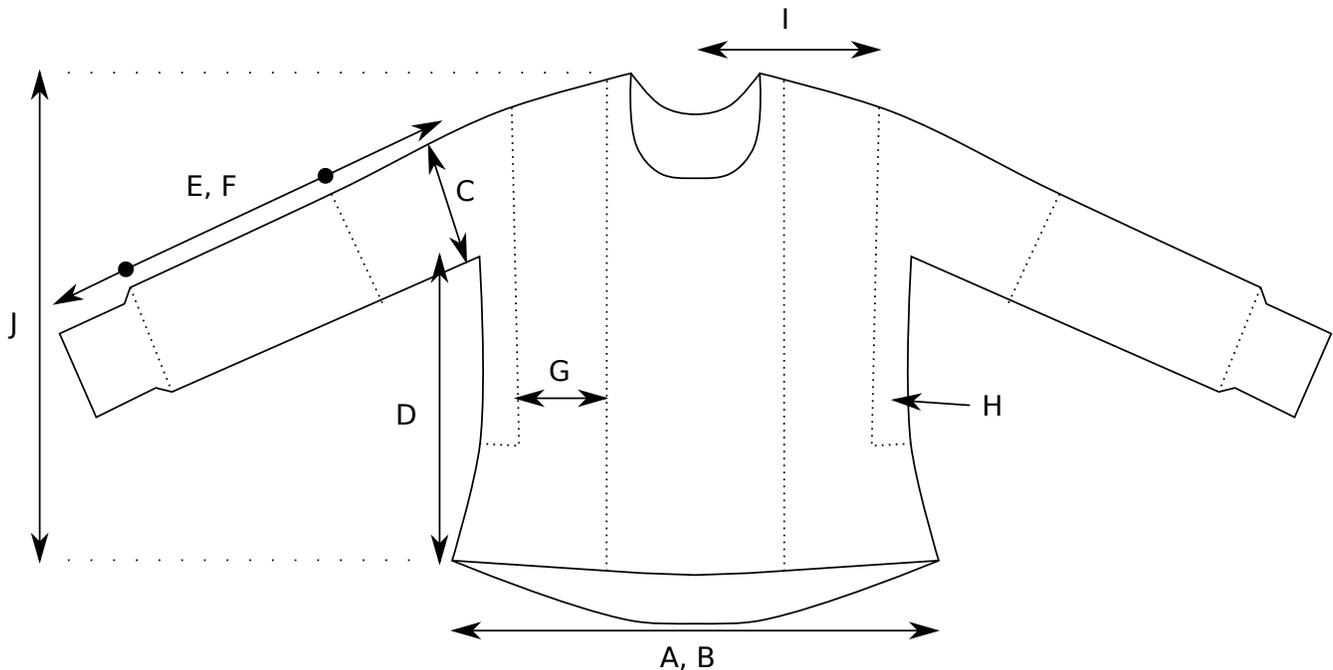

Special Techniques

Provisional cast on to a spare circular needle or spare interchangeable cable

Sunday Short Rows (they use the mst in the Abbreviations)

RS

Knit to mst, place removable marker around working yarn, turn work and continue in pattern on WS. When you turn your work and begin working on the WS, the removable marker gets "trapped" in the fabric and

marks a new loop (mst) that you can pull up and work on the next RS row as follows:

To knit across the mst on the RS and resolve the Sunday Short Row: knit to mst, pull the removable marker gently to pull up the marked loop and place this loop that the removable marker is through onto the LN, remove removable marker, k2tog, place removable marker through this k2tog (this marks the short row for counting purposes), and continue in pattern.

WS

Purl to mst, place removable marker around working yarn, turn work and continue in pattern on RS. When you turn your work and begin working on the RS, the removable marker gets "trapped" in the fabric and marks a new loop (mst) that you can pull up and work on the next WS row as follows:

To purl across the mst on the WS and resolve the Sunday Short Row: purl to mst, sl 1 st to RN, pull the removable marker gently to pull up the marked loop and place this loop that the removable marker is through onto the LN, remove removable marker, purl the new loop together with the slipped st, place removable marker through this p2tog (this marks the short row for counting purposes), and continue in pattern.

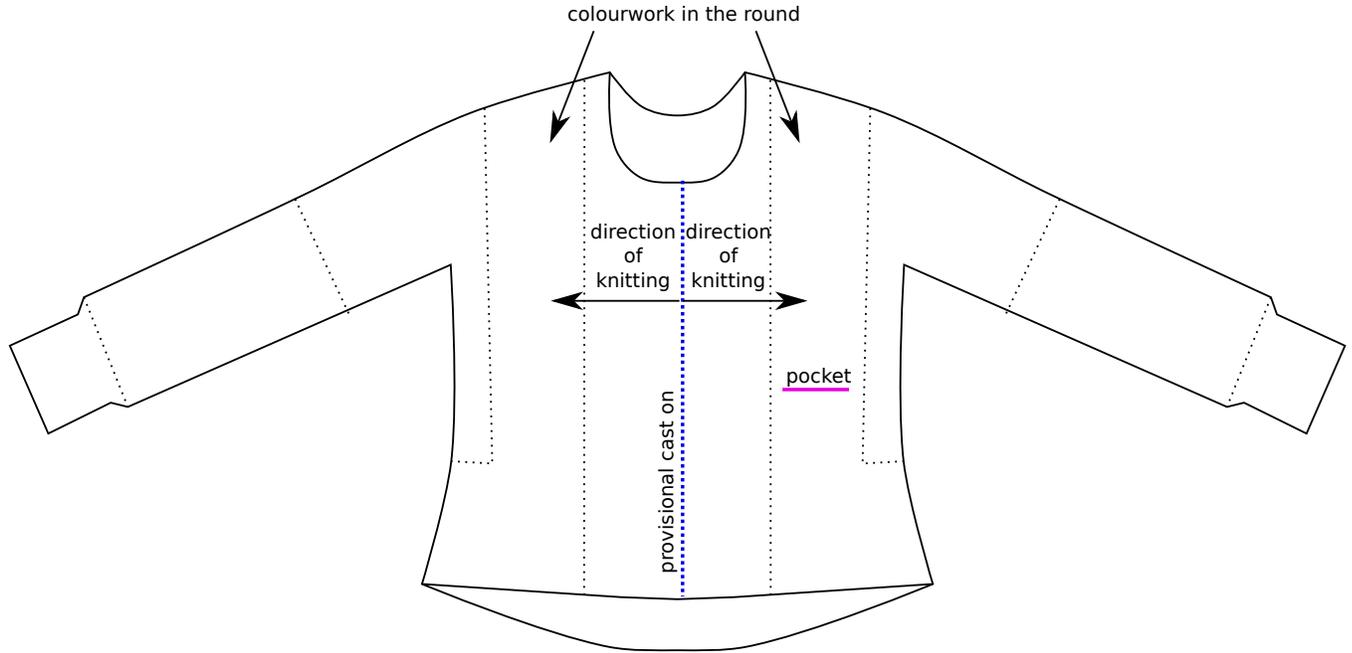
Long Tail Tubular Bind Off

Construction Overview

The general outline of steps:

1. Left back body sts are cast on using a provisional cast on, worked sideways, and placed on hold.
2. Left front body sts are cast on using a provisional cast on, worked sideways, and placed on hold.
3. The left front and back body sts are joined at the neck, and continued sideways.
4. The left stranded colourwork band is worked in the round and a little front pocket is incorporated into the round (the pocket is optional).
5. St st at the body side is continued sideways from the colourwork band and then grafted together using Kitchener st to close the side of the body before working the sleeve.
6. The right back and front body sts are continued from the provisionally cast on sts.
7. The right stranded colourwork band is worked in the round, followed by sideways St st at the body side and a Kitchener graft to close the side of the body before working the sleeve.
8. Lastly, sleeves are worked top down and in the round.



Directions

Left Back Body

With size A needles and MC, provisionally CO 147 (151, 154, 156) (160, 180, 184) (187, 189, 191) sts onto a spare circular needle or interchangeable cable.

Row 1 (WS): p to end.

Work even in St st until work measures 3cm / 1.25" from cast on row ending after working a RS row.

Hip Shaping Short Row Set

Note: if you do not want or need extra room at your hip or bum, do not work these short rows.

Short row 1 (WS): p 39 (39, 39, 42) (42, 48, 51) (51, 54, 54), mst.

Short row 2 (RS): k to end.

Short row 3 (WS): p to 6 (6, 3, 3) (3, 4, 4) (4, 4, 4) sts before last mst, mst.

Short row 4 (RS): k to end.

Rep last two short rows 0 (0, 2, 2) (3, 3, 3) (4, 4, 5) **more** times.

End of Hip Shaping Short Row Set.

Next row (WS): p to end, purling the mst tog with the next st as you come to them (see Special Techniques).

Neck shaping:

Sizes 1 (2, 3, 4) 5 only:

Inc Row (RS): k1, m1l, k to end. (*1 st increased.*)

Next row (WS): p to end.

Rep last two rows 2 **more** times.

Then rep Inc Row **once**.

Sizes (6, 7) (8, 9, 10) only:

Inc Row (RS): k1, m1l, k to end. (*1 st increased.*)

Short row 1 (WS): p (150, 152) (154, 156, 158), mst.

Short row 2 (RS): k to end.

Next row (WS): p to end, purling the mst tog with

the next st as you come to it.

Rep last four rows (2, 2) (3, 3, 4) **more** times.

Then rep Inc Row **once**.

All sizes:

End of Neck shaping.

Work Hip Shaping Short Row Set **once more**.

Next row (WS): p to end, purling the mst tog with the next st as you come to them. Break yarn and place these 151 (155, 158, 160) (164, 184, 188) (192, 194, 197) left back sts on hold.

Left Front Body

With size A needles and MC, provisionally CO 116 (120, 123, 125) (129, 149, 153) (155, 157, 158) sts onto a spare circular needle or interchangeable cable.

Row 1 (RS): k to end.

Work even in St st until work measures 3.5cm / 1.5" from cast on row and ending after working a RS row.

Neck shaping

Sizes 1 (2, 3, 4) 5 only:

Inc Row (WS): CO 2 sts, p to end. (2 sts increased.)

Next row (RS): k to end.

Rep last two rows 2 **more** times.

Then rep Inc Row **once**. Do not break yarn.

Sizes (6, 7) (8, 9, 10) only:

Inc Row (WS): CO 2 sts, p to end. (2 sts increased.)

Short row 1 (RS): k (147, 151) (153, 155, 156), mst.

Short row 2 (WS): p to end.

Next row (RS): k to end, knitting the mst tog with the next st as you come to it.

Rep last four rows (2, 2) (3, 3, 4) **more** times.

Then rep Inc Row **once**. Do not break yarn.

All sizes:

End of Neck shaping.

You have 124 (128, 131, 133) (137, 157, 161) (165, 167, 170) left front sts on your needles. You will now join front and back.

Join Front and Back

Next row (RS): k the 124 (128, 131, 133) (137, 157, 161) (165, 167, 170) front sts, CCO 35 (35, 36, 36) (36, 37, 37) (37, 37, 38) sts, pm, CCO 8 (8, 9, 9) (9, 10, 10) (10, 10, 11) sts, being careful not to twist the cast on sts, k the 151 (155, 158, 160) (164, 184, 188) (192, 194, 197) back sts to end. *I recommend a cable cast on for stability over the shoulders at the neck.*

You have 318 (326, 334, 338) (346, 388, 396) (404, 408, 416) sts on your needles: 159 (163, 167, 169) (173, 194, 198) (202, 204, 208) sts front/back.

Sizes 1 (2, 3) only:

Work even in St st until the front body measures 6 (7, 7.5)cm / 2.25 (2.75, 3)" from the provisional cast on and ending after working a RS row. Break yarn.

Size 4 only:

Work even in St st until the front body measures 8cm / 3.25" from the provisional cast on and ending after working a WS row.

Short row 1 (RS): k 137, mst.

Short row 2 (WS): p to end.

Short row 3 (RS): k to 4 before last mst, mst.

Short row 4 (WS): p to end.

Rep last 2 short rows 2 **more** times.

Next row (RS): k to end, knitting the mst tog with the next st as you come to them. Break yarn.

Sizes (5, 6, 7) (8, 9, 10) only:

Work even in St st until work measures 1cm / 0.5" from neck cast on and ending after working a WS row.

Extra Left Front Short Row Set

Short row 1 (RS): k (157, 175, 179) (181, 183, 187), mst.

Short row 2 (WS): p to end.

Short row 3 (RS): k to 11 sts before last mst, mst.

Short row 4 (WS): p to end.

Rep last two short rows (2, 2, 2) (2, 2, 4) **more** times.

End of Extra Left Front Short Row Set.

Note: on the following Dec Row remember to k each mst tog with the next st as you come to them.

Dec Row (RS): k to 10 sts before marker, k2tog, k to marker, sm, k 8, ssk, k to end. (2 sts decreased).

Cont in St st working a Dec Row every (8th, 4th, 4th) (6th, 6th, 6th) row (1, 2, 2) (2, 2, 2) **more** time(s).

Next row (WS): p to end.

Work Extra Left Front Short Row Set **once more**.

Next row (RS): k to end, knitting the mst tog with the next st as you come to them. Break yarn.

You have (342, 382, 390) (398, 402, 410) sts on your needles: (171, 191, 195) (199, 201, 205) sts front/back.

All sizes:

Next row (WS): with CC12 and leaving a 15cm / 6" tail of yarn that will be used in the i-cord hem, p 105 (105, 105, 105) (105, 121, 121) (121, 121, 121) sts, place BOR marker, p to end. Break CC12, leaving another tail of yarn that will be used in the i-cord hem. *Note: at this point, sts are not joined to work in the round but the BOR position is marked for working the left side colourwork band in the round.*

Left Side Colourwork Band

An optional pocket is incorporated into this band. Instructions for both pocket and no pocket options are provided.

With size A needles and CC1, CO 94 (94, 94, 94) (94, 94, 110) (110, 126, 126) sts and purl them. Break CC1. These are your joining sts at the hemline; put these sts aside and you will knit them in the following step.

Set-up rnd: with size A needles and CC1, and with your body sts RS facing, sl sts back to your LN until you reach the BOR marker, k 105 (105, 105, 105) (105, 121, 121) (121, 121, 121) and place a removable marker through the last stitch to mark the back left colourwork corner, k the 94 (94, 94, 94) (94, 94, 110) (110, 126, 126) hemline sts, being very careful not to twist stitches join to the front body sts and k1 placing a removable marker through this last stitch to mark the front left colourwork corner, k 104 (104, 104, 104) (104, 120, 120) (120, 120, 120), pm (this is your front shoulder marker), k to next marker, sm, k to BOR marker (this is your back shoulder marker).

Note: the BOR marker position when working the colourwork band is always the boundary between the shoulder sts and the body sts on the back side of the sweater.

You have 412 (420, 428, 432) (436, 476, 500) (508, 528, 536) sts on your needles: 104 (104, 104, 104) (104, 120, 120) (120, 120, 120) body sts front/back, 2 corner sts, 94 (94, 94, 94) (94, 94, 110) (110, 126, 126) hem sts, 54 (58, 62, 64) (66, 70, 74) (78, 80, 84) shoulder sts front/back.

Note: as you work each subsequent round of the colourwork band, you may find it convenient to move the removable marker that marks each corner stitch up on each round.

Shoulder Dec Rnd 1: *k to 2 sts before corner st, k2tog, k1, ssk (Note: the corner stitch is the k1)*, rep * to * one time, k 102 (102, 102, 102) (102, 118, 118) (118, 118, 118), sm, k to 10 sts before next marker, k2tog, k to next marker, sm, k 8, ssk, k to BOR (Note: the BOR marker is the back shoulder marker. 6 sts decreased: 2 shoulder sts, 2 hem sts, 2 body sts).

You have 406 (414, 422, 426) (430, 470, 494) (502, 522, 530) sts on your needles: 103 (103, 103, 103) (103, 119, 119) (119, 119, 119) body sts front/back, 2 corner sts, 92 (92, 92, 92) (92, 92, 108) (108, 124, 124) hem sts, 53 (57, 61, 63) (65, 69, 73) (77, 79, 83) shoulder sts front/back.

Work Chart A^{LEFT}, working the back rep a total of 24 (24, 24, 24) (24, 28, 28) (28, 28, 28) times, the hem rep a total of 20 (20, 20, 20) (20, 20, 24) (24, 28, 28) times, and the front rep a total of 51 (53, 55, 56) (57, 63, 65) (67, 68, 70) times, and remembering to change to size B needles for the stranded rounds and to size A needles for the single-colour rounds.

When Chart A^{LEFT} is complete you will have 99 (99, 99, 99) (99, 115, 115) (115, 115, 115) body sts front/back, 2 corner sts, 84 (84, 84, 84) (84, 84, 100) (100, 116, 116) hem sts, 53 (57, 61, 63) (65, 69, 73) (77, 79, 83) shoulder sts front/back.

Size 1 only:

Shoulder Dec Rnd 2: with size A needles and CC6, *k to 2 sts before corner st, k2tog, k1, ssk*, rep * to * 1 time, k to next marker, sm, k1, *k2tog, k1* 2 times, *k2tog, k2* 8 times, *k2tog, k1* 2 times, k2tog, k6, sm, k6, *k2tog, k2* 3 times, *k2tog, k1* 7 times, *k2tog, k2* 3 times, k2tog.

Size 2 only:

Shoulder Dec Rnd 2: with size A needles and CC6, *k to 2 sts before corner st, k2tog, k1, ssk*, rep * to * 1 time, k to next marker, sm, k2, k2tog, k3, *k2tog, k4* 6 times, k2tog, k3, k2tog, k7, sm, k7, k2tog, k4, *k2tog, k3* 7 times, k2tog, k4, k2tog, k1.

Size 3 only:

Shoulder Dec Rnd 2: with size A needles and CC6, *k to 2 sts before corner st, k2tog, k1, ssk*, rep * to * 1 time, k to next marker, sm, k5, *k2tog, k9* 4 times, k2tog, k10, sm, k9, k2tog, k8, *k2tog, k7* 4 times, k2tog, k4.

Size 4 only:

Shoulder Dec Rnd 2: with size A needles and CC6, *k to 2 sts before corner st, k2tog, k1, ssk*, rep * to * 1 time, k to next marker, sm, k4, *k2tog, k6* 6 times, k2tog, k9, sm, k9, *k2tog, k5* 6 times, k2tog, k6, k2tog, k2.

Sizes (5, 7) only:

Shoulder Dec Rnd 2: with size A needles and CC6, *k to 2 sts before corner st, k2tog, k1, ssk*, rep * to * 1 time, k to next marker, sm, k (28, 32), k2tog, k (35, 39), sm, k (21, 24), k2tog, k (27, 30), k2tog, k(13, 15).

Size 6 only:

Shoulder Dec Rnd 2: with size A needles and CC6, *k to 2 sts before corner st, k2tog, k1, ssk*, rep * to * 1 time, k to next marker, sm, k5, k2tog, k11, *k2tog, k10* 2 times, k2tog, k11, k2tog, k12, sm, k12, *k2tog, k8* 2 times, k2tog, k9, *k2tog, k8* 2 times, k2tog, k4.

Size 8 only:

Shoulder Dec Rnd 2: with size A needles and CC6, *k to 2 sts before corner st, k2tog, k1, ssk*, rep * to * 1 time, k to next marker, sm, k6, k2tog, k11, *k2tog, k12* 2 times, k2tog, k11, k2tog, k15, sm, k14, k2tog, k10, *k2tog, k9* 3 times, k2tog, k10, k2tog, k4.

Size 9 only:

Shoulder Dec Rnd 2: with size A needles and CC6, *k to 2 sts before corner st, k2tog, k1, ssk*, rep * to * 1 time, k to next marker, sm, k4, *k2tog, k8* 6 times, k2tog, k13, sm, k14, k2tog, k6, *k2tog, k7* 4 times, *k2tog, k6* 2 times, k2tog, k3.

Size 10 only:

Shoulder Dec Rnd 2: with size A needles and CC6, *k to 2 sts before corner st, k2tog, k1, ssk*, rep * to * 1 time, k to next marker, sm, k12, k2tog, k22, k2tog, k22, k2tog, k21, sm, k19, *k2tog, k16* 3 times, k2tog, k8.

All sizes:

2 hem sts decreased; 1 body st front/back decreased; 14 (10, 6, 8) (2, 6, 2) (6, 8, 4) back shoulder sts; 13 (9, 5, 7) (1, 5, 1) (5, 7, 3) front shoulder sts.

You have 98 (98, 98, 98) (98, 114, 114) (114, 114, 114) body sts front/back, 2 corner sts, 82 (82, 82, 82) (82, 82, 98) (98, 114, 114) hem sts, 39 (47, 55, 55) (63, 63, 71) (71, 71, 79) back shoulder sts, and 40 (48, 56, 56) (64, 64, 72) (72, 72, 80) front shoulder sts on your needles.

Work a 3-st i-cord bind-off to BOR, replacing the stitch markers with removable markers as you work. Graft the two ends of the i-cord together with Kitchener stitch.

Work Chart B^{LEFT} (no pocket version), working the back rep 4 (4, 4, 4) (4, 5, 5) (5, 5, 5) times total, the hem rep 1 (1, 1, 1) (1, 1, 2) (2, 3, 3) time(s) total, and the front rep 9 (10, 11, 11) (12, 13, 14) (14, 14, 15) times total, and remembering to change to size B needles for the stranded rounds and to size A needles for the single-colour rounds.

Next row (WS): purling the mst tog with the next st as you come to them, p to next marker, rm, p to next marker, sm, p to next marker, rm, place the last 68 (74, 82, 88) (96, 104, 106) (110, 114, 124) sts on hold (these are your sleeve sts), p to end.

Next row (RS): k 68 (68, 68, 68) (68, 84, 84) (84, 84, 84), turn.

Next row (WS): p to end, turn.

Rep last two rows until you have 8 (8, 8, 8) (8, 8, 13.5) (13.5, 19, 19)cm / 3.25 (3.25, 3.25, 3.25) (3.25, 3.25, 5.25) (5.25, 7.5, 7.5)" of MC rows across the side (from CC12 row to CC12 row).

Graft the side sts together with Kitchener stitch.

Right Front Body

Place 116 (120, 123, 125) (129, 149, 153) (155, 157, 158) provisionally cast on sts onto size A needles. Every second st will be twisted. You can untwist every second st before you proceed, or knit every twisted stitch through its back loop as you knit the first row.

Work even in St st until work measures 3.5cm / 1.5" from cast on row ending after a RS row.

Neck shaping

Inc Row (WS): p to end, CO 2 sts. (2 sts increased.)

Next row (RS): k to end.

Rep last two rows 2 **more** times.

Then rep Inc Row **once**.

Then rep Inc Row **once**, purling the mst tog with the next st as you come to it.

End of Neck shaping.

Next row (RS): k to end. Break yarn and place these 124 (128, 131, 133) (137, 157, 161) (165, 167, 170) right front sts on hold.

Right Back Body

Work even in St st until work measures 3cm / 1.25" from cast on row ending after a WS row.

Short row 2 (WS): p to end.

Rep last four rows (2, 2) (3, 3, 4) **more** times, knitting the mst tog with the next st in the Inc Row as you come to it.

Then rep Inc Row **once**, knitting the mst tog with the next st as you come to it.

Next row (WS): p to end.

All sizes:

End of Neck shaping.

You have 151 (155, 158, 160) (164, 184, 188) (192, 194, 197) right back sts on your needles.

Work Hip Shaping Short Row Set **once more**. Do not break yarn. You will now join front and back.

Join Front and Back

Next row (RS): k the 151 (155, 158, 160) (164, 184, 188) (192, 194, 197) back right sts, knitting the mst tog with the next st as you come to it, CCO 8 (8, 9, 9) (9, 10, 10) (10, 10, 11) sts, pm, CCO 35 (35, 36, 36) (36, 37, 37) (37, 37, 38) sts, being careful not to twist the cast on sts, k the 124 (128, 131, 133) (137, 157, 161) (165, 167, 170) front right sts to end. *I recommend a cable cast on for stability over the shoulders at the neck.*

You have 318 (326, 334, 338) (346, 388, 396) (404,

408, 416) sts on your needles: 159 (163, 167, 169) (173, 194, 198) (202, 204, 208) sts front/back.

Sizes 1 (2, 3) only:

Work even in St st until the front body measures 6 (7, 7.5)cm / 2.25 (2.75, 3)" from the provisional cast on and ending after working a WS row. Break yarn.

Size 4 only:

Work even in St st until the front body measures 8cm / 3.25" from the provisional cast on and ending after working a RS row.

Short row 1 (WS): p 137, mst.

Short row 2 (RS): k to end.

Short row 3 (WS): p to 4 before last mst, mst.

Short row 4 (RS): k to end.

Rep last 2 short rows 2 **more** times.

Next row (WS): p to end, purling the mst tog with the next st as you come to them. Break yarn.

Sizes (5, 6, 7) (8, 9, 10) only:

Work even in St st until work measures 1cm / 0.5" from neck cast on and ending after working a RS row.

Extra Right Front Short Row Set

Short row 1 (WS): p (157, 175, 179) (181, 183, 187), mst.

Short row 2 (RS): k to end.

Short row 3 (WS): p to 11 sts before last mst, mst.

Short row 4 (RS): k to end.

Rep last two short rows (2, 2, 2) (2, 2, 4) **more** times.

End of Extra Right Front Short Row Set

Next row (WS): p to end, purling each mst tog with the next st as you come to them.

Dec Row (RS): k to 10 sts before marker, k2tog, k to marker, sm, k 8, ssk, k to end. (2 sts decreased).

Cont in St st working a Dec Row every (8th, 4th, 4th) (6th, 6th, 6th) row (1, 2, 2) (2, 2, 2) **more** time(s).

Work Extra Right Front Short Row Set **once more**.

Next row (WS): p to end, purling the mst tog with the next st as you come to them. Break yarn.

You have (342, 382, 390) (398, 402, 410) sts on your needles: (171, 191, 195) (199, 201, 205) sts front/back.

All sizes:

Next row (RS): with CC12 and leaving a 15cm / 6" tail of yarn that will be used in the i-cord hem, k 105 (105, 105, 105) (105, 121, 121) (121, 121, 121) sts, place BOR marker, k to end. Break CC12, leaving another tail of yarn that will be used in the i-cord hem. *Note: at this point, sts are not joined to work in the round but the BOR position is marked for working the left side colourwork band in the round.*

Right Side Colourwork Band

With size A needles and CC1, CO 94 (94, 94, 94) (94, 94, 110) (110, 126, 126) sts and purl them. Break CC1. These are your joining sts at the hemline; put these sts aside and you will knit them in the following step.

Set-up rnd: with size A needles and CC1, and with your body sts RS facing, sl sts to your RN until you reach the BOR marker, k 108 (116, 124, 128) (132, 140, 148) (156, 160, 168), pm (this is your front shoulder marker), k to end placing a removable marker through this last stitch to mark the front right colourwork corner, k the 94 (94, 94, 94) (94, 94, 110) (110, 126, 126) hemline sts, being very careful not to twist stitches join to the back body sts and k1 placing a removable marker through this last stitch to mark the back right colourwork corner, k to BOR. *Note: the BOR marker position when working the colourwork band is always the boundary between the shoulder sts and the body sts on the back side of the sweater.*

You have 412 (420, 428, 432) (436, 476, 500) (508, 528, 536) sts on your needles: 104 (104, 104, 104) (104, 120, 120) (120, 120, 120) body sts front/back, 2 corner sts, 94 (94, 94, 94) (94, 94, 110) (110, 126, 126) hem sts, 54 (58, 62, 64) (66, 70, 74) (78, 80, 84) shoulder sts front/back.

Shoulder Dec Rnd 1: k to 10 sts before next marker, k2tog, k to next marker, sm, k 8, ssk, k to next

marker, sm, *k to 2 sts before corner st, k2tog, k1, ssk (*Note: the corner stitch is the k1*)*, rep * to * one time, k to BOR. *6 sts decreased: 2 shoulder sts, 2 hem sts, 2 body sts.*

You have 406 (414, 422, 426) (430, 470, 494) (502, 522, 530) sts on your needles: 103 (103, 103, 103) (103, 119, 119) (119, 119, 119) body sts front/back, 2 corner sts, 92 (92, 92, 92) (92, 92, 108) (108, 124, 124) hem sts, 53 (57, 61, 63) (65, 69, 73) (77, 79, 83) shoulder sts front/back.

Work Chart A^{RIGHT}, working the front rep a total of 51 (53, 55, 56) (57, 63, 65) (67, 68, 70) times, the hem rep a total of 20 (20, 20, 20) (20, 20, 24) (24, 28, 28) times, and the back rep a total of 24 (24, 24, 24) (24, 28, 28) (28, 28, 28) times, and remembering to change to size B needles for the stranded rounds and to size A needles for the single-colour rounds.

When Chart A^{RIGHT} is complete you will have 99 (99, 99, 99) (99, 115, 115) (115, 115, 115) body sts front/back, 2 corner sts, 84 (84, 84, 84) (84, 84, 100) (100, 116, 116) hem sts, 53 (57, 61, 63) (65, 69, 73) (77, 79, 83) shoulder sts front/back.

Size 1 only:

Shoulder Dec Rnd 2: with size A needles and CC6, k2tog, *k2, k2tog* 3 times, *k1, k2tog* 7 times, *k2, k2tog* 3 times, k6, sm, k6, *k2tog, k1* 2 times, *k2tog, k2* 8 times, *k2tog, k1* 2 times, k2tog, k1, sm, *k to 2 sts before corner st, k2tog, k1, ssk*, rep * to * 1 time, k to BOR.

Size 2 only:

Shoulder Dec Rnd 2: with size A needles and CC6, k1, k2tog, k4, k2tog, *k3, k2tog* 7 times, k4, k2tog, k7, sm, k7, k2tog, k3, k2tog, *k4, k2tog* 6 times, k3, k2tog, k2, sm, *k to 2 sts before corner st, k2tog, k1, ssk*, rep * to * 1 time, k to BOR.

Next rnd: with CC2, *k to next marker, sm* 2 times, k to corner, k1, k to 1 st before next corner, m1l, k1, k to BOR. (1 hem st increased.)

Work a 3-st i-cord bind-off to BOR, replacing the stitch markers with removable markers as you work. Graft the two ends of the i-cord together with Kitchener stitch.

Next rnd: with CC8 and starting at the removable marker marking the BOR, pick up and k **evenly** 39 (47, 55, 55) (63, 63, 71) (71, 71, 79) back shoulder sts to next removable marker, remove removable marker and place stitch marker, pick up and k evenly 40 (48, 56, 56) (64, 64, 72) (72, 72, 80) front shoulder sts to next removable marker, remove removable marker and place stitch marker, pick up and k **evenly** 97 (97, 97, 97) (97, 113, 113) (113, 113, 113) front body sts, 1 corner st, 81 (81, 81, 81) (81, 81, 97) (97, 113, 113) hem sts, 1 corner st, 97 (97, 97, 97) (97, 113, 113) (113, 113, 113) back body sts to next removable marker, remove removable marker and place BOR marker. *Note: when picking up stitches along the i-cord, pick up along the 1st st along the i-cord edge. This 1st st will have curled towards the back.*

You have 97 (97, 97, 97) (97, 113, 113) (113, 113, 113) body sts front/back, 2 corner sts, 81 (81, 81, 81) (81, 81, 97) (97, 113, 113) hem sts, 39 (47, 55, 55) (63, 63, 71) (71, 71, 79) back shoulder sts, and 40 (48, 56, 56) (64, 64, 72) (72, 72, 80) front shoulder sts on your needles.

Work Chart B^{RIGHT}, working the front rep 9 (10, 11, 11) (12, 13, 14) (14, 14, 15) times total, the hem rep 1 (1, 1, 1) (1, 1, 2) (2, 3, 3) time(s) total, and the back rep 4 (4, 4, 4) (4, 5, 5) (5, 5, 5) times total, and remembering to change to size B needles for the stranded rounds and to size A needles for the single-colour rounds.

When Chart B^{RIGHT} is complete you will have 76 (76, 76) (76, 92, 92) (92, 92, 92) body sts front/back, 2 corner sts, 39 (39, 39, 39) (39, 39, 55) (55, 71, 71) hem sts, 39 (47, 55, 55) (63, 63, 71) (71, 71, 79) back shoulder sts, and 40 (48, 56, 56) (64, 64, 72) (72, 72, 80) front shoulder sts on your needles.

Work Chart C^{RIGHT}, working the front rep a total of 34 (36, 38, 40) (42, 46, 50) (50, 52, 54) times, the hem repeat a total of 5 (5, 5, 5) (5, 5, 9) (9, 13, 13) times, and the back rep a total of 16 (16, 16, 16) (16, 20, 20) (20, 20, 20) times, and remembering to change to size B needles for the stranded rounds and to size A needles for the single colour rounds.

Short row 7 (WS): p to 2 sts before last mst, mst.

Next row (WS): purling the mst tog with the next st as you come to them, p to next marker, rm, p to next marker, sm, p to next marker, rm, place the last 68 (74, 82, 88) (96, 104, 106) (110, 114, 124) sts on hold (these are your sleeve sts), p to end.

Next row (RS): k 68 (68, 68, 68) (68, 84, 84) (84, 84, 84), turn.

Next row (WS): p to end, turn.

Graft the side sts together with Kitchener stitch.

Place the 68 (74, 82, 88) (96, 104, 106) (110, 114, 124) sts onto desired needles for knitting small circumferences. There should be a stitch marker halfway between these stitces marking the centre of the sleeve cap.

Set-up rnd: with size A needles and MC, and starting at the cenre of the underarm, pick up and k 5 (5, 5, 5) (6, 7, 9) (9, 15, 15) underarm sts (picking up one or two in the corner), k 68 (74, 82, 88) (96, 104, 106) (110, 114, 124) sleeve sts, pick up and k 5 (5, 5, 5) (6, 7, 9) (11, 15, 15) underarm sts (picking up one or two in the corner), place BOR marker for working in the round.

You have 78 (84, 92, 98) (108, 118, 124) (132, 144, 154) sleeve sts on your needles.

Sleeve Cap Shaping

Cap short row 1 (RS): k to next marker, k 13 (14, 16, 17) (18, 20, 21) (22, 24, 26), mst.

Cap short row 2 (WS): p to next marker, p 13 (14, 16, 17) (18, 20, 21) (22, 24, 26), mst.

Cap short row 3 (RS): k to next mst, k the mst tog with the next st, k3, mst.

Cap short row 4 (WS): p to last mst, p the mst tog with the next st, p3, mst.

Rep last two cap short rows 3 (3, 4, 4) (5, 6, 6) (6, 6, 7) **more** times.

Next row (RS): k to BOR, knitting the mst to with the next st.

End of Sleeve Cap Shaping

Rnd 1: k to 1 st before next mst, place the mst on the LN in front of the next st and k2tog, k to BOR. (Note: you will probably need to adjust this mst stitch to tidy it up after you work several more rounds.)

Sizes (3, 4) (5, 6, 7) (8, 9, 10) only:

Work even in St st until sleeve measures (6.5, 6.5) (2.5, 2.5, 2.5) (2.5, 2.5, 2.5) cm / (2.5, 2.5) (1, 1, 1) (1, 1, 1)" from underarm.

Dec Rnd: k1, ssk, k to 3 sts before BOR, k2tog, k1. (2 sts decreased.)

Work in St st rep a Dec Rnd every (0th, 0th) (20th, 10th, 8th) (8th, 6th, 4th) rnd (0, 0) (1, 1, 3) (3, 6, 9) **more** time(s), then every (0th, 0th) (0th, 12th, 0th) (0th, 0th, 0th) rnd (0, 0) (0, 2, 0) (0, 0, 0) times.

All sizes:

You have 78 (84, 90, 96) (104, 110, 116) (124, 130, 134) sts on your needles.

Work even in St st until sleeve measures 13 cm / 5" from underarm or to desired length allowing for 8cm / 3.25" over the cuff and 27cm / 10.75" over the colourwork.

Size 1 only:

Inc Rnd: k6, *m1l, k13* 5 times, m1l, k7.

You have 84 sts on your needles.

All sizes:

Identify and use Sleeve Chart according to your garment size.

Work Sleeve Chart, working the rep 5 times around, remembering to change to size A needles on the single colour rnds and to size B needles on the multicolour rnds, and working the decreases into the pattern. *Note: no sts are decreased in the Sleeve Chart for sizes 1 (2, 3, 4). Note: when picking up stitches along the i-cord, pick up along the 1st st along the i-cord edge. This 1st st will have curled towards the back.*

When Sleeve Chart is complete you have 84 (84, 90, 96) (96, 96, 96) (102, 102, 102) sts on your needles.

Cuff

Dec Rnd: with size A needles and MC, *k1, k2tog* 28 (28, 30, 32) (32, 32, 32) (34, 34, 34) times. You have 56 (56, 60, 64) (64, 64, 64) (68, 68, 68) sts.

Next rnd: k to end.

Next rnd: *k1, p1*, rep from * to * to end.

Rep last two rnds until cuff measures 8cm / 3.25" or to desired length.

BO using the Long Tail Tubular Bind Off (see Special Techniques).

Rep sleeve directions for other sleeve.

i-cord Collar

With size A needles and MC, starting at the centre back neck, pick up and k evenly 10 sts across back neck, 7 (7, 7, 7) (7, 7, 7) (8, 8, 8) sts up left back neck, 43 (43, 45, 45) (45, 47, 47) (47, 47, 49) sts along left neck, 10 (10, 10, 10) (10, 10, 10) (11, 11, 11) sts down front left neck, 20 sts along front neck, 10 (10, 10, 10) (10, 10, 10) (11, 11, 11) sts up front right neck, 43 (43, 45, 45) (45, 47, 47) (47, 47, 49) sts along right neck, 7 (7, 7, 7) (7, 7, 7) (8, 8, 8) sts down right back neck, and 10 sts across remaining back neck.

You have 160 (160, 164, 164) (164, 168, 168) (172, 172, 176) sts on your needles.

Work 4-st i-cord bind-off. Break yarn and graft ends of i-cord together.

i-cord Hem

With size A needles and starting at the back left corner where the stranded band meets the MC stockinette, with MC pick up and k evenly 41 (48, 69, 72) (84, 94, 93) (112, 115, 125) sts along the back hem selvedge to the next stranded band corner and break yarn, with CC1 pick up and k evenly 94 (94, 94, 94) (94, 94, 110) (110, 126, 126) sts along the stranded hem edge, to the next stranded band corner and break yarn, with MC pick up and k evenly 35 (40, 43, 56) (76, 86, 85) (100, 103, 117) sts along the front hem selvedge to the next stranded band corner, break yarn, with CC1 pick up and k evenly 94 (94, 94, 94) (94, 94, 110) (110, 126, 126) sts along the stranded hem edge, to the next stranded band corner and break yarn.

You have 264 (276, 300, 316) (348, 368, 398) (432, 470, 494) sts on your needles.

With MC work a 4-st i-cord bind-off to 1 st before end of MC sts, with CC12 work a 4-st i-cord bind-off once, with CC1 work a 4-st i-cord bind-off to 1 st before end of CC1 sts, with CC12 work a 4-st i-cord bind-off once, with MC work a 4-st i-cord bind-off to 1 st before end of MC sts, with CC12 work a 4-st i-cord bind-off once, with CC1 work a 4-st i-cord bind-off to 1 st before end of CC1 sts. Break yarn and with CC12 graft ends of i-cord together. *Note: when working the i-cord bind off with CC12 you can use the tail of CC12 leftover at the hemline which is leftover from the CC12 stripe.*

Finishing

Carefully sew with mattress stitch the selvedge of side stockinette to bound off sts along stranded band at the side.

Flip the pocket so that it is outside of the sweater and not tucked in, with RS facing and CC8, sew with mattress stitch the sides of the pocket together. To keep the pocket looking invisible, take care to neatly close any holes at the top of the pocket where it joins and the pattern continues along the front of the sweater. Tuck the pocket back inside the sweater and enjoy!
