MATERIALS

2 (3) 3 (4) 4 skeins of Winter Glow Solid, color Cream (02)

2 (3) 3 (4) 4 skeins of Winter Glow Solid, color Graphite (05)

4 (5) 6 (7) 8 skeins of Diablo, color Silver (05)

Circular needle 5 mm (US 8) 80 cm (31.5")

Circular needle 6 mm (US 10) 80 cm (31.5")

Stitch markers

Darning needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Winter Glow Solid**, Hobbii

51% wool, 49% polyacrylic

100 g (3.5 oz) = 350 m (382 yds)

 **Diablo**, Hobbii

40% acrylic, 30% mohair, 30% polyamide

25 g (0.9 oz) = 225 m (246 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 12 sts x 16 rows

2 strands of Winter Glow and 1 strand of Diablo held together!

SIZE

XS (S) M (L) XL

MEASUREMENTS

Bust circumference: 85 (95) 105 (115) 125 cm / 33 (38) 42 (46) 50"

Length: 28 (30) 32 (32) 33 cm / 11 (12) 12 (13) 13", measured from under the sleeve

PATTERN INFORMATION

The simple raglan sweater is knitted from the top down. It has a cozy turtleneck and extra-long sleeves. The sweater is worked with 2 strands of Winter Glow and 1 strand of Diablo held together.

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit

P = purl

CO = cast on

BO = bind off

PM = place marker

SM = stitch marker

M1L = insert the left-hand needle from front to back, under the bar between the stitches and knit it through the back loop

M1R = insert the left-hand needle from back to front, under the bar between the stitches and knit it through the front loop

INFO AND TIPS

It has approximately 15cm / 6" of positive ease built in. Choose the size closest to your bust measurement. If you are in between the sizes: choose the bigger size.

NECK

Co 60 stitches on a 5 mm (US 8) circular needle. Place a stitch marker at the beginning of the round. Start working 1x1 ribbing (knit 1, purl 1) in the round. Knit until the neck measures 22 cm (9").

Change to 6mm (US 10) circular needle and place markers:

k 8, PM, k 3, PM, k 8, PM, k 3, PM, k 16, PM, k 3, PM, k 8, PM, k 3, PM, k 8

RAGLAN

Round 1: knit to M, M1R, slip M, knit 3, slip M, M1L, knit to M, M1R, slip M, knit 3, slip M, M1L, knit to M, M1R, slip M, knit 3, slip M, M1L, knit to M, M1R, slip M, knit 3, slip M, M1L, knit to the beginning of the round

Round 2: Knit all stitches

Repeat these two rounds a total of 13 (16) 19 (22) 25 times.
You should have 164 (188) 212 (236) 260 stitches on the needle.

Separate for the sleeves: Knit to the first SM, remove the marker and knit the 3 raglan stitches, remove the second marker and put the sleeve stitches on waste yarn. CO 3 stitches, PM, Co 3 stitches, remove the 3rd marker, knit the raglan stitches and remove the 4th marker. Knit to the 5th marker, remove the marker, knit the raglan stitches and remove the 6th marker. Put the sleeve stitches on waste yarn and CO 3 stitches, PM, Co 3 stitches. Remove the 7th marker and knit the next 3 stitches, remove the last marker. Knit to the end of the round.

BODY

Knit in stockinette stitch until your work measures 28 (30) 32 (32) 33 cm, 11 (12) 12 (13) 13" (measured from the CO stitches under the arm):

Split hem:

Back: Change to 5mm (US 8) circular needle and knit to the first side stitch marker, turn your work. Purl to the beginning of the row and remove the SM. Purl to the second side SM, turn. Work in 1x1 ribbing for 10 rows. BO the stitches.

Front: With 5mm (US 8) circular needle: work 10 rows of 1x1 ribbing and BO all of the stitches.

SLEEVES

Pick up the sleeve stitches with a 6mm (US 10) circular needle and knit 42 cm (16") of stockinette stitch (measured from the CO stitches under the arm). Change to 5mm (US 8) circular needle and work 10 rows of 1x1 ribbing. BO the stitches.

Repeat for the second sleeve.

Weave in all of the ends.
