## NEEDLES & EXTRAS

3½ mm (US 4) circular needle - at least 120 cm for the body and 80 cm for the sleeves.

3¾ mm (US 5) circular needle - at least 120 cm for the body and 80 cm for the sleeves.

One 4 mm (US 6) needle for cast off.

Stitch holders - 2 extra cables for use as stitch holders. Markers.

Buttons 5 x 16 mm.

I recommend interchangeable circular needles and cables.

## TENSION

21 sts x 28 rows to 10 cm (4") measured over st st using 3¾mm (US 5) needles and yarn held DOUBLE.

21 sts x 32 rows to 10 cm (4") measured over patt using 3¾mm (US 5) needles and yarn held DOUBLE.

## ABBREVIATIONS & TECHNIQUES

**dec** = decrease

**inc** = increase

**K** = knit

**k2tog** = knit 2 sts together

**RLI** (Right Lifted Increase) = Lift right leg of the stitch below the next stitch on the left-hand needle onto the left-hand needle and knit it

**LLI** (Left Lifted Increase): Lift the left leg of the stitch 2 rows below the stitch on right-hand needle onto left-hand needle and knit it through the back loop

**m ds** = **make doubled stitch (German short rows)**

Step 1: With yarn in front, slip the next stitch as if to purl.

Step 2: Move the yarn to the other side of the work – not in front of the right needle, but over it! This will pull the single strand stitch with it, turning it into an interesting two strand version. (**Note!** These 2 strands still counts as 1 stitch.)

Continue knitting as pattern instructs.

**patt** = pattern

**P** = purl

**rep** = repeat

**RS** = right side

**ss, selvage st** = purl first st and knit last st tbl on all rows

**ssk** (slip, slip, knit) = slip 2 sts one at a time as if to knit, insert left needle into these sts and knit them together tbl

**ssp** (slip, slip, purl) = slip 2 sts one at a time as if to knit, slip the 2 sts back to left needle without twisting them and purl them together tbl

**st st** = stocking stitch

**st(s)** = stitch(es)

**tbl** = through back loop

**tog** = together

**yfwd** = yarn forward

**WS** = wrong side

**Read this before you start knitting!**

1. Back and fronts are knitted in one piece up to armholes, then divided and each piece is knitted separately. The shoulders are formed by German short row and then joined (3-needle cast-off). Sleeves worked flat bottom up and sewn on. The sleeves are seamed with 1 selvedge stitch, using mattress stitch.
2. When shaping the shoulder with German short rows, e.g "knit to 5 sts before turn", always treat a doubled stitch as just one of the five sts.
3. **NOTE! The entire work is knitted in DOUBLE yarns as follows:**  
 A Light grey = 1 thread Kid Seta 506 + 1 thread Cottonwool 3 Organic 506 held together.  
 B Dark grey = 1 thread Kid Seta 510 + 1 thread Cottonwool 3 Organic 148 held together.  
 C Orange = 1 thread Kid Seta 1411 + 1 thread Cottonwool 3 Organic 208 held together.
4. Pattern with stripes are knitted back and forth on a circular needle using slip sts. When you only work 1 row of each color, you work from the same side 2 times and only turn the work every other row. Just push the sts to the beginning again. In the instruction you see if a row is to be worked from WS or RS, it also says turn when to turn.  
**Tip!** Keep the colors on each side of the body when knitting the pattern to avoid mess up.

**INSTRUCTION****BODY**

(worked in one piece up to armholes)

Using 3¾mm (US 5) circular needle and yarn B (see note), cast on 259 [279: 299: 319: 339] sts.

Change to 3½mm (US 4) circular needle.

Work in g st for 2 rows, beg with a RS row and ending with RS facing for next row, do NOT turn after last row.

Change to 3¾mm (US 5) circular needle.

Work in patt as folls:

**\*\*Row 1 (WS):** using A, 1 ss, purl to last st, 1 ss, turn.

**Row 2 (RS):** using B, 1 ss, knit to last st, 1 ss.

**Row 3 (RS):** using A from the same side as row 2, 1 ss, knit to last st, 1 ss, turn.

**Row 4 (WS):** using B, 1 ss, p2, \*slip 3 sts purlwise with yarn at front of work, p7, rep from \* until 6 sts rem, slip 3 sts purlwise with yarn at front of work, p2, 1 ss.

**Row 5 (WS):** using A from the same side as row 4, 1 ss, purl to last st, 1 ss, turn.

**Row 6 (RS):** using B, 1 ss, k2, \*slip 3 sts purlwise with yarn at back of work, k7, rep from \* until 6 sts rem, slip 3 sts purlwise with yarn at back of work, k2, 1 ss.

**Row 7 (RS):** using A from the same side as row 6, 1 ss, knit to last st, 1 ss, turn.

**Row 8 (WS):** as row 4.

**Row 9 (WS):** as row 1.

**Row 10 (RS):** as row 2.

**Row 11 (RS):** as row 3.

**Row 12 (WS):** using B, 1 ss, p7, \*slip 3 sts purlwise with yarn at front of work, p7, rep from \* until 11 sts rem, slip 3 sts purlwise with yarn at front of work, p7, 1 ss.

**Row 13 (WS):** using A from the same side as row 12, 1 ss, purl to last st, 1 ss, turn.

**Row 14 (RS):** using B, 1 ss, k7, \*slip 3 sts purlwise with yarn at back of work, k7, rep from \* until 11 sts rem, slip 3 sts purlwise with yarn at back of work, k7, 1 ss.

**Row 15 (RS):** using A from the same side as row 14, 1 ss, knit to last st, 1 ss, turn.

**Row 16 (WS):** as row 12.

These 16 rows form patt.

Rep last 16 rows 2 times more, then work rows 1 – 11 once more (work should meas approx 19cm (7½in)).

Break off yarn B and join in yarn C (keep yarn A).

Begin with a K row, cont in st st and stripes as folls:

**Row 1 (RS):** using C, 1 ss, knit to last st, 1 ss, turn.

**Row 2 (WS):** using A, 1 ss, purl to last st, 1 ss.

**Row 3 (WS):** using C from the same side as row 2, 1 ss, purl to last st, 1 ss, turn.

**Row 4 (RS):** using A, 1 ss, knit to last st, 1 ss.

**Row 5 (RS):** using C from the same side as row 4, 1 ss, knit to last st, 1 ss turn.\*\*

Break off yarn C.

Begin with a P row and cont in st st throughout in yarn A only, beg and end every row with 1 ss.

Work until body meas approx 31 [32: 33: 35: 36] cm (12¼ [12⅝: 13: 13¾: 14⅞] in), ending with RS facing for next row.

**Divide for fronts and back**

K64 [69: 74: 79: 84] sts, turn and leave rem sts onto a holder or cable.

**RIGHT FRONT**

**Next row (WS):** cast on 1 st at beg (sleeve edge), purl to last st, 1 ss = 65 [70: 75: 80: 85] sts.

Beg and end every row with 1 ss, cont in st st as folls: Work 15 [17: 19: 15: 17] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

**Shape V-neck**

**Row 1 (RS):** 1 ss, ssk, knit to last st, 1 ss.

Place a marker at beg of last row denote beg of V-neck.

**Row 2 (WS):** 1 ss, purl to last st, 1 ss.

**Row 3 (RS):** 1 ss, knit to last st, 1 ss.

**Row 4 (WS):** 1 ss, purl to last 3 sts, ssp, 1 ss.

**Row 5 (RS):** as row 3.

**Row 6 (WS):** as row 2.

Cont dec 1 st at neck edge on every 3rd row in this way (alternately from a RS and WS row) in total 12 [12: 12: 14: 14] times, ending after dec row 4 and with RS facing for next row = 53 [58: 63: 66: 71] sts.

(Armhole should now meas approx 17.5 [18.5: 19: 20: 20.5]cm, 6⅞ [7¼: 7½: 7⅞: 8⅞]in.)

**Shape shoulder using German short row and cont dec for V-neck**

**Row 1 (RS):** 1 ss, knit until 5 [6: 6: 6: 7] sts rem, turn.

**Row 2 (WS):** mds, purl to last st, 1 ss.

**Row 3 (RS):** 1 ss, ssk, knit to 5 [6: 6: 6: 7] sts before turn, turn.

**Row 4 (WS):** as row 2.

**Row 5 (RS):** 1 ss, knit to 5 [6: 6: 6: 7] sts before turn, turn.

**Row 6 (WS):** mds, purl to last 3 sts, ssp, 1 ss.

**Row 7 (RS):** as row 5.

**Row 8 (WS):** as row 2.

**Row 9 (RS):** 1 ss, ssk, knit to 5 [6: 6: 6: 7] sts before turn, turn.

**Row 10 (WS):** as row 2.

**Row 11 (RS):** 1 ss, knit to 5 [6: 6: 6: 6] sts before turn, turn.

**Row 12 (WS):** as row 6.

**Row 13 (RS):** 1 ss, knit to 5 [4: 6: 6: 6] sts before turn, turn.

**Row 14 (WS):** as row 2.

**Row 15 (RS):** 1 ss, ssk, knit to 4 [4: 5: 6: 6] sts before turn, turn.

**Row 16 (WS):** as row 2.

**Row 17 (RS):** 1 ss, knit to 4 [4: 5: 6: 6] sts before turn, turn.

**Row 18 (WS):** as row 6.

(It should now be 4 [4: 5: 6: 6] sts left after last turn.)

**Row 19 (RS):** knit all sts (remembering to knit two loops of doubled stitches together) = 47 [52: 57: 60: 65] sts.

Leave sts onto a holder or cable.

**BACK**

With RS facing, using 3¾mm (US 5) circular needle cont work from 1st holder as folls:

**Next row (RS):** RLI, k131 [141: 151: 161: 171] sts, LLI, turn and leave rem sts onto a holder = 133 [143: 153: 163: 173] sts.

(It should now be 64 [69: 74: 79: 84] sts left for left front.)

Beg with a **P** row and beg and end every row with 1 ss, cont in st st for 49 [51: 53: 55: 57] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

**Shape shoulder using German short row**

**Row 1 (RS):** 1 ss, knit until 5 [6: 6: 6: 7] sts rem, turn.

**Row 2 (WS):** mds, purl until 5 [6: 6: 6: 7] sts rem, turn.

**Row 3 (RS):** mds, knit to 5 [6: 6: 6: 7] sts before turn, turn.

**Row 4 (WS):** mds, purl to 5 [6: 6: 6: 7] sts before turn, turn.

**Row 5 – 10:** as row 3 – 4, 3 times.

**Row 11 (RS):** mds, knit to 5 [6: 6: 6: 6] sts before turn, turn.

**Row 12 (WS):** mds, purl to 5 [6: 6: 6: 6] sts before turn, turn.

**Row 13 (RS):** mds, knit to 5 [4: 6: 6: 6] sts before turn, turn.

**Row 14 (WS):** mds, purl to 5 [4: 6: 6: 6] sts before turn, turn.

**Row 15 (RS):** mds, k15 [15: 18: 21: 21] sts, turn = 16 [16: 19: 22: 22] sts.

Work each side of neck separately.

**Right shoulder**

**Next row (WS):** p1, p2tog, purl to 4 [4: 5: 6: 6] sts before turn, turn.

**Next row (RS):** mds, knit until 3 sts rem, k2tog, k1.

**Next row (WS):** p1, p2tog, purl to 4 [4: 5: 6: 6] sts before turn, turn.

**Next row (RS):** mds, knit until 3 sts rem, k2tog, k1. (It should now be 4 [4: 5: 6: 6] sts left after last turn.)

**Next row (WS):** purl all sts (remembering to purl two loops of doubled stitches together) = 47 [52: 57: 60: 65] sts.

**Join right shoulder 3-needle cast-off/bind-off**

Transfer live sts on right front to open needles 3¾mm (US 5). Holding RS of front against RS of back, using a 3rd needle 4mm (US 6) and join shoulder seams by casting off all sts together, taking one st from 1st needle with corresponding st from 2nd needle.

**Left shoulder (back)**

With RS facing, slip centre 31 [31: 31: 35: 35] sts onto a holder, rejoin yarn and knit to 4 [4: 5: 6: 6] sts before turn, turn.

**Next row (WS):** mds, purl to last 3 sts, ssp, p1.

**Next row (RS):** k1, ssk, knit to 4 [4: 5: 6: 6] sts before turn, turn.

**Next row (WS):** mds, purl to last 3 sts, ssp, p1.

(It should now be 5 [5: 6: 7: 7] sts left after last turn.)

**Next row (RS):** k1, ssk, cont knit all sts (remembering to knit two loops of doubled stitches together) = 47 [52: 57: 60: 65] sts.

Leave sts onto a holder or cable.

**LEFT FRONT**

With RS facing, using 3¼mm (US 5) circular needle and cont work on 64 [69: 74: 79: 84] sts from left front holder as folls:

**Next row (RS):** RLI (armhole edge), knit to last st, 1 ss = 65 [70: 75: 80: 85] sts.

Beg with a **P** row and beg and end every row with 1 ss, cont in st st for 15 [17: 19: 15: 17] rows, ending with RS facing for next row.

**Shape V-neck**

**Row 1 (RS):** 1 ss, knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, 1 ss.

Place a marker at end of last row to denote beg of V-neck.

**Row 2 (WS):** 1 ss, purl to last st, 1 ss.

**Row 3 (RS):** 1 ss, knit to last st, 1 ss.

**Row 4 (WS):** 1 ss, p2tog, purl to last st, 1 ss.

**Row 5 (RS):** as row 3.

**Row 6 (WS):** as row 2.

Cont dec 1 st at neck edge on every 3rd row in this way (alternately from a RS and WS row) in total 12 [12: 12: 14: 14] times, ending after dec row 4 and with RS facing for next row = 53 [58: 63: 66: 71] sts.

(Armhole should now meas approx 17.5 [18.5: 19: 20: 20.5]cm, 6⅞ [7¼: 7½: 7⅞: 8½]in.)

**Shape shoulder using German short row and cont dec for V-neck**

**Row 1 (RS):** 1 ss, knit to last st, 1 ss.

**Row 2 (WS):** 1 ss, purl until 5 [6: 6: 6: 7] sts rem, turn.

**Row 3 (RS):** mds, knit until 3 sts rem, k2tog, 1 ss.

**Row 4 (WS):** 1 ss, purl to 5 [6: 6: 6: 7] sts before turn, turn.

**Row 5 (RS):** mds, knit to last st, 1 ss.

**Row 6 (WS):** 1 ss, p2tog, purl to 5 [6: 6: 6: 7] sts before turn, turn.

**Row 7 (RS):** as row 5.

**Row 8 (WS):** 1 ss, purl to 5 [6: 6: 6: 7] sts before turn, turn.

**Row 9 (RS):** as row 3.

**Row 10 (WS):** 1 ss, purl to 5 [6: 6: 6: 7] sts before turn, turn.

**Row 11 (RS):** as row 5.

**Row 12 (WS):** 1 ss, p2tog, purl to 5 [6: 6: 6: 6] sts before turn, turn.

**Row 13 (RS):** as row 5.

**Row 14 (WS):** 1 ss, purl to 5 [4: 6: 6: 6] sts before turn, turn.

**Row 15 (RS):** as row 3.

**Row 16 (WS):** 1 ss, purl to 4 [4: 5: 6: 6] sts before turn, turn.

**Row 17 (RS):** as row 5.

**Row 18 (WS):** 1 ss, p2tog, purl to 4 [4: 5: 6: 6] sts before turn, turn.

**Row 19 (RS):** as row 5.

(It should now be 4 [4: 5: 6: 6] sts left after last turn.)

**Row 20 (WS):** purl all sts (remembering to purl two loops of doubled stitches together) = 47 [52: 57: 60: 65] sts.

Join left shoulder in the same way as right shoulder.

**SLEEVES**

Using 3¼mm (US 5) circular needle and yarn B (see note), cast on 49 [49: 49: 59: 59] sts.

Change to 3½mm (US 4) circular needle.

Beg and end every row with 1 ss.

Work in g st for 2 rows, beg with a RS row and ending with RS facing for next row, do NOT turn after last row.

Change to 3¼mm (US 5) circular needle.

Work in patt as given for back from \*\* - \*\*, and **at same time** inc 1 st at each end of 10th row, then every 8th row 6 [3: 3: 6: 6] times and then every 4th row 0 [6: 6: 0: 0] times, take inc sts into patt when it is possible = 63 [69: 69: 73: 73] sts.

Break off yarn C.

Begin with a **P** row and cont in st st throughout in yarn A only, as folls:

Inc 1 st at each end of 2nd row, then on every 6th row 4 [4: 5: 5: 2] times and then on every 4th row 0 [0: 0: 0: 4] times = 73 [79: 81: 85: 87] sts.

Cont straight until sleeve meas 34 cm (13⅜in), ending with RS facing for next row.

**Shape top with German shortrow**

**Row 1 (RS):** 1 ss, knit until 6 sts rem, turn.

**Row 2 (WS):** mds, purl until 6 sts rem, turn.

**Row 3 (RS):** mds, knit to 6 sts before turn, turn.

**Row 4 (WS):** mds, purl to 6 sts before turn, turn.

**Row 5 – 10:** as row 3 – 4, 3 times.

**Row 11 (RS):** mds, knit to last st (remembering to knit two loops of doubled stitches together), 1 ss.

**Row 12 (WS):** 1 ss, purl to last st (remembering to purl two loops of doubled stitches together), 1 ss.

Mark centre stitch (for shoulder point).

Using needle 4mm (US 6), cast off on RS.

**FINISHING**

Pin out garment to measurement given. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry.

**Front band**

With RS facing, using 3½mm (US 4) circular needle and yarn A, beg and ending at front cast on edges, pick up 78 [80: 84: 84: 90] sts up right front opening edge to marker at beg of V-neck, 43 [43: 43: 47: 47] sts up right V-neck, 5 sts down right side of back neck, K across 31 [31: 31: 35: 35] sts on back holder, pick up 5 sts up left side of back neck, 43 [43: 43: 47: 47] sts down left V-neck to marker and 78 [80: 84: 84: 90] sts down left front opening edge = 283 [287: 295: 307: 319] sts.

Work in g st for 3 rows.

Work 5 buttonholes as folls:



**Row 4 Buttonholes (RS):** k3 [4: 4: 4: 3] sts, \* yfwd (to make a buttonhole), k2tog, k16 [16: 17: 17: 19] sts, rep from \* 3 times more, yfwd, k2tog, K to end.

Work in g st for a further 3 rows.

Using needle 3¾mm (US 5), cast off on RS.

Sew sleeve seams, using 1 ss as your seam allowance.

Sew sleeves into armholes, matching marker at shoulder point. Sew on buttons. Weave in ends.
