### Knitting Pattern S111 - Intermediate

#### Size:

Small (Medium, Large, 1X, 2X). Instructions are for the smallest size with changes for other sizes in parentheses as necessary.

#### Materials:

- Cascade Yarns<sup>®</sup> 220 Sport: 100% Peruvian Highland Wool; 50 g (1.75 oz); 164 yds (150 m):
  - 3 (3, 3, 4, 4) skeins #8400 Charcoal Grey (A)
  - 2 (2, 2, 3, 3) skeins #8012 Doeskin Heather (B)
  - 2 (2, 2, 3, 3) skeins #8010 Natural (C)
  - 2 (2, 2, 3, 3) skeins #8401 Silver Grey (D)
  - 2 (2, 2, 3, 3) skeins #9675 Cocoa Brown (E)
  - 2 (2, 2, 3, 4) skeins #4002 Jet (F)
- US 4 (3.5 mm) knitting needles
- US 6 (4.0 mm) knitting needles
- 7 Buttons, 1 1/8"

#### Finished Measurements:

Bust: 36 (40, 44, 48, 52)" Length: 24"

#### Gauge:

22 sts x 31 rows = 4" (10 cm) in stockinette stitch, blocked

#### Begin Pattern:

**Left Sleeve Stripe Pattern:** (Only work the number of rows indicated for your size) 20 rows D, 10 rows E, 6 rows B, 14 rows F, 6 rows C, 20 rows A, 6 rows D, 12 rows B, 10 rows F, 18 rows D, 4 rows E, 10 rows C, 20 rows E, 8 rows A, 10 rows B.

#### Back:

With the smaller needles and A, cast on 100 (112, 122, 134, 144) stitches. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 1/2".



**Right Sleeve Stripe Pattern:** (Only work the number of rows indicated for your size)

4 rows E, 10 rows B, 20 rows D, 8 rows C, 14 rows A, 6 rows F, 10 rows B, 4 rows E, 10 rows D, 4 rows A, 20 rows E, 6 rows C, 20 rows B, 10 rows F, 4 rows D, 12 rows C, 6 rows E, 6 rows C.

Change to the larger needles, and begin Back Chart 1.

Continue working the chart in Stockinette Stitch

#### Abbreviations:

K = Knit  
P = Purl  
RS = Right side  
St(s) = Stitch(es)

working the middle 82 stitches in the large chart with the stitches on either side worked in the side charts.

When Row 86 is completed, begin Back Chart 2.

After Row 174, bind off.

### Left Front:

With the smaller needles and A, cast on 46 (52, 58, 64, 69) stitches. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½”.

Change to the larger needles, and begin Left Front Chart 1.

Continue working the chart in Stockinette Stitch, working the 46 stitches in the chart with the stitches on the right-hand side worked in the side chart.

When Row 86 is completed, begin Left Front Chart 2, working neck shaping as shown in chart.

After Row 174, bind off.

### Right Front:

Same as Left Front except use the Right Front charts.

### Left Sleeve:

With the smaller needles and A, cast on 52 stitches.

Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½”.

Change to the larger needles, Stockinette Stitch, and increase 1 stitch each side every other row 0 (0, 0, 0, 2) times, every 4 rows 7 (8, 21, 25, 25) times, then every 6 rows 17 (16, 6, 2, 0) times, working in the Stripe Pattern for Left Sleeve—100 (100, 106, 106, 106) stitches.

Continue even in the Stripe Pattern for Left Sleeve until the piece measures approximately 19 ½ (19, 18, 17, 16)” from the beginning. Bind off.

### Right Sleeve:

Same as Left Sleeve, except use the Stripe Pattern for Right Sleeve.

### Finishing:

Block pieces to finished measurements.

Sew shoulder seams, leaving the middle 40 (40, 42, 42, 42) stitches unsewn for back of neck.

### Neckband:

With the RS facing, the smaller needles, and A, pick up and knit 85 stitches along the neckline. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½”. Bind off in the pattern.

### Buttonband:

With the RS facing, the smaller needles, and A, pick up and knit 165 stitches along the Left Front. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½”. Bind off in the pattern. Place markers for 7 buttons, placing the first ¼” from the neck opening and the last ¼” from the lower edge.

### Buttonhole Band:

Same as Buttonband for ¾”.

Make buttonholes opposite markers by binding off 3 stitches; on the next row, cast on 3 stitches over the bound off stitches of the previous row. Complete same as buttonband. Place markers 9 (9, 9 ½, 9 ½, 9 ½)” down from shoulders. Set in sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.

### Gauge:

In Stockinette Stitch with the larger needles, 22 stitches and 31 rows = 4”, blocked. To save time, take time to check gauge.

**Left Sleeve Stripe Pattern:** (Only work the number of rows indicated for your size) 20 rows D, 10 rows E, 6 rows B, 14 rows F, 6 rows C, 20 rows A, 6 rows D, 12 rows B, 10 rows F, 18 rows D, 4 rows E, 10 rows C, 20 rows E, 8 rows A, 10 rows B.

**Right Sleeve Stripe Pattern:** (Only work the number of rows indicated for your size) 4 rows E, 10 rows B, 20 rows D, 8 rows C, 14 rows A, 6 rows F, 10 rows B, 4 rows E, 10 rows D, 4 rows A, 20 rows E, 6 rows C, 20 rows B, 10 rows F, 4 rows D, 12 rows C, 6 rows E, 6 rows C.



**Back:**

With the smaller needles and A, cast on 100 (112, 122, 134, 144) stitches. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½”.

Change to the larger needles, and begin Back Chart 1.

Continue working the chart in Stockinette Stitch, working the middle 82 stitches in the large chart with the stitches on either side worked in the side charts. When Row 86 is completed, begin Back Chart 2. After Row 174, bind off.

**Left Front:**

With the smaller needles and A, cast on 46 (52, 58, 64, 69) stitches. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½”. Change to the larger needles, and begin Left Front Chart 1. Continue working the chart in Stockinette Stitch, working the 46 stitches in the chart with the stitches on the right-hand side worked in the side chart. When Row 86 is completed, begin Left Front Chart 2, working neck shaping as shown in chart.

After Row 174, bind off.

**Right Front:**

Same as Left Front except use the Right Front charts.

**Left Sleeve:**

With the smaller needles and A, cast on 52 stitches. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½”. Change to the larger needles, Stockinette Stitch, and increase 1 stitch each side every other row 0 (0, 0, 0, 2) times, every 4 rows 7 (8, 21, 25, 25) times, then every 6 rows 17 (16, 6, 2, 0) times, working in the Stripe Pattern for Left Sleeve–100 (100, 106, 106, 106) stitches. Continue even in the Stripe Pattern for Left Sleeve until the piece measures approximately 19 ½ (19, 18, 17, 16)” from the beginning. Bind off.

**Right Sleeve:**

Same as Left Sleeve, except use the Stripe Pattern for Right Sleeve.

**Finishing:**

Block pieces to finished measurements. Sew shoulder seams, leaving the middle 40 (40, 42, 42, 42) stitches unsewn for back of neck.

**Neckband:**

With the RS facing, the smaller needles, and A, pick up and knit 85 stitches along the neckline. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½”. Bind off in the pattern.

**Buttonband:**

With the RS facing, the smaller needles, and A, pick up and knit 165 stitches along the Left Front. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½”. Bind off in the pattern. Place markers for 7 buttons, placing the first ¾” from the neck opening and the last ¾” from the lower edge.

**Buttonhole Band:**

Same as Buttonband for ¾”.

Make buttonholes opposite markers by binding off 3 stitches; on the next row, cast on 3 stitches over the bound off stitches of the previous row. Complete same as buttonband. Place markers 9 (9, 9 ½, 9 ½, 9 ½)” down from shoulders. Set in sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.

**Gauge:**

In Stockinette Stitch with the larger needles, 22 stitches and 31 rows = 4”, blocked. To save time, take time to check gauge.

**Left Sleeve Stripe Pattern:** (Only work the number of rows indicated for your size) 20 rows D, 10 rows E, 6 rows B, 14 rows F, 6 rows C, 20 rows A, 6 rows D, 12 rows B, 10 rows F, 18 rows D, 4 rows E, 10 rows C, 20 rows E, 8 rows A, 10 rows B.

**Right Sleeve Stripe Pattern:** (Only work the number of rows indicated for your size) 4 rows E, 10 rows B, 20 rows D, 8 rows C, 14 rows A, 6 rows F, 10 rows B, 4 rows E, 10 rows D, 4 rows A, 20 rows E, 6 rows C, 20 rows B, 10 rows F, 4 rows D, 12 rows C, 6 rows E, 6 rows C.

**Back:**

With the smaller needles and A, cast on 100 (112, 122, 134, 144) stitches. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½”. Change to the larger needles, and begin Back Chart 1. Continue working the chart in Stockinette Stitch, working the middle 82 stitches in the large chart with the stitches on either side worked in the side charts. When Row 86 is completed, begin Back Chart 2. After Row 174, bind off.

**Left Front:**

With the smaller needles and A, cast on 46 (52, 58, 64, 69) stitches. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½”. Change to the larger needles, and begin Left Front Chart 1. Continue working the chart in Stockinette Stitch, working the 46 stitches in the chart with the stitches on the right-hand side worked in the side chart.

When Row 86 is completed, begin Left Front Chart 2, working neck shaping as shown in chart.

After Row 174, bind off.

### Right Front:

Same as Left Front except use the Right Front charts.

### Left Sleeve:

With the smaller needles and A, cast on 52 stitches. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Change to the larger needles, Stockinette Stitch, and increase 1 stitch each side every other row 0 (0, 0, 0, 2) times, every 4 rows 7 (8, 21, 25, 25) times, then every 6 rows 17 (16, 6, 2, 0) times, working in the Stripe Pattern for Left Sleeve—100 (100, 106, 106, 106) stitches. Continue even in the Stripe Pattern for Left Sleeve until the piece measures approximately 19 ½ (19, 18, 17, 16)" from the beginning. Bind off.

### Right Sleeve:

Same as Left Sleeve, except use the Stripe Pattern for Right Sleeve.

### Finishing:

Block pieces to finished measurements.

Sew shoulder seams, leaving the middle 40 (40, 42, 42, 42) stitches unsewn for back of neck.



### Neckband:

With the RS facing, the smaller needles, and A, pick up and knit 85 stitches along the neckline. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Bind off in the pattern.

### Buttonband:

With the RS facing, the smaller needles, and A, pick up and knit 165 stitches along the Left Front. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Bind off in the pattern. Place markers for 7 buttons, placing the first ¾" from the neck opening and the last ¾" from the lower edge.

### Buttonhole Band:

Same as Buttonband for ¾".

Make buttonholes opposite markers by binding off 3 stitches; on the next row, cast on 3 stitches over the bound off stitches of the previous row. Complete same as buttonband. Place markers 9 (9, 9 ½, 9 ½, 9 ½)" down from shoulders. Set in sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.

### Gauge:

In Stockinette Stitch with the larger needles, 22 stitches and 31 rows = 4", blocked. To save time, take time to check gauge.

**Left Sleeve Stripe Pattern:** (Only work the number of rows indicated for your size)

20 rows D, 10 rows E, 6 rows B, 14 rows F, 6 rows C, 20 rows A, 6 rows D, 12 rows B, 10 rows F, 18 rows D, 4 rows E, 10 rows C, 20 rows E, 8 rows A, 10 rows B.

**Right Sleeve Stripe Pattern:** (Only work the number of rows indicated for your size)

4 rows E, 10 rows B, 20 rows D, 8 rows C, 14 rows A, 6 rows F, 10 rows B, 4 rows E, 10 rows D, 4 rows A, 20 rows E, 6 rows C, 20 rows B, 10 rows F, 4 rows D, 12 rows C, 6 rows E, 6 rows C.

### Back:

With the smaller needles and A, cast on 100 (112, 122, 134, 144) stitches. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Change to the larger needles, and begin Back Chart 1. Continue working the chart in Stockinette Stitch, working the middle 82 stitches in the large chart with the stitches on either side worked in the side charts. When Row 86 is completed, begin Back Chart 2. After Row 174, bind off.

### Left Front:

With the smaller needles and A, cast on 46 (52, 58, 64, 69) stitches. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Change to the larger needles, and begin Left Front Chart 1. Continue working the chart in Stockinette Stitch, working the 46 stitches in the chart with the stitches on the right-hand side worked in the side chart. When Row 86 is completed, begin Left Front Chart 2, working neck shaping as shown in chart.

After Row 174, bind off.

### Right Front:

Same as Left Front except use the Right Front charts.

### Left Sleeve:

With the smaller needles and A, cast on 52 stitches.

Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Change to the larger needles, Stockinette Stitch, and increase 1 stitch each side every other row 0 (0, 0, 0, 2) times, every 4 rows 7 (8, 21, 25, 25) times, then every 6 rows 17 (16, 6, 2, 0) times, working in the Stripe Pattern for Left Sleeve—100 (100, 106, 106, 106) stitches. Continue even in the Stripe Pattern for Left Sleeve until the piece measures approximately 19 ½ (19, 18, 17, 16)" from the beginning. Bind off.

### Right Sleeve:

Same as Left Sleeve, except use the Stripe Pattern for Right Sleeve.

### Finishing:

Block pieces to finished measurements.

Sew shoulder seams, leaving the middle 40 (40, 42, 42, 42) stitches unsewn for back of neck.

### Neckband:

With the RS facing, the smaller needles, and A, pick up and knit 85 stitches along the neckline. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Bind off in the pattern.

### Buttonband:

With the RS facing, the smaller needles, and A, pick up and knit 165 stitches along the Left Front. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½".

Bind off in the pattern. Place markers for 7 buttons, placing the first ¾" from the neck opening and the last ¾" from the lower edge.



### Buttonhole Band:

Same as Buttonband for ¾". Make buttonholes opposite markers by binding off 3 stitches; on the next row, cast on 3 stitches over the bound off stitches of the previous row. Complete same as buttonband. Place markers 9 (9, 9 ½, 9 ½, 9 ½)" down from shoulders. Set in sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.

### Gauge:

In Stockinette Stitch with the larger needles, 22 stitches and 31 rows = 4", blocked. To save time, take time to check gauge.

**Left Sleeve Stripe Pattern:** (Only work the number of rows indicated for your size) 20 rows D, 10 rows E, 6 rows B, 14 rows F, 6 rows C, 20 rows A, 6 rows D, 12 rows B, 10 rows F, 18 rows D, 4 rows E, 10 rows C, 20 rows E, 8 rows A, 10 rows B.

**Right Sleeve Stripe Pattern:** (Only work the number of rows indicated for your size) 4 rows E, 10 rows B, 20 rows D, 8 rows C, 14 rows A, 6 rows F, 10 rows B, 4 rows E, 10 rows D, 4 rows A, 20 rows E, 6 rows C, 20 rows B, 10 rows F, 4 rows D, 12 rows C, 6 rows E, 6 rows C.

### Back:

With the smaller needles and A, cast on 100 (112, 122, 134, 144) stitches. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Change to the larger needles, and begin Back Chart 1. Continue working the chart in Stockinette Stitch, working the middle 82

stitches in the large chart with the stitches on either side worked in the side charts. When Row 86 is completed, begin Back Chart 2. After Row 174, bind off.

### **Left Front:**

With the smaller needles and A, cast on 46 (52, 58, 64, 69) stitches. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Change to the larger needles, and begin Left Front Chart 1. Continue working the chart in Stockinette Stitch, working the 46 stitches in the chart with the stitches on the right-hand side worked in the side chart. When Row 86 is completed, begin Left Front Chart 2, working neck shaping as shown in chart.

After Row 174, bind off.

### **Right Front:**

Same as Left Front except use the Right Front charts.

### **Left Sleeve:**

With the smaller needles and A, cast on 52 stitches. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Change to the larger needles, Stockinette Stitch, and increase 1 stitch each side every other row 0 (0, 0, 0, 2) times, every 4 rows 7 (8, 21, 25, 25) times, then every 6 rows 17 (16, 6, 2, 0) times, working in the Stripe Pattern for Left Sleeve—100 (100, 106, 106, 106) stitches. Continue even in the Stripe Pattern for Left Sleeve until the piece measures approximately 19 ½ (19, 18, 17, 16)" from the beginning. Bind off.

### **Right Sleeve:**

Same as Left Sleeve, except use the Stripe Pattern for Right Sleeve.

### **Finishing:**

Block pieces to finished measurements. Sew shoulder seams, leaving the middle 40 (40, 42, 42, 42) stitches unsewn for back of neck.

### **Neckband:**

With the RS facing, the smaller needles, and A, pick up and knit 85 stitches along the neckline. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Bind off in the pattern.

### **Buttonband:**

With the RS facing, the smaller needles, and A, pick up and knit 165 stitches along the Left Front. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Bind off in the pattern. Place markers for 7

buttons, placing the first ¾" from the neck opening and the last ¾" from the lower edge.

### **Buttonhole Band:**

Same as Buttonband for ¾". Make buttonholes opposite markers by binding off 3 stitches; on the next row, cast on 3 stitches over the bound off stitches of the previous row.

Complete same as buttonband. Place markers 9 (9, 9 ½, 9 ½, 9 ½)" down from shoulders. Set in sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.

### **Gauge:**

In Stockinette Stitch with the larger needles, 22 stitches and 31 rows = 4", blocked. To save time, take time to check gauge.

**Left Sleeve Stripe Pattern:** (Only work the number of rows indicated for your size) 20 rows D, 10 rows E, 6 rows B, 14 rows F, 6 rows C, 20 rows A, 6 rows D, 12 rows B, 10 rows E, 18 rows D, 4 rows E, 10 rows C, 20 rows E, 8 rows A, 10 rows B.

**Right Sleeve Stripe Pattern:** (Only work the number of rows indicated for your size) 4 rows E, 10 rows B, 20 rows D, 8 rows C, 14 rows A, 6 rows F, 10 rows B, 4 rows E, 10 rows D, 4 rows A, 20 rows E, 6 rows C, 20 rows B, 10 rows F, 4 rows D, 12 rows C, 6 rows E, 6 rows C.

### **Back:**

With the smaller needles and A, cast on 100 (112, 122, 134, 144) stitches. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Change to the larger needles, and begin Back Chart 1. Continue working the chart in Stockinette Stitch, working the middle 82 stitches in the large chart with the stitches on either side worked in the side charts. When Row 86 is completed, begin Back Chart 2. After Row 174, bind off.

### **Left Front:**

With the smaller needles and A, cast on 46 (52, 58, 64, 69) stitches. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Change to the larger needles, and begin Left Front Chart 1. Continue working the chart in Stockinette Stitch, working the 46 stitches in the chart with the stitches on the right-hand side worked in the side chart. When Row 86 is completed, begin Left Front Chart 2, working neck shaping as shown in chart.

After Row 174, bind off.

**Right Front:**

Same as Left Front except use the Right Front charts.

**Left Sleeve:**

With the smaller needles and A, cast on 52 stitches. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Change to the larger needles, Stockinette Stitch, and increase 1 stitch each side every other row 0 (0, 0, 0, 2) times, every 4 rows 7 (8, 21, 25, 25) times, then every 6 rows 17 (16, 6, 2, 0) times, working in the Stripe Pattern for Left Sleeve—100 (100, 106, 106, 106) stitches. Continue even in the Stripe Pattern for Left Sleeve until the piece measures approximately 19 ½ (19, 18, 17, 16)" from the beginning. Bind off.

**Right Sleeve:**

Same as Left Sleeve, except use the Stripe Pattern for Right Sleeve.

**Finishing:**

Block pieces to finished measurements. Sew shoulder seams, leaving the middle 40 (40, 42, 42, 42) stitches unsewn for back of neck.

**Neckband:**

With the RS facing, the smaller needles, and A, pick up and knit 85 stitches along the neckline. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Bind off in the pattern.

**Buttonband:**

With the RS facing, the smaller needles, and A, pick up and knit 165 stitches along the Left Front. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Bind off in the pattern. Place markers for 7 buttons, placing the first ¾" from the neck opening and the last ¾" from the lower edge.

**Buttonhole Band:**

Same as Buttonband for ¾". Make buttonholes opposite markers by binding off 3 stitches; on the next row, cast on 3 stitches over the bound off stitches of the previous row. Complete same as buttonband. Place markers 9 (9, 9 ½, 9 ½, 9 ½)" down from shoulders. Set in sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.

**Gauge:**

In Stockinette Stitch with the larger needles, 22 stitches and 31 rows = 4", blocked. To save time, take time to check gauge.

**Left Sleeve Stripe Pattern:** (Only work the number of rows indicated for your size) 20 rows D, 10 rows E, 6 rows B, 14 rows F, 6 rows C, 20 rows A, 6 rows D, 12 rows B, 10 rows F, 18 rows D, 4 rows E, 10 rows C, 20 rows E, 8 rows A, 10 rows B.

**Right Sleeve Stripe Pattern:** (Only work the number of rows indicated for your size) 4 rows E, 10 rows B, 20 rows D, 8 rows C, 14 rows A, 6 rows F, 10 rows B, 4 rows E, 10 rows D, 4 rows A, 20 rows E, 6 rows C, 20 rows B, 10 rows F, 4 rows D, 12 rows C, 6 rows E, 6 rows C.

**Back:**

With the smaller needles and A, cast on 100 (112, 122, 134, 144) stitches. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Change to the larger needles, and begin Back Chart 1. Continue working the chart in Stockinette Stitch, working the middle 82 stitches in the large chart with the stitches on either side worked in the side charts. When Row 86 is completed, begin Back Chart 2. After Row 174, bind off.

**Left Front:**

With the smaller needles and A, cast on 46 (52, 58, 64, 69) stitches. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Change to the larger needles, and begin Left Front Chart 1. Continue working the chart in Stockinette Stitch, working the 46 stitches in the chart with the stitches on the right-hand side worked in the side chart. When Row 86 is completed, begin Left Front Chart 2, working neck shaping as shown in chart.

After Row 174, bind off.

**Right Front:**

Same as Left Front except use the Right Front charts.

**Left Sleeve:**

With the smaller needles and A, cast on 52 stitches. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Change to the larger needles, Stockinette Stitch, and increase 1 stitch each side every other row 0 (0, 0, 0, 2) times, every 4 rows 7 (8, 21, 25, 25) times, then every 6 rows 17 (16, 6, 2, 0) times, working in the Stripe Pattern for Left Sleeve—100 (100, 106, 106, 106) stitches. Continue even in the Stripe Pattern for Left Sleeve until the piece measures approximately 19 ½ (19, 18, 17, 16)" from the beginning. Bind off.

**Right Sleeve:**

Same as Left Sleeve, except use the Stripe Pattern for Right Sleeve.

### **Finishing:**

Block pieces to finished measurements. Sew shoulder seams, leaving the middle 40 (40, 42, 42, 42) stitches unsewn for back of neck.

### **Neckband:**

With the RS facing, the smaller needles, and A, pick up and knit 85 stitches along the neckline. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Bind off in the pattern.

### **Buttonband:**

With the RS facing, the smaller needles, and A, pick up and knit 165 stitches along the Left Front. Work K1P1 Rib for 1 ½". Bind off in the pattern. Place markers for 7 buttons, placing the first ¾" from the neck opening and the last ¾" from the lower edge.

### **Buttonhole Band:**


Same as Buttonband for ¾". Make buttonholes opposite markers by binding off 3 stitches; on the next row, cast on 3 stitches over the bound off stitches of the previous row.

Complete same as buttonband.

Place markers 9 (9, 9 ½, 9 ½, 9 ½)" down from shoulders.

Set in sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams.






