The Sadie Top is a soft veil worked seamlessly top down in stockinette stitch. Starting with an elegant boat neck, the design uses a saddle shoulder construction to follow the natural curve of the shoulders. The roomy sleeves and cropped body are adorned with non rolling edges.

Sizes: XS (S, M, L) (XL, 2XL, 3XL, 4XL)

Bust Circumference: The garment measures 100 (106, 111.5, 116) (123, 133, 146, 156) cm or 39 ½ (41 ½, 43 ¾, 45 ½) (48 ½, 52 ¼, 57 ¼, 61 ¼) inches to fit a bust circumference of 80-85 (85-90, 90-95, 95-100) (100-110, 110-120, 120-130, 130-140) cm or 30.5-33.5 (33.5-35.5, 35.5-37.5, 37.5-39.5) (39.5-43.25, 43.25-47.25, 47.25- 51.25, 51.25-55) inches.

The Sadie Top is designed to have 15-20 cm (6-8 inches) of positive ease, meaning that the finished garment is going to be 15-20 cm (6-8 inches) larger in circumference than your bust.

The sample is knitted in a size S to fit a bust circumference of 86 cm (34 inches). The resulting positive ease is 20 cm (8 inches).

You can refer to the testers' versions on the last few pages to see how the top looks knitted in different sizes.

Body Length: 43 (45, 47, 49) (51, 53, 55, 57) cm or 17 (17.7, 18.5, 19.3) (20, 20.8, 21.6, 22.5) inches mid front measured from cast on edge.

Sleeve Length: 41 cm (16 inches) measured from the underarm.

Gauge: 14 sts x 23 rows = 10 x 10 cm (4 x 4 inches) in stockinette stitch on 6.5 mm (US10.5) needles after wash and blocking.

Needles:

6.5 mm (US 10.5) 40 cm and 80 or 100 cm (16 and 32 or 40 inches) long circular needles

8 mm (US 11) 40 cm (16 inches) long circular needles

Yarn: approx. 550 (575, 625, 675) (725, 775, 875, 950) metres or 601 (628, 684, 738) (793, 848, 957, 1039) yards of any lace weight yarn. Note that you may need more or less yarn if you want to modify the length of the body and/or sleeves.

Yarn Suggestions:

3 (3, 3, 3) (4, 4, 4, 5) skeins of Knitting For Olive 'Soft Silk Mohair' (25 g = 225 m/246 yds).

3 (3, 3, 4) (4, 4, 5, 5) skeins of Isager 'Silk Mohair' (25 g = 212 m/232 yds).

You can refer to the testers' versions on the last few pages to see the yarn quantities they used.

The sample was knitted in a size S using 3 skeins of Knitting For Olive 'Soft Silk Mohair' in the shade 'Cloud'.

Notions:

Stitch markers

Measuring tape

Tapestry needle

Scissors

Abbreviations:

Approx.: approximately

BOR: beginning of round

Ds: double stitch

K: knit

M1R: make 1 right - Insert the left needle under the strand that runs between two stitches from back to front, then knit this strand.

M1L: make 1 left - Insert the left needle under the strand that runs between two stitches from front to back, then knit this strand through the back loop (twisted).

M1pR: make 1 purl right - Insert the left needle under the strand that runs between two stitches from back to front, then purl this strand.

M1pL: make 1 purl left - Insert the left needle under the strand that runs between two stitches from front to back, then purl this strand through the back loop (twisted).

P: purl

Pm: place marker

RS: right side

Sm: slip marker

St(s): stitch(es)

WS: wrong side

Wyib: with yarn in the back

Instructions

Before you begin, knit a swatch to ensure you hit the correct gauge of 14 sts x 23 rows = 10 x 10 cm (4 x 4 inches). If your gauge doesn't match, your final top proportions are not going to be true to size. Adjust your needle size accordingly to meet gauge.

Neck Edge

Cast on 68 (68, 68, 70) (72, 74, 76, 78) sts on 8 mm (US11) 40 cm (16 inches) circular needles, using the German Twisted Long Tail cast on (watch video [here](#)).

Place BOR (to indicate mid back) and join in the round, being careful not to twist the stitches.

Set-up Round: k 15 (15, 15, 15) (16, 16, 17, 17) (right back), pm, k4 (right shoulder), pm, k30 (30, 30, 31) (32, 33, 34, 35) (front), pm, k4 (left shoulder), pm, k15 (15, 15, 16) (16, 17, 17, 18) (left back)

Change to 6.5 mm (US 10.5) 40 cm (16 inches) needles.

You will now work shoulder increases and German short rows simultaneously:

Short row 1 (RS): k to marker, M1R, SM, k 4 shoulder sts, SM, M1L, k1, turn (2 sts increased)

Short row 2 (WS): make a ds, p to marker, M1pL, SM, p 4 shoulder sts, SM, M1pR, p to BOR, p to marker, M1pL, SM, p 4 shoulder sts, SM, M1pR, p1, turn (4 sts increased)

Stitch count check: 74 (74, 74, 76) (78, 80, 82, 84) sts.

Carry on working the short row shaping and the increases as follows:

Short row 3 (RS): make a ds, k to marker, M1R, SM, k 4 shoulder sts, SM, M1L, k to BOR, k to marker, M1R, SM, k 4 shoulder sts, SM, M1L, k to ds, k the ds as one st, k4, turn (4 sts increased)

Short row 4 (WS): make a ds, p to marker, M1pL, SM, p 4 shoulder sts, SM, M1pR, p to BOR, p to marker, M1pL, SM, p 4 shoulder sts, SM, M1pR, p to ds, p the ds as one st, p4, turn (4 sts increased)

Stitch count check: 82 (82, 82, 84) (86, 88, 90, 92) sts.

Make a ds, k to marker, M1R, SM, k 4 shoulder sts, SM, M1L, k to BOR (2 sts increased).

Stitch count check: 84 (84, 84, 86) (88, 90, 92, 94) sts.

Try on your work here, ensure it fits over your head.

The short rows have been completed. Resume knitting in the round. Don't forget to knit the remaining double stitches as 1 stitch.

*TIP: Working one strand of mohair can be a fiddle. You'll be knitting in the round from here on, so you may want to switch your **left needle** to a smaller size (I suggest 0.5 mm smaller). This way the stitches can glide around the cable more easily.*

Shoulder Increases Continued

Increasing round: k to marker, M1R, SM, k 4 shoulder sts, SM, M1L, k to marker, M1R, SM, k 4 shoulder sts, SM, M1L, k to BOR (4 sts increased)

Work the above increasing round a total of 5 (6, 7, 8) (8, 8, 8, 8) times.

Stitch count check: 104 (108, 112, 118) (120, 122, 124, 126) sts.

Change to longer circular needles when necessary.

Sleeve Increases

Next, work the yoke and sleeve caps as follows:

Round 1: k to marker, SM, M1L, k to marker, M1R, SM, k to marker, SM, M1L, k to marker, M1R, SM, k to BOR (4 sts increased)

Work round 1 a total of 3 (3, 3, 3) (3, 3, 6, 7) times.

Stitch count check: 116 (120, 124, 130) (132, 134, 148, 154) sts.

Continue working the yoke and sleeve caps as follows:

Round 1: knit across

Round 2: k to marker, SM, M1L, k to marker, M1R, SM, k to marker, SM, M1L, k to marker, M1R, SM, k to BOR (4 sts increased)

Work rounds 1 and 2 a total of 16 (17, 17, 18) (20, 21, 19, 19) times.

Stitch count check: 180 (188, 192, 202) (212, 218, 224, 230) sts.

Distribution of stitches:

24 (25, 26, 27) (28, 28, 29, 29) sts (right back), marker, 42 (44, 44, 46) (50, 52, 54, 56) sts (right shoulder), marker, 48 (50, 52, 55) (56, 57, 58, 59) sts (front), marker, 42 (44, 44, 46) (50, 52, 54, 56) sts (left shoulder), marker, 24 (25, 26, 28) (28, 29, 29, 30) sts (left back).

Raglan Increases

Now the yoke will be shaped with raglan increases. Increases will be worked on both the body and sleeves, as follows:

Sizes XS, S, M, and L ONLY:

Round 1: knit across

Round 2: k to 1 st before marker, M1R, k1 (raglan st), SM, M1L, k sleeve sts, M1R, SM, k1 (raglan st), M1L, k to 1 st before marker, M1R, k1 (raglan st), SM, M1L, k sleeve sts, M1R, SM, k1 (raglan st), M1L, k to BOR (8 sts increased)

Work rounds 1 and 2 a total of 3 (3, 4, 4) (0, 0, 0, 0) times.

Stitch count check: 204 (212, 224, 234) (-, -, -, -).

Sizes XL, 2XL, 3XL, and 4XL ONLY:

Round 1: k to 1 st before marker, M1R, k1 (raglan st), SM, M1L, k sleeve sts, M1R, SM, k1 (raglan st), M1L, k to 1 st before marker, M1R, k1 (raglan st) , SM, M1L, k sleeve sts, M1R, SM, k1 (raglan st), M1L, k to BOR (8 sts increased)

Work round 1 a total of 0 (0, 0, 0) (4, 5, 6, 7) times.

Stitch count check: - (-, -, -) (244, 258, 272, 286) sts.

Distribution of stitches:

27 (28, 30, 31) (32, 33, 35, 36) sts (right back), marker, 48 (50, 52, 54) (58, 62, 66, 70) sts (right shoulder), marker, 54 (56, 60, 63) (64, 67, 70, 73) sts (front), marker, 48 (50, 62, 54) (58, 62, 66, 70) sts (left shoulder), marker, 27 (28, 30, 32) (32, 34, 35, 37) sts (left back).

Body Increases

Next you are going to make increases on the body only:

Round 1: k to 1 st before marker, M1R, k1 (raglan st), SM, k sleeve sts, SM, k1 (raglan st), M1L, k to 1 st before marker, M1R, k1 (raglan st), SM, k sleeve sts, SM, k1 (raglan st), M1L, k to BOR (4 sts increased)

Work round 1 a total of 4 (5, 5, 5) (7, 9, 11, 12) times.

Stitch count check: 220 (232, 244, 254) (272, 294, 316, 334) sts.

Distribution of stitches:

31 (33, 35, 36) (39, 42, 46, 48) sts (right back), marker, 48 (50, 52, 54) (58, 62, 66, 70) sts (right shoulder), marker, 62 (66, 70, 73) (78, 85, 92, 97) sts (front), marker, 48 (50, 52, 54) (58, 62, 66, 70) sts (left shoulder), marker, 31 (33, 35, 37) (39, 43, 46, 49) sts (left back).

Body

Removing markers as you go, divide the body and sleeve sts while casting on new underarm sts as follows:

Knit 31 (33, 35, 36) (39, 42, 46, 48) sts (right back), place the 48 (50, 52, 54) (58, 62, 66, 70) sleeve sts on hold (right sleeve), cast on 8 (8, 8, 8) (8, 8, 10, 12) new sts for the underarm using the backward loop method, k 62 (66, 70, 73) (78, 85, 92, 97) sts (front), place the next 48 (50, 52, 54) (58, 62, 66, 70) sleeve sts on hold (left sleeve), cast on 4 (4, 4, 4) (4, 4, 5, 6) new underarm sts, place new BOR marker, cast on another 4 (4, 4, 4) (4, 4, 5, 6) new underarm sts, k 31 (33, 35, 37) (39, 43, 46, 49) sts (left back).

Knit across to reach new BOR.

Stitch count check for the body: 140 (148, 156, 162) (172, 186, 204, 218) sts.

Work in stockinette stitch until the top measures 43 (45, 47, 49) (51, 53, 55, 57) cm or 17 (17.7, 18.5, 19.3) (20, 20.8, 21.6, 22.5) inches mid front measured from cast on edge (or to desired length, noting that if you make your body longer, yarn requirements might change).

To keep the body edge from rolling, complete a 'non rolling' round as follows (watch video [here](#)):

Step 1: Slip st knit wise wyib.

Step 2: On the WS, find the purl bump two rounds below the stitch on the right needle. Lift it with the right needle. Insert the left needle into the lifted stitch. Knit the stitch tbl.

Step 3: Use the left needle to pass the stitch you slipped in step 1 over the stitch you just knitted in step 2 and off the right needle.

Step 4: Repeat steps 1-3 until you reach the BOR.

Loosely bind off all body sts using a 8 mm (US11) needle.

Sleeves

The sleeves are worked in the round on 6.5 mm (US10.5) needles. You can use double-pointed needles or circular needles and the magic loop method.

Place the 48 (50, 52, 54) (58, 62, 66, 70) sleeve sts on your needles. Pick up and knit 8 (8, 8, 8) (8, 8, 10, 12) sts along the sts that have been cast on for the underarm on the body. Place BOR marker in the middle of the picked up stitches. You will have 56 (58, 60, 62) (66, 70, 76, 82) sleeve sts.

Work in stockinette stitch until the sleeve measures 18 cm (7 inches) from the underarm.

Now the sleeves are going to be given their bell shape:

Step 1 (increasing round): k1, M1L, k to 1 st before BOR, M1R, k1 (2 sts increased). *TIP: add a removable marker to this round to facilitate the next step.*

Step 2: Knit 7 cm (2.75 inches) of stockinette stitch.

Work steps 1 and 2 a total of 2 times.

Work one more increasing round as follows:

Increasing round: k1, M1L, k to 1 st before BOR, M1R, k1 (2 sts increased)

Stitch count check for the sleeves: 62 (64, 66, 68) (72, 76, 82, 88) sts.

Work in stockinette stitch until the sleeve measures 38 cm (15 inches) from the underarm (or to desired length).

To keep the sleeve edge from rolling, complete a 'non rolling' round as follows (watch video [here](#)):

Step 1: Slip st knit wise wyib.

Step 2: On the WS, find the purl bump two rounds below the stitch on the right needle. Lift it with the right needle. Insert the left needle into the lifted stitch. Knit the stitch tbl.

Step 3: Use the left needle to pass the stitch you slipped in step 1 over the stitch you just knitted in step 2 and off the right needle.

Step 4: Repeat steps 1-3 until you reach the BOR.

Loosely bind off all sleeve sts using a 8 mm (US11) needle.

Repeat this section for the second sleeve.

Finish

Weave in the ends and give your top a good block :)
