

MINNESOTA YARN SHOP HOP 2025
KNIT PATTERN

Row 27: sl1wyib, k1, ssk, k to last 2 sts, sl1wyib, p1
Row 28: sl1wyib, p1, k to last 2 sts, sl1wyif, p1
Row 29: sl1wyib, k1, switch to C1: k to last 7 sts, turn
Row 30: GSR, p to last 2 sts, switch to C2: sl1wyif, p1
Rows 31-38: Repeat Rows 27-30 2 more times.
Rows 39-40: Repeat Rows 27-28 (129 sts on needle at completion of Section 3)

SECTION 4: DECREASES

Row 1: sl1wyib, k1, ssk, k to last 2 sts, sl1wyib, p1
Row 2: sl1wyib, p to last 2 sts, sl1wyif, p1
Rows 3-12: Repeat Rows 1-2 5 more times.
Row 13: sl1wyib, k1, ssk, k to last 2 sts, sl1wyib, p1
Row 14: sl1wyib, p1, k to last 2 sts, sl1wyif, p1
Row 15: sl1wyib, k1, ssk, k to last 7 sts, turn
Row 16: GSR, p to last 2 sts, sl1wyif, p1
Rows 17-20: Repeat Rows 13-16
Rows 21-22: Repeat Rows 13-14
Row 23: sl1wyib, k1, switch to C1: k to last 7 sts, turn
Row 24: GSR, p to last 2 sts, switch to C2: sl1wyif, p1
Rows 25-26: Repeat Rows 13-14
Rows 27-28: Repeat Rows 23-24
Rows 29-30: Repeat Rows 13-14
Rows 31-32: Repeat Rows 23-24
Rows 33-42: Repeat Rows 13-22 (18 sts decreased in Section 4 Rows 1-42)
Rows 43-252: Repeat Section 4 Rows 1-42 5 more times (21 sts on needle at completion of Section 4)

SECTION 5: TO FINISH

Row 1: sl1wyib, k1, ssk, k to last 2 sts, sl1wyib, p1
Row 2: sl1wyib, p to last 2 sts, sl1wyif, p1
Rows 3-32: Repeat Rows 1-2 15 more times
Row 33: sl1wyib, ssk, k2tog
Row 34: p3
Row 35: sl1wyib, k2tog
Row 36: p2tog

Break yarn, pull through remaining stitch. Weave in ends. Block gently, lay flat to dry, and if desired, place small domed object (approx 2") under each short row dome to add a bit of accent to the those sections. Crumpled tissue paper, half a plastic egg or styrofoam round all work well.

MATERIALS

Single Ply SW Merino Fingering by Purls & Pines (393 yds per 100 g skein): 1 skein each of 2 colors; C1: Sunken Garden; C2: Latticework

US 4 (3.5 mm) 24" circular needle
Stitch markers

FINISHED DIMENSIONS

66" x 22" at deepest point, after blocking

GAUGE

22 sts = 4" in stockinette and garter st

ABBREVIATIONS

k: knit
p: purl
kfb: knit through front and back of same stitch (one stitch increased)
slwyib: slip stitch with yarn in back

slwyif: slit stitch with yarn in front
GSR (German Short Row): After turning work, with yarn in front, slip first stitch on left needle to right needle purlwise. Pull the working yarn over the right needle so it ends up behind the work, tighten the yarn, then continue as written. Be sure to knit both legs of that slipped stitch as one stitch when you next encounter it (it looks like a double stitch).

st(s): stitch(es)

C1: Color 1; C2: Color 2

ssk (slip, slip, knit): slip 1 stitch to right needle as if to knit; return stitch to left needle as slipped; knit 2 stitches together through back (1 stitch decreased)

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together as 1 stitch (1 stitch decreased)

p2tog: purl 2 stitches together as 1 stitch (1 stitch decreased)

Because the shawl is knit end to end, each section begins again with Row 1 so the row count doesn't get unwieldy. Repeat Rows refer only to the section you're currently working.

Slip sts as to purl.

Be sure to pick up both legs of German Short Row slipped stitch when knitting past it (it looks like a double stitch).

Pick up new color under existing color when switching colors at selvedge edge.

TO KNIT

SECTION 1: SET UP

With C1, cast on 2 sts.

Row 1: k2

Row 2: p2

Row 3: k1, m1r, k1

Row 4: p3

Row 5: k1, kfb, k1

Row 6: p4

Row 7: sl1wyib, k1, sl1wyib, p1

Row 8: sl1wyib, p1, sl1wyif, p1

Rows 9–28: Repeat Rows 7–8

10 more times

Row 29: sl1wyib, k1, m1r, sl1wyib, p1

Row 30: sl1wyib, p to last 2 sts,

sl1wyif, p1

Row 31: sl1wyib, k1, kfb, sl1wyib, p1

Row 32: sl1wyib, p to last 2 sts,

sl1wyif, p1

Row 33: sl1wyib, k1, kfb, k to last 2 sts,

sl1wyib, p1

Row 34: sl1wyib, p to last 2 sts,

sl1wyif, p1

Rows 35–60: Repeat Rows 33–34 13 more times (20 sts at completion of Section 1)

SECTION 2: INCREASES

Row 1: sl1wyib, k1, kfb, k to last 2 sts,

sl1wyib, p1

Row 2: sl1wyib, p1, k to last 2 sts,

sl1wyif, p1

Row 3: sl1wyib, k1, kfb, k to last 7 sts, turn

Row 4: GSR, p to last 2 sts, sl1wyif, p1

Rows 5–8: Repeat Rows 1–4

Rows 9–10: Repeat Rows 1–2

Row 11: sl1wyib, k1, switch to C2: k to last 7 sts, turn

Row 12: GSR, p to last 2 sts, switch to C1: sl1wyif, p1

Rows 13–14: Repeat Rows 1–2

Rows 15–16: Repeat Rows 11–12

Rows 17–18: Repeat Rows 1–2

Rows 19–20: Repeat Rows 11–12

Rows 21–30: Repeat Rows 1–10

Row 31: sl1wyib, k1, kfb, k to last 2 sts, sl1wyib, p1

Row 32: sl1wyib, p to last 2 sts, sl1wyif, p1

Rows 33–42: Repeat Rows 31–32 5 more times (18 sts increased in Section, 2 Rows 1–42)

Rows 43–252: Repeat Section 2

Rows 1–42 5 more times (128 sts at completion of Section 2)

SECTION 3: CENTER

Row 1: sl1wyib, k1, kfb, k to last 2 sts, sl1wyib, p1

Row 2: sl1wyib, p1, k to last 2 sts,

sl1wyif, p1

Row 3: sl1wyib, k1, switch to C2: k to last 7 sts, turn

Row 4: GSR, p to last 2 sts, switch to C1: sl1wyif, p1

Rows 5–12: Repeat Rows 1–4 2 more times.

Rows 13–14: Repeat Rows 1–2

Row 15: sl1wyib, k1, switch to C2: k to last 7 sts, turn

Row 16: GSR, p to last 2 sts, switch to C1: sl1wyif, p1

Row 17: sl1wyib, k to last 15 sts, turn

Row 18: GSR, p to last 2 sts, sl1wyif, p1

Row 19: sl1wyib, k1, switch to C2: k to last 23 sts, turn

Row 20: GSR, p to last 2 sts, switch to C1: sl1wyif, p1

Row 21: With C2, sl1wyib, k1, switch to C1: kfb, k to last 24 sts, turn

Row 22: GSR, p to last 2 sts, switch to C2: sl1wyif, p1

Row 23: With C2, sl1wyib, k to last 16 sts, turn

Row 24: GSR, p to last 2 sts, sl1wyif, p1

Row 25: sl1wyib, k1, switch to C1: kfb, k to last 8 sts, turn

Row 26: GSR, p to last 2 sts, switch to C2: sl1wyif, p1
