**Gauge:** 20 sts / 38 rows = 10 cm / 4" in Garter stitch (with the main needle size)

Measured after blocking. Gauge has an influence on the size of your finished piece and your yardage!

**Needles:** **Main needle size:** US 7/4.5 mm circular needles (or size needed to obtain gauge and optimal drape), 80-120 cm / 32-47" long; optional: DPNs in same size for sleeves, third needle of same size for 3-needle bind-off

**Smaller needle size:** US 6/4.0 mm short circular needles and/or DPNs for cuffs and pocket ribbing

**Notions:** 2-11 buttons (about 2.5 cm / 1"), tapestry needle, 9 stitch markers, 1 locking/removable stitch marker, waste yarn for provisional cast on and for holding sleeve sts, crochet hook for sleeve seam and provisional cast-on (optional)

## MIX & MATCH SIZING

Customize your size by combining any of the 16 circumferences, 8 lengths and 3 neckline options.

### Circumference:

1 (1 1/2, 2, 2 1/2)[3, 3 1/2, 4, 4 1/2]  
(5, 5 1/2, 6, 6 1/2)[7, 7 1/2, 8, 8 1/2]

Your bust circumference (body measurement) should be about 10% less than the finished bust of the cardigan (positive ease); less ease will result in a tighter-fitting garment, more ease will result in a more over-sized garment. As the cardigan has a straight fit without any waist shaping, the circumference is the same at the bust and hips.


### Length:

a (b, c, d)[e, f, g, h]

Pick a length from cropped to tunic length. You can base the length on a body measurement (start at the back of the neck and measure down the center back to where you want your cardigan to end) or by measuring a garment from your wardrobe.

### Neckline:

Crew / Round / V-neck



Choose between a narrow crew neck, a wider round neckline or a v-neck.







Note:

Color A and B are stated for the striped version (as pictured), with ribbing details worked in Color A. The difference between A and B is the yardage required for the ribbing. Use the total yardage for a uni-color version. For the pictured contrasting cuffs and pocket ribbing of the pink sample, you'll need about 45 m / 50 yd out of the total. For a Color-blocked version, you'll need the yardage stated for B for both colors, plus the difference between A and B for the ribbing.

\* The number of skeins refers to the yarn used in the sample (230 m/250 yd per 100 g skein).

## YARN & COLORS

### 1 or more colors of DK weight yarn

(about 200-250 m / 219-273 yd per 100 g)

### 828-2275 m / 905-2488 yard / 5-11 skeins\* in total

Please check the yardage table on page 4 for the exact yardage of your custom size. Color A and B is stated for the striped version.

\* The number of skeins refers to the yarn used in the sample (230 m/250 yd per 100 g).

Alternatively to using DK weight yarn, you can hold multiple strands of lighter weight yarn together for a marled effect (e.g., 2 strands of Fingering weight held together, or 1 strand of Fingering weight and 1 strand of fluffy Lace weight held together).

For a striped version, switch between Colors A and B every two rows/rounds (1 Garter ridge per color) in the body and sleeve sections and use Color A for the cuffs, hem, and neckline. For a one-color version, use the same color throughout.

The simple Garter stitch texture of the body is a blank canvas for you to play with, you could, for instance use leftovers, vertical stripes, different colors for left and right side, different colors for front and back etc.

## CONSTRUCTION

The cardigan is worked sideways from the center out: First, stitches are cast on for the center front (Section 1), then the right front is worked with neckline shaping at the beginning of the RS rows. While those stitches are placed on hold, the stitches for the center back (Section 2) are cast on and the right back is worked with neckline shaping at the end of the RS rows; then both pieces are worked together towards the right sleeve with shoulder shaping at the center (Section 3). After placing the right sleeve stitches on hold and working additional rows at the underarms, the right side seam is closed with a graft or 3-needle bind-off (Section 4).

After unraveling the provisional back cast-on (or picking up sts from the long-tail cast-on), the left back (Section 5) is worked with neckline shaping at the beginning of the RS rows; those stitches are placed on hold. After casting on stitches, the left front (Section 6) is worked with neckline shaping at the end of the RS rows; then both pieces are worked together towards the left sleeve with shoulder shaping at the center (Section 7). After placing the left sleeve stitches on hold and working additional rows at the underarms, the left side seam is closed with a graft or 3-needle bind-off (Section 8).

Then both sleeves are worked (separately) either in the round or flat and finished with a folded ribbed cuff (Section 9). After picking up stitches around the body, the back part of the split hem is worked in 2x2

ribbing (Section 10). The front part of the split hem is worked together with the buttonband and neckline finish (Section 11). For that, stitches are picked up from the body for the front part of the hem, then the provisionally cast-on stitches for the right front are worked, then stitches are picked up around the neckline, then then provisionally cast-on stitches for the left front are worked, and finally, the remaining stitches for the front hem are picked up and worked in 2x2 ribbing. The optional patch pockets (Section 12) can be worked first as a gauge swatch and are seamed to the finished cardigan after blocking. You can make one, two or no pockets.

## GAUGE

**20 sts / 38 rows = 10 cm / 4" in Garter stitch** with the main needle size, measured after blocking.

Gauge has an influence on the size of your finished piece and your yardage.

Because the cardigan is knit sideways, stitch gauge (the number of stitches over a specific length) determines the length of the garment and the sleeve circumference, while row gauge (the number of rows over a specific length) determines the circumference of the garment and the sleeve length. A tighter stitch gauge (more sts per cm/inch) will result in a shorter cardigan body and tighter fitting sleeves, a looser row gauge (fewer rows per cm/inch) in a looser fitting cardigan body and longer sleeves, and vice versa. A looser gauge will also mean that you will need more yardage than stated.

Getting a close match to the stated gauge will give you the best results.

Tip: Knit the patch pockets as gauge swatches!

## INCREASES & DECREASES

All increases and decreases are highlighted in **color** throughout the pattern! At the end of every increase- or decrease row you can find the number of stitch count change (eg. 2 sts inc'd) as well as the total number of stitches after that row (eg. 15 sts) when appropriate.

## REPEATS




In this pattern, repeats are written in parentheses "( )". Work the instructions in parentheses the number of times stated after the closing parenthesis (eg. "5 times" or "repeat to M").

- ssk.....decrease ("slip, slip, knit"): slip two stitches knitwise, one after the other, then insert the left needle again and knit them together through the back loop
- st / sts ....stitch/stitches
- WS .....wrong side
- wyib.....with yarn in back of the work
- wyif.....with yarn in front of the work
- yo .....increase ("yarn-over"): bring the yarn under the needle to the front and over the needle to the back again

## Section 4: Right Side Seam

After placing stitches from the center of the row on hold (these will form the sleeves later), extra side/underarm rows are worked between the beginning of the row and the sleeve sts. The side of the cardigan is then closed by working a graft or 3-needle bind-off.



### Tips for customization:

You can combine a different sleeve circumference to your body circumference (e.g. body circ. 3 and sleeve circ. 4). Simply follow the instructions for the sleeve circumference in the setup of this section to place the correct number of sleeve sts on hold. The repeats of R1-2 should be worked for the body circumference.

For a sleeveless version, bind the sleeve stitches off instead of placing them on hold in the setup.

**Setup (RS):** k to 24 (25, 26, 28)[31, 33, 36, 39][38, 40, 41, 42][45, 47, 48, 49] sts before M for sleeve circumference 1 (1 ½, 2, 2 ½)[3, 3 ½, 4, 4 ½][5, 5 ½, 6, 6 ½][7, 7 ½, 8, 8 ½], sl1 wyif; then place the following 47 (49, 51, 55) [61, 65, 71, 77][75, 79, 81, 83][89, 93, 95, 97] sts on a piece of waste yarn on hold (sleeve sts), then slide the remaining sts of the row onto the cable on hold; turn work (see tables below for st counts)

**Setup (WS):** k to last st, sl1 wyif

**R1 (RS):** k to last st, sl1 wyif

**R2 (WS):** k to last st, sl1 wyif

Repeat R1-2 another 4 times for circumferences 1 to 4 ½ (6 extra Garter ridges) or another 8 times for circumferences 5 to 8 ½ (10 extra Garter ridges), then repeat R1 once more.

Continue with graft.

Alternatively, you can repeat R2 once more, then work a 3-needle bind-off on the WS to connect the front and back of the cardigan and seamlessly close the side.

Please note: The stitch counts in these tables assume that the same body and sleeve circumference is worked. If you combine different sizes, you can calculate the stitch count for the side seam by subtracting the sleeve sts (see setup of Section 4 for stitch counts) from the sts after the side (see tables on page 9), then dividing that number by 2.

## GARTER STITCH GRAFT

Break yarn. Leave a long tail of the yarn you worked the last row with.

Slide sts from the end of the row from the cable back to the left-hand needle, then fold piece so the WS are facing in and RS are facing out, and hold the two needles parallel to each other in the left-hand.

Thread a tapestry needle through the long tail-end and close the side with a Garter stitch graft as follows:

**Setup 1:** Insert the tapestry needle purlwise through the first st on the front needle, leave the st on the needle and pull the yarn through .

**Setup 2:** Insert the tapestry needle purlwise through the first st on the back needle, leave the st on the needle and pull the yarn through.

**Step 1:** Insert the tapestry needle knitwise through the first st on the front needle and slip it off the needle, then insert the tapestry needle purlwise through the next st on the front needle, leave the stitch on the needle and pull the yarn through.

**Step 2:** Insert the tapestry needle knitwise through the first st on the back needle and slip it off the needle, then insert the tapestry needle purlwise through the next st on the back needle, leave the stitch on the needle and pull the yarn through.

Repeat steps 1 and 2 until there is only 1 st left on each needle, then insert the tapestry needle knitwise through the last st on the front needle and slip it off the needle, then insert the tapestry needle knitwise through the last st on the back needle and slip it off the needle.

I recommend taking up the slack/evening out the tension of the graft every 5-10 sts.


## Section 5: Left Back

Unravel the provisional CO of the Right Back and place the sts onto the circular needles of the main needle size. You may have to pick up an extra stitch at one edge to make up for pattern offset from the provisional CO, so you have the same number of sts on your needles as originally cast-on for the Right Back.

If you have used a long-tail cast-on for the Right Back, pick up and knit the following number of sts from the CO with Color A and RS facing, then skip R1 and continue with R2.

Place a locking/removable stitch marker onto the last Garter ridge of the Right Back to mark the center back.

For a striped version, start with Color A, then switch colors every 2 rows.

## Section 9: Sleeves

The sleeves can be worked seamlessly in the round or flat and later seamed (with a crochet seam).

Work with the main needle size and continue switching between colors every 2 rows/rounds for the striped version.



### Tip for customization:

You can customize the sleeve length and tapering by working fewer/more repeats or fewer/more rows/rounds between repeats.

If you are mixing body and sleeve circumferences, follow the instructions for the chosen sleeve circumference in this section.

Place sleeve sts back on the needles.

**Setup 1 (RS):** Pick up and knit 4 sts for circumferences 1-4 ½ or 6 sts for circumferences 5-8 ½ from the underarm rows, starting at the center Garter ridge, pick up the last stitch of the underarm rows from the previous row with the left-hand needle and knit it together with the next st (like **k2tog**), k to M, SM, sl1 wyib, k to last sleeve st, sl1 k-wise, then pick up the first stitch from the underarm rows from the previous row with the right-hand needle from front to back and knit it together with the slipped st (like **ssk**), pick up and knit another 4 sts for circumferences 1-4 ½ or 6 sts for circumferences 5-8 ½ from the underarm rows at the underarm, ending with the middle stitch that the first stitch has been picked-up from as well; Do not close to knit in the round!

**Setup 2 (WS):** sl1 wyif, k to 1 st before M, sl1 wyif, SM, k to end

Continue with R1 of the pattern repeat.

**Sizes 1 ½, 2 ½, 4, 4 ½, 6, 7 ½, and 8:**

**Setup 1 (RS):** Pick up and knit 4 sts for circumferences 1-4 ½ or 6 sts for circumferences 5-8 ½ from the underarm rows, starting at the center Garter ridge, pick up the last stitch of the underarm rows from the previous row with the left-hand needle and knit it together with the next st (like **k2tog**), k to M, SM, k to last sleeve st, sl1 k-wise, pick up the first stitch from the underarm rows from the previous row with the right-hand needle from front to back and knit it together with the slipped st (like **ssk**), pick up and knit another 4 sts for circumferences 1-4 ½ or 6 sts for circumferences 5-8 ½ from the underarm rows at the underarm, ending with the middle stitch that the first stitch has been picked-up from as well; Do not close to knit in the round!

**Setup 2 (WS):** k to 1 st before M, sl1 wyif, SM, k to last st, sl1 wyif

Skip R1-2 and continue with R3 of the pattern repeat.

**Sizes 2 and 4:** Work one more row of the pattern repeat. Break yarn and continue with Sleeve Seam.

**All other sizes:** Continue with Decrease Set 2.

Slide sleeve stitches to the cable on hold, then seam the sleeves on the RS with mattress stitch, or alternatively work a crocheted seam as follows:

With the sleeve inside-out, line up the sleeve edges and hold them parallel in your left hand with WS facing out. Begin at the underarm and work towards the cuff. Working with Color A, make a slip-knot and place it onto the crochet hook. \*Insert the hook from front to back through 1 leg of the selvedge stitches on both edges of the sleeve. Bring the yarn over the hook and draw the yarn-over through both layers and the loop on the hook.\*

Repeat from \* to \* until the entire sleeve is seamed. Break yarn and pull the tail end through the remaining loop on the hook. Turn the sleeve right-side out again and continue with Cuff.

**Cuff**

Work with Color A and the smaller needle size in the round as follows:

**Sizes 1, 2, 2 ½, 3, 3 ½, 4 ½, 5 ½, 6, 7 ½, 8, and 8 ½:**

**Setup 1:** k to M, SM, **kyok**, k to end; PM and close to knit in the round (2 sts inc'd)

**Setup 2:** p1, (k2, p2) repeat to M, RM, k1, **k2tog**, (p2, k2) repeat to last st, p1 (1 st dec'd)

**Sizes 1 ½, 4, 5, 6 ½, and 7:**

**Setup 1:** k3, **k2tog**, k to M, SM, **kyok**, k to last 5 sts, **k2tog**, k3; PM and close to knit in the round

**Setup 2:** k1, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to M, RM, k1, **k2tog**, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to last st, k1 (1 st dec'd)



## Section 10: Back Hem

The back part of the ribbed hem is worked top-down after picking up stitches from the body of the cardigan.



Work with Color A and the main needle size.

**Setup 1 (RS):** With RS facing, start at the CO of the Left Front, skip the first 39 (43, 47, 51)[51, 55, 59, 59][63, 63, 67, 71][71, 75, 79, 79] selvedge sts, then pick up and knit 88 (92, 96, 100)[112, 112, 116, 124][128, 136, 140, 144][152, 156, 156, 168] sts (1 st from every selvedge st) along the back of the body

Repeat R1-2 another 12 times (27 rows of ribbing in total).


**Tip:** If you prefer the back and front hem to be the same length, repeat only 5 times more (13 rows of ribbing in total).

Bind off in pattern. Break yarn.

## Section 11: Hem, Buttonband & Collar

The front hem, buttonband and collar are worked in one piece.

Work with Color A and the main needle size.



**Setup 1 (RS):** With RS facing, start where the back hem ended and pick up and knit 39 (43, 47, 51)[51, 55, 59, 59][63, 63, 67, 71][71, 75, 79, 79] sts for sizes 1 (1 ½, 2, 2 ½)[3, 3 ½, 4, 4 ½][5, 5 ½, 6, 6 ½][7, 7 ½, 8, 8 ½] from the lower edge of the cardigan towards the front sts (1 st from the same as the last back hem st; 1 st per selvedge st), PM;

then unravel the provisional CO of the Right Front and place the live sts onto the left-hand needle (not the one you used for picking up sts) and work them as follows: **kyok**, k all front sts, PM;

then pick up and knit 13/17 sts from the front selvedge for the Crew/Round Neckline (1 st from every selvedge st) or 24 sts for the V-Neck (3 sts from every 4 rows);

then pick up and knit 11/15/18 sts for the Crew/Round/V-Neck from the shoulder CO (1 st per CO st, the last one from the center of the slipped st);

then pick up and knit 32/40/40 sts for the Crew/Round/V-Neck along the back neckline (1 st per selvedge st);

then pick up and knit another 11/15/18 sts for the Crew/Round/V-Neck from the shoulder CO (1 st per CO st; the first one from the center of the slipped st);

then pick up and knit another 13/17 sts from the front selvedge for the Crew/Round Neckline (1 st from every selvedge st) or 24 sts for the V-Neck (3 sts from every 4 rows), PM;

then unravel the provisional CO of the Left Front and place the live sts onto the left-hand needle (not the one you used for picking up sts) and work them as follows: k to last left st, **kyok**, PM;

then pick up and knit another 39 (43, 47, 51)[51, 55, 59, 59][63, 63, 67, 71][71, 75, 79, 79] sts for sizes 1 (1 ½, 2, 2 ½)[3, 3 ½, 4, 4 ½][5, 5 ½, 6, 6 ½][7, 7 ½, 8, 8 ½] from the lower edge of the cardigan towards the back hem (1 st per selvedge st, last one from the same as the first back hem st) – see tables on page 18 for the full stitch count for each size

**R5 (RS) – Buttonhole Row 1:** k1, (k2, p2) repeat to 1 st before M, k1, **M1R**, SM, k1, SM, **M1L**, k1, p2, k1, **ssk, yo, k2tog**, [(k1, p2, k1) 2 times, **ssk, yo, k2tog**] repeat to 1 st before M, k1, SM, **M1L**, k1, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to 1 st before M, k1, **M1R**, SM, (k2, p2) repeat to 1 st before M, k1, **M1R**, SM, k1, SM, **M1L**, k1, (p2, k2) repeat to last st, sl1 wyif – 6 sts inc'd and 1 st dec'd per buttonhole

**R6 (WS) – Buttonhole Row 2:** k1, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to M, SM, p1, SM, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to M, SM, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to M, SM, p2, **k1/p1 into yo**, [p2, (k2, p2) 2 times, **k1/p1 into yo**] repeat to 6 sts before M, p2, k2, p2, SM, p1, SM, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to last st, sl1 wyif – 1 st inc'd per buttonhole

Continue with R7 (for all lengths).

**Lengths c & d:**

**R5 (RS) – Buttonhole Row 1:** k1, (k2, p2) repeat to 1 st before M, k1, **M1R**, SM, k1, SM, **M1L**, **ssk, yo, k2tog**, [(k1, p2, k1) 2 times, **ssk, yo, k2tog**] repeat to 1 st before M, k1, SM, **M1L**, k1, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to 1 st before M, k1, **M1R**, SM, (k2, p2) repeat to 1 st before M, k1, **M1R**, SM, k1, SM, **M1L**, k1, (p2, k2) repeat to last st, sl1 wyif – 6 sts inc'd and 1 st dec'd per buttonhole

**R6 (WS) – Buttonhole Row 2:** k1, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to M, SM, p1, SM, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to M, SM, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to M, SM, p2, **k1/p1 into yo**, [p2, (k2, p2) 2 times, **k1/p1 into yo**] repeat to 2 sts before M, p2, SM, p1, SM, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to last st, sl1 wyif – 1 st inc'd per buttonhole

Continue with R7 (for all lengths).

**Lengths e & f:**

**R5 (RS) – Buttonhole Row 1:** k1, (k2, p2) repeat to 1 st before M, k1, **M1R**, SM, k1, SM, **M1L**, k1, p2, k2, p2, k1, **ssk, yo, k2tog**, [(k1, p2, k1) 2 times, **ssk, yo, k2tog**] repeat to 1 st before M, k1, SM, **M1L**, k1, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to 1 st before M, k1, **M1R**, SM, (k2, p2) repeat to 1 st before M, k1, **M1R**, SM, k1, SM, **M1L**, k1, (p2, k2) repeat to last st, sl1 wyif – 6 sts inc'd and 1 st dec'd per buttonhole

**R6 (WS) – Buttonhole Row 2:** k1, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to M, SM, p1, SM, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to M, SM, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to M, SM, p2, **k1/p1 into yo**, [p2, (k2, p2) 2 times, **k1/p1 into yo**] repeat to 10 sts before M, p2, (k2, p2) 2 times, SM, p1, SM, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to last st, sl1 wyif – 1 st inc'd per buttonhole

Continue with R7 (for all lengths).

**All Lengths:**

**R7 (RS):** k3, (p2, k2) repeat to M, **M1p**, SM, k1, SM, **M1p**, k2, (p2, k2) repeat to M, SM, **M1p**, k2, (p2, k2) repeat to M, **M1p**, SM, k2, (p2, k2) repeat to M, **M1p**, SM, k1, SM, **M1p**, k2, (p2, k2) repeat to last st, sl1 wyif – 6 sts inc'd

**R8 (WS):** k1, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to 1 st before M, k1, SM, p1, SM, k1, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to M, SM, k1, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to 1 st before M, k1, SM, p1, SM, k1, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to last st, sl1 wyif

**R9 (RS):** k3, (p2, k2) repeat to 1 st before M, p1, **M1p**, SM, k1, SM, **M1p**, p1, k2, (p2, k2) repeat to M, SM, **M1p**, p1, k2, (p2, k2) repeat to 1 st before M, p1, **M1p**, SM, k2, (p2, k2) repeat to 1 st before M, p1, **M1p**, SM, k1, SM, **M1p**, p1, k2, (p2, k2) repeat to last st, sl1 wyif – 6 sts inc'd

**R10 (WS):** k1, (p2, k2) repeat to M, SM, p1, SM, (k2, p2) repeat to M, SM, k2, (p2, k2) repeat to M, SM, (p2, k2) repeat to M, SM, p1, SM, (k2, p2) repeat to last st, sl1 wyif

**R11 (RS):** k1, (k2, p2) repeat to M, **M1R**, SM, k1, SM, **M1L**, (p2, k2) repeat to M, SM, **M1L**, p2, (k2, p2) repeat to M, **M1R**, SM, (k2, p2) repeat to M, **M1R**, SM, k1, SM, **M1L**, (p2, k2) repeat to last st, sl1 wyif – 6 sts inc'd

**R12 (WS):** k1, (p2, k2) repeat to 1 st before M, p1, SM, p1, SM, p1, (k2, p2) repeat to M, SM, p1, k2, (p2, k2) repeat to 1 st before M, p1, SM, (p2, k2) repeat to 1 st before M, p1, SM, p1, SM, p1, (k2, p2) repeat to last st, sl1 wyif

Bind off in pattern. Break yarn.

**R39 (RS):** k2, (p2, k2) repeat to end

**R40 (WS):** p2, (k2, p2) repeat to end

Repeat R39-40 another 2 times, then bind off all sts. Break yarn.

Block the pockets and cardigan before sewing the pockets in place with Mattress stitch.

As you'll be connecting a vertical to a horizontal piece, you can sew one stitch to one row along the Garter stitch part, and along the ribbing, sew \*one stitch to one row 2 times, then one stitch to two rows of the ribbing once; repeat from \*. I recommend starting at the bottom corner that's closest to the buttonband and working upwards, then seaming the bottom edge and up the other side of the pocket.


Optional: Repeat instructions for a second pocket.

## Finishing

Gently block to dimensions and then weave in all ends. I recommend gently wet or steam blocking. Attach buttons to buttonband opposite the button holes. Attach pocket(s).

## Section 12: Patch Pockets (optional)

You can knit the following patch pockets as gauge swatches.



For a striped version, start with Color B and work the ribbing in Color A. You can also work a solid version and/or use a contrasting color for the ribbing.

Cast on 26 sts with a long-tail cast on using the main needle size (US 7/4.5 mm).

**Setup (WS):** p1, k to last st, p1

**R1 (RS):** k to end

**R2 (WS):** p1, k to last st, p1

Repeat R1-2 another 17 times (19 Garter ridges from CO).

Switch to the smaller needle size (US 6/4.0 mm) and continue as follows:

**R37 (RS):** k to end

**R38 (WS):** p2, (k2, p2) repeat to end
