
SPOILER ALERT CLUE 1

This PDF contains spoiler images to help you visualize the shapes and colors of Clue 1. We are knitting 6 Scallops inspired by soundwaves with a modular construction. Watch this week's video tutorial to assist with all of the techniques in Clue 1. At the end of the video I show the finished Clue 1.

SECTION 1



This is the RS of Clue 1.

Color A is the dominant main color this week, but it won't be the main color in the entire design.

Color B is a fun welt technique with a textural pop.

Color C is the background brioche color. There is also a simple garter stitch option for a non-brioche version of Clue 1. If you haven't done brioche before, I recommend doing the garter stitch option because we are working with a modular construction this week, so there is quite a bit to focus on with color, texture, and shaping. The brioche version is a bit more difficult if you haven't done this technique before.

Color D is used for some eyelet stripes.



This is the WS of Clue 1



Here are some beautiful Clue 1 examples from my amazing testknitters.

Color B is a bold red pop with 3 shades of brown for colors A, C & D.



Bright & cheerful yellow welts for color B. A refreshing light blue for color A. Color C is a bright purple shade striped with the blue color A. This shawl shows the garter stitch option instead of brioche for the color A & C blue/purple stripes. Color D is a vibrant orange for the eyelet stripes.



A beautiful pink pop is the main color A in this Clue 1 example. Color B is a peachy coral color pop for the welts. So sweet!



Moody and mysterious blues. I love the dark blue as color A, making the lighter colors pop. Color A is very prominent this week, but colors B, C & D will get to shine more in later Clues.



This multi-color contrast palette is very exciting with bright turquoise for color A. Dramatic red welts for Color B. Bright orange for the background brioche color C. Dark blue eyelets for Color D.

Here are the first 3 scallops of Clue 1. I loved adding a strand of lace weight mohair to color B for some fluffy welts in the terracotta + lime pop palette.



This is the wrong side with a bright lime green as color C for the background brioche option.



There are so many fun textures and color opportunities this week! We are working with colorful stripes, textured stitches, increases, and a modular construction this week. That a lot! Don't worry, there are some very relaxing knitting rhythms coming in later clues. Clue 1 requires focus and detail, resulting in a beautifully intricate motif inspired by soundwaves. Each clue is like a different song, so there will be some simpler knitting coming soon!
