

# Sallywrap

knitting pattern



**Sally Wrap** is a quick and easy project that is meant to encourage you to experiment with color combinations. We always have a few skeins in our stash that we bought to try out or left over from another knit. The best proportions and spacing of the stripes will be provided by using yarns with similar parameters, but don't be afraid to try and find your own solutions. You can always adjust the pattern to yourself, not yourself to the pattern ;)

<b>Sizes:</b>	mini (midi) maxi
<b>Length (from tip to tip):</b>	approx. 140 (154) 168 cm
<b>Width at center:</b>	approx. 26 (30) 34 cm
<b>Needles:</b>	4 mm / 60 cm circular needle
<b>Materials:</b>	<p><b>main color:</b> one strand kroopa wool col. 0936/ Gabo Wool approx. 2 (2) 3 skeins (50 g = 100m) held together with one strand of mohair: approx. 1 (1) 1.5 skein Tilia col. 145/ Filcolana (25 g = 210m)</p> <p><b>contrast color :</b> one strand Peer Gynt col. 6046/ Sandnes Garn approx. 0.2 (0.3) 0.3 skein (50 g = 91 m) held together with one strand of mohair: Tynn Silk Mohair col. 6046 / Sandnes Garn 0.2 (0.3) 0.3 skein (25 g = 210 m)</p>
<b>Gauge:</b>	15 sts x 20 rows = 10 x 10 cm in stockinette stitch on a 4 mm needle

**Sally Wrap** is worked back and forth (in one piece), from tip to tip in stockinette stitch with i-cord edges. First you make increases (expanding the knit), then you will decreases (narrowing the knit). The i-cord edge, which does not expand or narrow, will serve to discreetly guide the contrasting color thread in it. This will avoid cutting the wool during work and will provide an aesthetic appearance at the end without the need to hidetoo many ends. Once you have made the first stripe in a contrasting colour, before you start working on the next right rows, you will wrap the contrasting thread over the main colour thread from right to left. The contrasting color is the dominant color in this project, so always keep it close to the work. Check the video guide, it may help you:

## ABBREVIATIONS

<b>k</b>	knit
<b>k_cc</b>	knit contrast color
<b>k_mc</b>	knit main color
<b>p</b>	purl
<b>p_mc</b>	purl main color
<b>mc</b>	main color
<b>cc</b>	contrast color
<b>M1R</b>	make one right
<b>BER</b>	before the end of the row
<b>slip 2_ (wyif_mc)</b>	slip 2 sts with main color yarn held in front
<b>slip 2_ (wyif_mc/cc)</b>	slip 2 sts with main color and contrast color yarn held in front
<b>skp_mc</b>	slip 1 stitch knit-wise, <b>k1_mc</b> , pass the slipped stitch over the knited stitch
<b>skp_cc</b>	slip 1 stitch knit-wise, <b>k1_cc</b> , pass the slipped stitch over the knited stitch
<b>rs</b>	right side of your work
<b>ws</b>	wrong side of your work
<b>*</b>	after completing this row and turning the work to the right side, exceptionally You do not wrap the contrasting thread over the main color thread, but leave it hanging freely down; You will start wrapping it again from the next row on the right side
<b>sts</b>	stitches

Cast On 5 sts (long tail cast on) on 4 mm / 60 cm circular needle.

ws **0** k2, p1, slip 2 (wyif\_mc)

INCREASES

**A** rs **1** k to 2 sts BER, **M1R**, slip 2 (wyif\_mc)

ws **2** k2, p to 2 sts BER, slip 2 (wyif\_mc)

rs **3** k to 2 sts BER, slip 2 (wyif\_mc)

ws **4** k2, p to 2 sts BER, slip 2 (wyif\_mc)

x3

**B** rs **1** k to 2 sts BER, **M1R**, slip 2 (wyif\_mc)

ws **2** k2, p to 2 sts BER, slip 2 (wyif\_mc)

rs **3** k2\_mc, /k1\_cc, k1\_mc/ to 3 sts BER, k1\_cc, slip 2 (wyif\_mc)

ws **4** k2\_mc, /k1\_cc, p1\_mc/ to 3 sts BER, k1\_cc, slip 2 (wyif\_mc/cc)\*

Bind Off (rs):

the first 3 sts knit-wise\_mc  
and the last 2 sts purl-wise\_mc.

Weave in all ends.

DECREASES

**A** rs **1** k to 2 sts BER, slip 2 (wyif\_mc)

ws **2** k2, p to 2 sts BER, slip 2 (wyif\_mc)

rs **3** k to 4 sts BER, **skp\_mc**, slip 2 (wyif\_mc)

ws **4** k2, p to 2 sts BER, slip 2 (wyif\_mc)

x3

**B** rs **1** k to 2 sts BER, slip 2 (wyif\_mc)

ws **2** k2, p to 2 sts BER, slip 2 (wyif\_mc)

rs **3** k2\_mc, /k1\_cc, k1\_mc/ to 4 sts BER, **skp\_cc**, slip 2 (wyif\_mc)

ws **4** k2\_mc, /k1\_cc, p1\_mc/ to 3 sts BER, k1\_cc, slip 2 (wyif\_mc/cc)\*
