SIZE

(2XS) XS (S) M (L-XL) 2XL-3XL

MEASUREMENTS

Bust: (112) 120 (130) 139 (149) 157 cm

Length: approx (44) 45 (46) 47 (50) 54 cm, or suitable

Sleeve length: 45 cm, or suitable

All measurements are for the finished garment = personal body measurements + movement allowance. The measurements are all according to given tension.

THE GARMENT

Work cardigan from neck down with cable pattern.

Beg to work the back until underarms and transfer sts to spare thread. Knit up sts on left and right shoulder, for left and right front.

Work dec and inc to shape neck, at the same time work turning rows with GSR for slanting shoulder. Join fronts to the back. Work back and front in rows (back and forth) with cable pattern, and end with ribbing. Knit up sts on each armhole for sleeves. Work sleeves in rnds with cable pattern, and end with ribbing. Work front bands in double knit, and attach to cardigan at the same time.

Work garment with double yarn: 1 strand Tynn Peer Gynt + 1 strand Tynn Silk Mohair Print.

YARN

TYNN PEER GYNT (100 % Norwegian wool, 50 g = 205 m)

TYNN SILK MOHAIR PRINT (57 % mohair, 28 % silk, 15 % wool, 50 g = 424 m)

or

TYNN SILK MOHAIR (57 % mohair, 28 % silk, 15 % wool, 25 g = 212 m)

ALTERNATIVE YARN FOR TYNN PEER GYNT

MINI ALPAKKA, ALPAKKA SILKE, MANDARIN PETIT, BABYULL LANETT, SISU, TYNN MERINOULL

ALTERNATIVE YARN FOR TYNN SILK MOHAIR

ALPAKKA FØLGETRÅD

NOTE: If alternative yarn is chosen be sure to check the yardage on label. The image of garment might change by using alternative yarn.

YARN REQUIRED

TYNN PEER GYNT

Blue hydrangea #6032/Natural tweed #2523: (5) 5 (6) 7 (7) 8 balls

TYNN SILK MOHAIR PRINT

Desert dawn #6085: (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) 4 balls

or

TYNN SILK MOHAIR

Natural #1012: (5) 5 (6) 7 (7) 8 balls

NOTIONS

3 buttons

SUGGESTED KNITTING NEEDLES

Circular and double pointed 4 mm

Circular 3 mm for front bands

Needle sizes are only suggestions. If your knitting shows tighter tension, use thicker needles, for looser tension use thinner needle.

TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows diagram with 4 mm ndls
= 10 x 10 cm

GSR = GERMAN SHORT ROWS

After each turning always sl first st p-wise with yarn in front of work, lead yarn over right ndl and pull yarn firmly at the back until 2 loops on ndl. The 2 loops count as 1 st. When working rows/rnds with loops work loops tog to 1 st.

INC K1 RIGHT

From back insert left ndl under yarn between 2 sts and k the new stitch.

INC K1 LEFT

From front insert left ndl under yarn between 2 sts and k tbl the new stitch.

INC P1 RIGHT

From back insert left ndl under yarn between 2 sts and p the new stitch.

INC P1 LEFT

From front insert left ndl under yarn between 2 sts and p tbl the new stitch.

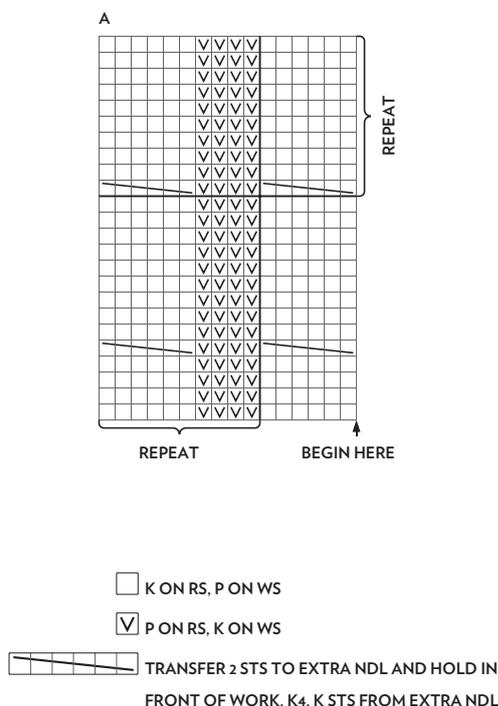
Edge st: work k every row

BACK

With double yarn and 4 mm cast on (118) 128 (138) 148 (158) 168 sts, and work first row from WS as follows: 1 edge st, p6, *k4, p6*, rep from *-* end with 1 edge st. Work diagram A back and forth inside 1 edge st on each side until work meas (21) 21 (23) 23 (25) 25 cm. Cut yarn, transfer sts to spare ndl and work fronts. Tips: Mark on diagram last st worked, to end with the same row when working fronts.

RIGHT FRONT

Beg at outer point of right shoulder. With double yarn and 4 mm circular ndl knit up (48) 54 (58) 64 (68) 74 sts. From WS work row 1 on diagram B, for chosen size. Work, dec and turn with GSR as shown on diagram B



= (42) 48 (52) 58 (62) 68 sts.

Place marker on edge st at armhole side when slanting shoulder is finished.

Cont diagram B, and inc for v-neck as shown on diagram until front meas approx (21) 21 (23) 23 (25) 25 cm from marker on edge st.

Note: Work new sts in diagram as they arise. End with same row as the back.

Transfer sts to spare thread and work left front.

LEFT FRONT

Beg by neck. With double yarn and 4 mm circular ndl knit up (48) 54 (58) 64 (68) 74 sts on left shoulder. From WS work first row on diagram B, for chosen size. Work, dec and turn with GSR as shown on diagram B = (42) 48 (52) 58 (62) 68 sts.

Place marker on edge st when slanting shoulder is finished.

Cont diagram B, and inc for v-neck as shown on diagram until front meas approx (21) 21 (23) 23 (25) 25 cm, meas from marker on edge st.

Note: Work new sts in diagram as they arise. End with same row as the back.

Join fronts and back in this manner:

Cont diagram further and work sts from left front, cast on 2 new sts, work sts for the back, cast on 2 new sts and work sts for right front.

Work new sts in diagram.

BACK AND FRONT

Cont diagram back and forth, and inc for v-neck every 4th row as shown in diagram.

Inc for v-neck in total (17) 15 (17) 15 (17) 15 times, and until (240) 258 (280) 298 (320) 338 sts on ndl.

Cont until garment meas approx (34) 35 (36) 37 (40) 44 cm, meas straight down from cast on at neck back, or until 10 cm before suitable length

End with at least 3 rows without cable twisting.

Next row, dec as follows

SIZE (2XS)(S)(L-XL)

Work 1 edge st, k2tog, k5, *p2tog, p2tog, k6*, rep from *-*, end with p2tog, p2tog, k5, p2tog, 1 edge st = (192) (224)(256) sts.

Work 10 cm ribbing back and forth as follows:

Row 1: (= WS) 1 edge st, p2, *k2, p2*, rep from *-*, end with 1 edge st.

Row 2: (= RS) 1 edge st, k2, *p2, k2*, rep from *-*, end with 1 edge st.

End with row 1.

SIZE XS, M, 2XL-3XL

Work 1 edge st, k1, p2tog, p2tog, *k6, p2tog, p2tog*, rep from *-*, end with k1, 1 edge st = 206, 238, 270 sts.

Work 10 cm ribbing back and forth as follows:

Row 1: (= WS) 1 edge st, p1, k2, *p2, k2*, rep from *-*, end with p1, 1 edge st.

Row 2: (= RS) 1 edge st, k1, p2, *k2, p2*, rep from *-*, end with k1, 1 edge st.

End with row 1.

ALL SIZES

By use of an extra ndl, move sts to be organized as [k1, p1] on ndl.

Note: Move k st in front of p st.

Work 2 rows double knit as follows:

Row 1: (= RS) 1 edge st, *k1, sl 1 p-wise with yarn in front of work*, rep from *-*, end with 1 edge st.

Row 2: (= WS) 1 edge st, *k1, sl 1 p-wise with yarn in front of work*, rep from *-*, end with 1 edge st.

Work Italian cast-off.

SLEEVES

Beg at middle underarm.

With double yarn and small 4 mm circular or double pointed ndls knit up (90) 90 (100) 100 (110) 110 sts on armhole edge.

Place marker at middle underarm.

Work diagram A in rnds until sleeve meas 8 cm, but beg and end with p2.

Read following chapter for dec at underarm before continue knitting.

First dec: Dec 1 st on each side of marker: p2tog before and after marker.

Second dec: Dec 1 st on each side of marker: k2tog after marker, and sl 1 k-wise, transfer st k-tbl back to left ndl and k2tog tbl before marker.

Cont diagram A and work first dec.

Cont dec further approx every 2½ cm in this manner:

work second dec 6 times, then work first dec 3 times = (70) 70 (80) 80 (90) 90 sts.

Note: Knit the sts if not enough sts for a complete cable.

Cont until sleeve meas 33 cm, or until 12 cm before suitable length.

End with at least 3 rnds without cable twisting.

Next rnd dec as follows :

Work *p2tog, k6, p2tog*, rep from *-* in the rnd = (56) 56 (64) 64 (72) 72 sts.

Work 12 cm ribbing in rnds as follows:

Work p1, k2, *p2, k2*, rep from *-*, end with p1.

By use of an extra ndl, move sts to be organized as k1, p1 on ndl.

Note: Move k st in front of p st.

Work 2 rnds double knit as follows:

Rnd 1: Work *k1, sl 1 with yarn in front of work*, rep from *-* in the rnd.

Rnd 2: *Sl 1 p-wise with yarn in back of work, p1*, rep from *-* in the rnd.

Work Italian cast-off.

Work other sleeve the same.

FRONT BAND

With double yarn and 3 mm circular ndl knit up 1 st every st/row on edge of right front, neck back and left front.

Cut yarn, and from WS work 16 sts with Italian cast-on to same ndl, and beg cast on with p1.

Place markers for buttonholes as follows:

Place marker approx 2 cm under beg of dec for v-neck, one marker approx 4 cm lower edge of ribbing and 1 marker at middle between the two. Markers indicate lower part of buttonhole.

Work double knit back and forth in this manner:

Row 1: (RS) Sl 1 p-wise with yarn in front of work, *k1, sl 1 p-wise with yarn in front of work*, rep from *-* until 1 st rem before the knitted-on sts on front, k2tog tbl.

Row 2: (WS) *Sl 1 p-wise with yarn in front of work, k1*, rep from *-* to end of row.

Rep row 1 - 2 and work buttonholes according to markers as follows:

Work 9 rows double knit back and forth, but over the first 8 sts only.

Cut yarn and transfer sts to spare thread.

Work 9 rows double knit back and forth, but over the last 8 sts only. Remember to work front band for front.

Transfer sts from spare thread to same ndl and cont double knit over all sts.

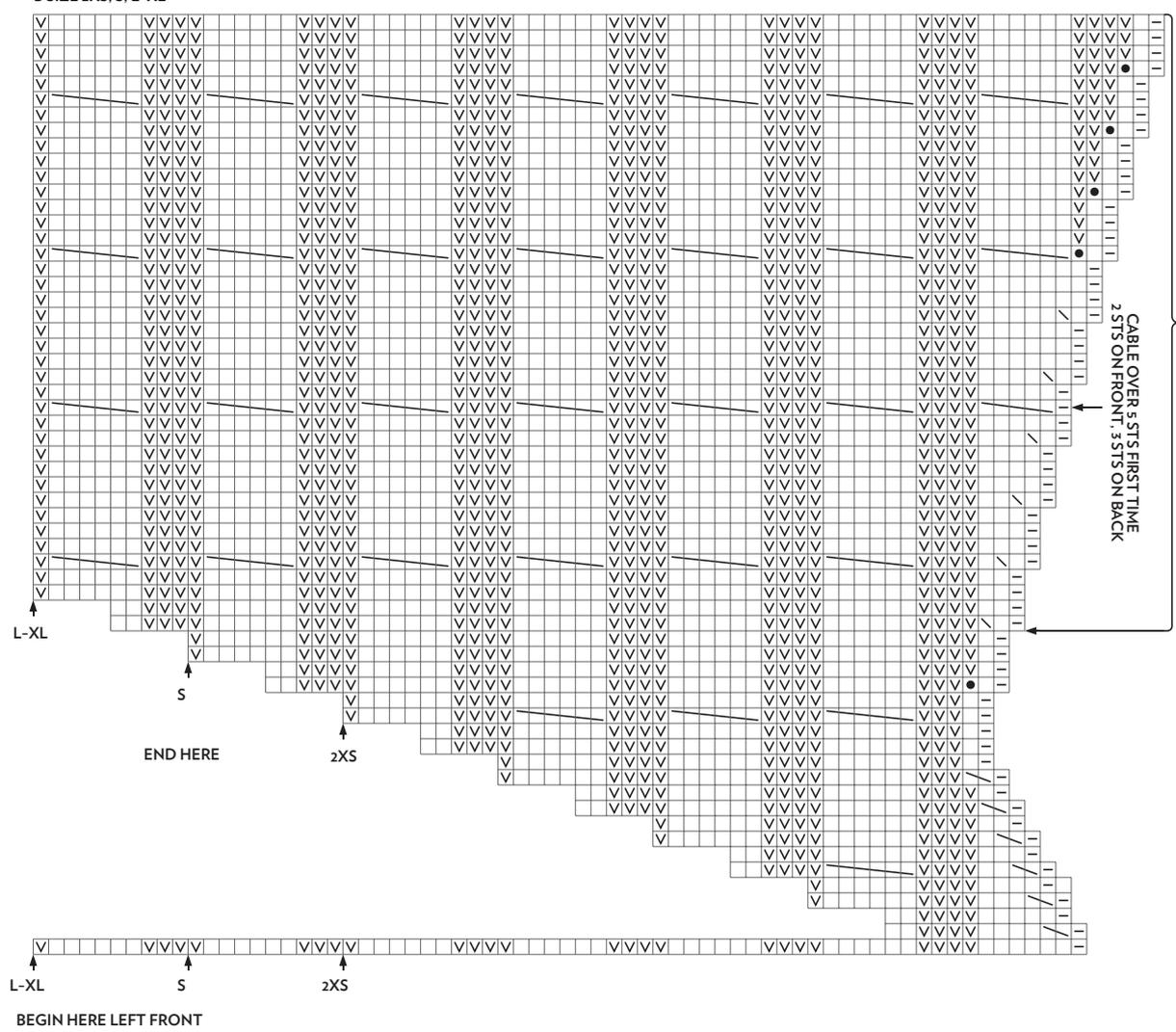
End with row 2.

Work Italian cast-off.

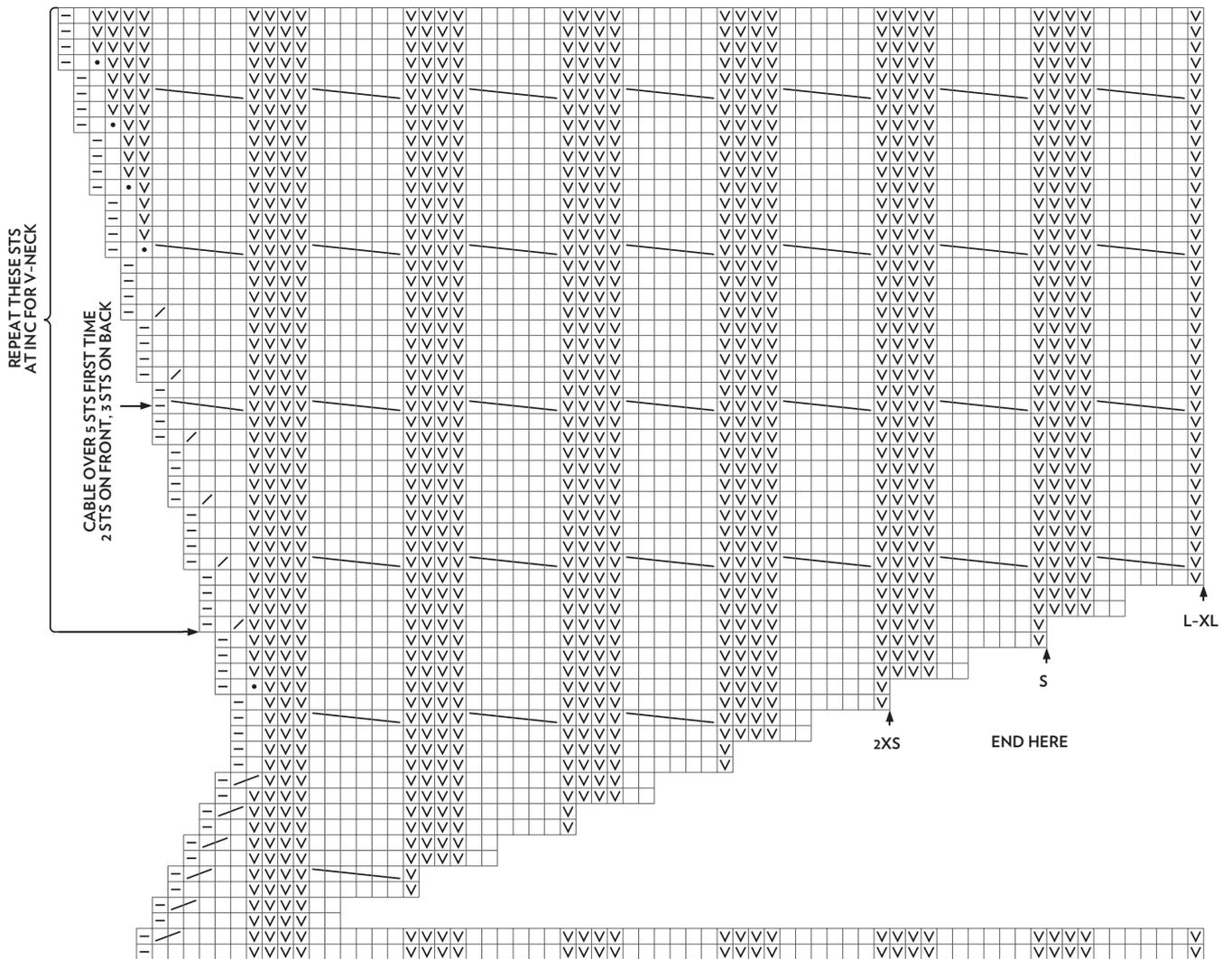
Sew buttons on.

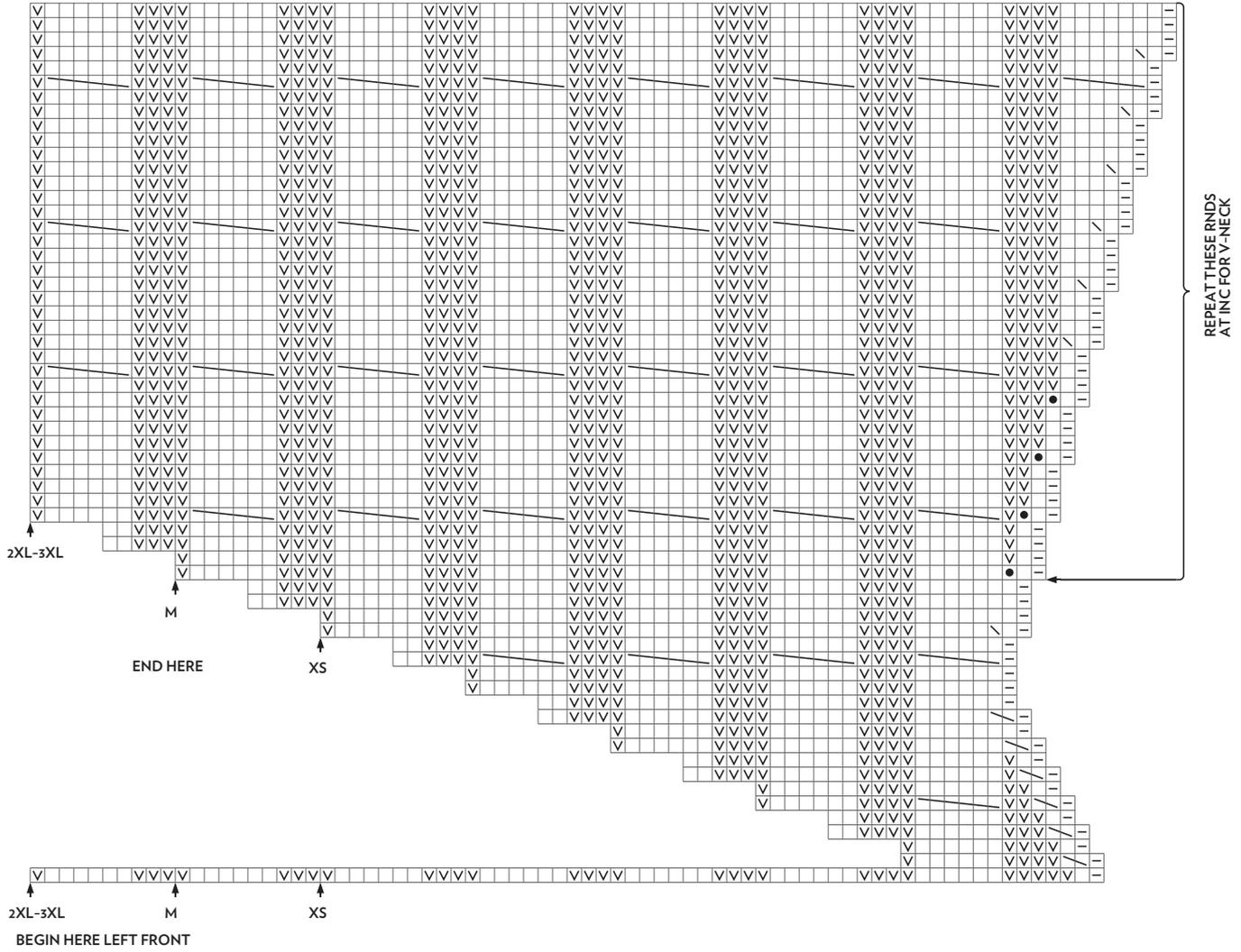
