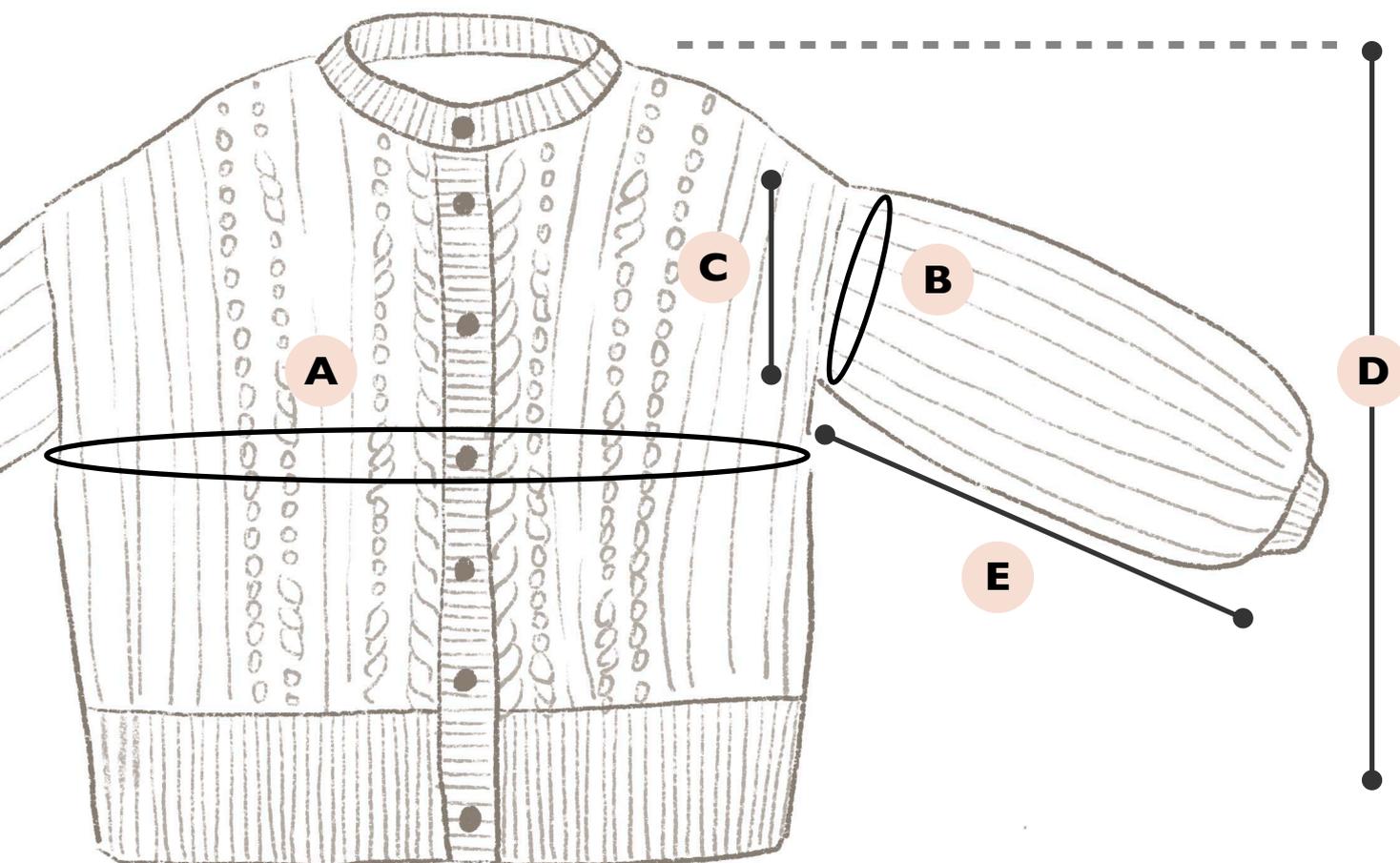

The cardigan is designed to have approx. 12" / 30cm of positive ease at the bust.

INFORMATION

OVERVIEW

The Sera cardigan pattern can be knitted in two different directions: bottom-up, starting from the hem, and top-down, starting from the shoulders. The sleeves, button bands, and neckbands are common parts for both methods.

The bottom-up method has shaping at the back neck, which provides more ease around the neckline and makes it easier to work in pattern. No seaming is required.

The top-down method can be tried on as it's being knitted, making it easier to adjust the length.

CONSTRUCTION

- **Bottom-up:** Please follow the **BOTTOM-UP** instructions marked in purple at the top of each page.
The cardigan is knitted from the bottom, starting with the hem which is worked in a ribbed stitch, then the body is worked in the stitch pattern up until the underarm where the fronts and back panels are separated and worked up to the shoulders, and they are finished with a 3 needle bind off to create the shoulder seam.
- **Top-down:** Please follow the **TOP-DOWN** instructions marked in green at the top of each page.
The cardigan is knitted from the top starting with the back which is worked in pattern down to the underarm, the stitches are then picked for each front, the right and left fronts are worked separately until the underarm where everything is joined. The body is worked in one piece in pattern to the ribbed hem.
- **Common:** Please follow the **COMMON** instructions marked in brown at the top of each page.
When the body is completed, the sleeves are picked up along the armhole opening, then worked in the round to the cuff. Stitches for the button bands and the neckband are picked up and worked in 1x1 ribbing.

SIZES

XS (S, M, L, XL) (2XL, 3XL, 4XL, 5XL)

YARN

Two strands held together.

- Wild & soft from Gepard garn / Fingering weight / 240 meters per 50g.
 - Kid seta tweed from Gepard garn / Lace weight(mohair) / 210 meters per 25g.
- 1093 (1148, 1268, 1367, 1465) (1574, 1684, 1760, 1826) yard / 1000 (1050, 1160, 1250, 1340) (1440, 1540, 1610, 1670) meters of each fingering and lace weight yarn or the same yardage of single strand of DK.

NEEDLES

- **Large:** 4mm(US6) 40" / 100cm circular needles for the body. 4mm(US6) 16" / 40cm circular needles for the sleeves.
- **Small:** 3.5mm(US5) 40" / 100cm circular needles for the hem, cuffs, button bands and neckband.

32" or 40" / 80cm or 100cm circular needles can be used if you are familiar with the Magic loop for working the sleeves in the round.

GAUGE

23 stitches 30 rows in Cable stitch / 15 stitches 30 rows in Brioche stitch / 20 stitches 27 rows in Stockinette stitch on the larger needles / 4 x 4" (10x10cm) / Blocked.

You will also need stitch markers, extra needles, cable needle, stitch holders, 7 buttons(14-20mm).

SYMBOLS

 Knit on RS / purl on WS.

 Purl on RS / knit on WS.

 Make one right.(M1R)

 Make one left.(M1L)

 BRK: Brioche Knit / knit yarn over and slipped stitch together.

 BRP: Brioche Purl / Purl yarn over and slipped stitch together.(knit 2 together in flat.)

 SLYO: with yarn in front slip on as if to purl, yarn over.

 Backwards loop cast on.

 Bind off.

 Repeat.

 No stitches.

 RC: Right Cross / slip 1 to cable needle and hold in back, knit 1, knit 1 from cable needle.

 LC: Left Cross / slip 1 to cable needle and hold in front, knit 1, knit 1 from cable needle.

 RPC: Right Purl Cross / slip 1 to cable needle and hold in back, knit 1, purl 1 from cable needle.

 LPC: Left Purl Cross / slip 1 to cable needle and hold in front, purl 1, knit 1 from cable needle.

 1/2 RC: slip 2 to cable needle and hold in back, knit 1, knit 2 from cable needle.

 1/2 LC: slip 1 to cable needle and hold in front, knit 2, knit 1 from cable needle.

 3/3 RC: slip 3 to cable needle and hold in back, knit 3, knit 3 from cable needle.

 3/3 LC: slip 3 to cable needle and hold in front, knit 3, knit 3 from cable needle.

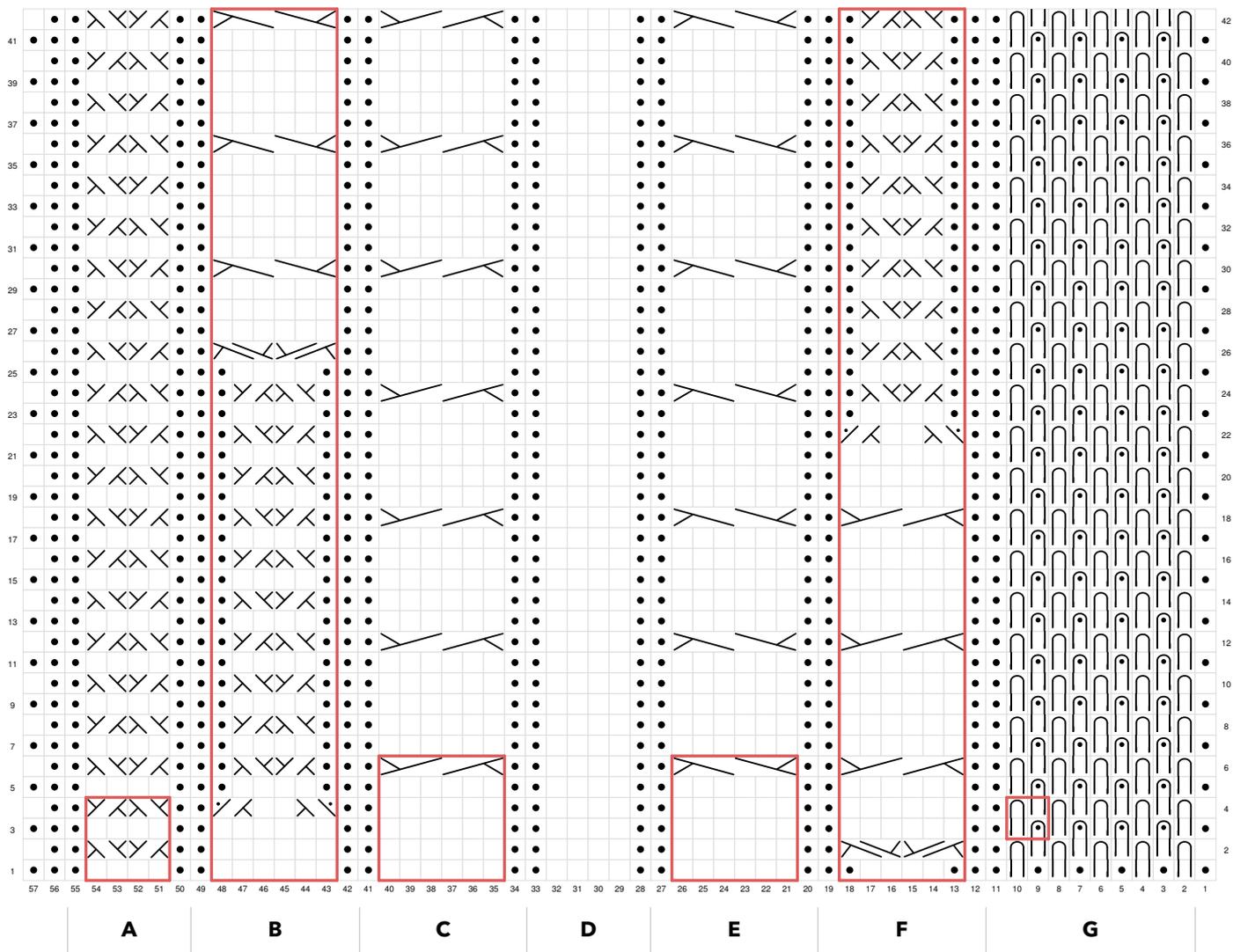

Knit on RS, purl on WS.

6-stitch & 6-row repeat.

Rows 1-5: stockinette stitch.

Row 6: 3/3LC.

G: FLAT

2-stitch & 2-row repeat.

Set-up: SLYO, k1.

Row 1(RS): SLYO, BRK.

Row 2(WS): BRK, SLYO.

G: IN THE ROUND

2-stitch & 2-round repeat.

Set-up: k1, SLYO.

Round 1: SLYO, BRP.

Round 2: BRK, SLYO.

B

6-stitch & 42-row repeat.

Rows 1-3: stockinette stitch.

Row 4(RS): 1/1 LPC, k2, 1/1 RPC.

Every WS of rows 5-25: k1, p4, k1.

Row 6: p1, RC, LC, p1.

Row 8: p1, LC, RC, p1.

Repeat rows 6-9 four more times.

Row 26: 1/2 RC, 1/2 LC.

Rows 27-29: stockinette stitch.

Row 30: 3/3 LC.

Rows 31-35: stockinette stitch.

Repeat rows 30-35 once more.

Row 42: 3/3 LC.

F

6-stitch & 42-row repeat.

Row 1(WS): k1, p4, k1.

Row 2(RS): 1/2 RC, 1/2 LC.

Rows 3-5: stockinette stitch.

Row 6: 3/3 RC.

Rows 7-11: stockinette stitch.

Repeat rows 6-11 once more.

Row 18: 3/3 RC.

Rows 19-21: stockinette stitch.

Rows 22: 1/1 LPC, k2, 1/1 RPC.

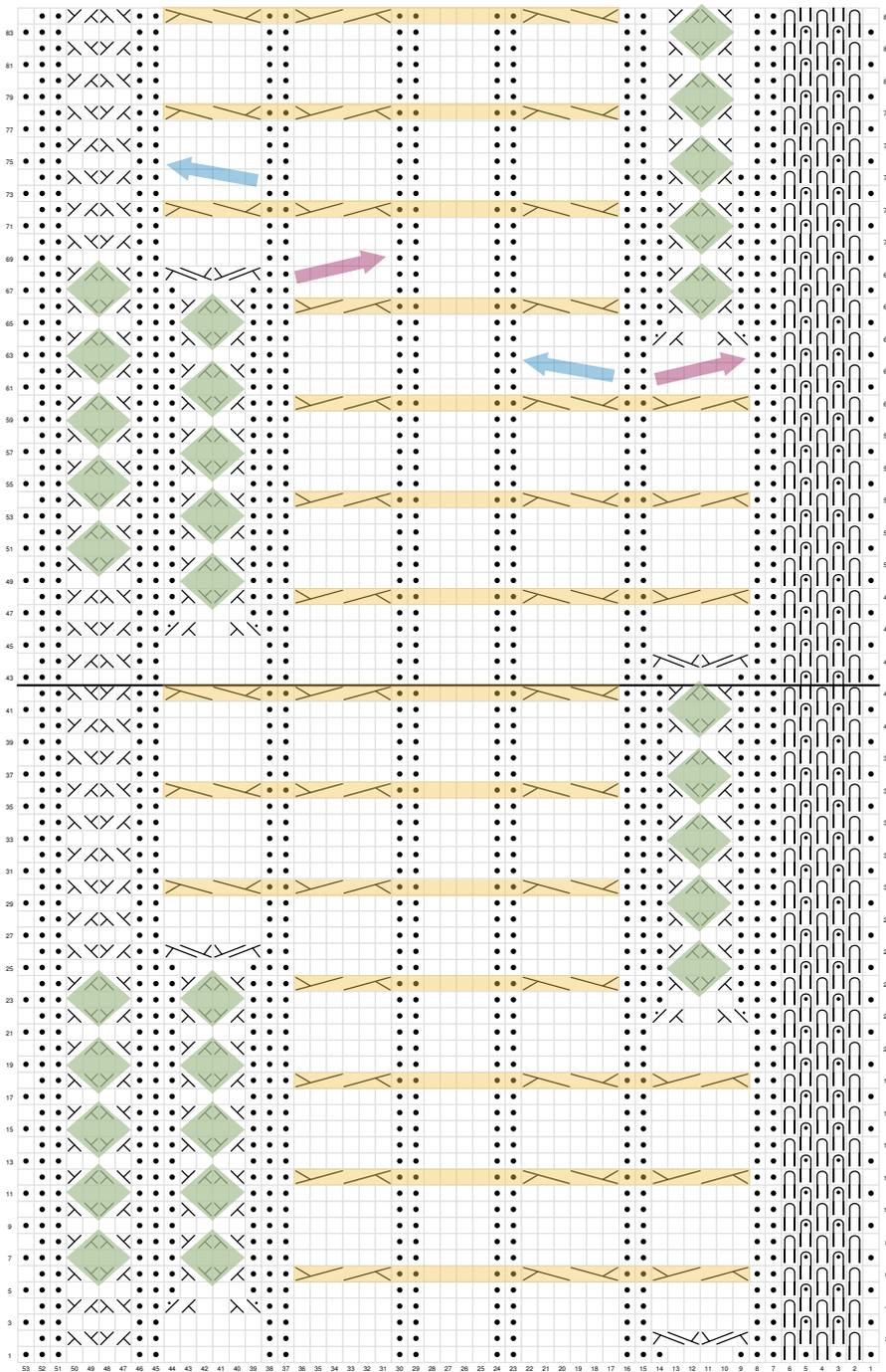
Every WS of rows 23-41: k1, p4, k1.

Row 24: p1, RC, LC, p1.

Row 26: p1, LC, RC, p1.

Repeat rows 24-27 four more times.

TIPS FOR AVOIDING MISTAKES:

1. Stitches don't always line up.
2. Each cable stitch direction is always reversed.
3. Brioche stitches are not included in the charts.
4. Check frequently to see if the overall stitch pattern is lining up well while knitting.
5. Brioche stitch sections are shorter than other sections. After completing the cardigan, stretch the Brioche section while blocking to match the length / row gauge or the other sections.

STEP 1. LOWER BODY

BOTTOM-UP

HEM

With the smaller needles cast on 207 (223, 237, 255, 269) (285, 309, 317, 333) stitches using Italian cast on.

Row 1(RS): k1, repeat *k1, p1* to the last 2 stitches, k2.

Row 2(WS): repeat *k1, p1* to the last stitch, k1.

Repeat rows 1-2 until the hem measures 3" / 8cm ending with a WS row.

Next row(RS): increase 15 (15, 17, 17, 19) (19, 19, 19, 19) stitches evenly as follows:

XS: k6, [M1L, k14] x 6, [M1L, k13] x 2, [M1L, k14] x 6, M1L, k7.

S: k7, M1L, k14, [M1L, k15] x 12, M1L, k14, M1L, k8.

M: k6, [M1L, k14] x 16, M1L, k7.

L: k7, [M1L, k15] x 16, M1L, k8.

XL: k7, [M1L, k14] x 8, [M1L, k15] x 2, [M1L, k14] x 8, M1L, k8.

2XL: k7, [M1L, k15] x 18, M1L, k8.

3XL: k8, [M1L, k16] x 7, [M1L, k17] x 4, [M1L, k16] x 7, M1L, k9.

4XL: k8, [M1L, k16] x 3, [M1L, k17] x 12, [M1L, k16] x 3, M1L, k9.

5XL: k8, [M1L, k18] x 5, [M1L, k17] x 8, [M1L, k18] x 5, M1L, k9.

Total: 222 (238, 254, 272, 288) (304, 328, 336, 352) stitches.

Swatch to the larger needles.

Row 1(WS): work the left front(starting with row 1 of the left front chart), pm, [SLYO, k1] x 14 (18, 22, 18, 22) (26, 24, 26, 30), SLYO, pm, work the back(starting with row 1 of the back chart), pm, [SLYO, k1] x 14 (18, 22, 18, 22) (26, 24, 26, 30), SLYO, pm, work the right front(starting with row 1 of the right front chart).

Row 2(RS): work the right front, sm, repeat *BRK, SLYO* to 1 stitch before next marker, BRK, sm, work the back, sm, repeat *BRK, SLYO* to 1 stitch before next marker, BRK, sm, work the left front.

Row 3: work the left front, sm, repeat *SLYO, BRK* to 1 stitch before next marker, SLYO, sm, work the back, sm, repeat *SLYO, BRK* to 1 stitch before next marker, SLYO, sm, work the right front.

Repeat rows 2-3 until the body measures 9¾" / 25cm ending with a WS row.

STEP 2. FRONTS

Work the left and right fronts and back separately.

Row 1(RS): work the right front, sm, *work 13 (17, 21, 17, 21) (25, 23, 25, 29) stitches in Brioche stitch, k1, BRK, k1, pass the second stitch on right needle over the first stitch(bind off 1), work in Brioche stitch to next marker, sm*, work the back, sm, repeat *-* once more, work the left front.

*Each front: 53 (57, 61, 65, 69) (73, 79, 81, 85) stitches.
Back: 114 (122, 130, 140, 148) (156, 168, 172, 180) stitches.*

LEFT FRONT

BOTTOM-UP

Place the right front and back stitches on hold, work over the next 53 (57, 61, 65, 69) (73, 79, 81, 85) stitches for the left front.

Work in pattern until the left front measures approx. 4¾ (5, 5½, 5¾, 6) (6½, 6¾, 7½, 7½)'' / 12 (12.5, 13, 14.5, 15) (16.5, 17, 18.5, 19)cm / 36 (38, 40, 44, 46) (50, 52, 56, 58) rows from underarm.

Always k the first and last stitch(Garter stitch) ending with a RS row.

SHAPE NECKLINE

Row 1(WS): bind off 4, work in pattern to the end.

Rows 2, 4, 6, and 8(RS): work in pattern to the end.

Rows 3 and 5: bind off 3, work in pattern to the end.

Row 7: bind off 1, work in pattern to the end.

Repeat rows 7-8 5 more times.

Work 7 rows in pattern.

Total: 37 (41, 45, 49, 53) (57, 63, 65, 69) stitches.

Break the yarn and place on hold.

RIGHT FRONT

With the WS facing, join new yarn and work over 53 (57, 61, 65, 69) (73, 79, 81, 85) stitches for the right front.

Work in pattern until the right front measures approx. 4¾ (5, 5½, 5¾, 6) (6½, 6¾, 7½, 7½)'' / 12 (13, 13.5, 15, 15.5) (17, 17.5, 18.5, 19.5)cm / 37 (39, 41, 45, 47) (51, 53, 57, 59) rows from underarm.

Always k the first and last stitch(Garter stitch) ending with a WS row.

SHAPE NECKLINE

Row 1(RS): bind off 4, work in pattern to the end.

Rows 2, 4, 6, and 8(WS): work in pattern to the end.

Rows 3 and 5: bind off 3, work in pattern to the end.

Row 7: bind off 1, work in pattern to the end.

Repeat rows 7-8 5 more times.

Work 6 rows in pattern.

Total: 37 (41, 45, 49, 53) (57, 63, 65, 69) stitches.

Break the yarn and place on hold.

STEP 3. BACK

BOTTOM-UP

With the WS facing, join new yarn and work over 114 (122, 130, 140, 148) (156, 168, 172, 180) stitches for the back.

Work in pattern until the back measures approx. 6¼ (6¾, 6¾, 7½, 7¾) (8¼, 8½, 9, 9¼)" / 16 (17, 17.5, 19, 19.5) (21, 21.5, 23, 23.5)cm /49 (51, 53, 57, 59) (63, 65, 69, 71) rows from underarm.

Always k the first and last stitch(Garter stitch) ending a WS row.

Next row(RS): work 41 (45, 49, 53, 57) (61, 67, 69, 73) stitches in pattern, bind off 32 (32, 32, 34, 34) (34, 34, 34, 34) for the back neck, work in pattern to the end.

LEFT SHOULDER

Row 1(WS): work 41 (45, 49, 53, 57) (61, 67, 69, 73) stitches in pattern, turn.

Row 2(RS): bind off 2, work in pattern to the end.

Row 3: work in pattern to the end.

Row 4: work as row 2.

Work 7 rows in pattern.

Total: 37 (41, 45, 49, 53) (57, 63, 65, 69) stitches.

Turn your work so that WS facing you, place the left front shoulder stitches on an extra needle, hold the working needle parallel to the extra needle and bind off using the Three needle bind off method.

RIGHT SHOULDER

With the WS facing, join new yarn.

Row 1(WS): bind off 2 stitches, work in pattern to the end.

Row 2(RS): work in pattern to the end.

Repeat rows 1-2 once more.

work 7 rows in pattern.

Total: 37 (41, 45, 49, 53) (57, 63, 65, 69) stitches.

Turn your work so that WS facing you, place the right front shoulder stitches on an extra needle, hold the working needle parallel to the extra needle and bind off using the Three needle bind off method.

STEP 1. BACK

TOP-DOWN

With the larger needles cast on 114 (122, 130, 140, 148) (156, 168, 172, 180) stitches.

Place locking markers in 37th (41st, 45th, 49th, 53rd) (57th, 63rd, 65th, 69th) and 78th (82nd, 86th, 92nd, 96th) (100th, 106th, 108th, 112th) stitch. *(to help identify stitches to pick up for the two fronts later)*

Row 1(WS): k1, [SLYO, k1] x 6 (8, 10, 8, 10) (12, 11, 12, 14), SLYO, pm, work the chart(starting with row 1 of the back chart), pm, [SLYO, k1] x 6 (8, 10, 8, 10) (12, 11, 12, 14), SLYO, k1.

Row 2(RS): k1, [BRK, SLYO] x 6 (8, 10, 8, 10) (12, 11, 12, 14), BRK, sm, work the chart, sm, [BRK, SLYO] x 6 (8, 10, 8, 10) (12, 11, 12, 14), BRK, k1.

Row 3: k1, [SLYO, BRK] x 6 (8, 10, 8, 10) (12, 11, 12, 14), SLYO, sm, work the chart, sm, [SLYO, BRK] x 6 (8, 10, 8, 10) (12, 11, 12, 14), SLYO, k1.

Repeat rows 2-3 until the armhole measures approx. 8 (8¼, 8½, 9, 9½) (10, 10¼, 10½, 11)" / 20 (21, 22, 23, 24) (25, 26, 27, 28)cm / 62 (64, 66, 70, 72) (76, 78, 82, 84) rows.

Always k the first and last stitch(Garter stitch). You will have 13 (17, 21, 17, 21) (25, 23, 25, 29) stitches for the Brioché stitch section excluding the edge stitch.

End with a WS row. Make a note of the last row you have knitted on the chart so that you can adjust the length when knitting the front later.

Break the yarn and place on hold.

STEP 2. FRONTS

RIGHT FRONT

With the RS of the back facing, and the cast on edge at the top, pick up and knit 37 (41, 45, 49, 53) (57, 63, 65, 69) stitches beginning with the right edge to the marked stitch. Remove marker.

Always k the first and last stitch(Garter stitch).

Row 1(WS): work the chart(starting with row 1 of the right front chart), pm, [SLYO, k1] x 6 (8, 10, 8, 10) (12, 11, 12, 14), SLYO, k1.

Row 2(RS): k1, [BRK, SLYO] x 6 (8, 10, 8, 10) (12, 11, 12, 14), BRK, sm, work the chart.

Row 3: work the chart, sm, repeat *SLYO, BRK* to the last 2 stitches, SLYO, k1.

Repeat rows 2-3 until the armhole measures approx. 8 (8¼, 8½, 9, 9½) (10, 10¼, 10½, 11)" / 20 (21, 22, 23, 24) (25, 26, 27, 28)cm / 62 (64, 66, 70, 72) (76, 78, 82, 84) rows ending with the same row as the back.

Break the yarn and place on hold.

LEFT FRONT

With the RS of the back facing, and the cast on edge at the top, pick up and knit 37 (41, 45, 49, 53) (57, 63, 65, 69) stitches beginning with the marked stitch to the left edge. Remove marker.

Always k the first and last stitch(Garter stitch).

Row 1(WS): k1, [SLYO, k1] x 6 (8, 10, 8, 10) (12, 11, 12, 14), SLYO, pm, work the chart(starting with row 1 of the left front chart).

Row 2(RS): work the chart, sm, [BRK, SLYO] x 6 (8, 10, 8, 10) (12, 11, 12, 14), BRK, k1.

Row 3: k1, repeat *SLYO, BRK* to 1 stitch before next marker, SLYO, sm, work the chart.

Repeat rows 2-3 until the armhole measures approx. 8 (8¼, 8½, 9, 9½) (10, 10¼, 10½, 11)" / 20 (21, 22, 23, 24) (25, 26, 27, 28)cm / 62 (64, 66, 70, 72) (76, 78, 82, 84) rows ending with the same row of the back.

Do not break the yarn.

Each front: 53 (57, 61, 65, 69) (73, 79, 81, 85) stitches.

STEP 3. LOWER BODY

Join the fronts and back. Work the 4 underarm stitches (the last stitch of the left front, the first and the last stitch of the back, the first stitch of the right front) to continues in Brioche pattern.

Work to the end of the left front, cast on 1 using Backwards loop cast on, work the back, cast on 1, work the right front.

Total: 222 (238, 254, 272, 288) (304, 328, 336, 352) stitches.

Keeping the first and last stitches of the row in Garter stitch throughout, continue knitting in pattern down the length of the body until it measures approx. 6¾" / 17cm from underarm or to 3" / 8cm less than desired length ending with a WS row.

Next row(RS): decrease 15 (15, 17, 17, 19) (19, 19, 19, 19) stitches evenly as follows:

XS: k6, [k2tog, k13] x 6, [k2tog, k12] x 2, [k2tog, k13] x 6, k2tog, k6.

S: k7, k2tog, k13, [k2tog, k14] x 12, k2tog, k13, k2tog, k7.

M: k6, [k2tog, k13] x 16, k2tog, k6.

L: k7, [k2tog, k14] x 16, k2tog, k7.

XL: k7, [k2tog, k13] x 8, [k2tog, k14] x 2, [k2tog, k13] x 8, k2tog, k7.

2XL: k7, [k2tog, k14] x 18, k2tog, k7.

3XL: k8, [k2tog, k15] x 7, [k2tog, k16] x 4, [k2tog, k15] x 7, k2tog, k8.

4XL: k8, [k2tog, k15] x 3, [k2tog, k16] x 12, [k2tog, k15] x 3, k2tog, k8.

5XL: k8, [k2tog, k17] x 5, [k2tog, k16] x 8, [k2tog, k17] x 5, k2tog, k8.

Total: 207 (223, 237, 255, 269) (285, 309, 317, 333) stitches.

HEM

With the smaller needles, working 1x1 ribbing as follows:

Row 1(WS): repeat *k1, p1* to the last stitch, k1.

Row 2(RS): k1, repeat *k1, p1* to the last 2 stitches, k2.

Repeat rows 1-2 until the hem measures 3" / 8cm, bind off using Tubular bind off.

STEP 4. SLEEVES

COMMON

Pick up and knit 1 stitch at the underarm, 61 (63, 65, 69, 71) (75, 77, 81, 83) stitches along the armhole approx. 1 stitch in each of stitches: Due to the Brioché stitch, there is only one hole over two rows in the Garter stitch. This means that although you are picking up one stitch per 2 rows, it looks like you are picking up one stitch per hole, so insert your needle into every hole to pick up the stitches.

Total: 62 (64, 66, 70, 72) (76, 78, 82, 84) stitches.

Round 1: repeat *k1, SLYO* to the end.

Round 2: repeat *SLYO, BRP* to the end.

Round 3: repeat *BRK, SLYO* to the end.

Repeat rounds 2-3 until the sleeve measures 15¾" / 40cm or to 1" / 3cm less than desired length.

Next round(RS): decrease 16 (16, 16, 18, 18) (20, 22, 24, 26) stitches evenly as follows:

XS: k1, [k2tog, k2] x 7, k2tog, k1, [k2tog, k2] x 7, k2tog.

S: k1, [k2tog, k2] x 15, k2tog, k1.

M: k2, [k2tog, k2] x 7, k2tog, k3, [k2tog, k2] x 7, k2tog, k1.

L: k1, [k2tog, k2] x 8, k2tog, k1, [k2tog, k2] x 8, k2tog.

XL: k1, [k2tog, k2] x 17, k2tog, k1.

2XL: k1, [k2tog, k2] x 8, [k2tog, k1] x 3, [k2tog, k2] x 8, k2tog.

3XL: k1, [k2tog, k2] x 6, [k2tog, k1] x 9, [k2tog, k2] x 6, k2tog.

4XL: k1, [k2tog, k2] x 5, [k2tog, k1] x 13, [k2tog, k2] x 5, k2tog.

5XL: k1, [k2tog, k2] x 3, [k2tog, k1] x 19, [k2tog, k2] x 3, k2tog.

Total: 46 (48, 50, 52, 54) (56, 56, 58, 58) stitches.

CUFF

Switch to the smaller needles, work 1x1 ribbing 1" / 3cm by repeating *k1, p1*.

Bind off using Tubular bind off.

STEP 5. BUTTON BANDS

LEFT BUTTON BAND

With the smaller needles, RS facing, start from the neckline edge of the left front, cast on 1, pick up and knit 2 stitches for every 3 rows along the entire front, then cast on 1. The total number of stitches should be odd.

Row 1(WS): sl1wyif, repeat *p1, k1* to the end.

Row 2(RS): k1, repeat *k1, p1* to the last 2 stitches, k2.

Work a total of 11 (11, 11, 13, 13) (13, 13, 13, 13) rows by repeating rows 1-2.

Bind off using Tubular bind off.

RIGHT BUTTON BAND

With the smaller needles, start from the bottom of the right front, cast on 1, pick up and knit the same number of stitches as the left button band, then cast on 1.

Row 1(WS): repeat *k1, p1* to the last stitch, p1.

Row 2(RS): sl1wyib, repeat *k1, p1* to the last 2 stitches, k2.



Work a total of 11 (11, 11, 13, 13) (13, 13, 13, 13) rows by repeating rows 1-2, make buttonholes on row 6 (6, 6, 7, 7) (7, 7, 7, 7).

The cardigan has 7 buttons, 6 on the button band and 1 on the neckband. Make 6 buttonholes. The first buttonhole placement should be as shown in Fig.

The last buttonhole is placed about 1" / 2.5cm away from the bottom edge. Place markers at the first and the last buttonhole locations, 4 more in the middle.

Buttonhole row: work to m, yo, k2tog/p2tog(k2tog when the first stitch on the left needle is purl stitch / p2tog when the first stitch on the left needle is knit stitch)

STEP 6. NECKBAND

With the smaller needles, RS facing, start from the right front, cast on 1, pick up and knit 8 (8, 8, 9, 9) (9, 9, 9, 9) stitches across the button band, 3 stitches for every 4 rows of the front neck, 1 stitch in each of stitch across the back neck, then the same number of stitches for the other front, cast on 1. The total number of stitches should be odd.

Row 1(WS): sl1wyif, repeat *p1, k1* to the last 2 stitches, p2.

Row 2(RS): sl1wyib, repeat *k1, p1* to the last 2 stitches, k2.

Work a total of 11 rows, make buttonhole on row 6.

Bind off using Tubular bind off.

FINISH

Sew the buttons on the left front leveled with the buttonholes, and weave in all ends.

Wash the cardigan, pin on a flat surface to dry taking extra care to ease the button band to shape.

ABBREVIATIONS

K	Knit.
K2tog	Knit two stitches together. 1 stitch decreased.
P	Purl.
PM	Place stitch marker.
RS	Right side.
Sl1wyib	Slip one with yarn in back.
Sl1wyif	Slip one with yarn in front.
SM	Slip stitch marker.
WS	Wrong side.
YO	Yarn over.
