

Shawl Catalonia + 3 Types of Flowers@ 2015 Tashashu Gordon

Abbreviations:

- BO = bind off
- CO = cast on
- k = knit
- k2tog= knit two (2) stitches together
- k3tog= knit three (3) stitches together
- LN= left needle
- MB = make Bobble
- p = purl
- rep = repeat
- sl1k = slip a stitch knit-wise
- st(s) = stitch (es)
- RN= right needle
- RS = right side
- yo = yarn over
- YO2 = YO twice (yarn over twice)
- w/o = without
- WS = wrong side
- w&t = wrap and turn
- wyib = slip a 1 stitch with yarn in back
- wyif = slip a 1 stitch with yarn in front



Gauge: 35sts and 40 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

Yarn: for the shawl-2100m (100g-600m)

For the one "A" flower -20 meters (approximately)

For the one "B" flower – dark color 10 meters, light color - 17 meters (approximately)

For the one "C" flower - dark color 18 meters, light color - 10 meters (approximately)

Shawl size: wide- 105 cm. / long- 245 cm.


Needles: 2mm, circular needles 2mm, 2 x cable needles.

Pattern (shawl)


Work the stitches as they present themselves on the WS rows. Pay attention - YO2 will be treated as purl st and crossed purl st on the next row. The first and last stitches (empty spaces of the chart) will be either slipped, purred/knitted or purred and knitted together with one stitch from the previous SQUARE. You'll notice that there are two rows that have no numbers, that is because, depending on the tier, you'll have to knit one more row before the stitch pattern or after the stitch pattern is knitted. Every tier begins by casting an extra 26sts using the loop cast-on method.



Row 25: slip 1st, p1, transfer 10 sts to cable needle and hold in front of work, hold 2 purl sts on cable needle behind work, k10, then p2 from cable needle behind work, now 10 (k1, yo, k2tog, k2tog, yo,yo,k2tog, k2tog, yo, k1) from cable needle in front of work, p1, p1 or k2tog (together with one stitch from the previous square) depending on the tier

SQUARE-1:

RS and WS - slip the first stitch and purl the last stitch of every row.

Cast on 26 sts on circular needle size 2 mm. Work the chart from Row 1 (of the chart) to Row 51. Last row worked from RS. W/o turn and leave sts on needle.


SQUARE-2 (a: hereinafter - red letters mark SQUARES type of knitting, please see Diagram):

Using the working yarn cast on 26 stitches (using the loop cast-on method) on the same needle. Work - back and forth on the new 26 sts



RS - slip the first stitch and purl the last stitch/ WS - slip the first stitch and P2tog the last stitch with 1 st from SQUARE-1.

Purl one Row. Continue work the chart from Row 1 (of the chart) until all sts from SQUARE-1 are knitted = 26 sts on needle. Last row worked from WS. Leave sts on needle.



SQUARE-3(b):

W/o turn! Pick up and purl 26 sts along the edge of SQUARE-1 from WS. Work - back and forth on the new 26 sts

RS and WS - slip the first stitch and purl the last stitch of every row. Continue work the chart from Row 1 to Row 50. Last row worked from WS. Leave sts on needle.



SQUARE-4(c):

Using the working yarn cast on 26 stitches (using the loop cast-on method) on the same needle. Work - back and forth on the new 26 sts

RS - slip the first stitch and K2tog the last stitch with 1 st from SQUARE-3 / WS - slip the first stitch and purl the last stitch.

Continue work the chart from Row 1 (of the chart) until all sts from SQUARE-2 are knitted (work last row from RS). Leave sts on needle.



SQUARE-5(d):

W/o turn! Pick up and knit 26 sts along the edge of SQUARE-3 from RS. Work - back and forth on the new 26 sts

RS - slip the first stitch and K2tog the last stitch with 1 st from SQUARE-2 / WS - slip the first stitch and purl the last stitch.

Purl one Row. Continue work the chart from Row 1 (of the chart) until all sts from SQUARE-2 are knitted (work last row from RS). Leave sts on needle.



SQUARE-6(e):

W/o turn! Cast on 26 stitches (using the loop cast-on method) on the same needle (RS). Work - back and forth on the new 26 sts RS and WS - slip the first stitch and purl the last stitch of every row.
Purl one Row. Work the chart from Row 1 (of the chart) to Row 51. Last row worked from RS. Leave sts on needle.



SQUARE-7(a):

Using the working yarn cast on 26 stitches (using the loop cast-on method) on the same needle. Work - back and forth on the new 26 sts RS - slip the first stitch and purl the last stitch/ WS - slip the first stitch and P2tog the last stitch with 1 st from SQUARE-6.
Purl one Row. Continue work the chart from Row 1 (of the chart) until all sts from SQUARE-6 are knitted = 26 sts on needle. Last row worked from WS. Leave sts on needle.

SQUARE-8(f):

W/o turn! Pick up and purl 26 sts along the edge of SQUARE-6 from WS. Work - back and forth on the new 26 sts RS - slip the first stitch and purl the last stitch/ WS - slip the first stitch and P2tog the last stitch with 1 st from SQUARE-5.
Continue work the chart from Row 1 (of the chart) until all sts from SQUARE-5 are knitted = 26 sts on needle. Last row worked from WS. Leave sts on needle.

Continue work: From here on, all tiers are worked in a similar fashion, each one having one more SQUARE block than the tier before it.

The final tier (triangles)

TRIANGLE-92

K all rows RS, P all rows WS.

Using the working yarn cast on 26 stitches (using the loop cast-on method) on the same needle (RS). Work - back and forth on the new sts.

RS - slip the first stitch and K2tog the last 2 stitch of every row.

WS - slip the first stitch and P2tog the last stitch with 1 st from SQUARE-91 of every row.

Continue work until all sts from SQUARE-91 are knitted = 1 st on needle.

TRIANGLE-93(g)

K all rows RS, P all rows WS.

W/o turn! Pick up and purl 26 sts along the edge of SQUARE-91 from WS. Work - back and forth on the new sts.

RS - slip the first stitch and K2tog the last 2 stitch of every row.

WS - slip the first stitch and P2tog the last stitch with 1 st from SQUARE-90 of every row.

Continue work until all sts from SQUARE-90 are knitted = 1 st on needle.

TRIANGLE-105

K all rows RS, P all rows WS.

Using the working yarn cast on 26 stitches (using the loop cast-on method) on the same needle (WS). Work - back and forth on the new sts.

RS - slip the first stitch and K2tog the last 2sts of every row.


WS - slip the first stitch and P2tog the last 2sts of every row.

Continue work until all sts are knitted = 1 st on needle. BO 1st. Block (see block spots on the Diagram "Color").

Flowers

Note: I used "wrap and turn" (knit the indicated number of sts, wrap working yarn around next stitch, turn and knit back in the opposite direction, but any other short-row turn works just as well. This Flower is knitted seamlessly in one piece (without seams). Do not confuse "w/o turning" and "wrap and turn"! In wrong side YO of the previous row knit crossed stitch to avoid holes in the knitted cloth. Use short needles.
Work step by step and you will have excellent results.

S11k, k1, w&t/ k1, p1/ sl1k, k3, w&t/ k3, p1/ sl1k, k5, w&t/ k5, p1/ sl1k, k7, w&t/ k7, p1/ sl1k, k9, w&t/ k9, p1/ sl1k, k11, w&t/ k11, p1/ sl1k, k13, w&t/ k11, k2tog, p1/ BO 5, w/o turning, (1 st remaining on RN), p8, w&t (1 st remaining on RN) (see photo 1)



K9, w/o turning, CO 5 using the loop cast-on method /sl1k, k13, w&t/ (1 st remaining on RN), k13, yo, p1/ sl1k, k12, w&t/ k12, p1/ sl1k, k10, w&t / k10, p1/ sl1k, k8, w&t/ k8, p1/ sl1k, k6, w&t/ k6, p1/ sl1k, k4, w&t/ k4, p1/ sl1k, k2, w&t/ k2, p1/ sl1k, k14, wyif, turn work (see photo 5), make Bobble (see photo 6), slip 1 st (Bobble) from RN to LN (see photo 7), turn work, pick up and knit 15sts (see photo 8 (WS)). Turn work.



P9, CO 5 using the loop cast-on method/ sl1k, k13, w&t/ k13, yo, p1/ sl1k, k12, w&t/ k12, p1/ sl1k, k10, w&t / k10, p1/ sl1k, k8, w&t / k8, p1/ sl1k, k6, w&t/ k6, p1/ sl1k, k4, w&t/ k4, p1/ sl1k, k2, w&t / k2, p1/ sl1k, k13, k3tog (see photo 11) * slip 2 st from RN to LN (see photo 12), k3tog* rep from * to * 13 more times (see photo 13), (1 st remaining on RN).

BO the last 1st. Number of flowers optional. Place flowers on shawl (see photo 14) and sew on using tapestry needle.

Continue work (light color): sl1k, k15, w&t/ k13, w&t/ k11, w&t/ k9, w&t/ k7, w&t/ k6, w&t/ k7, w&t/ k9, w&t/ k11, w&t/ k13, w&t/

Continue work (dark color): k15, p1, turn work. BO 10, w&t (1 st remaining on LN) (see photo 1).





K1, w/o turn, CO 10 using the loop cast-on method (see photo 2), turn work.

Sl1k, k15, p1, w&t (1 st remaining on RN).

Continue work (light color): k15, w&t/ k13, w&t/ k11, w&t/ k9, w&t/ k7, w&t/ k6, w&t/ k7, w&t/ k9, w&t/ k11, w&t/ k13, w&t/

Continue work (dark color): k15, p1, turn work. BO 10, w&t (1 st remaining on LN) (see photo 3).



Parts 3, 4, 5 (see schematic) - rep Part 2

Part 6 (see schematic)

K1, w/o turn, CO 10 using the loop cast-on method, turn work.

Sl1k, k15, p1, w&t (1 st remaining on RN).

Slip 1 st from RN to LN, make Bobble (see photo 4).

Continue work (light color): k15, w&t/ k13, w&t/ k11, w&t/ k9, w&t/ k7, w&t/ k6, w&t/ k7, w&t/ k9, w&t/ k11, w&t/ k13, w&t/

Continue work (dark color): k15, p1, turn work. BO 10, (1 st remaining on RN), w/o turn, k5, p1, wyif, turn work,


pick up to RN 7 sts along the edge of Part 1 from RS (see photo 5,5a), slip 1 st from RN to LN, k3tog, (see photo 6), *slip 2 sts from RN to LN,

k3tog* - rep from*to * 5 more times (see photo 7), BO last 1st. Number of flowers optional. Place flowers on shawl (see photo 8) and sew on

using tapestry needle.

Continue work (light color): sl1k, k15, w&t/ k13, w&t/ k11, w&t/ k9, w&t/ k7, w&t/ k6, w&t/ k7, w&t/ k9, w&t/ k11, w&t/ k13, w&t/

Continue work (dark color): k15, p1, turn work. BO 5, w&t (1 st remaining on LN) (see photo 1).





Sl1k, k19, p1, w&t

Continue work (light color): k19, w&t/ k6, w&t/ k4, w&t/ 6, w&t/ 4, w&t/ k6, w&t/ k5, w&t/ k4, w&t/ k6, w&t/ k4, w&t/ k6, w&t/ k17, w&t/

Continue work (dark color): k19, p1, turn work. BO 9, w&t (1 st remaining on LN), (see photo 3).

K1, w/o turn, CO 5 using the loop cast-on method, turn work.

Sl1k, k15, p1, w&t (see photo 4),

Continue work (light color): k15, w&t/ k13, w&t/ k11, w&t/ k9, w&t/ k7, w&t/ k6, w&t/ k7, w&t/ k9, w&t/ k11, w&t/ k13, w&t/

Continue work (dark color): k15, p1, turn work. BO 5, w&t (1 st remaining on LN), (see photo 5)




Part 12 (see schematic)

K1, w/o turn, CO 5 using the loop cast-on method, turn work.

S11k, k15, p1, w&t,

Continue work (light color): k15, w&t/ k13, w&t/ k11, w&t/ k9, w&t/ k7, w&t/ k6, w&t/ k7, w&t/ k9, w&t/ k11, w&t/ k13, w&t/

Continue work (dark color): k15, p1, turn work. BO 5, (1 st remaining on RN), w/o turn, k10, p1, (see photo 14), turn work!, slip 1 st from RN to LN, make Bobble, slip 1st (Bobble) from RN to LN (see photo 15), pick up to RN 12 sts along the edge of Part 1 from RS (see photo 16, 16a), slip 1 st from RN to LN, k3tog (see photo 17), *slip 2 sts from RN to LN, k3tog* - rep from * to * 10 more times (see photo 18), BO last 1st. Number of flowers optional. Place flowers on shawl (see photo 19) and sew on using tapestry needle.
