JACKET

MATERIALS

JOHN DEACON Standard Double Knitting.
19 (21 : 22 : 24 : 25 : 27 : 28) ozs.

JOHN DEACON Bri-Nylon Double Knitting.
22 (25 : 27 : 28 : 30 : 31 : 33) ozs.

JOHN DEACON Deaconfleck, Deacrepe, Scotch
Double Knittings.
21 (23 : 24 : 26 : 27 : 29 : 30) ozs.

1 pair needles each No. 9 and No. 11.
6 buttons.

WASHING

Using a mild detergent or soap completely dissolved
by hand. DO NOT RUB. Rinse several times in
squeeze out the water, then fold garment in a clean
again. Pull carefully to shape and dry flat away from d

BACK

Using No. 11 needles cast on 90 (96:102:
108:114:120:126) sts., and work 18 rows in
k1, p1 rib.

Change to No. 9 needles and commence
pattern:—

1st row. (Right side) K.

2nd row. * P1, k1; rep. from * to end.

3rd row. K.

4th row. * K1, p1; rep. from * to end.

Rep. these 4 rows until back measures 6 ins.,
ending with a wrong side row.

Inc. 1 st. at side edge of next row, then
every following 20th row twice more.
96 (102:108:114:120:126:132) sts.

Work straight until back measures 15 (15½:
15½:16:16:16:16) ins. or desired length to
underarm, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape Raglans

Cast off 1 (1:1:2:2:3:3) sts. at beg. of next 2
rows.

Next row. K2, p1, k to last 3 sts., p1, k2.

Next row. P3, work to last 3 sts., p3.

Next row. K2, p2tog., k to last 4 sts.,
p2tog., k2.

Next row. P3, work to last 3 sts., p3.

Rep. last 4 rows twice more, 88 (94:100:
104:110:114:120) sts. remain, then rep. last
2 rows only, until 26 (28:30:32:34:36:38)
sts. remain, ending with the wrong side row.
Cast off.

POCKET LININGS (Make 2)

Using No. 9 needles cast on 28 (28:30:30:
32:32:32) sts., and work 27 rows in st.st.
starting with a p row.

Leave sts. on holder.

RIGHT FRONT

Using No. 11 needles cast on 56 (58:62:64:
68:70:74) sts.

1st row. * K1, p1; rep. from * to end.

Rep. last row 17 times more, increasing 1 st.
at beg. of last row on sizes 36, 40 and 44
only. 56 (59:62:65:68:71:74) sts.

1st row. Rib 15, change to No. 9 needles
and k to end. Leave the 15 sts. at front
edge on a spare needle.

Sizes 36, 40 and 44 only. Start next row with
a k st., **remaining sizes**, start next row with
a p st.

Next row. Work k1, p1 or p1, k1 rib to end.
Work 26 more rows in pattern, thus ending
at front edge.

Place Pocket (Omit this row if pocket is not
required).

Next row. Work 10 (12:13:15:16:18:20) sts.,
slip next 28 (28:30:30:32:32:32) sts. on to
a holder for pocket top, k across sts. of
pocket lining, k to end.

Work straight until front measures 6 ins.

Inc. 1 st. at side edge of next row then on
every 20th row twice more. 44 (47:50:53:
56:59:62) sts.

MEASUREMENTS

To fit chest sizes	34 (36:38:40:42:44:46) inches
Actual measurement	36½ (39:41½:43½:46:48:50) inches
Centre back length	24½ (25½:26:26½:27½:28) inches
Sleeve seam	17½ (18:18½:19:19:19) inches

TENSION

21 sts. = 4 ins. measured over pattern.

It is essential to obtain the correct tension in the yarn used and a small test piece should be worked. If there are too many stitches to the inch, use a thicker needle, if too few, use a finer one.

ABBREVIATIONS

K=knit; **P**=purl; **st(s)**. = stitch(es); **rep.** = repeat; **in(s)**. = inch(es); **inc.** = increase; **dec(s)**. = decrease(s); **beg.** = beginning; **tog.** = together; **st.st** = stocking stitch (1 row K, 1 row P); **alt.** = alternate; **sl.** = slip.

Where the figure '0' occurs in the pattern, no sts. or rows are worked for this size.

Tweed, or Special

warm water, wash
fresh water—gently
towel and squeeze
ect heat or sunlight.

Work straight until front measures same as back to start of raglan shaping, ending at side edge.

Shape Raglan

Next row. Cast off 1 (1:1:2:2:3:3) sts., work to end.

Next row. K.

Next row. P3, work to end.

Next row. Work to last 4 sts., p2tog., k2.

Next row. P3 work to end.

** Rep. last 4 rows twice more, 40 (43:46:48:51:53:56) sts. remain.

Shape Neck

Dec. 1 st. at raglan edge as before on next and every alt. row, **AND AT THE SAME TIME** dec. 1 st. at neck edge on next row and then every following 6th (6th:6th:6th:6th:4th:4th) row, 1 (3:5:8:10:1:2) times more, 34 (29:24:14:9:48:48) sts. remain, and then on every 8th (8th:8th:8th:8th:6th:6th) row until 4 sts. remain. Work 1 more raglan dec. as before, ending with the wrong side row. 3 sts.

Next row. P2tog., p1. Cast off **.

LEFT FRONT

Using No. 11 needles cast on 56 (58:62:64:68:70:74) sts.

1st row. * K1, p1; rep. from * to end.

Rep. last row 5 times more.

Next row. (Buttonhole) Work to last 9 sts., cast off next 3 sts., rib to end.

Cast on 3 sts. above buttonhole in next row.

Work 10 more rows in rib, increasing 1 st. at end of last row on sizes 36, 40 and 44 only. 56 (59:62:65:68:71:74) sts.

Change to No. 9 needles and commence pattern:—

1st row. K to last 15 sts., turn and leave these sts. on holder for front band.

2nd row. * K1, p1; rep. from * across row.

Work 26 more rows in pattern.

Place Pocket

Next row. K3(4:4:5:5:6:7), slip next 28 (28:30:30:32:32:32) sts. on to a holder, k across sts. of pocket lining, work to end increasing as on left front. Continue in pattern until front measures same as back to beg. of raglan shaping, ending with a wrong side row.

Shape Raglan

1st row. Cast off 1 (1:1:2:2:3:3) sts., work to end.

2nd and every alt. Work to last 3 sts., p3.

3rd row. K2, p1, work to end.

5th row. K2, p2tog., work to end.

Continue as given for right front from ** to ** reversing shaping.

SLEEVES

Using No. 11 needles cast on 40 (42:46:48:52:54:56) sts., and work 18 rows in k1, p1 rib, increasing 4 sts. evenly across last row. Change to No. 9 needles and work 8 rows in pattern as given for back.

Keeping pattern correct, increase 1 st. at each end of next and every following 8th (8th:8th:8th:8th:7th:7th) row, until there are 70 (74:78:82:86:90:94) sts.

Work straight until sleeve measures 17½ (18:18½:19:19:19:19) ins., ending with a wrong side row.

Shape Raglans

Cast off 1 (1:1:2:2:3:3) sts. at beg. of next 2 rows.

Next row. K2, p1, k to last 3 sts., p1, k2.

Next row. P3, work to last 3 sts., p3.

Next row. K2, p2tog., work to last 4 sts., p2tog., k2.

Next row. P3, work to last 3 sts., p3.

Rep. last 4 rows 6 times more, 54 (58:62:64:68:70:74) sts. remain, then rep. last 2 rows only until 8 sts. remain, ending with the dec. row. Cast off.

RIGHT FRONT BAND AND COLLAR

Rejoin yarn to inner edge of sts. left on holder at right front. Using No. 11 needles work in k1, p1 rib until band, when **slightly stretched** fits front to start of neck shaping finishing at inner edge. (Right side row for Right Front Band and wrong side row for Left Front Band).

Shape Collar:

1st row. Inc. in first st., rib to end.

2nd row. Rib 15, p1.

3rd row. K1, rib 15.

4th row. As 2nd.

5th row. As 1st.

6th row. Rib 15, k1, p1.

7th row. K2, rib to end.

8th row. Rib 15, p1, k1.

Keeping the increased sts. in reversed pattern (so that right side shows when collar folds over), inc. 1 st. at neck edge of next and every following 4th row until there are 32 (33:34:35:36:37:38) sts. Work straight until collar fits front start of neck shaping to top. Keeping rib and pattern correct, inc. 1 st. at neck edge of next and alt. rows 3 times in all, ending at ribbed outer edge.

Next row. Work to last 6 sts., k6.

Next row. K6, work to end.

Rep. last 2 rows 19 (20:21:22:23:24:25) times more.

Leave sts. on spare needle.

Mark positions on band for 6 buttons, the first in 7th row of welt and the 6th to be 1½ ins. below start of collar shaping. Space remaining 4 evenly between.

LEFT FRONT BAND AND COLLAR

Work as given for Right Front Band making buttonholes opposite markers as before. Do not break yarn.

Cast off collar sts. tog. by placing fronts tog, right sides facing, then * knit 1 st. from each needle tog; rep. from * once more, then cast off in the usual way. Continue in this way until all sts. are worked off.

POCKET TOPS

Using No. 9 needles, k across sts. on holders at pockets, increasing 8 (8:10:10:10:12:12) sts. evenly. Work 7 rows in k1, p1 rib. Cast off in rib.

TO MAKE UP

Press using a warm iron and a damp cloth. Stitch pocket linings into place, neaten pocket tops. Join raglan, side and sleeve seams. Flat stitch bands and collar into position. Press seams. Sew on buttons.
