SIGGE'S BIB



-
- Sizes:** One size
- Gauge:** 22 sts in garter st = 10 cm / 4 in
- Suggested needles:** 4 mm needles
- Materials:** approx. 25 gr of yarn, 1 button
- Suggested yarn:** Mandarin Petite from Sandnes Garn (50 g = 180 m / 197 yards), held double

PATTERN

Sigge's Bib is worked bottom-up in garter st with the yarn held double. You can place a marker on the RS so that you know which side you are working on.

Please, read the following note about increases and decreases before starting:

Both increases and decreases are worked on RS rows.

Increases at the beginning and at the end of the row are worked as a yo, after the first st and before the last st, respectively. On the next WS row, these yo are worked through the back loop to prevent holes.

Decreases are also worked on RS rows: at the beginning of the row as "k2togtbl" after the first st and at the end of the row as "k2tog" before the last st.

Cast on 20 sts on 4 mm needles. K 2 rows. You are now on the RS.

Work an increase at the beginning and at the end of the row, k back. Repeat a total of 9 times (= 38 sts).

K across 10 rows.

Cast off the middle 4 sts from the RS and finish the two sides separately as follows:

Right side: K across 1 row so you are back on the RS.

Work a decrease at the beginning of the row (i.e. on the neck side), k back. Repeat a total of 4 times (= 13 sts).

K across 4 rows.

Work a decrease at the end of the row, k back. Repeat a total of 4 times (= 9 sts).

Work an **increase** at the beginning of the row and a **decrease** at the end of the row, k back. Repeat a total of 8 times (= 9 sts).

Work a decrease at the beginning and end of the row, k back. Repeat a total 2 times (= 5 sts). Cast off.

Left side: Cut the yarn, start on the neck side and k across 1 row so you are back on the RS. Work a decrease at the end of the row (i.e. on the neck side), k back. Repeat a total of 4 times (= 13 sts).

K across 4 rows.

Work a decrease at the beginning of the row, k back. Repeat a total of 4 times (= 9 sts).

Work a **decrease** at the beginning of the row and an **increase** at the end of the row, k back. Repeat a total of 8 times (= 9 sts).

On the next row, work a buttonhole and an increase as follows: K1, k2togtbl, k2tog, yo, k1, k2tog, k1 (7 sts). K back.

Work a decrease at the beginning and end of the row, k back (= 5 sts). Cast off.

Weave in all ends. Sew a button on the right side. Wash and block lightly and it will be ready to use.

Abbreviations:

st(s) = stitch(es)

k = knit

yo = yarn over

k2tog = knit 2 sts together

k2togtbl = knit 2 sts together through the back loop

RS = right side

WS = wrong side
