Sirius

SIRIUS IS AN ELEGANT AND SOFT SWEATER WITH A RELAXED FIT, ROUND YOKE AND A PRETTY COLORWORK WITH 4 COLORS. SIRIUS IS WORKED SEAMLESSLY IN THE ROUND IN ONE PIECE TOP DOWN WITH AN A-SHAPED BODY

SIZES

xxs (xs) s (m) l (xl) 2xl (3xl)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest circumference:

94 (100) 104 (108) 114 (120) 126 (132) cm

Length from armhole to bottom hem:

38 cm

Sleeve length from cuff to armhole:

46 cm

Upper sleeve circumference:

34 (35) 37 (38) 40 (41) 46 (49) cm

MATERIALS

CAMILLA VAD LAMBSWOOL 9/3 (New Zealand Lambswool, 100% wool, 300m / 328 yds per 100 g)

MC: 350 (350) 350 (400) 400 (450) 450 (500)g colourway 12 (Lys Grå)

CC1: 50 (50) 50 (50) 50 (50) 50 (50) g colourway 31 (Polar)

CC2: 50 (50) 50 (50) 50 (50) 50 (50) g colourway 20 (Duck Egg)

CC3: 50 (50) 50 (50) 50 (100) 50 (50) g colourway 14 (Stålgrå)

CC4: 50 (50) 50 (50) 50 (50) 50 (50) g colourway 15 (Antracit)

NEEDLES

Circular needles 3.5 mm + 4.0 mm / US 4 + US 6 in suitable lengths

GAUGE

20 sts x 28 rows = 10 x 10 cm / 4 x 4 inches on 4.0 mm /US 6 needles in stocking stitch, after blocking.

PLEASE NOTE

You work the sweater from the top down in the round. It is recommended to tighten the increases quite a bit to avoid holes.

DECREASES (sleeves)

After marker: k2tog

Before marker: ssk (slip, slip, knit - slip the next 2 sts knitwise one at a time, slip them back to the left needle, k2tog tbl)

INCREASES

Pick up the strand between the sts and knit it tbl

HOW TO TURN

In this pattern German short rows are used.

Work to the point where you need to turn. Turn work. Slip the first st (the last st worked) purlwise with the yarn in front of the work. Bring the yarn up over the needle and over the last st worked.

Pull slightly on the yarn to create a “double stitch”. Continue working as per the directions.

When you come back to the ”double stitch” just work the 2 loops together as 1 stitch (a purl or a knit according to the directions)

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit

p = purl

st(s) = stitch(es)

st st = stocking stitch

rnd = round

tog = together

ssk = slip, slip, knit (dec)

tbl = through the back loop

inc = increase

dec = decrease

M = marker

PM = place marker

BOR = beginning of round

Directions

NECK

Cast on **96 (100) 100 (100) 100 (100) 108 (108)** sts loosely on **3.5 mm / US 4** needle with MC, PM to indicate BOR. Join to start working in the round, and work in twisted rib; * **k1 tbl, p1** * to end of rnd. Work in established twisted rib pattern until work measures **3 cm / 1.25 inches**. Change to **4.0 mm / US 6** needle. Now continue in st st and at the same time, work short rows (please see the instructions in the pattern techniques section above) to shape the neckline;

K 18 (20) 20 (20) 20 (20) 20 (20), turn, p to **18 (20) 20 (20) 20 (20) 20 (20)** sts after M, turn, k to 4 sts after last turn, turn, p to 4 sts after last turn, turn. Cont working short rows by turning 4 sts after last turn on both sides, until there are 6 turns on each side. After the last turn, k to M.

YOKE

K 1 rnd, in which you inc **0 (0) 4 (8) 12 (16) 12 (20)** sts evenly spaced on the rnd (please see the instructions for increases in the pattern techniques section above) = **96 (100) 104 (108) 112 (116) 120 (128)** sts.

K 2 rnds.

Join CC and work rnds 1-45 of yoke chart, changing to longer circular needle when necessary. For optimal color dominance, make sure CC strand is left and the MC strand to the right. When adding in a third color, keep CC1 to the left, the new third color in the middle, and MC or other CC to the right.

K 8 (10) 12 (12) 14 (14) 16 (18) rnds.

DIVIDE THE WORK FOR BODY AND SLEEVES

K 42 (44) 46 (48) 50 (52) 54 (57), place **60 (62) 64**

(66) 68 (70) 72 (78) sts on a spare needle, cast on **10 (12) 12 (12) 14 16 (18 (18)** sts, k **84 (88) 92 (96) 100 (104) 108 (114)**, place **60 (62) 64 (66) 68 (70) 72 (78)** sts on a spare needle, cast on **10 (12) 12 (12) 14 16 (18 (18)** sts, k **42 (44) 46 (48) 50 (52) 54 (57)**. **188 (200) 208 (216) 228 (240) 252 (264)** sts.

BODY

Work straight in stocking stitch until the body measures **5 cm**. Remove M, k **47 (50) 52 (54) 57 (60) 63 (66)**, place M to indicate a new BOR, k **94 (100) 104 (108) 114 (120) 126 (132)**, place M1, k to BOR.

Inc rnd: **K3, inc 1, k to 3 sts before M1, inc 1, k 3, slip M, k 3, inc 1, k to 3 sts before BOR, inc 1, k3.**
192 (204) 212 (220) 232 (244) 256 (268) sts

Knit 10 rnds

Continue in stocking stitch, repeating these inc on each side of the markers in every **10th** rnd **7** times more. **220 (232) 240 (248) 260 (272) 284(296)**

Work straight down until work measures **30 cm** from the armhole or desired length, from the armhole to the top of the bottom border, which is **8 cm** wide work to the BOR.

Now continue in st st and at the same time, work short rows (please see the instructions in the pattern techniques section above) to shape the the bottom of the sweater;

K 10 turn, p to **10** sts after M1 turn, k to **5** sts before last turn, turn, p to **5** sts before last turn, turn. Cont working short rows by turning **5** sts before last turn on both sides, until there are **5** turns on each side. After the last turn, k to BOR. Work twisted rib in the round * **k1tbl, p1** * repeat from * to * for a total of **8 cm** of twisted rib. Bind off all sts in twisted rib.

SLEEVES

With 4.0 mm / US 6 needle, pick up 12 (14) 14 (14) 16 (18) 20 (20) sts in the cast-on sts for the armholes; pick up 1 st before the cast-on sts, pick up 1 st in each of the cast-on sts, pick up 1 st after the cast-on sts. 72 (76) 78 (80) 84 (88) 92 (98) sts. PM in the centre of the picked up sts. This marks the BOR.

Continue in st st over the sleeve sts to the last st before the picked up sts, K2 together, work to the last of the picked up sts, K2 together. 70 (74) 76 (78) 82 (86) 90 (96) sts.

K 8 rnds.

Dec round: K2, K2tog, k to last 4 sts, ssk, k2. 68 (72) 74 (76) 80 (84) 88 (94) sts.


Continue in st st, repeating these decreases on each side of the marker in every 8th round until 50 (52) 54 (56) 58 (58) 60 (62) sts remain on the needle. Work straight until sleeve measures 38 cm from armhole or desired length before the rib which is ca. 8 cm wide work to the beginning of the round. Work twisted rib in the round * k1tbl, p1 * repeat from * to * for a total of 8 cm of twisted rib. Bind off all sts in twisted rib.

Make the other sleeve in the same way.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Wash the finished knitting and lay it flat to dry.
