Mane/Tail, on the photo to the left, sewn on:
2 x different types of synthetic hair (15 cm x 200 cm), (How this is done is explained in the instructions "Unicorn".)

* Notes on yarn consumption: This is only intended as a guideline. Everyone crochets differently, everyone will have a different yarn consumption. Example: While I use 3 balls of yarn for the big fox, there are people who use 5 balls of yarn for that. There you can see how differently we crochet.

For all Versions:

- Filling cotton for stuffing
- A long sewing needle with a larger eye for the yarn.
- tearproof sewing thread/nylon thread
- Scissors
- Stitch marker or other colored yarn to mark the stitches

NOT NECESSARY, but used here:

- 4 plastic discs (can be made from a solid folder or any other packaging material cut out) in the diameter of the legs/arms.

Alternatively, you can use 4 felt gliders in the diameter of the legs and arms.

In my case the arms have a diameter of about 3.5 cm and the legs about 4.5 cm.

The plastic discs let the edge of the hooves become more visible.


Arms x 2

Note on yarn consumption*:

Himalaya Dolphin Baby: approx. 8 g of hoof color for both arms, approx. 13 g of body color for both arms.

Scheepjes Catona: approx. 3 g of hoof color for both arms, approx. 4 g of body color for both arms.

1. hoof color:
6 sc in MR (6)
2. inc x 6 (12)
3. (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)
4. **TIP: In the 5th round you have to crochet into the back loop of the 3rd round. If you find it hard to recognize them, then mark each back loop in this round with a stitch marker as soon as you crochet into the front loop.**
FLO: 18 slst (18)
5. Back loops of the 3rd round: 18 sc (18)
6. both loops: 18 sc (18)
7. body color:
FLO: 18 slst (18) **TIP: again you can mark The back loop!**
Cut the appropriate plastic base for the arm and insert it.
8. Back loops of the slsts: (7 sc, dec) x 2 (16)
9. (6 sc, dec) x 2 (14)
10. 14 sc (14)

- 12.-13. 12 sc (12) (2 rounds), stuff with filling cotton.

Scheepjes Catona: approx. 4 g of the hoof color, approx. 5 g of the body color for both legs.

Himalaya Dolphin BABY: ca. 34 g

Scheepjes Catona: ca. 12 g

The arms and legs must be finished before you crochet the body.

6 sc in MR (6)
2. inc x 6 (12)
3. (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)
4. (2 sc, inc) x 6 (24)
5. (3 sc, inc) x 6 (30)
6. (4 sc, inc) x 6 (36)

TIP: In the 10th round the tail will be tied/sewn on later. You can set a stitch marker after about 38 sc to find this position better later. The position should be in the middle of the back between the legs. The 38 sc are only a guideline. Adapt the number to your pony.

TIP 1: The arm should be folded and placed on the body so that the color change points to the back.

TIP 2: If the arms are not parallel to the legs, then move the arms to the right or left by 1-2 stitches.

22. (3 sc, dec) x 6 (24)

24. (2 sc, dec) x 6 (18), stuff with filling cotton.
- 25.-29. 18 sc (5 rounds)

Leave a long thread to sew the head to the body and then cut the thread.

How to crochet the legs/arms to the body:

The crochet hook stays in the loop of the last stitch as usual. Now place the leg/arm against the body from the outside, like in the first picture. Make sure that it is positioned correctly. Fold the opening of the leg so that the stitches, which normally lie in a circle, now run parallel next to each other. Now stitch through the first two parallel stitches of the leg / arm and then through the next stitch of the body and continue crocheting according to the instructions. Small blaze: Himalaya Dolphin Baby -> Snout/Blaze approx. 4 g, body color approx. 23 g

Big blaze: Himalayan Dolphin Baby -> Snout/blaze approx. 7 g, body color approx. 20 g

Scheepjes Catona -> snout/blaze approx. 2 g, body color approx. 6 g

Position of the safetyeyes:

On the pony the eyes are between the 11th and 12th round with a distance of approx. 11 stitches (counted from eyelid to eyelid). Once you have decided where to place the safety eyes, fasten them on the back with the usual fastener. If the eyes you have are not EN71 compliant, you should also melt and flatten the back of the safety eyes with a lighter. There is also a video about this on my Instagram account



Deepen the eyes:

Note: I only deepen the eyes of the pony when the head is finished.

----- red dotted line: the thread is in the head

_____ red solid line: the thread is outside the head



- 1) Take a long needle with a firm, approx. 90 cm long cotton thread or a tearproof nylon thread. Insert a needle under the eyelid at the side of the left eye.

TIP: You can temporarily just turn the eyelid up.



- 2) Come out with the needle to the right side of the right eye (from the animal's perspective).



- 3) Insert the needle again on the other side of the same eye and come out at the first eye on the other side.

Pull on both thread ends, so that the thread disappears under the eyelid/under the eye in the right eye. It should no longer be visible.



- 4) Here you can see how the threads come out of the left eye. Knot the threads together 2-3 times so that the knot disappears under the eye and then sew the thread ends in.

TIP: Do not overdo it. If the eyes are too deeply set together, it no longer looks beautiful.

Ears x 2

Note on yarn consumption*:

Himalaya Dolphin BABY: approx. 7 g for both ears

Scheepjes Catona: about 3 g for both ears

1. Body color:
4 sc in MR (4)
2. (inc, 1 sc) x 2 (6)
3. (inc, 2 sc) x 2 (8)
4. (inc, 1 sc) x 4 (12)
5. (inc, 2 sc) x 4 (16)

The ears don't get stuffed.



1) This is how the ear looks at first.

2) Fold the opening and crochet it together with 8 sc. The exact number of stitches is not important here.

3) fold the ear again and crochet it together with approx. 4 sc.

Position of the ears:

The ears are on the 16. -18. round. Between the ears there are about 6-7 stitches.



Embroider the nostrils:

The nostrils are embroidered to the 3rd - 4th round with 3-5 stitches of the same color as the snout. Between the two nostrils there are 4 sc.



Sew the head on:

Sew the head to the head so that the chin points down. This means you sew directly along the neck at the back and at the front you sew the head 2-3 rounds lower from the neck. The head should look down rather than up. Orientate yourself by the photos. Make sure that it does not look to the side and that it is not sewn on crooked.



Halter:

Note on yarn consumption*: Scheepjes Catona: max. 1 g



1) Crochet a chain of chainstitches that fits once around the snout. For me it is 22 ch.



2) Close the chain with a slst to make a circle.



3) Make more chainstitches, so the halter fits around the head.



4) Put the holster on to see how many chainstitches you need. For me it is 39 ch. I have attached this chain to the "circle" with a pin to know where to attach the chain.



5) With a slst you attach the chain to the "circle". In this photo you can see how the halter runs along the back of the head.



6) This is what the finished halter looks like. Put it on and sew it to the head. If the halter should be removable, you should first sew on the mane and not attach the halter by sewing.

Mane / Tail:

Knotted:

Note on yarn consumption:*

Rico Creative So Cool + So Soft Cotton: approx. 30 g for the knotted mane

Scheepjes Furry Tales: approx. 20 g

The mane is applied after the ears and head are sewn to the body.

The number of strands can vary depending on the strength/thickness of the wool you want to use. Always cut a few strands, knot them to the head/body and then see how many more are needed to prevent the mane and tail from looking thin.

Ex. 1: At the brown pony with the mane from "Rico Creative So Cool + So Soft Cotton" are

-> 21 strands of 35 cm length in the tail.

-> 50 strands of 40 cm length in the mane.

Ex. 2: At the grey pony with the mane from „Scheepjes Furry Tales“ are

-> 9 strands of 35 cm length in the tail.

-> 18 strands of 40 cm length in the mane.

The tail is knotted approximately on the 10th round, around the 38th stitch. The strands do NOT all go into 1 stitch. The mane starts at the forehead on the 14th round and runs in the middle between the ears, along the back, to the 24th/25th round of the body. This is the 4th/5th round from the neck.

After you have finished knotting, you can trim and adjust the tips. Orientate yourself on the photos.

How to knot the strands:

- 1) Insert the crochet hook in the desired place and exit one stitch further.
- 2) Fold the thread, you want to knot, in the middle and pull it a little bit through the stitch with the crochet hook.
- 3) The crochet hook remains in the created loop. With the crochet hook pull the two thread ends
- 4) and pull it through the loop on the crochet hook.
- 5) Done.

The Position and the length of the mane/tail:



Crocheted:

Note on yarn consumption:*

Himalaya Dolphin Baby: approx. 60 g for the tail and mane, approx. 30 g per shade of brown

Scheepjes Catona: approx. 24 g for the tail and mane, approx. 12 g per shade of brown

The mane is attached when the ears are sewn to the head and the head to the body.

Altogether 26 curls are crocheted. 20 for the mane and 6 for the tail.

You can change the number of curls according to your taste.

As a general rule:

→ A curl always consists of a chain of chainstitches and in this chain crocheted sc.

→ The longer the chain, the longer the curl.

→ The more sc you crochet in a ch, the "curlier" the curl is and will be shorter accordingly.

→ As soon as you have crocheted a curl, you start directly with the new chain, so that at the end all curls are connected.

→ Depending on the yarn you use and how loose/tight you crochet, the curl may "curl" less or more, so you need to try it out and see what length is best for your pony.

→ If you want the curl to be less "curly", double every 3rd stitch. To the end of the curl you can also just crochet sc without doubling. Then the curly part is only at the bottom of the tail and mane.

Tail:

1.-3. 31-35 ch, starting in the 2. ch crochet „1 sc, inc“. (3 curls)

→ 3 curls in one shade of brown, 3 curls in another shade of brown.

TOTAL: 6 curls

(On the photo the curls are unfortunately all the same color.)



Mane:

1. 25 ch, starting in the 2. ch crochet „1 sc, inc“.

2. 31 ch, starting in the 2. ch crochet „1 sc, inc“.

3.-4. 41 ch, starting in the 2. ch crochet „1 sc, inc“. (2 curls)

5.-6. 31 ch, starting in the 2. ch crochet „1 sc, inc“. (2 curls)

7.-10. 25 ch, starting in the 2. ch crochet „1 sc, inc“. (4 curls)

→ 10 curls in one shade of brown, 10 curls in another shade of brown.

TOTAL: 20 curls

The position for the tail and mane is the same as for the knotted mane (see above). The only thing to note is that the 1st crocheted curl comes at the top of the forehead.



Horseshoe

Note on yarn consumption*:

Scheepjes Catona: approx. 4 g for all 4 hooves for the pony from *Himalaya Dolphin Baby*
max. 1 g for all 4 hooves for the pony from *Scheepjes Catona*

For the arms x 2

For the pony from

Himalaya Dolphin Baby:

21 ch,

into the chain: 5 hdc,

(2 hdc in one stitch, 2 hdc) x 3,

2 hdc in one stitch, 5 hdc

leave thread long enough to sew the chain to the arm hoofs.

For the legs x 2

For the pony from

Himalaya Dolphin Baby:

32 ch,

into the chain: 5 hdc,

(2 hdc in one stitch, 4 hdc) x 4, 2 hdc

in one stitch, 5 hdc

leave thread long enough to sew the chain to the leg hoofs.

For the arms x 2

For the pony from *Scheepjes Catona*:

10 ch, leave thread long enough to sew the chain to the arm hoofs

For the legs x 2

For the pony from *Scheepjes Catona*:

18 ch, leave thread long enough to sew the chain to the leg hoofs



If your horseshoes are too big or too small, add 1 stitch at the beginning and end or remove one stitch at the beginning and end.



Flower hair wreath:

Roses

Note on yarn consumption:*

Scheepjes Catona: approx. 2 g for one rose

1. Color of choice: 14 ch,
into the 2. ch start making 13 sc, tch
2. (1 sc, 2 ch, skip one stitch) x 6, 1 slst, tch.
You created 6 chainspaces
(see photo to the right).
3. Into the first 2 chainspaces: 1 sc, 3 hdc, 1 sc
Into the next 2 chainspaces: 1 hdc, 3 dc, 1 hdc
Into the next chainpace: 1 hdc, 5 dc, 1 hdc
Into the last chainpace: 1 hdc, 6 dc, 1 hdc

Roll up the crocheted strip from the first petal to the last, so that the larger petals are on the outside of the rose. Close the rose at the bottom so that it cannot unroll.



Flower

Note on yarn consumption:*

Scheepjes Catona: approx. 1 g for one flower

Into a MR: (1 slst, 3 dc) x 5
Close the MR. Tie the threads.

Sew the flowers to the head.
