


Snow Mantra Shawl
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Abbreviations:

CO = cast on
k = knit
k2tog = knit two (2) stitches together
p = purl
sl1k = slip a stitch knit-wise
st(s) = stitch (es)
RN= right needle
LN= left needle
rs = right side
ws = wrong side
w&t = wrap and turn
cdd = k3tog with centered double decreases (see picture below)



Yarn:

A: Schoppel Wolle Admiral (col. 990) - 100g (420m).

B: Opal Memories 4-ply (col 11008) - 230g (980m).

Size: width - 180cm. / height - 75 cm.

Circular knitting needles with sharp tips: 3mm (long - 60cm or longer); 1 marker; tapestry needle to weave in ends.

Gauge: 26sts and 35 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm

I'm roughly giving a flat gauge here, but it is irrelevant for this type of pattern.


Note: Please, read the entire pattern before starting the work.

Attention! This project contains many work turns.

Heavier or lighter yarn weights can also be used for this pattern though dimensions and yardage will change. This shawl is knitted seamlessly.

I used "wrap and turn" (knit the indicated number of sts, wrap working yarn around next stitch, turn and knit back in the opposite direction), but any other short-row turn works just as well.


The direction of knitting is shown by arrow in the schematic. Selvedge stitches are already included in the stitch count. Do not add any additional selvedge stitches.



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
Special abbreviation:

"1-to-9 inc" = Increase from 1 stitch to 9 as follows: *K1, yo, k1 into 1 stitch (*photo 1*), do not turn the work; slip 2sts back to left needle (*photo 1a*), do not turn the work * - rep between ** 2 more times, (*photo 1b*); k1, yo, k1 into 1 stitch (*photo 1c*), do not turn the work; k3, (*photo 1d*); continue work without turning. As a result has added 8 stitches.




"1-to-19 inc" = Increase from 1 stitch to 19 as follows: K1, turn work; * yo, p1, (*photo 2*), turn work; yo, k1, (*photo 2a*), turn work* - rep between ** 9 more times; (*photo 2b*); k9 (*photo 2c; maybe you will be more comfortable working these 9 stitches tbl*); continue work without turning. As a result has added 18 stitches.

Such a large increase in loops is not very convenient for work, but it is repeated only 11 times for the entire project.



"cddx4" = Decreases 8 stitches as follows: K3 (**Important! don't forget to knit these three stitches before the first cdd, please!**), cdd (*photo 3*); *slip the new stitch and the stitch beside it on the right hand needle together onto the left hand needle, (*photo 3a*); cdd, (*photo 3b*)* - rep between ** 2 more times, (*photo 3c*).




"I-Cord" = 1. With the right side facing, cast-on 2 stitches. I used the loop cast-on method, (*photo 4*).
 2. Knit 1 stitch, knit 2 stitches together through the back loop, and continue work without turning, (*photo 4a*).


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3. Slip the 2 stitches on the right needle back to the left hand needle, (photo 4b).
4. Repeat steps 2 to 3 until last 2 stitches on the right hand needle, (photo 4c).



“Row with alternating Yarn A and Yarn B”=

1. **Yarn A:** k3, (photo 5).
2. Do not turn the work; slip the new 3sts on the left hand needle (photo 5a).
3. Continue work without turning and starting with the first stitch; **Yarn B:** k6, w&t; k3, w&t, (photo 5b).
4. **Yarn A:** k6, w&t; k3, w&t, (photo 5c). Make sure the yarn is alternating behind your work.
5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 until less than 7 stitches (this number will change for different Stripes) on the left hand needle, (photo 5d). Note that on the right needle, the colors of the yarns alternate every three stitches.
6. Now knit the remaining stitches with another yarn, (photo 5e).
7. Slip 2 or 3sts (this number will change for different Stripes) back to left hand needle, (photo 5f).
8. Work to end of row with second another yarn, (photo 5g).



The color alternation can get a bit tedious (or maybe meditative :), but the result is well worth it.

Row-by row description:

For this photo tutorial I used: Yarn A - Malabrigo Sock (col 811), Yarn B - Opal Memories 4-ply (col 11004)

Strip 1: Stripe dominated of Yarn A.

Yarn A CO 23sts

Row 1 ws: Sl1k, p22.

Row 2 rs: Sl1k, k10, “1-to-19 inc”, k11.

(18 stitches were added, now there are 41 stitches in total).

Yarn B

Row 3 ws: P41.

Row 4 rs: “I-Cord”; (photo 1), Break the Yarn B. Turn work.



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Strip 2: Stripe dominated of Yarn A.

Yarn A

Row 1 ws: BO 1st (1st remained on RN – photo 2), without turning; from the selvedge stitches of the previous row pick up and purl **40sts** (pick up stitches only through front loops – photo 2a). Turn work, (photo 2b).

Row 2 rs: “Row with alternating Yarn A and Yarn B”, (photo 2c).

Yarn A

Row 3 ws: Sl1k, p20, place marker, p20.


Row 4 rs: Sl1k, “1-to-9 inc”, k4, “cddx4”, k4, “1-to-9 inc”; remove marker, k1 (this stitch is the center); “1-to-9 inc”, k4, “cddx4”, k4, “1-to-9 inc”, k1.

(16 stitches were added, now there are 57 stitches in total).

Yarn B

Row 5 ws: P57.

Row 6 rs: “I-Cord”; Break the Yarn B, (photo 2d). Turn work.



Strip 3: Stripe dominated of Yarn A.

Yarn A

Row 1 ws: BO 1st (1st remained on RN), without turning; from the selvedge stitches of the previous row pick up and purl **56sts** (pick up stitches only through front loops).

Row 2 rs: “Row with alternating Yarn A and Yarn B”. Break the Yarn B.

Yarn A

Row 3 ws: P29, place marker; p28; without turning; CO 11sts using the loop cast-on method, (photo 3).

Row 4 rs: Sl1k, k15, “1-to-9 inc”, k4, “cddx4”, k4, “1-to-9 inc”, k4; remove marker, “1-to-19 inc”; k4, “1-to-9 inc”, k4, “cddx4”, k4, “1-to-9 inc”, k5; without turning; CO 11sts using the loop cast-on method, (photo 3a).

(56 stitches were added, now there are 113 stitches in total).

Yarn B

Row 5 ws: P113.

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Row 6 rs: "I-Cord"; Break the Yarn B, (*photo 3b*). Turn work.



Strip 4: Stripe dominated of Yarn A.

Yarn A

Row 1 ws: BO 1st (*1st remained on RN*), without turning; from the selvedge stitches of the previous row pick up and purl **112sts** (*pick up stitches only through front loops*).

Row 2 rs: "Row with alternating Yarn A and Yarn B".

Yarn A

Row 3 ws: Sl1k, p56, place marker, p56.

Row 4 rs: Sl1k, "1-to-9 inc", *k4, "cddx4", k4, "1-to-9 inc"* - rep between ** 2 more times; remove marker, k1 (*this stitch is the center*); *"1-to-9 inc", k4, "cddx4", k4* - rep between ** 2 more times; "1-to-9 inc", k1.

(16 stitches were added, now there are 129 stitches in total).

Yarn B

Row 5 ws: P129.

Row 6 rs: "I-Cord"; Break the Yarn B, (*photo 4*). Turn work.



Strip 5: Stripe dominated of Yarn A.

Yarn A

Row 1 ws: BO 1st (*1st remained on RN*), without turning; from the selvedge stitches of the previous row pick up and purl **128sts** (*pick up stitches only through front loops*).

Row 2 rs: "Row with alternating Yarn A and Yarn B". Break the Yarn B.

Yarn A

Row 3 ws: P65, place marker; p64; without turning; CO 11sts using the loop cast-on method.

Row 4 rs: Sl1k, k15, "1-to-9 inc", k4, *"cddx4", k4, "1-to-9 inc", k4* - rep between ** 2 more times; remove marker, "1-to-19 inc"; *k4, "1-to-9 inc", k4, "cddx4"* - rep between ** 2 more times; k4, "1-to-9 inc", k5; without turning; CO 11sts using the loop cast-on method.

(56 stitches were added, now there are 185 stitches in total). Break the Yarn A.

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Yarn B

Row 5 ws: P185.

Row 6 rs: "I-Cord", (photo 5). Turn work.



Strip 6: Stripe dominated of Yarn B.

Yarn B

Row 1 ws: BO 1st (1st remained on RN), without turning; from the selvedge stitches of the previous row pick up and purl **184sts** (pick up stitches only through front loops).

Row 2 rs: "Row with alternating Yarn A and Yarn B".

Yarn B

Row 3 ws: P93, place marker, p92.

Row 4 rs: Sl1k, "1-to-9 inc", *k4, "cddx4", k4, "1-to-9 inc"* - rep between ** 4 more times; remove marker, k1 (this stitch is the center); *"1-to-9 inc", k4, "cddx4", k4* - rep between ** 4 more times; "1-to-9 inc", k1.

(16 stitches were added, now there are 201 stitches in total).

Row 5 ws: Sl1k, p200.

Row 6 rs: "I-Cord"; Break the Yarn B. Turn work.

Strip 7: Stripe dominated of Yarn A.

Yarn A

Row 1 ws: BO 1st (1st remained on RN), without turning; from the selvedge stitches of the previous row pick up and purl **200sts** (pick up stitches only through front loops). Turn work.

Row 2 rs: "Row with alternating Yarn A and Yarn B". Break the Yarn B.

Yarn A

Row 3 ws: P101, place marker; p100; without turning; CO 11sts using the loop cast-on method.

Row 4 rs: Sl1k, k15, "1-to-9 inc", k4, *"cddx4", k4, "1-to-9 inc", k4* - rep between ** 4 more times; remove marker, "1-to-19 inc"; *k4, "1-to-9 inc", k4, "cddx4"* - rep between ** 4 more times; k4, "1-to-9 inc", k5; without turning; CO 11sts using the loop cast-on method.

(56 stitches were added, now there are 257 stitches in total).

Yarn B

Row 5 ws: P257.

Row 6 rs: "I-Cord"; Break the Yarn B. Turn work.

Strip 8: Stripe dominated of Yarn A.

Yarn A

Row 1 ws: BO 1st (*1st remained on RN*), without turning; from the selvedge stitches of the previous row pick up and purl **256sts** (*pick up stitches only through front loops*).

Row 2 rs: "Row with alternating Yarn A and Yarn B".

Yarn A

Row 3 ws: Sl1k, p128, place marker, p128.

Row 4 rs: Sl1k, "1-to-9 inc", *k4, "cddx4", k4, "1-to-9 inc"* - rep between ** 6 more times; remove marker, k1 (*this stitch is the center*); *"1-to-9 inc", k4, "cddx4", k4* - rep between ** 6 more times; "1-to-9 inc", k1.

(16 stitches were added, now there are 273 stitches in total).

Yarn B

Row 5 ws: P273.

Row 6 rs: "I-Cord"; Break the Yarn B. Turn work.

Strip 9: Stripe dominated of Yarn A.

Yarn A

Row 1 ws: BO 1st (*1st remained on RN*), without turning; from the selvedge stitches of the previous row pick up and purl **272sts** (*pick up stitches only through front loops*). Turn work.

Row 2 rs: "Row with alternating Yarn A and Yarn B". Break the Yarn B.

Yarn A

Row 3 ws: P137, place marker; p136; without turning; CO 11sts using the loop cast-on method.

Row 4 rs: Sl1k, k15, "1-to-9 inc", k4, *"cddx4", k4, "1-to-9 inc", k4* - rep between ** 6 more times; remove marker, "1-to-19 inc"; *k4, "1-to-9 inc", k4, "cddx4"* - rep between ** 6 more times; k4, "1-to-9 inc", k5; without turning; CO 11sts using the loop cast-on method.

(56 stitches were added, now there are 329 stitches in total).

Yarn B

Row 5 ws: P329.

Row 6 rs: "I-Cord"; Break the Yarn B. Turn work.

Strip 10: Stripe dominated of Yarn A.

Yarn A

Row 1 ws: BO 1st (*1st remained on RN*), without turning; from the selvedge stitches of the previous row pick up and purl **328sts** (*pick up stitches only through front loops*). Turn work.

Row 2 rs: "Row with alternating Yarn A and Yarn B".

Yarn A

Row 3 ws: Sl1k, p164, place marker, p164.

Row 4 rs: Sl1k, "1-to-9 inc", *k4, "cddx4", k4, "1-to-9 inc"* - rep between ** 8 more times; remove marker, k1 (*this stitch is the center*); *"1-to-9 inc", k4, "cddx4", k4* - rep between ** 8 more times; "1-to-9 inc", k1. Break the Yarn A.

(16 stitches were added, now there are 345 stitches in total).

Yarn B

Row 5 ws: P345.

Row 6 rs: "I-Cord". Turn work.

Strip 11: Stripe dominated of Yarn B.

Yarn B

Row 1 ws: BO 1st (*1st remained on RN*), without turning; from the selvedge stitches of the previous row pick up and purl **344sts** (*pick up stitches only through front loops*).

Row 2 rs: "Row with alternating Yarn A and Yarn B". Break the Yarn A.

Yarn B

Row 3 ws: Sl1k, p172, place marker; p172; without turning; CO 11sts using the loop cast-on method.

Row 4 rs: Sl1k, k15, "1-to-9 inc", k4, *"cddx4", k4, "1-to-9 inc", k4* - rep between ** 8 more times; remove marker, "1-to-19 inc"; *k4, "1-to-9 inc", k4, "cddx4"* - rep between ** 8 more times; k4, "1-to-9 inc", k5; without turning; CO 11sts using the loop cast-on method.

(56 stitches were added, now there are 401 stitches in total).

Row 5 ws: Sl1k, p400.

Row 6 rs: "I-Cord". Turn work.

Strip 12: Stripe dominated of Yarn B.

Yarn B

Row 1 ws: BO 1st (*1st remained on RN*), without turning; from the selvedge stitches of the previous row pick up and purl **400sts** (*pick up stitches only through front loops*).

Row 2 rs: "Row with alternating Yarn A and Yarn B".

Yarn B

Row 3 ws: Sl1k, p200, place marker, p200.

Row 4 rs: Sl1k, "1-to-9 inc", *k4, "cddx4", k4, "1-to-9 inc"* - rep between ** 10 more times; remove marker, k1 (*this stitch is the center*); *"1-to-9 inc", k4, "cddx4", k4* - rep between ** 10 more times; "1-to-9 inc", k1.

(16 stitches were added, now there are 417 stitches in total).

Row 5 ws: Sl1k, p416.

Row 6 rs: "I-Cord". Break the Yarn B. Turn work.

Strip 13: Stripe dominated of Yarn A.

Yarn A

Row 1 ws: BO 1st (*1st remained on RN*), without turning; from the selvedge stitches of the previous row pick up and purl **416sts** (*pick up stitches only through front loops*).

Row 2 rs: "Row with alternating Yarn A and Yarn B". Break the Yarn B.

Yarn A

Row 3 ws: P209, place marker; p208; without turning; CO 11sts using the loop cast-on method.

Row 4 rs: Sl1k, k15, "1-to-9 inc", k4, *"cddx4", k4, "1-to-9 inc", k4* - rep between ** 10 more times; remove marker, "1-to-19 inc"; *k4, "1-to-9 inc", k4, "cddx4"* - rep between ** 10 more times; k4, "1-to-9 inc", k5; without turning; CO 11sts using the loop cast-on method.

(56 stitches were added, now there are 473 stitches in total).

Yarn B

Row 5 ws: P473.

Row 6 rs: "I-Cord". Break the Yarn B. Turn work.

Strip 14: Stripe dominated of Yarn A.

Yarn A

Row 1 ws: BO 1st (1st remained on RN), without turning; from the selvedge stitches of the previous row pick up and purl **472sts** (pick up stitches only through front loops).

Row 2 rs: "Row with alternating Yarn A and Yarn B".

Yarn A

Row 3 ws: Sl1k, p236, place marker, p236.

Row 4 rs: Sl1k, "1-to-9 inc", *k4, "cddx4", k4, "1-to-9 inc"* - rep between ** 12 more times; remove marker, k1 (this stitch is the center); *"1-to-9 inc", k4, "cddx4", k4* - rep between ** 12 more times; "1-to-9 inc", k1.

(16 stitches were added, now there are 489 stitches in total).

Yarn B

Row 5 ws: P489.

Row 6 rs: "I-Cord". Break the Yarn B. Turn work.

Strip 15: Stripe dominated of Yarn A.

Yarn A

Row 1 ws: BO 1st (1st remained on RN), without turning; from the selvedge stitches of the previous row pick up and purl **488sts** (pick up stitches only through front loops).

Row 2 rs: "Row with alternating Yarn A and Yarn B". Break the Yarn B.

Yarn A

Row 3 ws: Sl1k, p244, place marker; p244; without turning; CO 11sts using the loop cast-on method.

Row 4 rs: Sl1k, k15, "1-to-9 inc", k4, *"cddx4", k4, "1-to-9 inc", k4* - rep between ** 12 more times; remove marker, "1-to-19 inc"; *k4, "1-to-9 inc", k4, "cddx4"* - rep between ** 12 more times; k4, "1-to-9 inc", k5; without turning; CO 11sts using the loop cast-on method.

Break the Yarn A.

(56 stitches were added, now there are 545 stitches in total).

Yarn B

Row 5 ws: P545.

Row 6 rs: "I-Cord". Turn work.

Strip 16: Stripe dominated of Yarn B.

Yarn B

Row 1 ws: BO 1st (1st remained on RN), without turning; from the selvedge stitches of the previous row pick up and purl **544sts** (pick up stitches only through front loops).

Row 2 rs: "Row with alternating Yarn A and Yarn B". Break the Yarn A.

Yarn B

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Row 3 ws: P273, place marker, p272.

Row 4 rs: Sl1k, "1-to-9 inc", *k4, "cddx4", k4, "1-to-9 inc"* - rep between ** 14 more times; remove marker, k1 (*this stitch is the center*); *"1-to-9 inc", k4, "cddx4", k4* - rep between ** 14 more times; "1-to-9 inc", k1.

(16 stitches were added, now there are 561 stitches in total).

Row 5 ws: Sl1k, p560.

Row 6 rs: "I-Cord". Turn work.

Strip 17: Stripe dominated of Yarn B.

Yarn B

Row 1 ws: BO 1st (*1st remained on RN*), without turning; from the selvedge stitches of the previous row pick up and purl **560sts** (*pick up stitches only through front loops*).

Row 2 rs: "Row with alternating Yarn A and Yarn B". Break the Yarn A.

Yarn B

Row 3 ws: Sl1k, p280, place marker; p280; without turning; CO 11sts using the loop cast-on method.

Row 4 rs: Sl1k, k15, "1-to-9 inc", k4, *"cddx4", k4, "1-to-9 inc", k4* - rep between ** 14 more times; remove marker, "1-to-19 inc"; *k4, "1-to-9 inc", k4, "cddx4"* - rep between ** 14 more times; k4, "1-to-9 inc", k5; without turning; CO 11sts using the loop cast-on method.

(56 stitches were added, now there are 617 stitches in total).

Row 5 ws: Sl1k, p616.

Row 6 rs: "I-Cord". Turn work.

Strip 18: Stripe dominated of Yarn B.

Yarn B

Row 1 ws: BO 1st (*1st remained on RN*), without turning; from the selvedge stitches of the previous row pick up and purl **616sts** (*pick up stitches only through front loops*).

Row 2 rs: "Row with alternating Yarn A and Yarn B". Break the Yarn A.

Yarn B

Row 3 ws: Sl1k, p308, place marker, p308.

Row 4 rs: Sl1k, "1-to-9 inc", *k4, "cddx4", k4, "1-to-9 inc"* - rep between ** 16 more times; remove marker, k1 (*this stitch is the center*); *"1-to-9 inc", k4, "cddx4", k4* - rep between ** 16 more times; "1-to-9 inc", k1.

(16 stitches were added, now there are 633 stitches in total).

Row 5 ws: Sl1k, p632.

Row 6 rs: "I-Cord". Turn work.

Strip 19: Stripe dominated of Yarn B.

Yarn B

Row 1 ws: BO 1st (*1st remained on RN*), without turning; from the selvedge stitches of the previous row pick up and purl **632sts** (*pick up stitches only through front loops*).

Row 2 rs: "Row with alternating Yarn A and Yarn B". Break the Yarn A.

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Yarn B

Row 3 ws: Sl1k, p316, place marker; p316; without turning; CO 11sts using the loop cast-on method.

Row 4 rs: Sl1k, k15, "1-to-9 inc", k4, *"cddx4", k4, "1-to-9 inc", k4* - rep between ** 16 more times; remove marker, "1-to-19 inc"; *k4, "1-to-9 inc", k4, "cddx4"* - rep between ** 16 more times; k4, "1-to-9 inc", k5; without turning; CO 11sts using the loop cast-on method.

(56 stitches were added, now there are 689 stitches in total).

Row 5 ws: Sl1k, p688.

Row 6 rs: "I-Cord". Turn work.

Strip 20: Stripe dominated of Yarn B.

Yarn B

Row 1 ws: BO 1st (*1st remained on RN*), without turning; from the selvedge stitches of the previous row pick up and purl **688sts** (*pick up stitches only through front loops*).

Row 2 rs: "Row with alternating Yarn A and Yarn B". Break the Yarn A.

Yarn B

Row 3 ws: P345, place marker, p344.

Row 4 rs: Sl1k, "1-to-9 inc", *k4, "cddx4", k4, "1-to-9 inc"* - rep between ** 18 more times; remove marker, k1 (*this stitch is the center*); *"1-to-9 inc", k4, "cddx4", k4* - rep between ** 18 more times; "1-to-9 inc", k1.

(16 stitches were added, now there are 705 stitches in total).

Row 5 ws: Sl1k, p704.

Row 6 rs: "I-Cord". Turn work.

Strip 21: Stripe dominated of Yarn B.

Yarn B

Row 1 ws: BO 1st (*1st remained on RN*), without turning; from the selvedge stitches of the previous row pick up and purl **704sts** (*pick up stitches only through front loops*).

Row 2 rs: "Row with alternating Yarn A and Yarn B". Break the Yarn A.

Yarn B

Row 3 ws: Sl1k, p352, place marker; p352; without turning.

Row 4 rs: Sl1k, k4, "1-to-9 inc", k4, *"cddx4", k4, "1-to-9 inc", k4* - rep between ** 18 more times; remove marker, "1-to-19 inc"; *k4, "1-to-9 inc", k4, "cddx4"* - rep between ** 18 more times; k4, "1-to-9 inc", k5; without turning.

(34 stitches were added, now there are 739 stitches in total).

Row 5 ws: Sl1k, p739.

Row 6 rs: "I-Cord". Turn work. BO 2sts.

Block: soak, press out excess water, spread out on horizontal surface until completely dry.
