

SNOWFALL SWEATER SCARF



Difficulty Level: Beginner

MATERIALS

- 5 (A, B), 6 (C) balls of Lion Brand Wool-Ease (pictured in "Linen") or approximately 825 (915, 1150) yards / 754 (837, 1052) meters of another worsted weight yarn, category 4
- Size US 10.5/6.5mm needles
 - Size US 8/5mm needles
 - 2 stitch markers
- 7 locking stitch markers (optional)
 - Scissors
 - Darning Needle

GAUGE

Knit in stockinette flat on size US 10.5/6.5mm needles blocked
13 sts x 19 rows = 4" x 4" (10 x 10 cm)

Knit in ribbing flat on size US 8/5mm needles (not stretched)
24 sts x 20 rows = 4" x 4" (10 x 10 cm)

DIMENSIONS

Length: 101 (109.75, 122)", 256 (278, 310) cm
Width: 16 (16, 18.25)", 41 (41, 46) cm

DESCRIPTION



A scarf that doubles as a wrap? That triples as a sweater? Yup. Count me in. The Snowfall Sweater Scarf is a cozy scarf with sleeves that is adorned with a dotted purl texture that changes in density from the cuffs, to the center – much like a snowfall. Wrap it around your neck like a normal scarf, insert your arms into the cuffs and pull down the section around your neck. Voila, you have the coziest little wrap you've ever seen. Pair it with a tee and some ripped jeans for a cozy campfire with the gals, or drape it around your shoulders on top of a little black dress for date night, this piece is perfect for all occasions.

This pattern is written in 3 sizes: A (B, C). Size A fits bust sizes 28-38" (71-96cm), B fits bust sizes 40-50" (101-127cm), and C fits bust sizes 52-62" (132-157cm) - so be sure to follow the correct size throughout. Highlighting or circling the instructions for the size you're following is helpful and encouraged. Model is wearing size A with a bust of 36.5" (92cm).

BO = Bind Off

CO = Cast On

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit 2 together

M1R = Make 1 Right

P = Purl

PM = Place Marker

P2tog = Purl 2 together

St(s) = Stitch(es)

SM = Slip Marker

RS = Right side

WS = Wrong Side

PATTERN

Note: This pattern is knit flat and then seamed together at the cuffs.

CUFF

On US 8/5mm needles, CO 43 (43, 51) sts using the long tail method, leaving a 3 foot long tail for weaving purposes.

R1: *K1, P1, repeat from * until the last st, K1, turn work.

R2: *P1, K1, repeat from * until the last st, P1, turn work.

Repeat R1-2 until your piece measures 14"/36 cm from the cast on edge ending on a R2.

INCREASE YOUR SCARF WIDTH

Sizes A & B:

R1: Switching to US 10.5/6.5mm needles: K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, PM, *K2, M1R, repeat from * until the last 7 sts, K1, M1R, PM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row. You will now have 59 (59, -) sts.

R2: *P1, K1, repeat from * until marker, SM, P until marker, SM, *K1, P1, repeat from * until end of row.

Size C:

R1: Switching to US 10.5/6.5mm needles: K1, P1, K1, P1, K1, P1, PM, *K3, M1R, repeat from * until the last 6 sts, PM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row. You will now have - (-, 64) sts.

R2: *P1, K1, repeat from * until marker, SM, *P13, M1R, repeat from * until 13 sts from marker, P13, SM, *K1, P1, repeat from * until end of row. You will now have 67 sts.

SCARF PORTION (Starting your dot stitch)

SECTION 1

R1: *K1, P1, repeat from * until marker, SM, K1, *P1, K3*. Repeat from * to *, until last 2 st before marker, P1, K1, SM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row.

R2: *P1, K1, repeat from * until marker, SM, P until marker, SM, *K1, P1, repeat from * until end of row.

R3: *K1, P1, repeat from * until marker, SM, *K3, P1*. Repeat from * to *, until last 3 sts before marker, K3, SM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row.

R4: Repeat R2.

Repeat R1-4 an additional 8 times, for a total of 9 times. Or until you reach 7.5"/19 cm in length, not including the ribbed cuff, ending on a R4. I would suggest starting to mark your sections with a locking stitch marker. Just for ease of use.

SECTION 2

R1: *K1, P1, repeat from * until marker, SM, K1, *P1, K3*. Repeat from * to *, until last 2 st before marker, P1, K1, SM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row.

R2: *P1, K1, repeat from * until marker, SM, P until marker, SM, *K1, P1, repeat from * until end of row.

R3: *K1, P1, repeat from * until marker, SM, K until marker, SM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row.

R4: Repeat R2.

R5: *K1, P1, repeat from * until marker, SM, *K3, P1*. Repeat from * to *, until last 3 sts before marker, K3, SM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row.

R6: Repeat R2

R7-8: Repeat R3-4.

Repeat R1-8 an additional 3 times, for a total of 4 times, or until **section 2** is 7"/18 cm in length and ending on a R8.

SECTION 3

R1: *K1, P1, repeat from * until marker, SM, K1, *P1, K7*. Repeat from * to *, until last 6 sts before marker, P1, K5, SM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row.

R2: *P1, K1, repeat from * until marker, SM, P until marker, SM, *K1, P1, repeat from * until end of row.

R3: *K1, P1, repeat from * until marker, SM, K5, *P1, K7*. Repeat from * to *, until last 2 sts before marker, P1, K1, SM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row.

R4: Repeat R2

Repeat R1-4 an additional 8 times, for a total of 9 times, or until **section 3** is 7.5"/19 cm in length and ending on a R4.

SECTION 4

R1: *K1, P1, repeat from * until marker, SM, K1, *P1, K7*. Repeat from * to *, until last 6 sts before marker, P1, K5, SM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row.

R2: *P1, K1, repeat from * until marker, SM, P until marker, SM, *K1, P1, repeat from * until end of row.

R3: *K1, P1, repeat from * until marker, SM, K until marker, SM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row.

R4: Repeat R2.

R5: *K1, P1, repeat from * until marker, SM, K5, *P1, K7*. Repeat from * to *, until last 2 sts before marker, P1, K1, SM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row.

R6: Repeat R2.

R7-8: Repeat R3-4

Repeat R1-8 an additional 16 (21, 28) times, for a total of 17 (22, 29) times, or until **section 4** is 28 (36.75, 49)"/71 (93, 124) cm in length and ending on a R8.

SECTION 5

R1: *K1, P1, repeat from * until marker, SM, K1, *P1, K7*. Repeat from * to *, until last 6 sts before marker, P1, K5, SM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row.

R2: *P1, K1, repeat from * until marker, SM, P until marker, SM, *K1, P1, repeat from * until end of row.

R3: *K1, P1, repeat from * until marker, SM, K5, *P1, K7*. Repeat from * to *, until last 2 sts before marker, P1, K1, SM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row.

R4: Repeat R2

Repeat R1-4 an additional 8 times, for a total of 9 times, or until **section 5** is 7.5"/19 cm in length and ending on a R4.

SECTION 6

Set up row 1: * K1, P1, repeat from * until marker, SM, K until marker, SM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row.

Set up row 2: * P1, K1, repeat from * until marker, SM, P until marker, SM, *K1, P1, repeat from * until end of row.

R1: *K1, P1, repeat from * until marker, SM, K1, *P1, K3*. Repeat from * to *, until last 2 st before marker, P1, K1, SM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row.

R2: *P1, K1, repeat from * until marker, SM, P until marker, SM, *K1, P1, repeat from * until end of row.

R3: *K1, P1, repeat from * until marker, SM, K until marker, SM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row.

R4: Repeat R2.

R5: *K1, P1, repeat from * until marker, SM, *K3, P1*. Repeat from * to *, until last 3 sts before marker, K3, SM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row.

R6: Repeat R2

R7-8: Repeat R3-4.

Repeat R1-8 an additional 3 times, for a total of 4 times, or until **section 6** is 7"/18 cm in length and ending on a R8.

SECTION 7

R1: *K1, P1, repeat from * until marker, SM, K1, *P1, K3*. Repeat from * to *, until last 2 st before marker, P1, K1, SM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row.

R2: *P1, K1, repeat from * until marker, SM, P until marker, SM, *K1, P1, repeat from * until end of row.

R3: *K1, P1, repeat from * until marker, SM, *K3, P1*. Repeat from * to *, until last 3 sts before marker, K3, SM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row.

R4: Repeat R2.

Repeat R1-4 an additional 8 times, for a total of 9 times. Or until **section 7** is 7.5"/19 cm and ending on a R4.

DECREASE YOUR SCARF WIDTH

Sizes A & B:

R1: *K1, P1, repeat from * until marker, SM, *K1, K2tog, repeat from * until the last 2 sts before marker, K2tog, SM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row. You will now have 43 (43, -) sts.

R2: *P1, K1, repeat from * until marker, SM, P until marker, SM, *K1, P1, repeat from * until end of row.

Size C:

R1: *K1, P1, repeat from * until marker, SM, *K12, K2tog, repeat from * until 13 sts before marker, K13, SM, *P1, K1, repeat from * until end of row. You will have - (-, 64) sts.

R2: *P1, K1, repeat from * until marker, SM, *P2, P2tog, repeat from * until marker, SM, *K1, P1, repeat from * until end of row. You will have - (-, 51) sts.

CUFF (All sizes)

All sizes:

You can now take off your stitch markers.

R1: Switching to US 8/5mm needles: *K1, P1, repeat from * until the last st, K1, turn work.

R2: *P1, K1, repeat from * until the last st, P1, turn work.

Repeat R1-2 until your ribbed cuff section is 14"/36 cm in length. BO all sts in 1x1 rib.

Leaving a 3 foot long tail, cut your working yarn. You will use it to seam your cuff together.

BLOCKING

At this point, I would highly suggest blocking your piece. This will really help in ensuring that your purl stitches pop, and the piece lies as flat as possible. It will also help combat the natural curling of stockinette.

SEAMING YOUR CUFFS

Thread your darning needle with the tail from the bind off. With the right side facing down, fold your ribbed cuff together so it vertically lines up, and the WS is facing in. Using the mattress stitch, seam up the 14"/36 cm of the ribbed sleeve, and an additional 3"/7.5 cm above. For more coverage, feel free to seam up an additional 3"/7.5 cm. Repeat on the second side.

FINISHING + NOTES

Now weave in your ends, place it over your shoulders and do a happy dance! You have finished your #SnowfallSweaterScarf. You can wear this pattern in multiple ways, please check out the Youtube video below on how. How to wear a Sweater Scarf: <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=49Xf01bH0uY>
