




# SUGARPLUM JUMPER

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NEEDLES: 4,5MM & 5MM

YARN OPTION: PICKLES COZY  
YARN OPTION: FABEL KNITWEAR MAPLE

SIZE: (XS) S (M) L (XL) 2XL (3XL)

BUST: APPROX. (80CM) 90CM (100CM) 108CM (118CM) 127CM (132CM)


QUANTITY PICKLES COZY: (350G) 350G (350G) 400G (450G) 500G (550G)

QUANTITY MAPLE: (600G) 650G (700G) 750G (800G) 850G (900G)

GAUGE: 14ST(S) = 10CM



The Sugarplum jumper is a soft and cozy jumper with the best of two worlds; It's practical and warm, yet with its blousing bishop-sleeves and double ribbed neckline it's also feminine and flattering. Win-win!

## BODY

Cast on (112) 116 (126) 136 (146) 158 (170) st(s) on circular needles 4,5mm.  
Place a stitchmarker at the start of the round, and after (56) 58 (63) 68 (73) 79 (85) st(s) to mark the sides.  
Knit ribbed (K1, P1) in the round for 7cm.

Change to circular needles 5mm and knit stockinette stitch (knit stitches) for 2cm from the ribbed edge.  
On the next round, knit until there is 1 st(s) left until the SM, increase 1, K1, move SM, K1, increase 1. Do the same for the next SM.  
Increase like this every (3) 3 (3,5) 3,5 (3,5) 3,5 (3,5) cm in total 3 times (that's 12 st(s) increased). This is done to shape the bodice.  
Continue until the bodice measures (24) 25 (26) 27 (28) 30 (32) cm, and cast off 6 st(s) on each side for sleeves, 3 st(s) on each side of the SM.

## SLEEVES

Cast on (26) 26 (26) 28 (30) 32 (34) st(s) on circular needles 4,5mm, and place a stitchmarker at the start of the round.  
Knit ribbed (K1, P1) in the round for 9cm.  
Change to circular needles 5mm, and increase like this; \*K1, Increase 1\* out the round = (52) 52 (52) 56 (60) 64 (68) st(s).  
Knit one round in only stockinette.  
Increase (10) 10 (12) 12 (12) 14 (14) st(s) evenly = (62) (62) 64 (68) 72 (78) st(s).

Continue knitting stockinette until the sleeve measures 30cm from the wrist.  
Decrease (6) 6 (6) 6 (4) 4 (4) st(s) evenly throughout the next round by knitting 2 together.

Continue knitting stockinette until the sleeve measures 40cm from the wrist.  
Decrease (6) 6 (6) 6 (4) 4 (4) st(s) evenly throughout the next round by knitting 2 together.



Knit until the sleeve measures (46) 47 (49) 49 (51) 51 (52) cm, or to your adjusted length. The sleeves are meant to balloon slightly.

Cast off 6 st(s) under the sleeve, 3 st(s) on each side of the stitchmarker.

Knit another sleeve.

## YOKE AND TURTLENECK

The sleeves will now be knit onto the same needles as the bodice.

Knit until the first cast-off armhole st(s) and knit the first sleeve onto your needles.

Repeat for the next cast-off armhole st(s).

Place stitchmarkers at each divide between sleeve and bodice = 4 in total.

Knit stockinette in the round for 3 rounds. The raglan decrease starts on the 4th round.

Knit until there are 2 st(s) left before the first SM.

Slip 1 st(s), K1, put the slipped stitch over the knit one, move the SM, K2 together.

Knit stockinette out the sleeve until there are 2 st(s) left before the second SM – repeat the raglan decrease.

Knit until the second sleeve and repeat.



The next round is knit without any decreases.

Repeat the raglan-instructions until there are (74) 76 (78) 80 (82) 82 (82) st(s) left on the needles.

Knit 5 rounds without any decreases.

Change to needles 4,5mm, and knit ribbed (K1, P1) to make the high turtleneck. Knit ribbed for 20cm, then cast off loosely.



## ALMOST DONE!

Fasten all loose threads and sew the underarms together.
