

Sumiko *by Svetlana Volkova*

SIZES

XXS/XS/S/M/L/XL/XXL/XXXL

Finished chest circumference:

26.2/30/33.7/37.5/41.2/45/48.7/52.5 in

67/76/86/95/105/114/124/133 cm

Top is designed to be worn with -2 +3 in
(-5 +8 cm) of positive ease in the bust.

GAUGE 21 sts x 26 rows= 4 in / 10 cm in
St st after blocking

YARN

Louet Euroflax Sport Weight (100% Linen
270 yards/247 meters per 100 g)
approximately 2/2/2/3/3/3/4/4 skeins or
sport weight yarn to obtain gauge

MATERIALS

- size 6 US / 4 mm circular needles
- spare needle
- stitch markers
- scrap yarn
- tapestry needle



Top is worked seamlessly from the bottom up.

TOP BACK

P 1 row.

Decrease row (RS): ssk, yo, ssk, yo, k2tog, k to 6 sts before end, ssk, yo, k2tog, yo, k2tog

WS row: p to end

Repeat this 2 rows 10/12/14/17/19/21/23/25 times more.

RS row: ssk, yo, ssk, yo, k to 4 sts before m, yo, k2tog, yo, k2tog

Work decrease row one more time and then RS and WS rows 4/5/5/5/6/6/7/7 times.

= 46/52/58/62/68/74/80/86 sts

Place all sts onto scrap yarn. Cut yarn.

TOP FRONT LEFT SIDE

With WS facing attach yarn, pick up and purl left front sts (from beginning to midfront marker).

Decrease row (RS): ssk, yo, ssk, yo, k2tog, k to 6 sts before end, ssk, yo, k2tog, to, k2tog

WS row: p to end

Repeat this 2 rows 10/12/14/17/19/21/23/25 times more.

RS row: ssk, yo, ssk, yo, k to 4 sts before m, yo, k2tog, yo, k2tog

Work decrease row one more time and then RS and WS rows 6/7/7/7/8/8/9/9 times.

= 11/12/13/12/13/14/15/16 sts

Place all sts onto scrap yarn. Cut yarn.

TOP FRONT RIGHT SIDE

With WS facing attach yarn, pick up and purl right front sts (all remaining sts).

Decrease row (RS): ssk, yo, ssk, yo, k2tog, k to 6 sts before end, ssk, yo, k2tog, yo, k2tog

WS row: p to end

Repeat this 2 rows 10/12/14/17/19/21/23/25 times more.

RS row: ssk, yo, ssk, yo, k to 4 sts before m, yo, k2tog, yo, k2tog

Work decrease row one more time and then RS and WS rows 6/7/7/7/8/8/9/9 times.

= 11/12/13/12/13/14/15/16 sts



Turn the garment inside out. Place the stitches of the back onto a spare needle. Hold the two needles parallel, with the right sides of the pieces together and wrong side of the back facing you. With a third needle in a similar size and starting from right to left join back and front right shoulder (11/12/13/12/13/14/15/16 sts from back and front) using 3 needle BO, BO next 24/28/32/38/42/46/50/54 back neckline sts, join back and front left shoulder (11/12/13/12/13/14/15/16 sts) using 3 needle BO.

FINISHING

Weave in all yarn ends. Wet/steam block the top.

ABBREVIATIONS

BOR – beginning of the round

St st – stockinette stitch (knit on RS, purl on WS)

CO/ BO – cast on/ bind off

RS/ WS – right side/ wrong side

st(s) – stitch(es)

k/ p - knit/ purl


p/sm – place/slip marker

k2tog - knit 2 stitches together, slanting the stitches to the right

k3tog - knit 3 stitches together, slanting the stitches to the right

ssk - slip slip knit, slanting the stitches to the left

yo – yarn over
