

My how summer flies by, but this lacy summer shawl is the perfect accessory to cover bare shoulders on a breezy summer evening. The butterfly and lace motif are accented by a knotted openwork trellis, reminiscent of butterflies happily fluttering through your summer garden.

This shawl is worked by sections with increases made only on the right side rows. This creates a gentle curve for a shallow half round shawl. I recommend using natural plant fiber yarn in a DK or worsted weight, but you may use any DK or worsted weight yarn you wish.

Materials

380 yards (347 m) worsted weight yarn.
Shown in Bonnie's Bamboo Colorway:
Terra Cotta

Size US8 circular knitting needle 16" or longer.

Gauge

12 sts = 4 inches

Size

54 inches end to end

Abbreviations

K - knit

P - purl

ST(s) - stitch(es)

SL - slip

YO - yarn over

K2TOG - knit 2 together

P2TOG - purl 2 together

PSSO - Pass sl stitch over

KFB - knit into the front and back of the same stitch

M1 - make one st

Directions

Cast On

Using the long tail cast on method, cast on 3 sts. Knit 6 rows. Pick up 3 sts from the long edge of the garter stitch, with an additional 3 sts from the cast on edge, for a total of 9 sts.

Section 1 – Ridged Eyelet

Row 1 (RS): K3, YO, K3, YO, K3 (11 sts)

Row 2 (WS): K3, P5, K3

Row 3: K3, YO, K5, YO, K3 (13)

Row 4: K3, P7, K3

Row 5: K3, YO, K1, M1, K5, M1, K1, YO, K3 (17)

Row 6: K3, P11, K3

Row 7: K3, YO, K1, (M1, K3) 3 times, M1, K1, YO, K3 (23)

Row 8: K3, P1, K15, P1, K3

Row 9: K3, YO, K17, YO, K3 (25)

Row 10: K3, P1, (YO, P2TOG) 9 times, K3

Row 11: K3, YO, K19, YO, K3 (27)

Row 12: K3, P1, K19, P1, K3

Row 13: K3, YO, K1, M1, K6, M1, K7, M1, K6, M1, K1, YO, K3 (33)

Row 14: K3, P1, (YO, P2TOG) 13 times, K3

Row 15: K3, YO, K27, YO, K3 (35)

Row 16: K3, P1, K27, P1, K3

Row 17: K3, YO, K1, (M1, K9) 3 times, M1, K1, YO, K3 (41)

Row 18: K3, P35, K3

Row 19: K3, YO, K35, YO, K3 (43)

Row 20: K3, P37, K3

Row 21: K3, YO, K37, YO, K3 (45)

Row 22: K3, P39, K3

Row 23: K3, YO, K3, (YO, SL1, K1, PSSO, K1, K2TOG, YO, K2) 5 times, K1, YO, K3 (47)

Row 24: K3, P41, K3

Row 25: K3, YO, K4, (K1, YO, SL1, K2TOG, PSSO, YO, K3) 5 times, K2, YO, K3 (49)

Row 26: K3, P43, K3


Row 27: K3, YO, K43, YO, K3 (51)

Row 28: K3, P45, K3

Row 29: K3, YO, K45, YO, K3 (53)

Row 30: K3, P47, K3

Row 31: K3, YO, K1, (M1, K2) 23 TIMES, M1, YO, K3 (79)

Row 34: K3, P1, (YO, P2TOG) 37 times, K3

Row 37: K3, YO, K1, (M1, K25) 3 times, M1,

K1, YO, K3 (89)

Row 38: K3, P1, (YO, P2TOG) 41 times, K3

Row 39: K3, YO, K83, YO, K3 (91)

Row 40: K3, P1, K83, P1, K3

Row 47: K3, YO, K3, (YO, SL1, K1, PSSO, K1, K2TOG, YO, K2) 15 times, K1, YO, K3 (117)

Row 48: K3, P111, K3

Row 49: K3, YO, K4, (K1, YO, SL1, K2TOG, PSSO, YO, K3) 15 times, K2, YO, K3 (119)

Row 50: K3, P113, K3

Row 51: K3, YO, K113, YO, K3 (121)

Row 52: K3, P115, K3

Row 53: K3, YO, K115, YO, K3 (123)

Row 54: K3, P117, K3

Row 55: K3, YO, K4 (M1, K5) 22 times, K3, YO, K3 (147)

- Row 67: K3, YO, K2, (YO, K3, PASS 1ST knit ST
 over last 2 knitted STs) 55 times, to 5 STs from end,
 YO, K2, YO, K3 (178)
 Row 68: K3, P172, K3
 Row 69: K3, YO, K2, (YO, K3, PASS) 56 times, to 5
 STs from end, YO, K2, YO, K3 (181)
 Row 70: K3, P175, K3
 Row 71: K3, YO, K2, (YO, K3, PASS) 57 times, to 5
 STs from end, YO, K2, YO, K3 (184)
 Row 72: K3, P178, K3
 Row 73: K3, YO, K2, (YO, K3, PASS) 58 times, TO
 5 STs from end, YO, K2, YO, K3 (187)
 Row 74: K3, P181, K3
 Row 75: K3, YO, K2, (YO, K3, PASS) 59 times, to
 5 STs from end, YO, K2, YO, K3 (190)
 Row 76: K3, P184, K3
 Row 77: K3, YO, K2, (YO, K3, PASS) 60 times, to 5

Section 7 – Ruffle Edge

Row 1 (RS): SL1, K197

Row 2 (WS): SL1, P197

Row 3: KFB 198 times (396)

Row 4: SL1, P395

Row 5: SL1, K395

Row 8: SL1, P395

Row 9: SL1, K395

Row 10: SL1, P395



Picot Edge Bind Off

Bind off 2 sts, * slip st from right needle to left, cable cast on 2 sts, bind off 5 sts; Repeat form * until 2 sts remain, slip st from right needle to left needle, cable cast on 2 sts , bind off remaining sts.

Finishing

Weave in loose ends. Wet block. Pin top edge straight. Gently pin the rest of the scarf into shape and let dry.
