




SUNSET HIGHWAY

SUNSET HIGHWAY



MATERIALS:

Yarn:

Fingering weight yarn suitable for colorwork

MC: 700 (750, 800, 850, 900, 1000) yards 640 (686, 732, 777, 823, 914) meters

CC1: 250 (270, 290, 310, 330, 350) yards 229 (247, 265, 283, 302, 320) meters

CC2: 90 (100, 110, 120, 140, 160) yards 82 (91, 101, 110, 128, 146) meters

CC3: 140 (150, 160, 170, 180, 190) yards 128 (137, 146, 155, 165, 174) meters

Sample Uses:

Olann Singles Sock (100% superwash merino, single ply 400 yards/ 366 m/ 100g)

MC: Cocktail (peach speckled)

CC1: Moonlit (Black/blue/green speckled)

CC2: Botticelli (teal speckled)

CC3: Meek (pale green speckled)

Needles:

Main Needle: US 4 (3.5mm) circular needles for the body and sleeves

Neck/Ribbing Needle: US 2 (2.75mm) circular needles for the neckband and sleeve hem, or one size smaller than main body needle. Longer cable needle for Magic Looping or DPNs will be needed for the sleeve cuffs.

Other Notions: Stitch markers, stitch holders (or scrap yarn), tapestry needle

Gauge: 22 sts and 24 rows over 4" (10 cm) in stockinette on larger needles, after washing and blocking.

Sizes:


Designed to fit with 5-9" of positive ease.

Measurements given are for the finished bust circumference.

XS (S, M, L, XL, 2XL)

36.5 (39.5, 45, 49, 52.25, 56)"

93 (100.5, 114.5, 124.5, 133, 142) cm

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DIRECTIONS:

With CC1 and smaller needles, cast on 108 (108, 120, 128, 132, 132) sts. Join in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Pm to mark BOR (which is also the center back).

Neck Ribbing:

Round 1-7: *K3, p1; repeat from * to BOR.

Switch to larger needles.

Increase Round 1:

Size XS only: *K3, m1L; repeat from * to BOR. 144 (x, x, x, x, x) sts

Sizes S-2XL: *K2, m1L; repeat from * to BOR. x (162, 180, 192, 198, 198) sts

Increase Round 2:

Sizes XS, S, M and, L: K.

Size XL: *K16, m1L; repeat to 6 sts before BOR, k6. 12 sts increased. x (x, x, x, 210, x) sts

Size 2XL: M1L, k4, m1L, k5, m1L, *k9, m1L; repeat to BOR. 24 sts increased. x (x, x, x, x, 222) sts

144 (162, 180, 192, 210, 222) sts

SHORT ROWS:

Short rows are worked back and forth to raise the back neckline for a better fit.

Row 1 (RS): From BOR, k54 (60, 70, 72, 78, 82) w&t.

Row 2 (WS): P to BOR, sm, p54 (60, 70, 72, 78, 82), w&t.

Row 3: K to 5 sts before last wrapped st, w&t.

Row 4: P to 5 sts before last wrapped st, w&t.

Repeat Rows 3 and 4 four (four, five, five, five, six) times more.

Knit to BOR.

End of short rows, resume knitting in the round.

Next Round: K, picking up and knitting wraps with their corresponding sts as you come to them.


Next Round: K.

BEGIN YOKE COLORWORK:

Switch to larger needles if necessary, make increases as noted in chart.

Follow Yoke Chart below, starting at bottom right and working up.

YOKE CHART



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End colorwork chart, breaking all colors except MC.

288 (324, 360, 384, 420, 444) sts

Switch to main gauge needles.

Continue to knit in stockinette for 1 (1.5, 1.75, 2, 2.5, 3)'' 2.5 (3.5, 4.5, 5, 6.5, 7.5) cm.

SEPARATE BODY AND SLEEVES:

From BOR, k 43 (49, 55, 60, 64, 67), place next 58 (65, 70, 73, 82, 88) sts on holder for right sleeve, cast on 14 (12, 14, 16, 14, 20) sts for underarm, k 86 (96, 110, 118, 128, 134), place next 58 (65, 70, 73, 82, 88) sts on holder for left sleeve, cast on 14 (12, 14, 16, 14, 20) sts for underarm, k to BOR.

200 (218, 248, 270, 284, 308) sts

Knit Body:

Continue to k in stockinette until body reaches 15'' (38 cm) from underarm (or desired length).

SHORT ROWS:

Begin working back and forth in short rows to drop back hem (optional).

Row 1 (RS): From BOR, k 75 (81, 93, 100, 106, 116) w&t.

Row 2 (WS): P to BOR, sm, p 75 (81, 93, 100, 106, 116) w&t.

Row 3: K to 5 sts before last wrapped st, w&t.

Row 4: P to 5 sts before last wrapped st, w&t.

Repeat Rows 3 and 4 five (five, six, six, seven, seven) times more.

K to BOR.

End of short rows, resume working in the round.

Next round: K, picking up and knitting wrapped sts as you come to them.

Sizes S and L ONLY:

Next Round: K1, k2tog, k to 3 sts before BOR, k2tog, k1. 2 sts reduced. 200 (216, 248, 268, 284, 308) sts.

RIBBED BOTTOM HEM:

Switch to ribbing needles.

Rounds 1-5: *K3, p1; repeat to BOR.

Bind off in pattern, using a stretchy bind off method.

Bottom hem will roll up slightly- this is an intended part of the design but will relax a bit after blocking. If you prefer a flatter hem, work 4-6 more rounds of hem ribbing.

SLEEVES (Work both sleeves the same):

Move sleeve sts onto main needle. Join yarn at underarm to begin knitting around. Knit all sts, picking up and knitting 14 (12, 14, 16, 14, 20) underarm sts when you come to them, placing m in center of underarm sts for BOR.

You will have 72 (77, 84, 89, 96, 108) sts on the needles.

Next Round: From BOR, k around.

Repeat until sleeve measures 1'' (2.5 cm) from underarm.

Sizes XS, M, XL and 2XL:

K for 1'' (2.5 cm) more.

Size S and L:

Round 1: K1, k2tog, k to 3 sts before m, ssk, k1. 2 sts decreased. x (75, x, 87, x, x) sts

Rounds 2-3: K.

Round 4: Repeat Round 1. x (73, x, 85, x, x) sts


Round 5: K.

Round 6: K1, k2tog, k to m. 1 st decreased. x (72, x, 84, x, x) sts

72 (72, 84, 84, 96, 108) sts

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SLEEVE CHART



Key

- knit
- MC
- CC1
- CC3
- repeat

BEGIN SLEEVE COLORWORK:

Work Sleeve Chart, working central repeat section for 3" (7.5 cm).

After completing sleeve chart, break all CC's.

Continuing in MC, knit 2" (5 cm).

Sleeve Decreases:

Round 1: *K1, k2tog, repeat from * to BOR. 48 (48, 56, 56, 64, 72) sts

Switch to ribbing needles.

Ribbed Sleeve Hem:

Round 1: *K2, p2; repeat from * to BOR.

Repeat until sleeve hem measures 6" (15 cm) (or desired length).

Bind off in pattern with stretchy bind off method.

FINISHING:

Weave in loose ends and block.

ABBREVIATIONS

BOR	beginning of round
CC1	contrast color 1
CC2	contrast color 2
CC3	contrast color 3
k	knit
k2tog	knit 2 sts together
m1l	make one left (Pick up the bar between the stitch you knit and the one you're about to knit, bringing the needle from front to back. Then knit into the back of the stitch.)
MC	main color
p	purl
st(s)	stitch(es)
w&t	wrap and turn
