GAUGE: 23M = 10CM MEASURED ON THE INSIDE.



The Sylphidejacket is inspired by the magical, Nordic midsummer. The jacket is figureknit with an intricate bluebell pattern, blousing bishop sleeves, and a feminine square neckline.





ABBREVIATIONS

K: Knit

P: Purl

St(s): Stitch

SM: Stitchmarker

C2b: Slip one stitch, place it behind the knitting, knit the next stitch, put the slipped stitch back on the needle and knit it.

C2f: Slip one stitch, place it in front of the knitting, knit the next stitch, put the slipped stitch back on the needle and knit it.

Cr2b: Slip one stitch, place it behind the knitting, knit the next stitch, put the slipped stitch back on the needle and purl it.

Cr2f: Slip one stitch, place it in front of the knitting, purl the next stitch, put the slipped stitch back on the needle and knit it.


BLUEBELLS

The bluebells are knit around the bishop sleeve, and on the back.

For the pattern on the back, follow «BLUEBELLS, BACK» as instructed in the «BODICE» section of the pattern.

The bluebell pattern for the sleeves are instructed in the «SLEEVES» section.

BODY

Start casting on (164) 170 (180) 186 (192) st(s) on needles 3mm.

Knit ribbed (K1, P1) for 1cm.

When you've knit 1cm, make a buttonhole by knitting until there are 5 stitches left, place the yarn over the needle, and knit (or purl) 2 together. Continue as normal with the remaining stitches. Make a buttonhole every 4cm.

The ribbed edge is knit for a total of 10cm.

Change to needles 4mm. The ribbed edge is now done, and the jacket will from now on be knit using a reverse stockinette stitch, meaning you knit purl-stitches on the outside, and knit-stitches on the inside, all the way until it's finished.

Place out stitchmarkers to mark the sides at (42) 44 (46) 48 (50) st(s) from each side.

Knit 10 st(s) ribbed (K1, P1), purl until the first SM.

Find the 46 middle st(s) on the back, and place another SM on each side to mark where «BLUEBELLS, BACK» will be knit. Purl until you reach the abovementioned 46 st(s), and knit those from the first row of «BLUEBELLS, BACK». Purl until you have 10st(s) left, and knit these ribbed.

Knit the inside with 10 ribbed st(s), knit until the 46 «BLUEBELLS, BACK» st(s), follow the pattern, knit until there are 10 st(s) left, knit these ribbed.

Continue knitting with the ribbed edge on the sides, reverse stockinette, and «BLUEBELLS, BACK» pattern until you've knit 2cm from the stockinette started.

On the next outside/purl-side the increase for a fitted bodice starts. Knit until there is 1 st(s) left until the SM, increase 1, K1, move SM, K1, increase 1. Do the same for the next SM. Knit the rest of the round as normal with the berry patten and ribbing. Increase like this every (3) 3 (3,5) 3,5 (3,5) cm in total 5 times.

Continue until the bodice measures (24) 25 (26) 27 (28) cm, and cast off 8 st(s) on each sides for sleeves. (4 st(s) on each side of the SM). Do this on the purl side.

NOTE – Remember to mark where you are in the Bluebell pattern when you cast off for the sleeves, are you pick up where you left off once the sleeves are knit onto the



bodice.

ROW 67: P1r, K2 together, cr2b, P20, cr2f, K2 together, P11

ROW 68: K11, P2 together, K22, P2 together, K11





SLEEVES

Cast on 36 st(s) on needles (3) 3 (3) 4 (4) mm. Knit a ribbed edge (K1, P1) for 10cm, in the round.

Place a SM at the start to mark the underside of the sleeve.

Change to needles 4mm for size XS, S and M. Continue on needles 4mm for size L and XL.

The increase for the bishop sleeves, and the pattern for the bluebells now start.

Instructions between * and * are to repeated out the round.

ROW 1: Continue with the ribbing (K1, P1), and increase 1 st(s) between each st(s).

K1, Increase 1 purl, P1, Increase 1 purl

ROW 31: *K1, P20, K1, P4, cr2f, P4*

ROW 32: *K1, P15, cast on 6 new st(s), P5, K1, P10*

ROW 33: *K1, P15, K6, P4, cr2b, P10*

ROW 34: *K1, P15, K6, P4, K1, P11*

ROW 35: *K1, P15, K6, P3, cr2b, P11*

ROW 36: *K1, P15, slip 1 st(s), K1, put the slipped stitch over the knit one, K2, K2 together, P2, cr2b, P12*

ROW 37: *K1, P15, K4, P2, K1, P13*

ROW 38: *K1, P15, slip 1 st(s), K1, put the slipped stitch over the knit one, K2 together, P1, cr2b, P13*

ROW 39: *K1, P15, K2, P1, K1, P14*

ROW 40: *K1, P15, K2 together, cr2b, P14*

ROW 41: *K1, P5, cast on 6 new st(s), P10, cr2b, P15*

ROW 42: *cr2f, P4, K6, P27*

ROW 43: *P1, K1, P4, K6, P27*

ROW 44: *P1, cr2f, P3, K6, P27*

ROW 45: *P2, cr2f, P2, slip 1 st(s), K1, put the slipped stitch over the knit one, K2, K2 together, P27*


ROW 46: *P3, K1, P2, K4, P27*

ROW 47: *P3, cr2f, P1, slip 1 st(s), K1, put the slipped stitch over the knit one, K2 together, P27*

ROW 48: *P4, K1, P1, K2, P27*

ROW 49: *P4, cr2f, K2 together, P27*

ROW 50: *P5, cr2f, P27*



From now on the sleeve will be knit in purl-stitches (reverse stockinette), while also decreasing to form the bishop sleeve.

ROW 51: Decrease 20 st(s) evenly by purling 2 st(s) together.

ROW 52: Purl.

ROW 53: Purl.

ROW 54: Decrease 20 st(s) evenly by purling 2 st(s) together.

ROW 55: Purl.

ROW 56: Purl.

ROW 57: Decrease 20 st(s) evenly by purling 2 st(s) together.

ROW 58: Purl.

ROW 59: Purl.

ROW 60: Purl.

ROW 61: Decrease 20 st(s) evenly by purling 2 st(s) together.

ROW 62: Purl.

ROW 63: Purl.

ROW 64: Purl.

ROW 65: Purl. "

ROW 66: Decrease 20 st(s) evenly by purling 2 st(s) together.

ROW 67: Purl.

ROW 68: Purl.

ROW 69: Purl.

ROW 70: Purl.

ROW 71: Decrease 20 st(s) evenly by purling 2 st(s) together. Size XL is done decreasing after row 71, and will continue purling.

ROW 72: Purl.

ROW 73: Purl.

ROW 74: Purl.

ROW 75: Purl.

ROW 76: Decrease 20 st(s) evenly by purling 2 st(s) together. Size L is done decreasing after row 76, and will continue purling.

ROW 77: Purl.

ROW 78: Purl.

ROW 79: Purl.



ROW 80: Purl.

ROW 81: Decrease 5 st(s) evenly by purling 2 st(s) together. Size M is done decreasing after row 81, and will continue purling..

ROW 82: Purl.

ROW 83: Purl.

ROW 84: Purl.

ROW 85: Purl.

ROW 86: Decrease 5 st(s) evenly by purling 2 st(s) together. Size S and XS is done decreasing after row 86, and will continue purling.

Purl until the sleeve measure (46) 47 (49) 49 (51) cm.

Cast off 8 st(s), 4 on each side of the SM, for the armhole.





YOKE

The sleeves are now to be knit onto the same needles as the bodice. Knit the 10 ribbed st(s), and reverse stockinette until you reach the 8 cast of st(s) on each side, transfer the sleeves.

Continue in reversed stockinette and with the bluebell pattern until you reach the next 8 cast of st(s), and repeat.

Knit the inside in reverse stockinette, with the ribbed edge and bluebell pattern.

Knit the outside in reverse stockinette, with ribbed edge and bluebell pattern.

Knit the inside in reverse stockinette, with the ribbed edge and bluebell pattern.

The next outside/purlside marks the start of the raglan decrease.

Knit the ribbed edge, and purl as usual until there are 2 stitches left before the first SM. Slip 1 st(s), K1, put the slipped stitch over the knit one, move the SM, K 2 together. Repeat at all 4 stitchmarkers.

NOTE – the raglan decrease is knit with KNIT stitches on the outside, but continue with the reverse stockinette as before for the other st(s).

Knit the inside with the ribbed edge and bluebell pattern as before, but the st(s) on each side of the sleeve SMs are purled.

Continue as mentioned above until you've knit 5cm of raglan.

The neckline is now worked by knitting the first and last (22) 22 (26) 27 (27) st(s) ribbed (K1, P1).

Knit reverse stockinette as before, with raglan decrease and bluebell pattern, and now the ribbed neckline, until the neckline-ribbing measures 2cm.

Cast off the ribbed stitches according to your size at the start of the next round, and knit as before out the round.

Cast off the ribbed stitches according to your size at the start of the next round, and knit as before out the round. The two fronts are now even.

Continue with the reverse stockinette, raglan decrease and bluebell pattern until there are 2 st(s) left between the neckline and the first SM.

Cast off all st(s).

To finish the neckline, pick up stitches along the raw cast-off neckline edge, and knit it ribbed (K1, P1) for 2cm. Cast off.

Sew the loose edge that meets the front neckline neatly together at the side.



ALMOST DONE!

Sew the underarm seams together, sew on buttons, and fasten all loose threads.

Knits in Pickles Merino Tweed must be washed before use, so the yarn gets to «fill out». When that's done you're good to go!

If you've used the recommended yarn it will stretch after a bit of use, so don't worry if it's just a tad too tight for a day or two – it will ease!
