



Talin & Talin Vest

Size Measurements (S, M, L):

Bust: (115cm/45.3", 125cm/49.2", 136cm/53.5")

Upper arm: (40cm/15.7", 44cm/17.3", 46cm/18.1")

Recommended ease: 10cm/3.94" to 30cm/11.8"

Yardage:

Sweater (1315m/1438yards, 1440m/1575yards, 1565m/1712yards) of DK weight yarn

Vest (840m/919yards, 914m/1000yards, 995m/1088yards)

Needles and Tools:

3.5mm and 3.75mm 60cm/24" or 80cm/32" circular needle

3.0mm, 3.5mm and 3.75 mm DPNs or short circular needles (for sleeves)

3.0mm and 3.5mm 40cm/16" circular needle (for neckband)

Stitch markers and tapestry needle

Stitch holders or waste yarns

Gauge:

22 sts & 30 rows = 10cm/4" in Stockinette Stitch on 3.75mm needle after blocking

Pattern

Note: This pattern includes 'Talin Vest', which has no sleeve but folded brim on the arms and neck opening.

If you knit the sweater version, please ignore the red squared instructions and follow 'For Sweater' part.

BACK PANEL

Using 3.75mm needle, cast on (34, 36, 38) sts.

Row 0 (WS): p4, pm, p (26, 28, 30), pm, p4.

Row 1 (RS): k4, sm, M1L, k to m, M1R, sm, k4. 2 sts increased.

Row 2 (WS): p4, sm, M1Rp, p to m, M1Lp, sm, p4. 2 sts increased.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2, (15, 17, 19) times more.

Back panel: (98, 108, 118) sts

Row 3 (RS): k to end.

Row 4 (WS): p to end.

Repeat Row 3 and 4, (6, 7, 7) times more.

Row 5 (RS): k4, sm, M1L, k to m, M1R, sm, k4. 2 sts increased.

Row 6 (WS): p to end.

Repeat Row 5 and 6, (4, 4, 4) times more.

Back Panel: (108, 118, 128) sts

Row 7 (RS): k4, sm, M1L, k to m, M1R, sm, k4. 2 sts increased.

Row 8 (WS): p4, sm, M1Rp, p to m, M1Lp, sm, p4. 2 sts increased.

Repeat Row 7 to 8, (3, 3, 3) times more.

Back panel: (124, 134, 144) sts

Do not cut the working yarn. You will want to start knitting with this yarn in **JOIN BACK & FRONT** section.

LEFT FRONT PANEL



Attach new yarn and pick up 1 stitch for every row. Total (32, 36, 40) sts picked up.

Row 0 (WS): p4, pm, p (24, 28, 32), pm, p4.

Row 1 (RS): k4, sm, k to 2 sts before m, k2tog, sm, k4. 1 stitch decreased.

Row 2 (WS): p to end.

Row 3 (RS): k to end.

Row 4 (WS): p to end.

Repeat Row 1 to 4, (3, 3, 3) times more.

Left Panel: (28, 32, 36) sts

Row 5 (RS): k4, sm, M1L, k to 2 sts before m, k2tog, sm, k4.

Row 6 (WS): p to end.

Row 7 (RS): k4, sm, M1L, k to m, sm, k4. 1 stitch increased.

Row 8 (WS): p to end.

Repeat Row 5 to 8, (1, 1, 1) more time.

Left Front: (30, 34, 38) sts

Row 9 (RS): k4, sm, M1L, k to 2 sts before m, k2tog, sm, k4.

Row 10 (WS): p4, sm, p to m, M1Lp, sm, p4. 1 stitch increased,

Row 11 (RS): k4, sm, M1L, k to m, sm, k4. 1 stitch increased.

Row 12 (WS): same as Row 10.

Repeat Row 9 to 12, (1, 1, 1) more time.

Left Front: (36, 40, 44) sts.

Cut the yarn and place the stitches on stitch holder.

RIGHT FRONT PANEL



Attach new yarn and pick up 1 stitch for every row. Total (32, 36, 40) sts.

Row 0 (WS): p4, pm, p (24, 28, 32), pm, p4.

Row 1 (RS): k4, sm, ssk, k to m, sm, k4. 1 stitch decreased.

Row 2 (WS): p to end.

Row 3 (RS): k to end.

Row 4 (WS): p to end.

Repeat Row 1 to 4, (3, 3, 3) times more.

Right Front: (28, 32, 36) sts

Row 5 (RS): k4, sm, ssk, k to m, M1R, sm, k4.

Row 6 (WS): p to end.

Row 7 (RS): k4, sm, k to m, M1R, sm, k4.
1 stitch increased.

Row 8 (WS): p to end.

Repeat Row 5 to 8, (1, 1, 1) more time.

Right Front: (30, 34, 38) sts

Row 9 (RS): k4, sm, ssk, k to m, M1R, sm, k4.

Row 10 (WS): p4, sm, M1Rp, p to m, sm, p4. 1 stitch increased.

Row 11 (RS): k4, sm, k to m, M1R, sm, k4.
1 stitch increased.

Row 12 (WS): same as Row 10.

Repeat Row 9 to 12, (1, 1, 1) more time.

Left Front: (36, 40, 44) sts

Do not cut the working yarn.

JOIN FRONT PANELS

Joining Row (RS): start with right front panel. k4, sm, k to m, remove marker, k4.
Do not turn work. Cast on (20, 22, 24) sts

using Backwards Loop Cast On and join to left front panel. k4, remove marker, k to m, sm, k4.

Next Row (WS): p4, sm, p to m, sm, p4.

Front Panel: (92, 102, 112) sts

Row 1 (RS): k to end.

Row 2 (WS): p to end.

Repeat Row 1 and 2, (6, 8, 10) times more.

Row 3 (RS): k4, sm, M1L, k to m, M1R, sm, k4. 2 sts increased.

Row 4 (WS): p to end.

Repeat Row 3 and 4, (14, 15, 15) times more.

Front Panel (122, 134, 144) sts

Cut the working yarn.

JOIN BACK & FRONT

Starting from back panel, k to end (do not remove markers). Do not turn, CO (4, 4, 6) sts using Backwards Loop Cast On, join to front panel for working in the round. k to end (do not remove markers). Do not turn. CO (4, 4, 6) sts using Backwards Loop Cast On, pm for BOR and join.
BOR is now left underarm.

Body: (252, 276, 300) sts

Next Round: k around.

BODY

Knit in Stockinette Stitch for (3, 4, 5) cm from underarm.

Decrease Round: (k to m, sm, ssk, k to 2 sts before m, k2tog, sm)* rep twice, k to end. 4 sts decreased.

Knit in Stockinette Stitch for 5cm and knit Decrease Round once.

Repeat the above 3 times more. Total 20 sts decreased.

Continue working in Stockinette Stitch until body measures (26, 27, 28) cm.

Short Row 1 (RS): (k to m, sm)* rep 3 times, k (32, 35, 37), W&T.

Short Row 2 (WS): (p to m, sm)* rep 3 times, p to BOR, sm, p to m, sm, p (32, 35, 37), W&T.

Short Row 3 (RS): k to m, sm, k to BOR, sm, (k to m, sm)* rep 3 times, k (27, 30, 32), W&T.

Short Row 4 (WS): (p to m, sm)* rep 3 times, p to BOR, sm, p to m, sm, p (27, 30,

32), W&T.

Short Row 5 (RS): k to m, sm, k to BOR, sm, (k to m, sm)* rep 3 times, k (22, 25, 27), W&T.

Short Row 6 (WS): (p to m, sm)* rep 3 times, p to BOR, sm, p to m, sm, p (22, 25, 27), W&T.

Short Row 7 (RS): k to m, sm, k to BOR, sm, (k to m, sm)* rep 3 times, k (17, 20, 22), W&T.

Short Row 8 (WS): (p to m, sm)* rep 3 times, p to BOR, sm, p to m, sm, p (17, 20, 22), W&T.

Short Row 9 (RS): k to m, sm, k to BOR, sm, (k to m, sm)* rep 3 times, k (12, 15, 17), W&T.

Short Row 10 (WS): (p to m, sm)* rep 3 times, p to BOR, sm, p to m, sm, p (12, 15, 17), W&T.

Short Row 11 (RS): k to m, sm, k to BOR, sm, (k to m, sm)* rep 3 times, k (7, 10, 12), W&T.

Short Row 12 (WS): (p to m, sm)* rep 3 times, p to BOR, sm, p to m, sm, p (7, 10, 12), W&T.

Short Row 13 (RS): k to m, sm, k to BOR, sm, (k to m, sm)* rep 3 times, k (2, 5, 7), W&T.

Short Row 14 (WS): (p to m, sm)* rep 3

times, p to BOR, sm, p to m, sm, p (2, 5, 7), W&T.

Short Row 15 (RS): k to m, sm, k to BOR.

Change to 3.5mm needle.

Next Round: k to end. Do not forget to pick up wrapped stitches.

Work in 1×1 rib for 26 rounds

Bind Off Prep Round 1: (k1, sl1 wyif)* rep to end.

Bind Off Prep Round 2: (sl1 wyib, p1)* rep to end.

Bind off all sts using Tubular Bind Off.

SLEEVES

Attach new yarn and start from center of the underarm with 3.00mm needle, pick up and knit (2, 2, 3) sts from the cast on edge, pick up and knit (84, 92, 96) sts from the edge of armhole (pick up 3 sts for 4 rows) as shown in the following images, pick up and knit (2, 2, 3) sts from CO edge, pm for BOR and join.



Each sleeve: (88, 96, 102) sts

For Sweater

Change to 3.75mm needle.

Short Row 1 (RS): k (44, 48, 51), **pm for centre of short rows**, k (18, 20, 22), W&T.

Short Row 2 (WS): p to m, sm, p (18, 20, 22), W&T.

Short Row 3 (RS): k to m, sm, k to the previous W&T, knit the wrapped stitch together with the wrap, k2, W&T.

Short Row 4 (WS): p to m, sm, p to the

previous W&T, purl the wrapped stitch together with the wrap, p2, W&T.

Repeat Short Row 3 and 4, until you have (6, 8, 12) sts unworked on underarm (between W&Ts).

Short Row 5 (RS): k to m. **Remove the marker** (that you placed on Short Row 1), k to the previous W&T, knit the wrapped stitch together with the wrap, k to BOR.

Next Round: k to the last W&T, knit the wrapped stitch together with the wrap, k to BOR.

Knit around (2, 3, 4) rounds more.

Round 1: k1, ssk, k to 3 sts before end, k2tog, k1. 2 sts decreased.

Round 2-6: k around.

Repeat Round 1 to 6, (16, 17, 17) times more. (34, 36, 36) sts decreased total.

Each Sleeve: (54, 60, 66) sts

Size L only: knit Round 1 one more time to decrease 2 sts more.

Each Sleeve: (54, 60, 64) sts

Change to 3.5mm needle and knit across one more round.

Work in 1×1 rib for 26 rounds

Bind Off Prep Round 1: (k1, sl1 wyif)* rep to end.

Bind Off Prep Round 2: (sl1 wyib, p1)* rep to end.

Bind off all sts using Tubular Bind Off.

For Vest

Pick up (3, 3, 6) sts more from the edge of armhole.

Change to 3.5mm needle.

Work in Stockinette Stitch for 12 rounds.


Fold the brim in half with right side facing and wrong side inside.

Make sure your stitches lining up straight.

Knit the live stitch and the picked up stitch together and bind off. The brim has to be sewn down to the inside of the garment.

NECKBAND

Using 40cm/16" 3.0mm circular needle, pick up (104, 108, 112) sts around the neck opening as shown in the image below.



Knit the live stitch and the picked up stitch together and bind off. The brim has to be sewn down to the inside of the garment.

For Sweater

Change to 3.5mm needle.

Work in 2×2 rib for 18cm.

Bind Off Prep Round: (k1, place the next knit stitch on a cable needle and hold it in front of your work, purl the next purl stitch, put the knit stitch back to left needle from the cable needle and knit this stitch, p1)* rep to end. Your 2×2 rib has converted to 1×1 rib and you can use normal 1×1 Tubular Bind Off method.

Bind off all sts using Tubular Bind Off.

For Vest

Pick up (2, 2, 4) sts more to create a slightly wider neck opening.

Change to 3.5mm needle.

Work in Stockinette Stitch for 12 rounds.

Fold the brim in half with right side facing and wrong side inside.

Make sure your stitches lining up straight.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends, soak and lay flat to dry.

Abbreviations

CO: cast on

BO: bind off

RS: right side

WS: wrong side

st: stitch

sts: stitches

k: knit

p: purl

m: stitch marker

pm: place stitch marker

sm: slip stitch marker

yo: yarn over

k2tog: knit two together

ssk: slip slip knit

M1L: make one left increase. Pick up the bar between stitches from front to back with left needle, knit the bar through the back loop.

M1R: make one right increase. Pick up the bar between stitches from back to front

with left needle, knit into front of the bar.

M1Lp: make M1L increase from WS

M1Rp: make M1R increase from WS

W&T: wrap and turn

wyif: with yarn in front

wyib: with yarn in back
