I can't get enough of this simple, slipped stitch pattern! Depending on if you choose high or low contrast colors, it completely changes the look. This comfy, drop-shoulder pullover is the perfect way to showcase this beautiful stitch in the color combos of your dreams!

SUGGESTED YARN

A - The Farmer's Daughter Fibers Spinster's Daughter - 100% American SW Wool (75 g/300 yds/275 m) - 3 (4, 4, 4)(5, 5, 6)(6, 6, 7) skeins in York
B - Spincycle Yarns Dyed in the Wool - 100% American SW Wool (50 g/200 yds/183 m) - 2 (2, 2, 2)(3, 3, 3)(3, 4, 4) skeins in Every Rose
C - The Farmer's Daughter Fibers Oh Dang! - 74% Suri Alpaca/26% Silk (50 g/328 yds/300 m) - 1 (1, 1, 2)(2, 2, 2)(2, 2, 2) skein/s in Clay Dreaming



SUGGESTED NEEDLES

Main Fabric: US 4/3.5 mm - 32-40"/80-100 cm circular (2 sets for 3 Needle BO)
Ribbing: US 2/2.75 mm - 32-40"/80-100 cm circular and preferred needles for small circumference knitting for cuffs and collar.
(Use the needle size you need to achieve gauge, going down two US sizes for the ribbing.)



NOTIONS

Stitch markers (2), cable needle (optional), tapestry needle, spare needle, stitch holders or waste yarn to hold stitches



GAUGE

27 sts & 38 rnds = 4"/10 cm
Measured over stitch pattern (pg. 4) using the Main Fabric needle, after blocking.

NOTES

- To pick your size, measure around your full chest, then add or subtract your desired ease to that number. Pick the size closest to that from the *FINISHED CHEST CIRCUMFERENCE* on page 2 - DETAILS.
- This sweater is worked from the bottom up. The body is worked in the round until the divide for the yoke. The remainder is worked flat, and the shoulders are finished using the 3 needle bind off. The sleeves are then picked up from the body and knit in the round down to the cuff.
- You can easily adjust however much length you would like to the body of the sweater before separating the front and back for the Yoke. Take into account this will affect the amount of yardage used, and there will be some growth in length (approx. 1"/2.5 cm) after blocking.
- There is no need to break yarn colors as you work, simply carry them up the inside/ edge of the sweater.

GLOSSARY

{ } - Repeat

1/1 LPC - Left purl cross: sl st to a CN and hold to front, p1; k1 from CN.

1/1 RPC - Right purl cross: sl st to a CN and hold to back, k1; p1 from CN.

BO - Bind off

BOR - Beginning of round

CN - Cable needle

CO - Cast on

CONT - Continue

DEC/D - Decrease/d

EST - Established

INC/D - Increase/d

K - Knit

K1-F/B - Knit into the front loop and then the back loop of the stitch. [1 st inc'd]

K2TOG - Knit 2 stitches together as one. [1 st dec'd]

LHN - Left hand needle

M - Marker

P - Purl

REM - Remain

REP - Repeat

RND/S - Round/s

RS - Right side

SL - Slip stitch purlwise

ST/S - Stitch/es

SSK - Slip, slip, knit: Slip two stitches, one at a time, as if to knit, insert LHN into these stitches and knit them together thru the back loops. [1 st dec'd]

TBL - Thru the back loop

WYIF - With yarn in front

Stitch Pattern Knit Flat

Row 1 (RS): Using A, knit.

Row 2 (WS): Using B, p3, {sl2 wyif, p2} to the last st, p1.


Row 3: Using B, k3, {sl2 wyib, k2} to the last st, k1.

Row 4: Using A, purl.

Row 5: Using C, k1, {sl2 wyib, k2} to the last 3 sts, sl2 wyib, k1.

Row 6: Using C, p1, {sl2 wyif, p2} to the last 3 sts, sl2 wyif, p1.

Rep [Rows 1-6]

Stitch Pattern Knit in the Round


Rnd 1: Using A, knit.

Rnds 2 & 3: Using B, {k2, sl2 wyib} to end.

Rnd 4: Using A, knit.

Rnds 5 & 6: Using C, {sl2 wyib, k2} to end.

Rep [Rnds 1-6]

— DIRECTIONS —

HEM

With the Ribbing needle & A, CO 228 (260, 284, 308)(**340, 364, 396**)(420, 444, 468) sts using the Long Tail Tubular Cast On method. Do not join to work in the rnd. *If you prefer to sub in a different CO method, skip the Tubular setup rows, join to work in the rnd, placing a BOR M and go straight to the Ribbing Rnd.*

Tubular Setup Row 1 (WS): {K1-tbl, sl1 wyif} to end.

Tubular Setup Row 2 (RS): {K1, sl1 wyif} to end.

Tubular Setup Row 3 (rearranging sts): Join to work in the rnd, placing a BOR M, *k1, 1/1 RPC, p1; rep from * to end.

Ribbing Rnd: *K2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rep [Ribbing Rnd] until hem measures 3"/7.5 cm from the CO edge.

BODY PATTERN REPEAT

Change to Main Fabric needle.

Rnd 1: Using A, knit.

Rnds 2 & 3: Join/using B, {k2, sl2 wyib} to end.

Rnd 4: Using A, knit.

Rnds 5 & 6: Join/using C, {sl2 wyib, k2} to end.

Rep [Rnds 1-6] until the body of the sweater measures 10"/25.5 cm (the sweater will grow a bit post-blocking, approx. 1"/2.5 cm) from the CO edge, ending with Rnd 3 of the repeat. Break B & C.

IMPORTANT: KEEP TRACK OF EXACTLY HOW MANY ROWS YOU WORK FOR THE FRONT, FROM THE YOKE SEPARATION UNTIL YOU PUT THE SHOULDER STS ON HOLD, SO THAT YOU WORK THE SAME AMOUNT OF ROWS FOR THE BACK.

SEPARATE FOR YOKE

Using A, remove BOR M, using the Cable Cast On Method, CO 9 sts, knit across new sts, k114 (130, 142, 154)(**170, 182, 198**)(210, 222, 234) Front sts, using the Backwards Loop Method, CO 9 sts. Turn. The remaining unworked 114 (130, 142, 154)(**170, 182, 198**)(210, 222, 234) Back sts may be placed on hold using a spare needle or waste yarn while the Front Yoke is finished.

132 (148, 160, 172)(**188, 200, 216**)(228, 240, 252) sts on needle for Front.



TESSELLATED PULLOVER

— DIRECTIONS —

FRONT YOKE PATTERN REPEAT

The remainder of the front and back yokes will be worked flat in rows. On RS rows, knit and sl sts wyib, and on WS rows, purl and sl sts wyif. See Chart below for a visual.

Row 1 (WS): Join/using C, p1, {sl2 wyif, p2} to the last 3 sts, sl2 wyif, p1.

Row 2 (RS): Using C, k1, {sl2 wyib, k2} to the last 3 sts, sl2 wyib, k1.



Row 3: Using A, purl.

Row 4: Join/using B, k3, {sl2 wyib, k2} to the last st, k1.

Row 5: Using B, p3, {sl2 wyif, p2} to the last st, p1.

Row 6: Using A, knit.

Rep [Rows 1-6] until the Front Yoke measures 4 (4, 5, 5)(6, 6, 7)(8, 8, 9)"/10 (10, 12.5, 12.5)(15, 15, 18)(20.5, 20.5, 23) cm from the underarm CO, ending with Row 5 of the repeat. Break B.



FRONT NECK SHAPING

Neck BO Row (RS): Using A, k58 (64, 70, 76)(82, 86, 92)(98, 104, 110), k1-f/b, k1, BO 1 by pulling the new st created by the k1-f/b over the st you just knit, BO 14 (18, 18, 18)(22, 26, 30)(30, 30, 30) more sts, knit to end.

[59 (65, 71, 77)(83, 87, 93)(99, 105, 111) sts rem per shoulder]

The Left Front Shoulder sts may be placed on hold using waste yarn or a spare needle while the Right Front Shoulder is finished.

RIGHT FRONT SHOULDER - as worn

Charts are located for Sizes 1 (-, 3, -)(5, 6, -)(8, -, 10) on pg. 9 & for Sizes - (2, -, 4)(-, -, 7)(-, 9, -) on pg. 10 to assist in staying in pattern.

Row 1 (WS): Using C, work in the est pattern to the last st, sl1 wyif.

Row 2 (RS/DEC): Using C, sl2 wyib, pass the first st over the top of the second and off the needle, BO 4 more sts, work in pattern to end. [5 sts dec'd]

Row 3: Using A, purl to the last st, sl1 wyif.

Row 4 (DEC): Using B, sl2 wyib, pass the first st over the top of the second and off the needle, BO 3 more sts, work in pattern to end. [4 sts dec'd]

Row 5: Using B, work in the est. pattern to the last st, sl1 wyif.

Row 6 (DEC): Using A, sl2 wyib, pass the first st over the top of the second and off the needle, BO 2 more sts, knit to end. [3 sts dec'd]

Row 7: Using C, work in the est pattern to the last st, sl1 wyif.

Row 8 (DEC): Using C, sl2 wyib, pass the first st over the top of the second and off the needle, BO 1 more st, work in pattern to the end. [2 sts dec'd]

Row 9: Using A, purl to the last st, sl1 wyif.

Row 10 (DEC): Using B, sl2 wyib, pass the first st over the top of the second and off the needle, work in pattern to end. [1 st dec'd]

Row 11: Using B, work in the est. pattern to the last st, sl1 wyif.

[15 sts dec'd in total; 44 (50, 56, 62)(68, 72, 78)(84, 90, 96) sts rem]

— DIRECTIONS —

RIGHT FRONT SHOULDER PATTERN

REPEAT - SIZES 1 (-, 3, -)(5, 6, -)(8, -, 10) ONLY

Row 1 (RS): Using A, knit.

Row 2 (WS): Using C, p1, {sl2 wyif, p2} to the last 3 sts, sl2 wyif, p1.

Row 3: Using C, k1, {sl2 wyib, k2} to the last 3 sts, sl 2 wyib, k1.

Row 4: Using A, purl.

Row 5: Using B, k3, {sl2 wyib, k2} to the last st, k1.

Row 6: Using B, p3, {sl2 wyif, p2} to the last st, p1.

Rep [Rows 1-6] until the Right Front Shoulder measures 7 (-, 8, -)(9, 9, -)(11, -, 12)"/18 (-, 20.5, -)(23, 23, -)(28, -, 30.5) cm from the underarm CO, ending with Row 1 of the repeat. Break all yarns and place sts on hold.

RIGHT FRONT SHOULDER PATTERN

REPEAT - SIZES - (2, -, 4)(-, -, 7)(-, 9, -) ONLY

Row 1 (RS): Using A, knit.

Row 2 (WS): Using C, p1, {sl2 wyif, p2} to the last st, p1.

Row 3: Using C, k3, {sl2 wyib, k2} to the last 3 sts, sl 2 wyib, k1.

Row 4: Using A, purl.

Row 5: Using B, k1, {sl2 wyib, k2} to the last st, k1.

Row 6: Using B, p3, {sl2 wyif, p2} to the last 3 sts, sl2 wyif, p1.

Rep [Rows 1-6] until the Right Front Shoulder measures - (7, -, 8)(-, -, 10)(-, 11, -)"/- (18, -, 20.5)(-, -, 25.5)(-, 28, -) cm from the underarm CO, ending with Row 1 of the repeat. Break all yarns and place sts on hold.

LEFT FRONT SHOULDER - as worn

Return held sts for the Left Front Shoulder to the Main Fabric needle and join C at the armhole edge with RS facing.

Row 1 (RS): Using C, work in the est pattern to the last st, sl1 wyif.

Row 2 (WS/DEC): Using C, sl2 wyib, pass the first st over the top of the second and off the needle, BO 4 more sts, work in pattern to end. [5 sts dec'd]

Row 3: Using A, knit to the last st, sl1 wyif.

Row 4 (DEC): Using B, sl2 wyib, pass the first st over the top of the second and off the needle, BO 3 more sts, work in pattern to end. [4 sts dec'd]

Row 5: Using B, work in the est. pattern to the last st, sl1 wyif.

Row 6 (DEC): Using A, sl2 wyib, pass the first st over the top of the second and off the needle, BO 2 more sts, purl to end. [3 sts dec'd]

Row 7: Using C, work in the est pattern to the last st, sl1 wyif.

Row 8 (DEC): Using C, sl2 wyib, pass the first st over the top of the second and off the needle, BO 1 more st, work in pattern to the end. [2 sts dec'd]

Row 9: Using A, knit to the last st, sl1 wyif.

Row 10 (DEC): Using B, sl2 wyib, pass the first st over the top of the second and off the needle, work in pattern to end. [1 st dec'd]

Row 11: Using B, work in the est. pattern to the last st, sl1 wyif.

[15 sts dec'd in total; 44 (50, 56, 62)(68, 72, 78)(84, 90, 96) sts rem]

LEFT FRONT SHOULDER PATTERN

**REPEAT - SIZES 1 (-, 3, -)(5, 6, -)(8, -, 10)
ONLY**

Row 1 (WS): Using A, purl.

Row 2 (RS): Using C, k1, {sl2 wyib, k2} to the last 3 sts, sl2 wyib, k1.

Row 3: Using C, p1, {sl2 wyif, p2} to the last 3 sts, sl2 wyif, p1.

Row 4: Using A, knit.

Row 5: Using B, p3, {sl2 wyif, p2} to the last st, p1.

Row 6: Using B, k3, {sl2 wyib, k2} to the last st, k1.

Rep [Rows 1-6] until the Left Front Shoulder measures 7 (-, 8, -)(**9, 9, -**)(11, -, 12)"/18 (-, 20.5, -)(**23, 23, -**)(28, -, 30.5) cm from the underarm CO, ending with Row 1 of the repeat. Break all yarns and place sts on hold.

LEFT FRONT SHOULDER PATTERN

**REPEAT - SIZES - (2, -, 4)(-, -, 7)(-, 9, -)
ONLY**

Row 1 (WS): Using A, purl.

Row 2 (RS): Using C, k1, {sl2 wyib, k2} to the last st, k1.

Row 3: Using C, p3, {sl2 wyif, p2} to the last 3 sts, sl2 wyif, p1.

Row 4: Using A, knit.




Row 5: Using B, p1, {sl2 wyif, p2} to the last st, p1.

Row 6: Using B, k3, {sl2 wyib, k2} to the last 3 sts, sl2 wyib, k1.

Rep [Rows 1-6] until the Left Front Shoulder measures - (7, -, 8)(-, -, **10**)(-, 11, -)"/- (18, -, 20.5)(-, -, **25.5**)(-, 28, -) cm from the underarm CO, ending with Row 1 of the repeat. Break all yarns and place sts on hold.





— DIRECTIONS —

Row 9: Using A, purl to the last st, sl1 wyif.

Row 10: Using B, work in the est pattern to end.

Row 11: Using B, work in the est. pattern to end. Break B.

Row 12: Using A, knit to end.
[10 sts dec'd in total; 44 (50, 56, 62)(**68, 72, 78**)(84, 90, 96) sts rem]

FINISH LEFT SHOULDER

Return Left Front Shoulder sts (as worn) to a spare needle. Using A, with wrong sides facing each other and right side facing you, (to create an exposed seam) use the 3 Needle BO as follows: Line up shoulder sts from the front and back of the sweater on parallel needles, with tips pointing to the armhole edge. Using a third needle, insert needle tip knitwise into the first stitch on the front needle and then knitwise into the first stitch on the back needle, and knit them together; *knit the next stitch from each needle together, pass the first stitch over the second; rep from * until all shoulder sts have been bound off. Break A.

RIGHT BACK SHOULDER - as worn

Return held sts for the Right Back Shoulder to the Main Fabric needle and join C at the armhole edge with RS facing.

Row 1 (RS): Using C, work in the est pattern to the last st, sl1 wyif.

Row 2 (WS/DEC): Using C, sl2 wyib, pass the first st over the top of the second and off the needle, BO 3 more sts, work in pattern to end. [4 sts dec'd]

Row 3: Using A, knit to the last st, sl1 wyif.

Row 4 (DEC): Using B, sl2 wyib, pass the first st over the top of the second and off the needle, BO 2 more sts, work in pattern to end. [3 sts dec'd]

Row 5: Using B, work in the est. pattern to the last st, sl1 wyif.

Row 6 (DEC): Using A, sl2 wyib, pass the first st over the top of the second and off the needle, BO 1 more st, purl to end. [2 sts dec'd]

Row 7: Using C, work in the est pattern to the last st, sl1 wyif.

Row 8 (DEC): Using C, sl2 wyib, pass the first st over the top of the second and off the needle, work in pattern to the end. Break C. [1 st dec'd]

Row 9: Using A, knit to the last st, sl1 wyif.

Row 10: Using B, work in the est pattern to end.

Row 11: Using B, work in the est. pattern to end. Break B.

Row 12: Using A, purl to end. Break A.
[10 sts dec'd in total; 44 (50, 56, 62)(**68, 72, 78**)(84, 90, 96) sts rem]


FINISH RIGHT SHOULDER

Return the sts of the Right Front Shoulder (as worn) to a spare needle. Using A, with the wrong sides facing each other, and the right side facing you, to create an exposed seam - use the 3 Needle BO as follows: Line up the shoulder sts from the front and the back of the sweater on parallel needles, with the tips pointing to the neck edge. Join A, & using a third needle, insert needle tip knitwise into the first stitch on the front needle and then knitwise into the first stitch on the back needle, and knit them together; *knit the next stitch from each needle together, pass the first stitch over the second; rep from * until all shoulder sts have been bound off. Break A.



BACK NECK SHAPING CHARTS




RIGHT BACK SHOULDER

SLEEVES (same for both)

Using Mattress stitch and A, with RS facing out, seam the 9 sts that were CO to the Front armhole edge to the 9 sts that were CO to the Back armhole edge, which creates the beginning of the sleeve.

Using Main Fabric needle in your preferred method for small circumference knitting, join A at the underarm seam and pick up and knit 96 (96, 108, 108)(**120, 120, 136**) (148, 148, 160) sts around the sleeve opening. Place a BOR M and join to work in the rnd.

SLEEVE SHAPING

To avoid disrupting the stitch pattern on the sleeves, I recommend pairing 2 dec rnds back to back - for instance, work a dec rnd on Rnd 1 of the pattern repeat, then immediately again on the next A rnd - Rnd 4.

After every set of Dec Rnds is worked, the patterning will shift by 2 sts. For the first repeat, we worked Rnds 2 & 3 with B as {k2, sl2 wyib}, but with those 2 sts dec'd out, you will now just shift the repeat over - {sl2 wyib, k2} so that the columns of each contrast color stay lined up. See the examples in the following column of what that looks like.

SLEEVE PATTERN REPEAT

Rnd 1: Using A, knit.

Rnds 2 & 3: Join/using B, {k2, sl2 wyib} to end.

Rnd 4: Using A, knit.

Rnds 5 & 6: Join/using C, {sl2 wyib, k2} to end.

DECREASE SET EXAMPLE 1

DEC RND: Using A, k2tog, knit to the last 2 sts, ssk. [2 sts dec'd]

Rnds 2 & 3: Using B, k1, {sl2 wyib, k2} to the last st, sl1 wyib.

DEC RND: Using A, k2tog, knit to the last 2 sts, ssk. [2 sts dec'd]

Rnds 5 & 6: Using C, {k2, sl2 wyib} to end. [4 sts dec'd]

DECREASE SET EXAMPLE 2

DEC RND: Using A, k2tog, knit to the last 2 sts, ssk. [2 sts dec'd]

Rnds 2 & 3: Using B, {sl2 wyib, k2} to the end.

DEC RND: Using A, k2tog, knit to the last 2 sts, ssk. [2 sts dec'd]

Rnds 5 & 6: Using C, k1, {sl2 wyib, k2} to the last st, sl1 wyib. [4 sts dec'd]

Cont working the sleeve in pattern, rep the Dec Rnds on either Rnd 1 or 4 of the pattern repeat in pairs (as described in the previous column), every 1 (1.5, 1, 1)(**1, 1, 0.5**)(0.5, 0.5, 0.5)"/2.5 (4, 2.5, 2.5)(**2.5, 2.5, 1**)(1, 1, 1) cm - a total of 9 (7, 10, 10)(**10, 10, 14**)(13, 13, 16) times, until the sleeve measures 16"/40.5 cm from the underarm (or 2"/5 cm less than your desired sleeve length) ending with Rnd 1 or 4 of the repeat. Break B & C.

[36 (28, 40, 40)(**40, 40, 56**)(52, 52, 64) total sts dec'd; 60 (68, 68, 68)(**80, 80, 80**)(96, 96, 96) sts rem]

CUFF

Change to Ribbing needle.

Ribbing Pattern: {K2, p2} to end of rnd.

Cont in the est ribbing pattern for 1.75"/4.5 cm. (If you prefer not to do a Tubular BO, cont the ribbing until it measures 2"/5 cm, then BO in pattern.)

Rearranging Sts for BO: *K1, 1/1 LPC, p1; rep from * to end of rnd.

Tubular BO Rnd 1: {K1, sl1 wyif} to end of rnd.

Tubular BO Rnd 2: {Sl1 wyib, p1} to end of rnd.

Sl each st purlwise, slipping the knit sts onto the working needle and the purl sts onto a spare needle, OR reference the Kitchener Stitch on One Needle Tutorial linked in the Notes on pg. 3 to skip this step.

Break yarn, leaving a tail 3 x the length of the sts to be bound off, and BO all sts using the Kitchener stitch.

Repeat for the other sleeve.

COLLAR

Using the Ribbing needle, join A at the right edge of the Back Neck and pick up and knit 132 (140, 140, 140)(**144, 152, 156**) (156, 156, 156) sts around the neck. *You can pick up more or fewer sts, as long as your final stitch count is divisible by 4.*

Ribbing Rnd: *K2, p2; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rep [Ribbing Rnd] until collar measures 1.25"/4 cm from the picked up edge.

If you prefer not to use the Tubular Bind Off, cont the ribbing until it measures 1.5"/4.5 cm and then bind off in pattern.

Rearranging Sts for BO: *K1, 1/1 LPC, p1; rep from * to end of rnd.

Tubular BO Rnd 1: {K1, sl1 wyif} to end of rnd.

Tubular BO Rnd 2: {Sl1 wyib, p1} to end of rnd.

Sl each st purlwise, slipping the knit sts onto the working needle and the purl sts onto a spare needle, OR reference the Kitchener Stitch on One Needle Tutorial linked in the Notes on pg. 3 to skip this step.

Break yarn, leaving a tail 3 x the length of the sts to be bound off, and BO all sts using the Kitchener stitch.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.

Wet block sweater by letting it soak in lukewarm bath with wool wash for at least 15 minutes. Gently squeeze the excess water from your sweater.

Sandwich sweater between clean towels and step on top to remove as much moisture as possible. Repeat with fresh towels if necessary.

Lay sweater flat to dry using the schematic to help achieve the desired shape and measurements. Trim yarn tails and wear!


