Laneus shawl is a sister design to my [Laneus pullover](#).

From Latin “woolly”, it is a crescent shape shawl knit top-down in a sport weight yarn. The design is worked in sections of garter stitch, textured pattern and two sections of floral inlay colourwork.

SIZE

The pattern is written for one full size with the finished wing span of ca. 196 cm (78.5 in) and depth of ca. 48 cm (19.25 in), and a smaller size of ca. 152 cm (60.75 in) and 38 cm (15 in) respectively. Further adjustments are also possible, see Notes.


YARN

MC: ca. 135 (75) g of **fingering weight** unspun Nutiden yarn from Honer Och Eir, 100% wool with ca. 500 m (547 yds) in 100 g plate, shown in colourway Kvartz;

held together with 1 strand of lace weight silk-mohair — ca. 75 (42) g or 3 (2) skeins of Soft Silk Mohair from Knitting for Olive, 70% Mohair and 30% Silk with ca. 225 m (246 yds) per 25 g skein, shown in colourway Plum Clay;

or ca. 675 m // 738 yds of any other sport/DK weight yarn or combination of yarns to match the gauge for the full size and 345 m // 410 yds for the small.

CC: ca. 20 m (22) yds of any fluffy loosely spun or unspun contrasting colour yarn for the inlay colourwork (double the number if holding 2 strands together, as I would recommend for Nutiden).



NEEDLES AND NOTIONS

- 4.5 mm (US 7) circular needles;
- 4.5 mm (US 7) DPNS for garter tab cast-on and to use as a cable needle (if necessary);
- spare cables, spare circular needles to be able to try the shawl on;
- two stitch markers;
- a tapestry needle or a crochet hook to weave in the ends.

GAUGE

16 sts & 28 rows in 10 cm (4 in) on 4.5 mm (US 7) needles measured over stockinette stitch worked flat after blocking;

15 sts & 36 rnds in 10 cm (4 in) on 4.5 mm (US 7) needles measured over garter stitch worked flat after blocking.

Adjust the needle sizes if necessary to obtain the correct gauge.

NOTES

- If you tend to knit tightly, use a bigger size needle than the one recommended (go half a size or a whole size up);
- The gauge it is knitted loosely for the yarn weight to achieve the fabric that drapes well;

- For the smaller size, skip increases in R89 and bind off after the fourth (4th) garter stitch section;
- For an even bigger size, add more rows in the last garter stitch section or add an extra colourwork section and finish with garter stitch trim;
- You can follow both the row by row written instructions and the charts provided. The charts should be read from right to left on the RS and from left to right on the WS.

ABBREVIATIONS AND TECHNIQUES

1-1LC – slip 1 st (onto a cable needle) and hold in front, k1, then k the 1 st on hold;

1-1LPC – slip 1 st (onto a cable needle) and hold in front, p1, then k the 1 st on hold;

1-1RPC – slip 1 st (onto a cable needle) and hold back, k1, then p the 1 st on hold;

BOR/EOR – beginning/end of the round;

ca. – circa – approximately;

inlay colourwork – [video demo](#) –

- work the floats loosely and stretch the work slightly after every pattern repeat. Remember, that you can always fix loose floats, but won't be able to fix those that are too tight;
- the pattern is designed in a way that you don't need to catch the floats since there will be no long floats;

ABBREVIATIONS AND TECHNIQUES

inlay colourwork –

- at the end of a row with colourwork, do not break the yarn and do not twist it as for intarsia, just pick it up where you left it in the next row. [Watch the video demo!](#)

fXccRS – [float with CC on the RS](#) – bring CC yarn to the front, knit X sts with MC, bring CC yarn to the back;

fXccWS – [float with CC on the WS](#) – bring CC yarn to the back, purl X sts with MC, bring CC yarn to the front;

kX – knit X sts with MC;

k1cc – knit 1 st with CC;

LH/RH – left/right hand (needle);

LLI – [left lifted increase](#) – lift the left leg of the st two rows below the st on RH needle onto LH needle and knit it through the back loop;

m1pb – [make 1 purl st from the row below](#) – insert the RH needle from back to front into a st below the next purl st on LH needle and pull the yarn through the st (creating an eyelet);

M – marker;

MC/CC – main/contrasting colour;

PM – place marker;

pX – purl x sts;

rep – repeat;

R – row;

RS/WS – right/wrong side of the work;

sl1yb – slip 1 purlwise with yarn behind;

sl1yf – slip 1 purlwise with yarn in front;

SM – slip marker;

st(s) – stitch(es);

ssk – slip the next 2 sts, one by one, knitwise, insert the tip of the LH needle, from left to right, into the fronts of those 2 sts and knit them together;

yo – yarn over.

GARTER TAB CAST-ON

With 4.5 mm (US 7) circular or DPNs cast on 3 sts. Work in garter st a total of 34 rows.

R1 (RS): with circular needles k3, PM, pick up and k17 sts along the garter tab edge, PM, pick up and k3 more sts from the cast-on edge. (23 sts)

BLOCKING

Weave in the remaining ends. Soak the garment in lukewarm water. Gently squeeze to remove most of the water and then roll in a towel to dry. Pin out to measurements or desired size/shape and leave flat to dry.




