NOTES

This jumper pattern is unisex, has a boxy fit, and comes in ten different adult sizes. There are two options for body length options - cropped and regular. Because the jumper is knitted top down, you can easily customize the length by stopping or continuing after the recommended body length measurements. The collar is knitted with corrugated rib technique. It is less stretchy compared to normal ribbing, so remember to check gauge, use a stretchy cast-on, and size up needles as needed.

There are also two sleeve length options, bracelet length and full length, so you can customize the jumper to fit you best. There are optional chest short rows for a looser fit around the chest area. I used Japanese short rows as it is the least visible method, but any short rows method works. The colourwork yoke has long floats, so remember to catch your floats! The colourwork charts are read from right to left, bottom to top. The intended positive ease is about 7.5cm / 3" to 13cm / 5".

CONSTRUCTION

The jumper is knitted top-down and in the round. A seamless colourwork round yoke follows, with increase intervals throughout. Sleeve separation creates the distinction between armholes and body. The sleeves are knitted top-down and in the round as well.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4) 5, 6 [7, 8, 9] 10

YARN

MC - Istex Plotulopi Dark Woods

CC 1 - Istex Plotulopi Ash

CC 2 - various scrap yarn in similar weight

CC 3 - black yarn in similar weight

NEEDLES

Size 4.5mm / 7 & Size 3 mm / US2.5 or size necessary to obtain gauge

GAUGE

30 sts x 32 rnds = 4"/10 cm in colourwork sts
30 sts x 32 rows = 4"/10 cm in stockinette sts

NOTIONS

Stitch markers
Tapestry needle
Stitch holders / Waste yarn

40cm/16"
60cm/24"
80cm/32"

BEGIN PATTERN

neck

Using larger needles and with CC1, co 92 (92, 92, 98) 104, 104 [110, 110, 110] 114 sts. Join in the rnd and pm to mark bor.

Set up rnd: * With CC1, k1, with MC, k1, rep from * around.

Rnd 1: * With CC1, k1, with MC, p1, rep from * around. Rep rnd 1 until collar measures 5cm/2".

NECK SHAPING

Switch to smaller needles. K one rnd.

SR1 (rs): k 46 (46, 46, 49) 52, 52 [55, 55, 55] 57, w&t.

SR2 (ws): p 69 (69, 69, 74) 78, 78 [83, 83, 83] 86, w&t.

SR3 (rs): k 59 (59, 59, 64) 68, 68 [73, 73, 73] 76, w&t.

SR4 (ws): p 49 (49, 49, 54) 58, 58 [63, 63, 63] 66, w&t.

SR5 (rs): k 9 (39, 39, 44) 48, 48 [53, 53, 53] 56, w&t.

SR6 (ws): p 29 (29, 29, 34) 38, 38 [43, 43, 43] 46, w&t.

SR7 (rs): k - (-, -, 24) 28, 28 [33, 33, 33] 36, w&t.

SR8 (ws): p - (-, -, 14) 18, 18 [23, 23, 23] 26, w&t.

Work in stockinette stitch (k all sts), picking up the wraps as you go. Knit an additional round, picking up remaining wraps and knit them together with the wrapped stitches as you go.

SET-UP INC ROUNDS

Before starting chart a, knit the following increases. Refer to your size section for increase rounds in the yoke. Switch to longer cables as yoke size increases.

Rnd 3: *K8, m1* to last 4 sts, k4. (14 inc) [130]

Rnd 5: *K9, m1* to last 4 sts, k4. (14 inc) [144]

Rnd 1: K4, *k3, m1, k4, m1* to last 4 sts, k4
(24 inc) [116]

Rnd 2: K to end. (0 inc) [116]

Rnd 3: *K8, m1* to last 4 sts, k4. (14 inc) [130]

Rnd 4: K to end. (0 inc) [130]

Rnd 5: *K5, m1* to end of rnd. (26 inc) [156]

SIZE 3

Rnd 1: K4 *k3, m1, k4, m1* to last 4 sts, k4
(24 inc) [116]

Rnd 2: K to end. (0 inc) [116]

Rnd 3: *K5, m1* to last 6 sts, k6. (22 inc) [138]

Rnd 4: K to end. (0 inc) [138]

Rnd 5: *K4, m1* to last 2 sts, k2. (34 inc) [172]

Rnd 1: K3 *k3, m1, k4, m1* to last 3 sts, k3

Rnd 4: K to end. (0 inc) [156]

Rnd 5: *K6, m1* to end of rnd. (26 inc) [182]

Rnd 6: K to end. (0 inc) [182]

Rnd 7: *K6, m1* to last 2 sts, k2. (30 inc) [212]

Rnd 1: K3 *k3, m1, k4, m1* to last 3 sts, k3.

Rnd 2: K to end. (0 inc) [132]

Rnd 3: K12, m1 *k6, m1* to last 6 sts, k6.

Rnd 4: K to end. (0 inc) [152]

Rnd 5: K8, m1 *k4, m1* to last 4 sts, k4. (36 inc) [188]

Rnd 6: K to end. (0 inc) [188]

Rnd 7: K9, m1 *k5, m1* to last 4 sts, k4.

Rnd 5: *K4, m1* to end of rnd. (40 inc) [200]

Rnd 7: *K5, m1* to end of rnd. (40 inc) [240]

Rnd 1: K6 *k3, m1, k4, m1* to last 6 sts, k6

Rnd 2: K to end. (0 inc) [138]

Rnd 3: K9, m1 *k5, m1* to last 4 sts, k4. (26 inc) [164]

Rnd 4: K to end. (0 inc) [164]

Rnd 5: K7, m1 *K5, m1* to last 2 sts, k2. (32 inc) [196]

Rnd 6: K to end. (0 inc) [196]

Rnd 7: *K6, m1* to last 4 sts, k4. (32 inc) [228]

Rnd 8: K to end. (0 inc) [228]

Rnd 9: K9, m1 *K7, m1* to last 2 sts, k2.

(32 inc) [260]

SIZE 9

Rnd 1: K6 *k3, m1, k4, m1* to last 6 sts, k6

(28 inc) [138]

Rnd 2: K to end. (0 inc) [138]

Rnd 3: K9, m1 *k4, m1* to last 5 sts, k5. (32 inc) [170]

Rnd 4: K to end. (0 inc) [170]

Rnd 5: *K5, m1* to end of rnd. (34 inc) [204]

Rnd 6: K to end. (0 inc) [204]

Rnd 7: *K6, m1* to end of rnd. (34 inc) [238]

Rnd 8: K to end. (0 inc) [238]

Rnd 9: K11, m1 *K6, m1* to last 5 sts, k5.

(38 inc) [276]

SIZE 10

Rnd 1: K4 *k3, m1, k4, m1* to last 5 sts, k5

(30 inc) [144]

Rnd 2: K to end. (0 inc) [144]

Rnd 3: *K6, m1* to end of rnd. (24 inc) [168]

Rnd 4: K to end. (0 inc) [168]

Rnd 5: K8, m1 *k4, m1* to last 4 sts, k4.

(40 inc) [208]

Rnd 6: K to end. (0 inc) [208]

Rnd 7: K9, m1 *K5, m1* to last 4 sts, k4.



STITCH COUNT AFTER INCREASES

After rnd 2, you should have:

180 (195, 215, 240) 265, 280 [300, 325, 345] 360 sts.

After rnd 6, you should have:

216 (234, 258, 288) 318, 336 [360, 390, 414] 432 sts.

After rnd 10, you should have:

252 (273, 301, 336) 371, 392 [420, 455, 483] 504 sts.

After rnd 13, you should have:

288 (312, 344, 384) 424, 448 [480, 520, 552] 576 sts.

After rnd 31, you should have:

324 (351, 387, 432) 477, 504 [540, 585, 621] 648 sts.

After rnd 38, you should have:

360 (390, 430, 480) 530, 560 [600, 650, 690] 720
sts.

SEPARATION OF SLEEVES

K the first 103 (117, 131, 147) 161, 171 [186, 199, 216]
230 sts for back of body.

Place the next 77 (78, 84, 93) 104, 109 [114, 126, 129]
130 sts on stitch holder or scrap yarn for sleeve a.

Backwards loop cast-on 11 (12, 12, 13) 14, 15 [16, 18,
19] 20 sts for underarm.

Repeat for front, sleeve b and second underarm
over remaining sts.

Pm to mark bor. The bor should be on the back of
your left shoulder.

You should have 228 (258, 286, 320) 350, 372 [404,
434, 470] 500 sts on needles.

CHEST SHORT ROW SHAPING - OPTIONAL

If you have a bigger chest circumference or prefer a fit with more room around your chest area, knit the following section.

SR1 (rs): k 217 (246, 274, 307) 336, 357 [388, 416, 451] 480, w&t.

SR2 (ws): p 103 (117, 131, 147) 161, 171 [186, 199, 216] 230, w&t.

SR3 (rs): k 98 (112, 126, 142) 156, 166 [181, 194, 221] 225, w&t.

SR4 (ws): p 93 (107, 121, 137) 151, 161 [176, 189, 206] 220, w&t.

SR5 (rs): k 88 (102, 116, 132) 146, 156 [171, 184, 201] 215, w&t.

SR6 (ws): p 83 (97, 111, 127) 141, 151 [166, 179, 196] 210, w&t.

SR7 (rs): k 79 (92, 106, 122) 136, 146 [161, 174, 181] 205, w&t.

SR8 (ws): p 73 (87, 101, 117) 131, 141 [156, 169, 186] 200, w&t.

SR9 (rs): k - (-, -, 112) 126, 136 [151, 164, 181] 195, w&t.

SR10 (ws): p - (-, -, 107) 121, 131 [146, 159, 176] 190, w&t.

SR11 (rs): k - (-, -, -) -, - [-, 154, 171] 185, w&t.

SR12 (ws): p - (-, -, -) -, - [-, 149, 166] 180, w&t.

Work in stockinette stitch (k all sts), picking up the wraps as you go. Knit an additional round, picking up remaining wraps and knit them together with the wrapped stitches as you go.

BODY

There are two options for body length - cropped or regular. If you are shorter or prefer a slightly cropped jumper, knit the section below labelled "cropped body". If you are taller or prefer a longer jumper, knit the section below labelled "regular body". Continue in stockinette stitch (k all stitches) until work measures:

CROPPED BODY

15.5 (15.5, 15.5, 15.5) 15.5, 15.5 [15.5, 15.5, 15.5] 15.5 cm /
6 (6, 6, 6) 6, 6 [6, 6, 6] 6" from underarm.

REGULAR BODY

28 (30.5, 33, 35.5) 38.5, 41 [42, 44, 44] 46cm /
11 (12, 13, 14) 15¼, 16¼ [16½, 17¼, 17¼] 18" from underarm.



HEM

Set up rnd: * With MC, k1, with CC1, k1, rep from * around.

Rnd 1: * With MC, k1, with CC1, p1, rep from * around. Rep rnd 1 until collar measures 5cm/2".

Bind off loosely.

SLEEVE

Transfer held stitches from stitch holder/scrap yarn onto longer needle for magic loop knitting, pick up an additional 11 (12, 12, 13) 14, 15 [16, 18, 19] 20 sts from underarm.

K the next 83 (84, 90, 100) 111, 117 [122, 135, 139] 140 sts, pm to mark bor.

You should have a total of 88 (90, 96, 106) 118, 124 [130, 144, 148] 150 sts.

SLEEVE LENGTHS

There are two sleeve length options - a shorter version (bracelet) and a longer version (full). Continue to your preferred length section.

SHORTER SLEEVE - BRACELET

Rnd 1: Using mc, k all sts to end of rnd.

Dec rnd: *k1, ssk, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1* (2 sts dec'd).

Work the dec rnd every

8 (9, 7, 6) 5, 4 [4, 3, 3] 3 rnds for a total of 13 (13, 16, 20) 24, 27 [30, 37, 39] 38 times.

After your final decrease, you should have 62 (64, 64, 66) 70, 70 [70, 70, 70] 74 sts.

Continue in stockinette stitch (k all sts) until sleeve measures 44.5 (44.5, 44.5, 46) 46, 47 [47, 48.5, 48.5] 48.5 cm / 17¼ (17½, 17½, 18) 18, 18½ [18½, 19, 19] 19 " from underarm.

Continue to cuff section.

LONGER SLEEVE - FULL

Rnd 1: Using mc, k all sts to end of rnd.

Dec rnd: *k1, ssk, k to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1* (2 sts dec'd).

Work the dec rnd every

9 (9, 7, 6) 5, 5 [4, 3, 3] 3 rnds for a total of 13 (13, 16, 20) 24, 27 [30, 37, 39] 38 times.

After your final decrease, you should have 62 (64, 64, 66) 70, 70 [70, 70, 70] 74 sts.

Continue in stockinette stitch (k all sts) until sleeve measures 45.5 (46.5, 47, 48.5) 51, 52 [53.5, 53.5, 54.5] 55 cm / 18 (18¼, 18½, 19) 20, 20½ [21, 21, 21½] 21¾ " from underarm.

Continue to cuff section.

CUFF

Set up rnd: * With MC, k1, with CC1, k1, rep from * around.

Rnd 1: * With MC, k1, with CC1, p1, rep from * around. Rep rnd 1 until collar measures 5cm/2".

Bind off loosely.

FINISHING

Weave in all ends. Wet block to measurements.
