# The Til

Designed by Lisa Di Fruscia for Sonder Yarn Co.



**THE TIL\*** is a beautiful and versatile accessory created by knitting two elongated triangles in modular fashion. After knitting the first one, the second one is attached to the first as you go. There are no short rows in this pattern, just simple increases and decreases and a clever joining technique. When finished, fold the shawl along the center seam and decide which colour you're in the mood to wear forward that day!

## Yarn

**Sunday Morning 4 Ply (75% Bluefaced Leicester, 25% Masham);**  
395 m (432 y) / 100 g  
2 skeins (C1), shown in 'Under the Duvet'  
2 skeins (C2), shown in 'Fresh Sheets'

## Needles

- Size 4 mm (US 6) 60 cm / 24" circular needles - or size needed to obtain gauge

## Notions

- Blocking wires and pins - optional

## Gauge

24 sts and 49 rows = 10 cm / 4" in garter after wet blocking

## Dimensions

206 cm x 84 cm (81" x 33")

## Abbreviations:

C1: colour 1  
C2: colour 2  
CO: cast on  
k: knit  
k2tog: knit two stitches together (decrease)  
kfb: knit into the front then the back of the same stitch (increase)  
ktbl: knit through the back loop  
LH: left-hand  
RH: right-hand  
RS: right side  
sl1pwyif: slip stitch purlwise with yarn in front  
ssk: slip 2 sts knitwise one at a time, then slip those stitches purlwise back to the left hand needle and knit both stitches together through the back loop (decrease)  
st(s): stitch (es)  
WS: wrong side  
yo: yarn over



## Panel A

With C1, CO 6 sts

### Set-up Rows

Row 1 (RS): knit.

Row 2 (WS): k5, sl1pwyif.

Row 3: ktbl, k to last st, kfb (7 sts).

Row 4: k2, yo, k1, k2tog, k1, sl1pwyif.

### Main Body

Row 1 (RS): ktbl, k to last st, kfb (1 st inc'd).

Row 2 (WS): k2, yo, k to last 4 sts, k2tog, k1, sl1pwyif.

Repeat Rows 1-2 a total of 220 times

Bind off on RS.

**Now that you have completed panel A, you will knit panel B and attach it to panel A as you go.**

The join happens at the beginning of every RS row by inserting the RH needle from front to back into the yo along the LH selvedge edge of the RS of panel A. Please refer to the photographs at right for a step by tutorial on how to join.

**Note that the last photo shows how the tip comes together by sewing in the ends.**

## Panel B

With C2, CO 6 sts

### Set-up Rows

Row 1 (RS): knit.

Row 2 (WS): ktbl, k5.

Row 3: insert RH needle from front to back into first yo, k2, pass selvedge stitch over the 2 sts just knit, yo, k2, ktbl, sl1pwyif (7 sts).

Row 4: ktbl, k to last st, kfb (8 sts).

### Main Body

Row 1 (RS): insert RH needle from front to back into next yo, k2, pass selvedge stitch over the 2 sts just knit, yo, k to last 4 sts, ssk, ktbl, sl1pwyif.

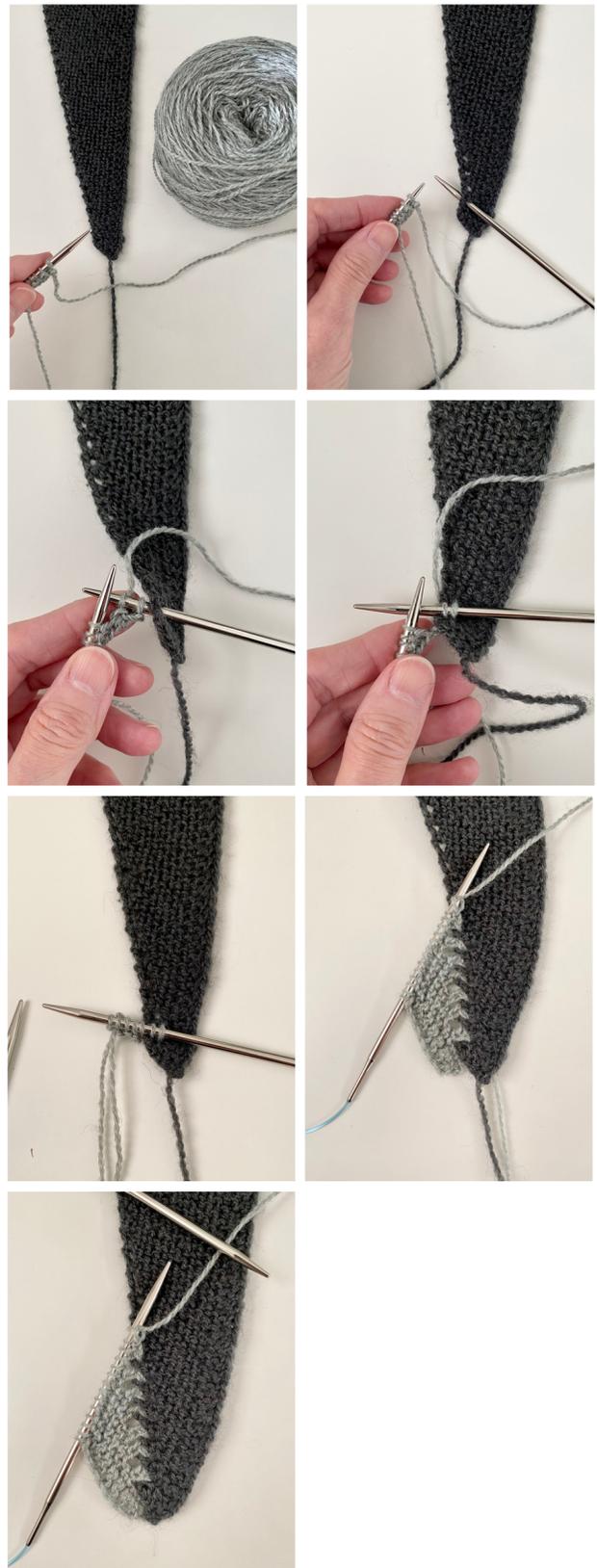
Row 2 (WS): ktbl, k to last st, kfb (1 st inc'd).

Repeat Rows 1-2 a total of 220 times (when all yarn overs have been picked up)

Bind off on RS.

Sew in ends.
