



## EMMA AND SAM

AMIGURUMI CROCHET PATTERN BY TILLYSOME

## MATERIALS AND TOOLS:

- Yarn calling for 2,5 mm (US 1 ½) hook;
- 2.5 mm (US 1 ½) **crochet hook**;
- **2 black safety amigurumi eyes** 6 mm (0.2 inch) for each toy;
- **Soft stuffing**;
- Yarn needle, sewing needle, scissors;
- 10 mm (0.4 inch) **wood button** for Sam's snud.

If you prefer to work continuously, you should use a **stitch marker**.



## NOTE:

You can use this pattern to make larger or smaller toys by using finer or bulkier yarn. Don't forget to choose the right hook size (you can pick crochet hook a size smaller than suggested on your yarn label, so you'll get more tightly fabric). Also, you may need to adjust size of the safety eyes.

## YARN:

- Color 1** – White “Jeans” by YarnArt #62  
**Color 2** – Black “Jeans” by YarnArt #28  
**Color 3** – Light Pink “Jeans” by YarnArt #18  
**Color 4** – Pink “Jeans” by YarnArt #20  
**Color 5** – Mint “Baby Cotton” by Gazzal #3452

**I used sport (5 ply) cotton and acrylic blend.**

You can choose other yarns and colors to make different accessories for Emma and Sam. Yellows, greys, reds and greens – any color that you like ;)

## ABBREVIATIONS:

**ch** = chain(s)

**rnd(s)** = round(s)

**sc** = single crochet

**dc** = double crochet

**sl st** = slip stitch

**tog** = together

**blo** = back loop only

**flo** = front loop only

**sc2tog** = sc next 2 stitches together

**[ ] × ...** repeat instructions in brackets

= ... times

**(...)** total amount of stitches in round

## IMPORTANT:

Emma and Sam are both made by using ONE pattern, which is below. You will find patterns for accessories right after the main pattern.

## HEAD:

### Color 1

*Start with the magic ring*

- 1 rnd:** 6 sc into the magic ring (6)
- 2 rnd:** 2 sc in each next sc (12)
- 3 rnd:** [1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] × 6 (18)
- 4 rnd:** [1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] × 6 (24)
- 5 rnd:** [1 sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc] × 6 (30)
- 6 rnd:** [1 sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc] × 6 (36)
- 7 rnd:** [1 sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc] × 6 (42)
- 8 rnd:** [1 sc in next 6 sc, 2 sc in next sc] × 6 (48)
- 9 rnd:** [1 sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc] × 6 (54)
- 10 rnd:** [1 sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc] × 6 (60)
- 11–17 rnds:** 1 sc in each next sc (60) – 7 rnds total
- 18 rnd:** [1 sc in next 8 sc, sc2tog] × 6 (54)
- 19 rnd:** [1 sc in next 7 sc, sc2tog] × 6 (48)
- 20 rnd:** [1 sc in next 6 sc, sc2tog] × 6 (42)
- 21 rnd:** [1 sc in next 5 sc, sc2tog] × 6 (36)
- 22 rnd:** [1 sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog] × 6 (30)

Stuff the Head.

**Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.**



## EARS × 2:

### Color 2

*Start with the magic ring*

- 1 rnd:** 6 sc into the magic ring (6)
- 2 rnd:** 2 sc in each next sc (12)
- 3 rnd:** [1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] × 6 (18)
- 4 rnd:** [1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc] × 6 (24)
- 5–7 rnds:** 1 sc in each next sc (24) – 3 rnds total

**Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.**



## EYE SPOTS × 2:

### Color 2

Start an oval piece with foundation chain of 5 ch

**1 rnd:** 1 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 1 sc in next 2 ch, 3 sc in the last ch, *rotate the piece so that you can work back down foundation chain*, 1 sc in next 2 ch, 2 sc in the same ch as the very first sc (10)

**2 rnd:** 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next 3 sc, 1 sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next 2 sc (16)

**3 rnd:** 1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 2 sc, [1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] × 3, 1 sc in next 2 sc, [1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] × 2 (22)

Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.



## FINISHING THE HEAD:



**1. Make a nose** as it shown at the pictures. Do 3 stitches between rnds 16 and 17 (in a distance about 2-3 sc between them) and 1 stitch down to 19-20 rnds. Fasten off and weave in tail.



2. Insert the safety eyes into the Eye Spots as it shown at the picture. Then place the Eye Spots on the Head near the Nose inserting the safety eyes into the Head (I insert them between rnds 14 and 15 of the Head). Use pins to choose the tilt angle of the Eye Spots. Sew them to the Head. Clip the safety eyes on the inside of your work. Fasten off and weave in tails.



3. Place the Ears on the Head: centered between rounds 7 and 17 of the Head. Sew them. Fasten off and weave in tails.



## LEGS × 2:

### Color 2

*Start with the magic ring*

- 1 rnd:** 6 sc into the magic ring (6)
- 2 rnd:** 2 sc in each next sc (12)
- 3 rnd:** [1 sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc] × 3 (15)
- 4 rnd:** 1 sc in each next sc (15)
- 5 rnd:** [1 sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc] × 3 (18)
- 6 rnd:** 1 sc in each next sc (18)
- 7 rnd:** [1 sc in next 5 sc, 2 sc in next sc] × 3 (21)
- 8 rnd:** 1 sc in each next sc (21)



Fasten off and weave in tail **ONLY FOR ONE LEG**. After you finish the second leg, don't fasten off – continue as the Body.

## BODY:

### Color 2, Color 1

*Start count from the Legs, so the 1st rnd of the Body is 9th rnd.*

*Don't forget to stuff the Body in time.*

- 9 rnd:** with 2nd leg on your hook, do 3 ch (pic. 1) and star this rnd into the 1st one (pic. 2)
- Do 21 sc around the 1st leg, 1 sc in each of next 3 ch (blo) (pic. 3) Then do 21 sc around the 2nd leg and 1 sc in each next 3 ch (flo) (pic. 4) (SC 48)

*Further continue in spiral as usual.*

- 10 rnd:** [1 sc in next 7 sc, 2 sc in next sc] × 6 (54)
- 11 rnd:** 1 sc in each next sc (54)
- 12 rnd:** [1 sc in next 8 sc, 2 sc in next sc] × 6 (60)

*Join Color 1*

- 13–17 rnds:** 1 sc in each next sc (60) – 5 rnds total
- 18 rnd:** [1 sc in next 8 sc, sc2tog] × 6 (54)
- 19 rnd:** 1 sc in each next sc (54)
- 20 rnd:** [1 sc in next 7 sc, sc2tog] × 6 (48)
- 21 rnd:** 1 sc in each next sc (48)



**22 rnd:** [1 sc in next 6 sc, sc2tog] × 6 (42)  
**23–25 rnds:** 1 sc in each next sc (42) – 3 rnds total  
**26 rnd:** [1 sc in next 5 sc, sc2tog] × 6 (36)  
**27–29 rnds:** 1 sc in each next sc (36) – 3 rnds total

*Join Color 2*

**30 rnd:** [1 sc in next 4 sc, sc2tog] × 6 (30)  
**31–32 rnds:** 1 sc in each next sc (30) – 2 rnds total

**Fasten off and weave in tail.**

**For Sam:** with Color 2 do 2 stitches crosswise to make a belly button (centered on 16th rnd).

**Fasten off and weave in tail.**



## ARMS × 2:

### Color 2

*Start with the magic ring*

**1 rnd:** 6 sc into the magic ring (6)  
**2 rnd:** 2 sc in each next sc (12)  
**3 rnd:** [1 sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc] × 3 (15)  
**4–11 rnds:** 1 sc in each next sc (15) – 8 rnds total

Here you should stuff the arms (*stuff them, gradually reducing the stuffing density from the bottom up*)

**12 rnd:** [1 sc in next 3 sc, sc2tog] × 3 (12)  
**13–16 rnds:** 1 sc in each next sc (12) – 4 rnds total

After you finish, fold both sides of the arm's open end together aligning the stitches side by side and sc tog the 2 opposed st (sc 6)

**Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.**



## TAIL:

### Color 2

*Start with the magic ring*

**1 rnd:** 6 sc into the magic ring (6)

**2 rnd:** 2 sc in each next sc (12)

**3 rnd:** [1 sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc] × 6 (18)

**4–6 rnds:** 1 sc in each next sc (18) – 3 rnds total

Stuff the Tail a little.

**Fasten off and leave a long tail for sewing.**



## FINISHING:



1. Sew the Head to the Body.
2. Sew the Arms on both sides of the Body.
3. Sew the Tail to the Body (centered between rnds 11 and 15 of the Body).

**CONGRATS!**  
**YOU FINISHED THE TOY!**

## SCARF:

### Color 5

*Start with foundation chain of 6 ch*

**1 rnd:** 1 sc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook,  
1 sc in next 4 ch, turn.


**2 rnd:** 1 ch (here and further doesn't count as 1<sup>st</sup> sc), 1 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 3 sc (blo),  
1 sc in the last sc (both loops), turn (5)

**3–120 rnds:** as 2<sup>nd</sup> rnd

I made 120 rnds to wrap a scarf around the neck twice, but you could adjust length of the scarf on your taste.

After you finish, fold both ends together aligning the stitches side by side and sl st them together.

Fasten off and weave in tails.  
Sew the wood button to the scarf.



## FLOWER:

### Color 3, Color 4

*Leave a long tail at the beginning and start with the magic ring with Color 4*

**1 rnd:** 6 sc into the magic ring

*Join Color 3 (leave a long tail of this color too)*

**2 rnd:** sl st to the 1<sup>st</sup> sc, 2 ch, 3dc in the same sc,  
2 ch, sl st in the same sc,  
[sl st in the next sc, 2 ch, 3dc in the same sc,  
2 ch, sl st in the same sc] x 5

Fasten off. Tie a knot on each of 3 out of 4 long tails that you got (in about 2-3 inches from the flower) and cut the tails close to the knots. Sew the Flower on the Head with one leftover tail.



## SKIRT:

### Color 3, Color 4

With Color 3 start with foundation chain of 61 ch.  
Join it with a sl st to form a ring

**1 rnd:** 1 ch, 1 sc in each of next 60 ch.

Join with a sl st.

**2 rnd:** 1 ch, 1 sc in each of next 60 sc.

Join with a sl st.

**3 rnd:** as 2<sup>nd</sup>, but in front loop only.

Join with a sl st.

**4 rnd:** 1 ch, 1 sc in next sc, skip 1 sc,  
5 dc in next sc, skip 1 sc,  
[1 sc in next sc, skip 1 sc, 5 dc in next sc,  
skip 1 sc] × 14.

Join with a sl st.

Fasten off and weave in Color 3.

Join Color 4 to the 2<sup>nd</sup> rnd

**5 rnd:** 1 ch, 1 sc in each of next 60 sc (in back loop only). Join with a sl st.

**6–7 rnds:** 1 ch, 1 sc in each of next 60 sc.

Join with a sl st.

**8 rnd:** as 4<sup>th</sup> rnd

1 ch, 1 sc in next sc, skip 1 sc,

5 dc in next sc, skip 1 sc,

[1 sc in next sc, skip 1 sc, 5 dc in next sc,  
skip 1 sc] × 14.

Join with a sl st.

Fasten off and weave in tails.

You could sew the Skirt to the Body, if needed.
