Sample is shown in size 1 with 23 cm positive ease at the bust.

PREPARATION

Size

1(2)3(4)

Yarn

Aran weight

Brushmere from Cardiff Cashmere (100% Cashmere goat, 44 meters / 25 grams)

16(18)19(21) balls / 670(770)800(890) meters / 380(438)455(505) grams

Needles

5 / 4 mm (US 8 / 6) a circular needle and a short tip needle (or longer if magic loop technique is used) or Double-Pointed Needles.

Gauge

16.5 sts x 21 rows / 10 x 10 cm in 5 mm (US 8) needle, with pattern (after wash)

Notions

Stitch markers, stitch holders, waste yarn or extra cable needle, 4(4)4(5) buttons(2 cm), tapestry needle

Abbreviations

k: Knit

p: Purl

(-) rep: Repeat from (to)

st(s): Stitches

(m)m: (main) marker

s(m)m: Slip (main) marker

p(m)m : Place (main) marker

r(m)m : Remove (main) marker

K2tog : Knit 2 sts together

P2tog : Purl 2 sts together

ssk : slip slip knit 2 together

yo : yarn over

Sl1wyb : Slip 1 st with yarn in back

Sl1wyf : Slip 1 st with yarn in front

RS: Right Side of your work

WS: Wrong Side of your work

Note

This pattern is a written pattern with charts. The charts are attached in A4 size version, and you can view them by enlarging them on the device or by enlarging and printing them.

Tuileries Cardigan is a V-neck knit with an airy, lace-like texture. With its repeating simple pattern and classic design, it is enjoyable to knit and will become a go-to piece in your wardrobe after completion.

It is constructed using the top-down method with an all-over lace pattern. You will first knit the neckband, then pick up stitches to knit the back panel flat down to the underarm. For the front panels, stitches are picked up separately from each shoulder while shaping the neckline. After joining the front and back panels at the underarm, the body is worked flat, and the sleeves are knitted in the round, maintaining the pattern while picking up stitches from the armhole. Finally, buttons are attached to complete the cardigan.

Technique

Reading Charts

When working on the right side, follow the chart from right to left, and when working on the wrong side, follow the chart from left to right, making sure to understand the symbols on RS and WS

Work in pattern : maintain the Tuileries pattern (12 sts, 2 rows) and the band pattern.

M1R : Insert left hand needle from back to front under the bar between the sts and K this bar

M1L : Insert left hand needle from front to back under bar and K1tbl this bar

M1RP : Insert the left hand needle from front to back bar between the sts and Ptbl this bar

M1LP : Insert the left hand needle from back to front, under the bar between the sts and P this bar

PATTERN

NECKBAND

Right Neckband

Using 5 mm (US 8) needles, CO 9 sts using a Longtail cast-on method.

Setup Row (WS) P2, (k1, p1) rep 3 times, p1

Row 1 (RS) K1, (k1, p1) rep 3 times, k2

Row 2 (WS) Sl1wyf, (p1, k1) rep 3 times, p2

Repeat Rows 1-2 until Row 25(25)25(33) or the neckband measures 12(12)12(16) cm (4.7(4.7)4.7(6.3) "), ending on a RS row.

Cut yarn and place all sts on a stitch holder.

Left Neckband

Using 5 mm (US 8) needles, with RS facing, pick up and knit 9 sts along the edge where the right neckband was cast on.

Setup Row (WS) P2, (k1, p1) rep 3 times, p1

Row 1 (RS) Sl1wyb, (k1, p1) rep 3 times, k2

Row 2 (WS) P2, (k1, p1) rep 3 times, p1

Repeat Rows 1-2 until Row 25(25)25(33) or the neckband measures 12(12)12(16) cm (4.7(4.7)4.7(6.3) "), ending on a RS row.

Cut yarn and place all sts on a stitch holder.

BACK

With the RS facing, place the left neckband on the right side and the right neckband on the left side. The slipped edge should be at the bottom. Using new yarn, pick up and knit 41(41)41(53) sts along the top edge of the piece. Turn the work.

Setup Row (WS) Work the Back Chart setup row.

Work Back Chart from Row 1 (RS) to 21(25)33(31) (RS). Cut the yarn.

Increase Row completed. A total of 42(50)66(62) sts increased.

There are now 83(91)107(115) sts on the needle.

Row 22(26)34(32) (WS) Place 6 sts on a stitch holder, work Back Chart Rows 22(26)34(32) to before last 6 sts, then place the last 6 sts on a stitch holder.

There are now 71(79)95(103) sts on the needle and 12 sts (6 on each side) on stitch holders.

Starting from Back Chart Row 23(27)35(33) (RS), work until Row 46(60)62(70) (WS).

Place all live sts on waste yarn, then cut the yarn.

FRONT

Right Front Panel

With RS facing, position the neckband at the top. Pick up and knit 20(24)32(29) sts from right shoulder. Cut the yarn. Transfer right neckband 9 sts onto the needle. Turn the work.

Setup Row (WS) Work 8 band sts as follows: Sl1wyf, p1, k1, p1, k1, p1, k1, p1, then work Right Front Chart setup row.

Row 1 (RS) Work Row 1 of Right Front Chart, then work 8 band sts as follows: k1, p1, k1, p1, k1, p1, k2.

PATTERN

Continue working Right Front Chart while maintaining the band pattern until Row 40(48)48(60) (WS).

For size 1 only
Cut the yarn.

For size (2)3(4) only
Make the first buttonhole.

Row (49)49(61) (RS) Work in pattern until 5 sts remain, yo, k2tog, p1, k2.

Row (50)50(62) (WS) Work 8 band sts, work Row (50)50(62) of Right Front Chart.

Cut the yarn.

Left Front Panel

Transfer left neckband 9 sts onto the needle, then Pick up and knit 20(24)32(29) sts from left shoulder. Turn the work.

Setup Row (WS) Work Left Front Chart setup row, then work 8 band sts as follows: p1, k1, p1, k1, p1, k1, p2.

Row 1 (RS) Work 8 band sts as follows: Sl1wyb, k1, p1, k1, p1, k1, p1, k1, then work Row 1 of the Left Front Chart.

Continue working Left Front Chart while maintaining the band pattern until Row 40(50)50(62) (WS).

JOINING FRONTS AND BACK PANELS

Work Row 41(51)51(63) of Left Front Chart, backward loop cast on 5(1)5(1) sts. Continue working Row 47(61)63(71) of Back Chart, backward loop cast on 5(1)5(1) sts. Finally, work Row 41(51)51(63) of Right Front Chart.

BODY

Maintain the band and Tuileries pattern (12 sts, 2-row repeat) while evenly spacing the buttonholes. Continue knitting the body from the underarm until it measures 21(21)21(28) cm (8.3(8.3)8.3(11)"), or 7 cm (2.8") shorter than the desired length.

Buttonholes

Work 4(4)4(5) buttonholes evenly, starting from Row 49(49)49(61) and every 17(17)17(19) rows or 7.6(7.6)7.6(8.6) cm (3(3)3(3.4)") apart as follow :

For Sizes 1(2)3

On Rows 49, 65, 81, 97 (RS), work in pattern until 5 sts remain, then yo, k2tog, p1, k2.

For Size 4

On Rows 61, 79, 97, 115, 133 (RS), work in pattern until 5 sts remain, then yo, k2tog, p1, k2.

Ribbing

Switch to 4 mm (US 6) needles.

Setup Row (RS) Work 8 band sts, p2tog, k1, p1, k1, p2tog, (k1, p1, k1, p1, k1, p2tog, k1, p1, k1, p2tog) rep until 8 sts remain, work 8 band sts.

Ribbing Row (WS) Sl1wyf, (p1, k1) rep until 2 sts remain, p2.

Ribbing Row (RS) Sl1wyb, (k1, p1) rep until 2 sts remain, k2.

Repeat these two rows until the ribbing measures 7 cm (2.8") or 18 rows in total. Cut the yarn and bind off all stitches using the tubular bind-off method.

PATTERN

SLEEVES

Left Sleeve

Using 5 mm (US 8) needles, pick up stitches from the left armhole as follows: 5(1)2(0) sts at the underarm, 30(38)38(47) sts from the front panel, without cutting the yarn, transfer 6 sts from the shoulder onto the needle, 19(27)23(30) sts from the back panel, 0(0)3(1) sts at the underarm. Total: 60(72)72(84) sts

Right Sleeve

Using 5 mm (US 8) needles, pick up stitches from the right armhole as follows: 5(0)3(1) sts at the underarm, 19(27)23(30) sts from the back panel, without cutting the yarn, transfer 6 sts from the shoulder onto the needle, 30(38)38(47) sts from the front panel, 0(1)2(0) sts at the underarm. Total: 60(72)72(84) sts

For Both Sleeves

Pm and begin knitting in the round. Without a setup row, follow the sleeve chart, knitting until the sleeve reaches 38 cm (15") or 7 cm (2.8") shorter than the desired length.

Ribbing

Switch to 4 mm (US 6) needles.

Setup Row sm, (k1, p1, k1, p1, k1, p2tog, k1, p1, k1, p2tog) rep until m.

Total decrease: 10(12)12(14) sts → Remaining: 50(60)60(70) sts

Ribbing Row sm, (k1, p1) rep to m.

Work 18 rows or until the ribbing measures 7 cm (2.8").

Cut the yarn and bind off all stitches using the tubular bind-off method.


FINISHING

Weave in all ends and sew buttons after wash



SIZE 1 SLEEVES CHART


