## TUKU HONEY

### DETAILS

I wanted the perfect socks to wear with my favorite boots! These socks hit just above the ankle, perfect for chelsea style boots. The sweet garter panel framed by honeycomb cables makes for an addictive little knit! They are my go to travel knit, and I hope you love them just as much as I do!



#### SIZES

1, 2, 3



#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

7 (8, 9)"/18 (20.5, 23) cm foot circumference

*Recommended fit is 0.5 to 1"/1 to 2.5 cm of negative ease in circumference (when measured at the widest part of the foot) and 15% negative ease in length.*



#### YARN

295 (335, 410) m/75 (85, 105) g Fingering weight

*I found that Tuku Wool knits up heavier than some of the popular, super-wash sock yarns. Make sure you can achieve the intended gauge with your yarn of choice before proceeding with the pattern. Opt for heavier fingering weight yarns for the best results.*



#### SUGGESTED YARN

Tukuwool Fingering (195 m/50 g) - 2 (2, 3) skeins H28 Ujo (Pink sample) or H22 Valo (Yellow Sample)



#### SUGGESTED NEEDLES

Main Fabric: US 1.5 /2.5 mm – 32" / 81cm circular for Magic Loop  
Ribbing: US 0/2 mm – 32" / 81cm circular for Magic Loop  
*(Use the needle size you need to achieve gauge.)*



#### NOTIONS

Removable/clip marker, tapestry needle, scissors, cable needle and a row counter (recommended).



#### GAUGE

32 sts & 42 rows = 4" / 10cm

*Worked over reverse stockinette stitch in the round & blocked.*



## TUKU HONEY

### NOTES

- Sample socks are size 2 modeled on an 8.5" circumference foot.
- These socks are worked from the toe up using the Magic Loop method, with a Fleegle Heel.
- While working in the Magic Loop method, the needles will be referred to as Top needle (TN) and Bottom needle (BN).
- It is not necessary to use a cable needle for the small cables of this sock if you don't want to! Here is a video tutorial for how I do it: [https://youtu.be/uA\\_YoPOk6fE](https://youtu.be/uA_YoPOk6fE)

## TUKU HONEY

### GLOSSARY

**BN** - Bottom needle

**BO** - Bind off

**BOR** - Beginning of round

**C2B** - Slip 1 st to CN & hold it to the back, knit the next st, knit the st from the CN.

**C2F** - Slip 1 st to CN & hold it to the front, knit the next st, knit the st from the CN.

**CN** - Cable needle

**CO** - Cast on

**DEC/'D** - Decrease/d

**INC/'D** - Increase/d

**K** - Knit

**K2TOG** - Knit 2 sts together as one. (1 st dec'd)

**M1L** - Make 1 Left: pick up the bar between the stitch you knit (purl) and the one you're about to knit (purl), bringing the needle from front to back. Knit (purl) thru the back of this stitch.

**M1R** - Make 1 Right: pick up the bar between the last stitch you knit (purl) and the one you're about to knit (purl), bringing the needle from the back to the front. Knit (purl) thru the front of this stitch.

**P** - Purl

**P2TOG** - Purl 2 sts together as one. (1 st dec'd)

**PM** - Place marker

**RND** - Round

**RS** - Right side

**SI** - Slip stitch purlwise

**SSP** - Slip the next two stitches, one at a time, from the left knitting needle to the right knitting needle as if to knit. Slip these stitches back to the left knitting needle keeping them twisted. Purl these two stitches together through their back loops.

**ST/S** - Stitch/es

**TN** - Top Needle

**WS** - Wrong side

**WYIF** - With yarn in front

**WYIB** - With yarn in back



## TUKU HONEY

### — DIRECTIONS —

#### TOE

Using larger needles and the Turkish Cast On method (see Notes section for tutorial), cast on 24 (28, 32) stitches (12 (14, 16) stitches on each needle). Clip removable marker to indicate BOR.

**Rnd 1:** Knit.

**Rnd 2 (INC):** \*K1, M1R, knit to the last st on this needle, M1L, k1; repeat from \* once more on BN. [4 sts inc'd]

**Repeat [Rnds 1 & 2]** a further 7 (8, 9) times.

32 (36, 40) sts inc'd; 56 (64, 72) total sts.

Knit 2 rounds.

#### FOOT

**Rnd 1:** TN - P5 (7, 9), k4, p10, k4, p5 (7, 9).  
BN - Purl.

**Rnd 2:** TN - P5 (7, 9), C2B, C2F, p1, k8, p1,  
C2B, C2F, P5 (7, 9).  
BN - Purl.

**Rnd 3:** Repeat Rnd 1.

**Rnd 4:** TN - P5 (7, 9), C2F, C2B, p1, k8, p1,  
C2F, C2B, P5 (7, 9).  
BN - Purl.

**Repeat [Rnds 1-4]** until Foot measures 2.5 (2.75, 3.25)"/6.5 (7, 8) cm less than the desired foot length from toe to heel.

#### HEEL GUSSET

*The 4-row pattern established in the Foot section will continue up the TN as the heel shaping is worked on the BN.*

**Rnd 1:** TN - Work in established pattern.

BN (INC) - P1, M1R p-wise, purl to last st, M1L p-wise, p1. [2 sts inc'd]

**Rnd 2:** TN - Work in established pattern.  
BN - Purl.

**Repeat [Rnds 1 and 2]** a further 12 (14, 16) times.

26 (30, 34) sts inc'd; 54 (62, 70) sts on BN. The number of sts on TN will not have changed.

#### HEEL TURN

Work across TN in established pattern.

*The remainder of the Heel will be worked flat, on the RS and WS of the Heel, beginning with the RS of BN facing.*

**Row 1 (RS):** P29 (33, 37), p2tog, p1. Turn. [1 st dec'd]

**Row 2 (WS):** Sl 1, k5, k2tog, k1. Turn. [1 st dec'd]

**Row 3:** Sl 1, purl to 1 st before gap, ssp across gap, p1. Turn. [1 st dec'd]

**Row 4:** Sl 1, knit to 1 st before gap, k2tog across gap, k1. Turn. [1 st dec'd]

**Repeat [Rows 3 and 4]** a further 9 (11, 13) times.

**Repeat [Row 3]** once.

23 (27, 31) sts dec'd; 31 (35, 39) sts remain on BN.

Do NOT turn work to WS.

Resume working in the round.



## TUKU HONEY

### — DIRECTIONS —

#### HEEL FINISHING

*These final 2 rounds of decreases worked in this manner will remove any chance of holes at the top of the gusset.*

**Rnd 1:** TN - Work in established pattern.

BN - p1, p2tog, purl to last 2 sts,  
ssp. [2 sts dec'd]

**Rnd 2:** TN - Work in established pattern.

BN - P2tog, purl to end. [1 st dec]  
56 (64, 72) total sts; 28 (32, 36) sts per  
needle.

#### LEG

*Return to working in the established pattern across TN, and purling across BN.*

Work even until the Leg, measured from the top of the gusset, measures approx. 4"/10 cm.

**Inc Round:** TN - Work in established

pattern.

BN - M1L p-wise, purl to the  
end, M1R p-wise. [2 sts inc'd]

**Repeat [Inc Round]** every 5th round a  
further 2 times.

6 sts inc'd; 62 (70, 78) total sts  
28 (32, 36) sts on TN, 34 (38, 42) sts on  
BN.

Continue working in established pattern  
until the Leg measures approx. 5.5"/14  
cm from the top of the gusset, ending with  
Rnd 4 of the stitch pattern repeat.

#### CUFF

Switch to smaller needles.

**Rnd 1:** \*K1, p1; repeat from \* to end.  
Continue in Rib Pattern for 1.5"/4 cm.

*See notes for Tubular Bind Off Tutorial.*

**Bind Off Setup Rnd 1:** \*K1, sl 1 wyif; re-  
peat from \* to end.

**Bind Off Setup Rnd 2:** \*Sl 1 wyib, p1; re-  
peat from \* to end.


Slip each stitch purlwise, slipping the knit  
stitches onto the working needle and the  
purl stitches onto a spare needle. Break  
yarn, leaving a tail 3 times the length of the  
stitches to be bound off, and BO all stitch-  
es using the Kitchener stitch.

Weave in ends and wet block.
