


Vercors



Notes

A simple and cosy cowl with a woodland inspired texture, Vercors is a quick knit featuring fun elongated stitches in Aran weight yarn. Choose a gradient transition of four shades, a brighter contrast or keep it one colour for a minimalistic look.

Use the hashtag #vercorscowl to share your project.

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Yarn :

Four colours of Aran weight yarn : 60 m – 65 ½ yds each or 240 m – 262 ½ yds total
Sample was knit in Fado Fonty in a gradient of natural shades 664 (C1), 662 (C2), 661 (C3)
and 660 (C4).

Needles :

Main Fabric : 5 mm (US 8) circular needles
Ribbing : 4.5 mm (US 7) circular needles
or sizes required to get gauge

Gauge :

17 stitches x 28 rounds per 10 cm - 4 inches in stockinette stitch after blocking.

Size :

53 cm – 20 ¾ inches circumference
30 cm – 11 ¾ inches tall

Techniques used :

Knitting in the round
Elongated stitches
Slipped stitches
Pattern instructions are written only

Notions :

Stitch markers, tapestry needle and scissors
Row counter recommended

Abbreviations :

- C1 : colour 1 / C2 : colour 2 / C3 : colour 3 / C4 : colour 4
- st : stitch
- rnd : round
- k : knit stitch / p : purl stitch
- pm : place marker
- BOR : beginning of round
- k wp 2(3) times : knit the stitch wrapping the yarn 2 (3) times around the needle
- el.st : elongated stitch
- sl : slip stitch purlwise

Elongated stitches technique :

To make the elongated stitch you will wrap the yarn 2 or 3 times around the needle for each stitch.

For example, k2 wp x times means two elongated stitches, so you need to knit one wrapping the yarn x times, then repeat for the second stitch.

On the next row you will slip this stitch and let all the extra wraps go, making one long stitch.

To form the motif, you will later drop those long stitches and reposition them in a different spot by slipping stitches.

Ribbing :

With C1, cast-on 90 st on smaller needles
Being careful not to twist, join to knit in the round and pm for BOR.

rnd 1 : *k3, p3* to end
Work this ribbing round 6 times total.

Switch to larger needles.
Knit 5 rounds.

Section 1 :

rnd 1 : k2, *k2 wp 2 times, k13* to last 13 st, k2 wp 2 times, k11
rnds 2 to 4 : k2, *sl2, k13* to last 13 st, sl2, k11
rnd 5 : *sl2, drop el.st to front, slip the 2 st back to the left needle, knit el.st, k2, drop el.st to front, k2, knit el.st, k9* to end
rnd 6 : repeat rnd 1
rnds 7 to 9 : repeat rnds 2 to 4
rnd 10 : repeat rnd 5
rnd 11 : k2, *k2 wp 3 times, k13* to last 13 st, k2 wp 3 times, k11

Cut C1 and join C2.

rnds 12 to 16 : k2, *sl2, k13* to last 13 st, sl2, k11
rnd 17 : repeat rnd 5
rnd 18 : knit
rnd 19 : k9, *p2, k13* to last 6 st, p2, k4
rnds 20, 21 : knit
rnd 22 : k3, *p2, k10* to last 3 st, p2, k1
rnd 23 : knit

Section 2 :

rnd 1 : k9, *k2 wp 2 times, k13* to last 6 st, k2 wp 2 times, k4
rnds 2 to 4 : k9, *sl2, k13* to last 6 st, sl2, k4
rnd 5 : k7, *sl2, drop el.st to front, slip the 2 st back to the left needle, knit el.st, k2, drop el.st to front, k2, knit el.st, k9* to last 8 st, sl2, drop el.st to front, slip the 2 st back to the left needle, knit el.st, k2, drop el.st to front, k2, knit el.st
rnd 6 : repeat rnd 1
rnds 7 to 9 : repeat rnds 2 to 4
rnd 10 : repeat rnd 5
rnd 11 : k9, *k2 wp 3 times, k13* to last 6 st, k2 wp 3 times, k4

Cut C2 and join C3.

rnds 12 to 16 : k9, *sl2, k13* to last 6 st, sl2, k4
rnd 17 : repeat rnd 5
rnd 18 : knit
rnd 19 : k2, *p2, k13* to last 13 st, p2, k11
rnds 20, 21 : knit
rnd 22 : k7, *p2, k11* to last 5 st, p2, k3
rnd 23 : knit

Section 3 :

Repeat Section 1, transitionning from C3 to C4.

Knit 4 rounds.

Ribbing :

Switch back to smaller needles.

rnd 1 : *k3, p3* to end
Work this ribbing round 6 times total.

Finishing :

Bind-off loosely in pattern.
Weave in all ends and block gently.
