One adult sized hat

Finished Measurements:

Hat: 23 inches in
circumference unstretched.

Mitts: 7.5 inches in
circumference unstretched and
7.5 inches in length

Materials:

- Cascade Yarns® Elysian;
60% Superwash Merino
Wool / 40% Acrylic;
100 g (3.5 oz) /
219 yds (200 m);
- 2 skeins color #40 (Nickel)
- US 6 (4.0 mm) 16" circular
knitting needle
- US 6 (4.0 mm) double
pointed needles
- Stitch markers
- Cable needle
- Yarn needle
- ½ yard waste yarn
- 3 1" buttons

**Gauge:**

20 sts x 24 rounds = 4" (10 cm) in stockinette stitch

Abbreviations:

BO	= Bind off
CN	= Cable needle
CO	= Cast on
C3B	= (Cable 3 Back) Slip 1 to CN, hold in back, K2, P1 from CN.
C3F	= (Cable 3 Front) Slip 2 to CN, hold in front, P1, K2 from CN.
C4F	= Slip 2 to CN and hold in front, K2, K2 from CN.
K	= Knit
K2tog	= Knit 2 stitches together
M1	= Make 1 stitch
P	= Purl
P2tog	= Purl 2 stitches together
PM	= Place marker
RS	= Right side
SM	= Slip marker
St(s)	= Stitch(es)
WS	= Wrong side

**Band Pattern** (worked flat)

Row 1 (RS) Purl

Row 2: Knit

Row 3 & 4: Purl

Row 5: Knit

Row 6 & 7: Purl

Row 8: Knit

Row 9 & 10: Purl

Row 11: Knit

Row 12 & 13: Purl

Row 14: Knit

Row 15: Purl

Cable Pattern (worked in the round)

Round 1: P5, k4, p5.
 Round 2: P5, c4f, p5.
 Round 3: P5, k4, p5.
 Round 4: P4, c3b, c3f, p4.
 Round 5: P4, k2, p2, k2, p4.
 Round 6: P3, c3b, p2, c3f, p3.
 Round 7: P3, k2, p4, k2, p3.
 Round 8: P2, c3b, p4, c3f, p2.
 Round 9: P2, k2, p6, k2, p2.
 Round 10: P1, c3b, p6, c3f, p1.
 Round 11: P1, k2, p8, k2, p1.
 Round 12: p1, c3f, p6, c3b, p1.
 Round 13: P2, k2, p6, k2, p2.
 Round 14: P2, c3f, p4, c3b, p2.
 Round 15: P3, k2, p4, k2, p3.
 Round 16: P3, c3f, p2, c3b, p3.
 Round 17: P4, k2, p2, k2, p4.
 Round 18: P4, c3f, c3b, p4.

**Hat**

With circular needle, CO 115, then work flat rows 1-14 of the Band Pattern.

BO 15 purlwise, purl to end of row. Place marker and join to work in the round, knit 1 round.

Next round, work in stockinette stitch until 14 stitches remain.

Begin Row 1 of the Cable Pattern on the last 14 stitches of the round. Continue in stockinette stitch and the Cable Pattern until you have completed 18 rows of the Cable Pattern once, then rows 1-16 rows once. The hat should measure 6 inches from the cast on edge.

Crown

Switch to double point needles when necessary.

Round 1: [K18, k2tog] 4 times, k6, p4, k2, p2, k2, p2, p2tog

Round 2: [K17, k2tog] 4 times, k6, p4, c3f, c3b, p1, p2tog.

Round 3: [k16, k2tog] 4 times, k6, p5, k4, p1, p2tog.

Round 4: [k15, k2tog] 4 times, k6, p5, c4f, p2tog.

Round 5 [k14, k2tog] 4 times, k6, p5, k3, k2tog.

Round 6 [K13, k2tog] 4 times, k6, p4, c3b, k2tog.

Round 7 [k12, k2tog] 4 times, k6, p4, k2, k2tog.

Round 8 [k11, k2tog] 4 times, k6, p3, k2, k2tog.

Round 9 [k10, k2tog] 4 times, k6, p3, k1, k2tog.

Round 10 [k9, k2tog] 4 times, k6, p3, k2tog.

Round 11 [k8, k2tog] 4 times, k6, p2, p2tog.

Round 12 [k9, k2tog] 4 times, k6 p1, p2tog.

Round 13 [k8, k2tog] 4 times, k6, p2tog.

Round 14 [k7, k2tog] 5 times.

Round 15 [k6, k2tog] 5 times.

Continue in this manner, working 1 less stitch before the k2tog each round until 10 stitches remain.

[K2tog] 5 times. Cut yarn. With tapestry needle, run yarn through remaining live stitches.

Pull tight and secure.

Finishing

On the inside of the band where the bands overlap, sew the inside band to the outside band with whip stitch, being careful to do so in a manner that won't be seen from the outside of the hat.

Sew a button onto the overlapping portion of the band as both an accent and to secure the overlapping portions of the band.

Left Mitt

With circular needles CO 55 stitches. Work rows 1-14 of Band Pattern. On the next row, p50, BO 15. Cut yarn.

Using double point needles, starting at the end of the band that is not bound of, knit 14 stitches onto the first needle, 14 stitches onto the second needle, and 12 stitches onto the third needle. Join to work in the round. Begin Cable Pattern on the first needle, and stockinette stitch on the second and third needles. Work 9 rounds in Cable Pattern and stockinette stitch.

Thumb Gusset

On the next round, work in pattern on the first and second needles. Work 7 stitches on the third needle, pm for thumb gusset, m1, pm, work in pattern to the end of the round. Work one round in pattern. On the next round work in pattern to the first marker, slip the marker, m1, k1, m1, slip marker, work to end of round. Work m1 increases every other round after the first marker and before the second marker until there are 13 stitches between the markers. Work one round in pattern.

On the next round work in pattern to the first marker, with a tapestry needle place the 13 thumb gusset stitches on waste yarn to hold to work later. Continue in the round, joining to the stitches after the thumb gusset, staying in pattern until the 18 row cable pattern has been completed twice.

Work rows 1 and 2 of cable pattern. Knit one round.



Top Band

Purl 3 rounds, knit 3 rounds, purl 3 rounds, BO purlwise.

Thumb

Transfer stitches on waste yarn on to 2 double point needles. Knit 13. With the third double point needle, pick up 6 stitches evenly along inside edge of mitt to complete the thumb in the round.

Knit 3 rounds, purl 3 rounds, knit 3 rounds, purl 3 rounds. BO purlwise.

Right Mitt

With circular needles CO 55 stitches. Work rows 1-14 of Band Pattern. On the next row, BO 15, P50. Distribute stitches on to 3 double point needles, 12 stitches on one needle adjacent to the bound off stitches and 14 stitches on the other two needles. Join to work in the round. Knit one round. Next round, work the first two needles in stockinette stitch, begin Cable Pattern on the third needle. Work 9 rounds in Cable Pattern and stockinette stitch.

**Thumb Gusset**

On the next round work 5 stitches on the first needle, pm for thumb gusset, m1, pm, work in pattern to the end of the round. Work one round in pattern. On the next round work in pattern to the first marker, slip the marker, m1, k1, m1, slip marker, work to end of round. Work m1 increases every other round after the first marker and before the second marker until there are 13 stitches between the markers. Work one round in pattern. On the next round work in pattern to the first marker, with a tapestry needle place the 13 thumb gusset stitches on waste yarn to hold to work later. Continue in the round, joining to the stitches after the thumb gusset, staying in pattern until the 18 row cable pattern has been completed twice. Work rows 1 and 2 of cable pattern. Knit one round.

Top Band

Purl 3 rounds, knit 3 rounds, purl 3 rounds, BO purlwise.



Thumb

Transfer stitches on waste yarn on to 2 double point needles. Knit 13. With the third double point needle, pick up 6 stitches evenly along inside edge of mitt to complete the thumb in the round. Knit 3 rounds, purl 3 rounds, knit 3 rounds, purl 3 rounds. BO purlwise.

Finishing Both Mitts

On the inside of the band where the bands overlap, sew the inside band to the outside band with whip stitch, being careful to do so in a manner that won't be seen from the outside of the hat. Sew a button onto the overlapping portion of the band as both an accent and to secure the overlapping portions of the band.



Key

- K - Knit
- P - Purl
-  C3b - Sl 1 to cn and hold in back, k2, p1 from cn
-  C3f - Sl 2 to cn and hold in front, p1, k2 from cn
-  C4f - Sl 2 to cn and hold in front, k2, k2 from cn
-  P2tog - Purl 2 together
-  K2tog - Knit 2 together
