

WABBIT



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FINISHED SIZE Approx. 18cm/ 7in tall from top of head to sole of paws

YARN You'll need less than quarter 50g ball of the following yarn, the shade I suggest is written in *italic* but you can substitute with a similar weight yarn if you wish, yarnsub.com is a good site for help with that:

Yarn **A** less than one 25g ball 4-ply/ fingering-weight in off-white

- My suggestion: *Cardiff Cashmere Classic shade 501 Neve (actual amount needed - 25 metres)*

Yarn **B** less than one 25g ball 4-ply/ fingering-weight in beige/ light-brown

- My suggestion: *Cardiff Cashmere Classic shade 700 Futon (actual amount needed - 75 metres)*

PLUS - length (approx. 20cm/ 8in) of black or dark-grey 4-ply yarn for the Nose Detail

KNITTING NEEDLES Pair 3.50mm/ US size 4

TENSION 8 rows and 5.5 stitches over 2.5cm with 3.50mm needles and yarn A

EXTRAS Pair 7mm black or brown Toy Safety Eyes with plastic washer-type backs; lockable-style stitch markers in various colours (*Ref. Page 2*); yarn sewing needle

If you want to add ***Wire** into the limbs I used 2 x 30cm gauge 24 wires similar to these from [Etsy](https://www.etsy.com/)

This guide is here to pull out and use together with the pattern should you wish to use similar coloured guides to mine for ease of following, especially at the making-up stage:

PATTERN NOTES & TIPS:

. I generally cast on with Cable Cast On unless it's casting on in the middle of a row then I use [Backward Loop Cast-On method](#)

. **WIRE:** I found the best wires to create an armature with are paper-wrapped (easier to handle) ones - the best gauge for this project being 24 which is very fine and really malleable so easy to bend and which I used for the legs

*To add Wire to the knitting simply create a basic stick animal armature for head and body; limbs and insert each armature before stuffing and closing the seams completely. I found wrapping the cut ends with masking tape prevented the wires from poking through.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

W+Tk bring working yarn to the front of the work, slip next stitch purl-wise onto the RH needle, take working yarn to the back, slip the slipped stitch back onto the LH needle, turn the knitting = W+Tk (wrap and turn knit)

W+Tp take working yarn to the back of the work, slip next stitch knit-wise onto the RH needle, bring working yarn to the front, slip the slipped stitch back onto the LH needle, turn the knitting = W+Tp (wrap and turn purl)

GENERAL ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit

p = purl

inc = increase

dec = decrease

k2tog/ k3tog = knit two together/ knit three together

p2tog/ p3tog = purl two together/ purl three together

RH/LH = right hand/ left hand RS/WS = right side/ wrong side

st/ sts =stitch/ stitches

skpo = slip one stitch, knit next stitch, pass slipped stitch over knit stitch to decrease by one stitch

kfb = knit into front then into back of stitch to increase by one stitch

pfb = purl into front then knit into back of stitch to increase by one stitch

m1= with RH needle point pick up the horizontal bar in between stitches, put onto LH needle, knit the new stitch

HEAD

Beginning at the **Nose End** with yarn **A** cast on 13 sts

Rows 1-2. Beginning with a knit row work two rows stocking stitch

Row 3. (inc) K5, kfb, k1, kfb, knit to end of row - 15sts

Row 4. Purl

Cut yarn A, join yarn **B**, continue as follows:

Row 5. (inc) K6, kfb, k1, kfb, knit to end of row - 17sts

Rows. 6, 8, 10, 12 & 14. Purl

Row 7. (inc) K7, kfb, k1, kfb, knit to end of row - 19sts

Row 9. (inc) K8, kfb, k1, kfb, knit to end of row - 21sts

Row 11. (inc) [K2, kfb] twice, k3, kfb, k1, kfb, k3, [kfb, k2] twice - 27sts

Row 13. (inc) K11, kfb, k3, kfb, knit to end of row - 29sts

Row 15. (inc) K2, kfb, k9, kfb, k3, kfb, k9, kfb, k2 - 33sts. **PM** (*place marker*) on first and last stitch of the last row for Left and Right **Chin Markers**

Rows 16-20. Beginning with a purl row work five rows stocking stitch. **PM** on first and last stitch of the last (*purl*) row for Left and Right **Neck Markers**

Row 21. (dec) K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 31sts

Row 22. (dec) P1, p2tog, purl to last 3 sts, p2tog, p1 - 29sts

Rows 23-24. (dec) Repeat last 2 rows once - 25sts

Row 25. (dec) K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 23sts

Row 26. (dec) P1, p2tog, p7, p3tog, p7, p2tog, p1 - 19sts. **PM** on first and last stitch of the last row for Left and Right **Jaw Markers**

Row 27. (dec) K2tog, k5, skpo, k1, k2tog, k5, k2tog - 15sts

Row 28. (dec) P6, p3tog, p6 to end of row - 13sts. **PM** on first and last stitch of the last row for Left and Right **Ear Front Markers**

Row 29. (dec) K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 11sts

Row 30. Purl

Rows 31-34. (dec) Repeat last 2 rows twice - 7sts

Rows 35-36. Work two rows stocking stitch

Row 37. (inc) Kfb, knit to last st, kfb - 9sts

Row 38. Purl. **PM** on first and last stitch of the last row for Left and Right **Ear Back Markers**

Rows 39-40. Work two rows stocking stitch

Row 41. (inc) K1, kfb, k2, kfb, k2, kfb, k1 - 12sts

Rows 42-43. Beginning with a purl row work two rows stocking stitch. **PM** on first and last stitch of the last (*knit*) row for Left and Right **Head Back Markers**

Cast off all 12 sts purl-wise for Head Back.

Join Nose Seam

With RS together fold the Nose Cast-On Edge in half and back stitch to join the tiny seam. Turn out to RS.

Thread up a sewing needle with doubled-up black sewing thread and work a 'Y' over and either side of the seam to create the nose. - *Ref. Fig. 1*

EARS

Bunny's Left Ear

RS facing, top of the head towards you, beginning at bunny's Left Ear Front Marker and with yarn **B**, pick up and knit 8 sts from left ear front marker to Left Ear Back Marker. - *Ref. Fig. 2, pick up and knit as dotted line A to B*

***Row 1.** (inc) Pfb, purl to last 2 sts, pfb - 10sts

Row 2.(inc) K4, [kfb] twice, knit to end of row - 12sts

Row 3. Purl

Row 4. (inc) K5, [kfb] twice, knit to end of row - 14sts

Rows 5-9. Beginning with a purl row work five rows stocking stitch

Row 10. (dec) K4, skpo, k2, k2tog, knit to end of row - 12sts

Rows 11, 13, 15 & 17. Purl

Row 12. (dec) K3, skpo, k2, k2tog, knit to end of row - 10sts

Row 14. (dec) K2, skpo, k2, k2tog, knit to end of row - 8sts

Row 16. (dec) K1, skpo, k2, k2tog, k1 to end of row - 6sts

Row 18. (dec) Skpo, k2, k2tog - 4sts

Row 19. (dec) [P2tog] twice - 2sts

Cut yarn, thread tail end through 2 sts, pull up and secure end, weave the tail end in along one side of the ear**.

Bunny's Right Ear

RS facing, top of the head and left ear towards you, beginning at bunny's Right Ear Back Marker, pick up and knit 8 sts from right ear back marker to Right Ear Front Marker. - *Ref. Fig. 3, pick up and knit as dotted line A to B*

Work as Left Ear from * to **.

Join Jaw Seam

RS facing, working on one side at a time, match Jaw Marker to Head Back Marker and match Front Ear Marker with Back Ear Marker then work back stitch to join the tiny Jaw Seam from jaw markers/ head back markers to Front and Back Ear Markers.

- Ref. Fig. 4, back stitch the tiny seam in between the two pairs of markers from A to B

Remove Front and Back Ear Markers and Head Back Markers

Add Eyes

Insert the eyes either side of the head - equidistant from ear base to nose and top of head to neck seam. Before totally securing the eyes with the eye backs work a couple of stitches above and below the eye with doubled-up yarn A, after that, push the backs on fully. - Ref. Fig. 5 & Fig. 6

INNER EARS

Left Ear

RS facing, with top of the head towards you and Wabbit's Left Ear to your left, beginning at the bottom of the front of the ear, with yarn A, pick up and knit 11 stitches evenly up to the fastened off/ peak of the ear. - *Ref. Fig. 7, shows stitches picked up and knitted from A to B*

Row 1. Purl

Row 2. (dec) Knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 10sts

Rows 3-4. (dec) Repeat last 2 rows once - 9sts

Row 5. Purl

Cast off all 9 Left Inner Ear sts.

Right Ear

RS facing, with top of the head towards you and Wabbit's Right Ear to your right, beginning at the fastened off/ peak of the ear, with yarn A, pick up and knit 11 stitches evenly along to the bottom of the front of the ear. - *Ref. Fig. 8, shows stitches picked up and knitted completely from A to B*

Row 1. Purl

Row 2. (dec) Knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 10sts

Rows 3-4. (dec) Repeat last 2 rows once - 9sts

Row 5. Purl

Cast off all 9 Right Inner Ear sts.



Join Inner Ear to Outer Ear

Push the WS of the Inner Ear against the WS of the Outer Ear, then, allowing the inner ear edge of the Outer Ear to slightly curl over the Inner Ear Cast-Off Edge, neatly over-sew or mattress stitch the inner ear to outer ear - *Ref. Fig. 9, join inner to outer ear as dotted line shows & Fig.. 10*

BACK

RS facing, with top of the head towards you, Wabbit's Ears to your left, beginning at Wabbit's Left Chin Marker, with yarn **B**, pick up and knit 3 stitches evenly along to Left Neck Marker; pick up and knit 3 sts from left neck marker to Left Jaw Marker; pick up and knit 6 sts evenly across Head Back Cast-off Edge; pick up and knit 3 sts from Right Jaw Marker to Right Neck Marker; pick up and knit 3 sts from right neck marker to Right Chin Marker. - *Ref. Fig.. 11, pick up and knit from A to B; B to C; then pick up and knit across the head back cast-off edge; then Ref. Fig. 12, pick up and knit from D to E; E to F*

Remove Jaw Markers and Neck Markers

Row 1. (inc) Cast on 4 sts, [p4, p2tog] twice, p2, p2tog, purl to end of row - 19sts

Row 2. (inc) Cast on 4 sts, k4, k2tog, knit to end of row - 22sts

Row 3. Purl. **PM** on first and last stitch of the last row for Left and Right **Front Markers**

Row 4. (inc) Kfb, k5, kfb, k8, kfb, k5, kfb - 26sts

Rows 5, 7 & 9. Purl

Row 6. (inc) K8, kfb, k8, kfb, k8 to end of row - 28sts

Row 8. (inc) Kfb, k8, kfb, k8, kfb, k8, kfb - 32sts

Row 10. (inc) K11, kfb, k8, kfb, k11 to end of row - 34sts

Row 11-15 Beginning with a purl row work five rows stocking stitch

Row 16. (inc) Kfb, k11, kfb, k8, kfb, k11, kfb - 38sts

Rows 17-21. Beginning with a purl row work five rows stocking stitch

Row 22. (inc) K14, kfb, k8, kfb, k14 to end of row - 40sts

Row 23. Purl

Work short rows to shape Left Thigh as follows:

Short row 1. (inc) Cast on 7 sts, **PM** on 7th cast-on stitch for Left **Thigh Marker**, k7, W+Tk

Short row 2. P1, W+Tp (*wrap and turn purl, see Page 3*)

Short row 3. K2, W+Tk (*wrap and turn knit, see Page 3*)

Short row 4. P3, W+Tp

Short row 5. K4, W+Tk

Short row 6. P5, W+Tp

Short row 7. K6, W+Tk

Short row 8. P7, W+Tp

Short row 9. K8, W+Tk

Short row 10. P9, W+Tp

Short row 11. K10, W+Tk

Short row 12. P11, W+Tp

Short row 13. Knit 46 sts to end of row

Work short rows to shape Right Thigh as follows:

Short row 1. (inc) Cast on 7 sts, **PM** on 7th cast-on stitch for Right **Thigh Marker**, p7, W+Tp

Short row 2. K1, W+Tp (*wrap and turn purl, see Page 3*)

Short row 3. P2, W+Tk (*wrap and turn knit, see Page 3*)

Short row 4. K3, W+Tp

Short row 5. P4, W+Tk

Short row 6. K5, W+Tp

Short row 7. P6, W+Tk

Short row 8. K7, W+Tp

Short row 9. P8, W+Tk

Short row 10. K9, W+Tp

Short row 11. P10, W+Tk

Short row 12. K11, W+Tp

Short row 13. Purl 53 sts to end of row

Row 24. (dec) K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 52sts

Row 25. Purl

Rows 26-27. (dec) Repeat last 2 rows once - 50sts

Row 28. (dec) K2tog, k8, skpo, k26, k2tog, k8, k2tog - 46sts

Rows 29, 31 & 33. Purl

Row 30. (dec) K2tog, k7, skpo, k6, skpo, k8, k2tog, k6, k2tog, k7, k2tog - 40sts

Row 32. (dec) K2tog, k6, skpo, k4, skpo, k8, k2tog, k4, k2tog, k6, k2tog - 34sts

Row 34. (dec) K2tog, k5, skpo, k2, skpo, k8, k2tog, k2, k2tog, k5, k2tog - 28sts

Rows 35-39. Beginning with a purl row work five rows stocking stitch

Make a space for the **Tail** as follows:

Row 40. (dec) K12, cast off next 4 sts (*for Tail*), k11 to end of row - 2 sets 12 sts either side of 4 Tail cast-off sts

Row 41. (inc) P11, [pfb] twice, p11 to end of row - 26sts

Rows 42-43. Beginning with a knit row work two rows stocking stitch

Divide for **Hind Legs** as follows:

Row 44 dec) Cast off 8 sts for **Left Hind Leg sts**, knit next 9 sts, cast off last 8 sts for **Right Hind Leg sts**

BELLY

Rejoin yarn A to 10 sts on the knitting needle

Rows 1-8. Beginning with a purl row work eight rows stocking stitch. **PM** on first and last stitch of the last (*purl*) row for Left and Right **Lower Belly Markers**

Row 9. (inc) Pfb, purl to last st, pfb - 12sts

Row 10. (inc) K3, kfb, k4, kfb, k3 to end of row - 14sts

Row 11. Purl

Row 12. (inc) K4, kfb, k4, kfb, k4 to end of row - 16sts

Row 13. Purl

Row 14. Skpo, k2, kfb, k6, kfb, k2, k2tog

Rows 15-18. Repeat last 2 rows twice

Row 19. Purl

Work short rows to shape Belly

Short Row 1. K12, W+Tk

Short Row 2. P8, W+Tp

Short Row 3. K7, W+Tk

Short Row 4. P6, W+Tp

Short Row 5. K11 to end of row

Rows 20-28. Beginning with a purl row work nine rows stocking stitch. **PM** on first and last stitch of the last (*purl*) row for Left and Right **Belly to Thigh Markers**

Row 29. Knit

Row 30. (dec) P2tog, purl to last 2 sts, p2tog - 14sts

Row 31. (dec) K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 12sts

Rows 32-38. Beginning with a purl row work seven rows stocking stitch

Row 39. (dec) K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 10sts

Rows 40-41. Beginning with a purl row work five rows stocking stitch. **PM** on first and last stitch of the last (*purl*) row for Left and Right **Breast Markers**

Row 42. (dec) K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 8sts

Row 43. Purl

Rows 44-45. (dec) Repeat last 2 rows once - 6sts

Cast off all 6 Breast sts.

BREAST

RS facing, starting at Wabbit's Left Breast Marker, with yarn B, pick up and knit 10 sts evenly along row ends, cast-off edge and row ends to the Right Belly Marker. - *Ref. Fig. 13, pick up and knit from A to B as dotted line shows*

Remove Breast Markers

Rows 1-9. Beginning with a purl row work nine rows stocking stitch

Row 10. (dec) K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 8sts

Rows 11-13. Beginning with a purl row work three rows stocking stitch

Row 14. (dec) K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 6sts

Cast off all 6 Throat Edge purl-wise.

Join Neck Seam

Working on one side at a time, RS together match Chin Marker with the Front (*near the corner of the Front Cast-On Edge*) ease the seam and work back stitch to join the tiny chin/ neck seam from the chin/ front markers to the split - *Ref. Fig. 14, join as dotted lines show*

Turn out to RS.

Remove Front Markers

Join Belly and Breast to Back

Working on one side at a time, WS together match the Belly to Thigh Marker with Thigh Marker then match the corner of the Front Cast-On Edge with the corner of the Throat Cast-Off Edge (*at the Chin Marker*) and work mattress stitch to join the Belly and Breast to Back Seam from the thigh markers to the corner of the throat/ near the Neck Seam . - *Ref. Fig. 15, join as dotted lines show*

Remove Chin and Thigh Markers



this is a tiny seam and the front edge needs easing a lot to fit so gather it up a little to ease it in place

Join Belly to Thigh Front

Working on one side at a time, WS together match the Lower Belly Marker to the corner of the Hind Leg Cast-Off Edge and work mattress stitch to join the Thigh Front to the Belly seam from the belly to thigh marker to the lower belly/ corner of the hind leg cast-off edge. - *Ref. Fig. 16, join as dotted lines show*

Stuff the body through the neck opening.

Remove Belly to Thigh Markers

THROAT AND CHIN

Return to the Throat Cast-Off Edge and with the Belly facing you, begin at Wabbit's left side (*on your right*), with yarn **A** pick up and knit 6 sts across the throat edge. - *Ref. Fig. 17, pick up and knit from A to B as dotted line shows*

Row 1. (dec) P2tog, p2, p2tog - 4sts

Rows 2-5. Beginning with a knit row work four rows stocking stitch

Work short rows to shape the Chin

Short row 1. K3 W+Tk

Short row 2 P2 W+Tp

Short row 3. K3 to end of row

Cut yarn, thread end through all 4 Chin sts, pull up and secure for Chin Point.

Join Chin Seam

Stuff the head with yarn endings and toy filling.

Match the Chin Point to the bottom of the Nose Seam, work a tiny stitch to hold those positions in place then, easing the edges together, join the throat/ chin row ends to the nose/ muzzle with mattress stitch. - *Ref. Fig. 18*

TAIL

Return to the Tail Cast-Off Edge at the Back.

RS of the Back facing you, head towards you, with yarn **A** pick up and knit 4 sts across the Tail Cast-Off Edge from your right to left

Row 1. (inc) Cast on 2 sts for Tail Underside #1, purl 6 to end of row

Row 2. (inc) Cast on 2 sts for Tail Underside #2, knit 8 to end of row

Rows 3, 5 & 7. Purl

Row 4. (dec) K1, skpo, k2, k2tog, k1 to end of row - 6sts

Row 6. (dec) Skpo, k2, k2tog - 4sts

Row 8. (dec) [K2tog] twice - 2sts

Cut yarn, thread tail end through 2 sts, pull up and secure end, weave the tail end in along one side of the tail.

Join Tail Seam

WS together match Tail Row Ends and work mattress or over-sew stitch to join the Tail Seam from the fastened-off point to the corners of the Tail Underside Cast-On Edge. Then join the cast-on edges, to the knitted stitches beneath the tail.

Tail isn't stuffed. - *Ref. Figs. 19 & 20*

HIND LEGS AND PAWS

Left Hind Leg and Paw

With Wabbit's head towards you, begin at the Left Lower Belly Marker and with yarn **B** pick up and knit one stitch at the marker then pick up and knit 4 sts across the Left Hind Leg Cast-Off Edge to the corner of the Cast-Off Edge - 5sts. - *Ref. Fig. 21, left hind leg shown as picked up knitted from A to B*

Remove Left Lower Belly Marker

Row 1. (inc) Cast on 5 sts for Inside Leg, p4, p2tog, p4 to end of row - 9sts

Row 2. Knit

***Row 3.** (inc) Cast on 8 sts for Paw Front #1, purl 17 to end of row

Row 4. (inc) Cast on 8 sts for Paw Front #2, knit 25 to end of row

Row 5. Purl

Work short rows to shape the Paw Side 1

Short Row 1. (inc) Kfb, k6, W+Tk

Short Row 2. P8

Short Row 3. K7, W+Tk

Short Row 4. P7

Row 6. Knit all 26 sts to end of row

Work short rows to shape the Paw – Side 2

Short Row 1. (inc) Pfb, p6, W+Tp

Short Row 2. K8

Short Row 3. P7, W+Tp

Short Row 4. K7

Row 7. (dec) P2tog, purl to last 2 sts, p2tog - 25sts

Cast off all 25 Paw Sole sts **.

Right Hind Leg and Paw

With Wabbit's head towards you, begin at the corner of the Right Hind Leg Cast-Off Edge (*opposite the Right Lower Belly Marker*), with yarn **B** pick up and knit 4 sts across the Cast-Off Edge to the Lower Belly Marker then pick up and knit one stitch at the marker - 5sts. - *Ref. Fig. 22, right hind leg shown as picked up knitted from A to B*

Row 1. Purl

Row 2. (inc) Cast on 5 sts for Inside Leg, k4, k2tog, k4 to end of row - 9sts

Continue as Left Hind Leg and Paw from * to **.



Join Paw Seams

Working on one paw at a time, WS together fold the Paw Sole Cast-Off Edge in half and mattress stitch the two halves together.

Match the Inside Leg Cast-On Edge to the Belly row ends and work mattress stitch to join both edges. - *Ref. Fig. 23, join as dotted lines show*

Finally, work mattress stitch join the paw front, upper and leg stuffing the paw and leg with yarn endings at the same time.

- *Ref. Fig. 24, join as dotted line shows*

FORELEGS *make 2 alike*

The Forelegs are knitted separately and then joined onto the body

Beginning at the Paw End, with yarn **B** cast on 10 sts

Row 1. Purl

Work short rows for Paw

Short row 1. K9, W+Tk

Short row 2. P8, W+Tp

Short row 3. K7, W+Tk

Short row 4. P6, W+Tp

Short row 5. K5, W+Tk

Short row 6. P4, W+Tp

Short row 7. K7 to end of row

Rows 2-6. Beginning with a purl row work five rows stocking stitch

Row 7. (dec) K2tog, knit to last 2 sts, k2tog - 8sts

Rows 8-14. Beginning with a purl row work seven rows stocking stitch

Row 15. (inc) [K2, kfb] twice, k2 - 10sts

Rows 16-18. Beginning with a purl row work three rows stocking stitch

Row 19. (dec) K1, k2tog, k4, k2tog, k1 to end of row - 8sts

Row 20. Purl

Row 21. (dec) K1, k2tog, k2, k2tog, k1 to end of row - 6sts

Cast off all 6 sts for Foreleg Leg Top Purl-wise

Join Foreleg Seam

WS together, fold the foreleg at the Paw Cast-On Edge and match the row ends. Work mattress or over-stitch to join the rows ends and cast-on edge along to the Foreleg Leg Top Cast-Off Edge, at the same time stuffing the foreleg with yarn endings and a tiny amount of stuffing.

Join Foreleg to the body

Lay the Foreleg Leg Top Cast-Off Edge against the body just down from the neck seam and at a 45 degree angle. - *Ref. Fig. 25*

Mattress stitch the cast off edge onto the body then work around the top of the foreleg joining the to the body as neatly as possible - the Foreleg Seam lies under the foreleg. - *Ref. Fig. 26, join as dotted line shows*
