FINISHED SIZES (also see notes and diagram below):

	XS	(S	M1	M2)	[L	XL	XXL]
Bust size (cm)	84	91	98	105	116	127	138
Bust size (inches)	33	35 ¾	38 ½	41 ½	45 ¾	50	54 ½

MATERIALS & TOOLS:

- Bulky yarn in the following amount, shown in Brooklyn Tweed Quarry (100% merino wool, 185 m (200 yds) per 100 g); colour 'Moonstone';

	XS	(S	M1	M2)	[L	XL	XXL]
metres:	625	690	760	830	925	1015	1130
yards:	675	750	825	900	1000	1100	1225


- 9 mm / US 13 circular needle, or size to obtain gauge, in a length suitable for the finished bust size you are making
- needle(s) of same size for working small diameter rounds using your preferred method for the collar, the beginning of the yoke, and the sleeves (e.g. short circular needle, DPNs, magic loop, second circular needle)
- 7 stitch markers (in different shapes or colours)
- waste yarn

GAUGE: 11 sts and 17 rows / 10 cm (4 inches) in st st, in the round after blocking

NOTES:

- Intended to fit with 2 – 7 cm (1 – 3 inches) of positive ease at the bust. Shown in Size M1 with approx. 12 cm (5 inches) of positive ease (for a slightly more oversized fit). Please review the measurements below to assist in selecting your size.
- Knit from the top down, in one piece beginning at the neck. The collar, yoke, body and sleeves are worked in the round.
- Abbreviations are provided at the end of the pattern (page 6).

INSTRUCTIONS:

Collar

With needle(s) for working small diameter rounds, using long tail method,

	XS	(S	M1	M2)	[L	XL	XXL]	
CO	52	52	56	56	56	56	58	sts.

Join in the round and pm BOR, being careful not to twist the sts.

Set up round (place markers): k **Back sts**, pm X, k **Sleeve sts**, pm Y, k2, pm RE, k **Half Front sts**, pm CF, k **Half Front sts**, pm LF, k2, pm Z, k **Sleeve sts**.

*NOTE: Refer to the table below for the values to insert for the **Back, Sleeve and Half Front sts**. Also see TIP below.*

Back sts	20	20	22	22	24	24	26
Sleeve sts	7	7	7	7	5	5	4
Half Front sts	7	7	8	8	9	9	10

TIP: Markers X, Y, Z, and BOR are raglan markers. Markers RE, CF, and LF are the right, center, and left markers for the front neck detail. When placing the markers, you may wish to use different coloured or shaped markers and note which is which.

Next 4 rounds: k all.

Next round (**back and front incs**): k1, m1l, k to 1 st before X, m1r, k to 1 st before CF, yo, k1, sm CF, k1, yo, k to end. (= 4 sts inc'd)

Next 3 rounds: k all.

Next round (**front incs**): k to 1 st before CF, yo, k1, sm CF, k1, yo, k to end. (= 2 sts inc'd)

Next 3 rounds: k all.

Next round: as **back and front incs** round. (= 10 sts more than CO sts)

Next round: k all.



Yoke

Work the SETS below the number of times and in the order given in the following table:

	XS	(S	M1	M2)	[L	XL	XXL]	
SET 1	2	2	3	3	5	6	8	times,
SET 2	5	5	5	5	4	3	2	times,
SET 3	1	2	1	2	-	1	-	time(s).

*TIP: The decs between markers RF and LF occur on **alt** rounds, and the front eyelets (=yo's) occur on **4th** rounds during **both** SETS 1 and 2. Only the rate of the raglan incs changes when moving from SET 1 to SET 2, from **alt** rounds to **4th** rounds. SET 3 has no front neck details, only raglan incs on **alt** rounds.*

SET 1 (= 4 rounds)

Next round (**raglan incs and front decs**): k1, m1l, k to 1 st before X, m1r, k1, sm X, k1, m1l, k to 1 st before Y, m1r, k1, sm Y, k1, m1l, k to RF, sm RF, k2 tog, k to 2 sts before LF, ssk, sm LF, k to 1 st before Z, m1r, k1, sm Z, k1, m1l, k to 1 st before BOR, m1r, k1. (8 sts inc'd and 2 sts dec'd = 6 incs)

Next round: k all.

Next round (**raglan incs and front decs and eyelets**): k1, m1l, k to 1 st before X, m1r, k1, sm X, k1, m1l, k to 1 st before Y, m1r, k1, sm Y, k1, m1l, k to 1 st before RF, yo, k1, sm RF, k2 tog, k to 1 st before CF, yo, k1, sm CF, k1, yo, k to 2 sts before LF, ssk, sm LF, k1, yo, k to 1 st before Z, m1r, k1, sm Z, k1, m1l, k to 1 st before BOR, m1r, k1. (12 sts inc'd, and 2 sts dec'd = 10 incs)

Next round: k all.

SET 2 (= 4 rounds)

Next round (**front decs**): k to RF, sm RF, k2 tog, k to 2 sts before LF, ssk, sm LF, k to end. (= 2 decs)

Next round: k all.

Next round: as **raglan incs and front decs and eyelets** round in **SET 1**.

Next round: k all. During only the last repeat of this round, rm RF, CF and LF.

NOTE: There should be 6 sts between RF and LF before you remove the markers on the last round.

SET 3 (= 2 rounds)

Next round (**raglan incs**): k1, m1l, k to 1 st before X, m1r, k1, sm X, k1, m1l, k to 1 st before Y, m1r, k1, sm Y, k1, m1l, k to 1 st before Z, m1r, k1, sm Z, k1, m1l, k to 1 st before BOR, m1r, k1. (=8 sts inc'd)

Next round: k all.

Stitch counts between raglan markers when yoke complete:

	XS	(S	M1	M2)	[L	XL	XXL]
Back and Front sts	44	46	50	52	56	60	66
Sleeve sts	27	29	31	33	33	37	40

Separate Body and Sleeve sts

Next round: rm BOR, k to X, rm X, move sts to Y (= right Sleeve sts) onto waste yarn, rm Y, backward loop CO **E** sts, and pm R (= right side of body), backward loop CO **E** sts, k to Z, rm Z, move sts to BOR (= left Sleeve sts) onto waste yarn, rm BOR, backward loop CO **E** sts, pm new BOR (= left side of body), backward loop CO **E** sts.

*NOTE: Refer to the table below for the value to insert for **E** and the resulting Body sts.*

	XS	(S	M1	M2)	[L	XL	XXL]
E	1	2	2	3	4	5	5
Body sts	92	100	108	116	128	140	152

Body (in the round)

Knit to new BOR.

Knit 12 rounds straight.

Next round (*decs*): k6, k2 tog, k to 8 sts before R, ssk, k to 6 sts past R, k2 tog, k to 8 sts before BOR, ssk, k to end. (= 4 sts dec'd)

Knit 7 rounds straight.

Repeat last 8 rounds once more. (=8 sts less than Body sts in table above)

Next round (*incs*): k6, m1l, k to 6 sts before R, m1r, k to 6 sts past R, m1l, k to 6 sts before BOR, m1r, k to end. (= 4 sts inc'd)

Knit 7 rounds straight.

Repeat the last 8 rounds 3 more times. (=8 sts more than Body sts in table above)

Knit straight until body measures 40 cm / 15 ¾ inches from underarm.

BO knitwise.



Sleeves – both alike (in the round)

Move Sleeve sts from waste yarn onto needle(s) for working in the round. With RS facing, beginning at the center of the Body underarm CO sts, join new yarn and pick up and k **F** sts, k Sleeve sts, pick up and k **F** sts.

NOTE: Refer to the table below for the values to insert for **F**, and the resulting sts.

	XS	(S	M1	M2)	[L	XL	XXL]
F	2	3	3	4	5	5	6
Sleeve sts	31	35	37	41	43	47	52

Knit 15 (10, 10, 8) [8, 7, 5] rounds straight in st st.

Next round (dec): k1, k2 tog, k to last 3 sts, ssk, k1. (= 2 sts dec'd)

Repeat the last 16 (11, 11, 9) [9, 8, 6] rounds 3 (5, 5, 7) [7, 8, 10] more times.

	XS	S	M1	M2)	[L	XL	XXL]
Sleeve sts	23	23	25	25	27	29	30

Work straight in st st until sleeve measures 42 (44, 45, 46) [46, 46, 46] cm / 16 ½ (17 ¼, 17 ¾, 18) [18, 18, 18] inches from underarm.

BO knitwise.

FINISHING:

Weave in ends. Wash and dry as instructed on yarn label.

alt = alternate (or every second)

approx. = approximately

beg = beginning

BOR = beginning of rounds

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

dec('d)(s) = decrease(d)(s)

inc('d)(s) = increase(d)(s)

LH = left hand

m1l = make one left: with RH needle lift bar between needles onto the LH needle so the right side of it is at the front, then knit into the back of it

m1r = make one right: with RH needle lift bar between needles onto the LH needle so the left side of it is at the front, then knit into the front of it

k = knit

p = purl

pm = place marker

RH = right hand

rm = remove marker

RS = right side

sm = slip marker

ssk = slip 2 sts individually as if to knit, then knit together through back loops

st(s) = stitch(es)

st st = stocking stitch - worked in the round: k all

tog = together

yo = yarn over



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
