Level: INTERMEDIATE / ADVANCED

Sizes: S (M, L, XL, 2XL)

Bust Circumference: 80-85 (86-90, 95-100, 101-106, 110-115)cm/

31 ½ - 33 ½ (34- 35 ½ , 37 ½ - 39 ¼ , 39 ¾ - 41 ¾ , 43 ½ - 45 ¼)”

MATERIALS:

Original yarn:

- Nako Super Inci Hit Tweed (51% wool/ 49% acryl) 180 m /197 yds per 100 g skein.

Shades:

- Yarn A: burgundy tweed. 6 (6, 7, 7, 8) skeins.
- Yarn B: yellow (for letter). 1 skein. 300-350m/328-383 yds per 100 g.

Alternative yarn:

- LION BRAND Re-Tweed,
- BERNAT Premium Tweeds,
- KNIT PICKS City Tweed Aran / HW,
- KNIT PICKS Wool of the Andes Tweed,
- CARON Simply Soft Tweeds.

Needles:

- Circular Needle 3 mm/ US 2.5, (40) cm/ (14)” length
- Circular Needle 4 mm/ US 6, (40) cm/ (14)” length
- Circular Needle 5 mm/ US 8, (40) cm/ (14)” length
- Circular Needle 4 mm/ US 6, (80 -100) cm/ (32- 40)” length
- Circular Needle 5 mm/ US 8, (80 -100) cm/ (32- 40)” length
- Double Pointed Needles 4 mm/ US 6

GAUGE:

18 sts & 25 rows = 10x10 cm / (4x4)” on 5 mm / US 8 needles in St st
Always use a needle size that will result in the correct gauge after blocking.

Note: Weasley is a Raglan sweater with embroidery, worked top-down in the round. Yoke is formed with German short row technique.

- Tapestry needle
- Waste yarn or stitch holders

BLCO – right-slanting loop cast on – Increase by making a backward loop over RH needle*

DS - double stitch

k – knit

k2tog – knit 2 stitches together (right-leaning decrease)

M1L – make one left – pick up strand between the two needles from the front to back with the tip of left needle, knit into the back of this stitch

M1R – make one right – pick up strand between the two needles from back to front with the tip of left needle, knit into the front of this stitch

p – purl

p2tog – purl 2 stitches together

ptbl – purl st through the back of loop (twisted purl st)

sl – slip

sl 1 DS (slip 1 creating DS)– with yarn in front slip 1 st purlwise, pull the yarn up and over the right needle to create a double stitch.

St st – stockinette stitch

wyib – with yarn held in back of yarn
wyif – with yarn held in front of yarn
yo – yarn over needle and into working position
*(...) - number of repeats

German short rows

On a RS row: Knit a number of sts as stated in the pattern, turn work (you are now at the beginning of a WS short row), bring yarn to front, slip the first sts as if to purl, bring yarn over the needle to the back of your work and pull tight (it will look like a double st = DS).

On a WS row: Purl a number of sts as stated in the pattern, turn work (you are now at the beginning of a RS short row), bring yarn to front, slip the first sts as if to purl, bring yarn over the needle to the back of your work and pull tight (it will look like a double st = DS).

Resolving double stitches: When you encounter the DS on subsequent rows knit (on RS row) or purl (on WS row) through both legs of the DS.

PATTERN

Using 4 mm/ US 6, (40) cm circular needle/ (14)'' length and yarn A cast on 122 (122, 124, 124, 126) sts. Join for working in a round being careful not to twist. PM to indicate beg of rnd.

Work in 1x1 Rib until it measures 3 cm / 1¼''. Change to 3 mm/ US 2.5 circular needle , (40) cm/ (14)'' length and work in Rib until it measures 1 cm / ¼''. Change to 4 mm/ US 6 circular needle, (40) cm/ (14)'' length and work in Rib until it measures 3 cm / 1¼''.

Rnd 1: p to end

Hollow Rib:

Rnd 2: *k1, yo*; repeat from *to* to end of rnd (244, 244, 248, 248, 252 sts)

Rnd 3: *sl k, wyib, yo work ptbl*; repeat from *to* to end of rnd

Rnd 4: *k1, sl p, wyif*; repeat from *to* to end of rnd

Rnd 5: *sl k, wyib, p1*; repeat from *to* to end of rnd

Rnd 6: p2tog to end of rnd (122, 122, 124, 124, 126 sts)

Bend the Rib inward and sew the edge to the 1st row of the Rib (you can sew the Rib at the end of the sweater knitting).

Change to 5 mm/ US 8 circular needle , (40) cm/ (14)'' length.

All sizes:

Set-up rnd: Work k36 (36, 37, 37, 38), pm, k2, pm, k17, pm, k2, pm, k44 (44, 45, 45, 46), pm, k2, pm, k17, pm, k2, **sm**, k35 (35, 36, 36, 37), turn.

German short rows technique:

Short row 1 (WS): DS, p to marker, sm, p2, sm, p4, turn.

Short row 2 (RS): DS, k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L, k34 (34, 35, 35, 36), DS, k1, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L, k4, turn.

(Total: 126, 126, 128, 128, 130 sts)

Short row 3 (WS): DS, (p to marker, sm, p2, sm)*2, p4, DS, p4, turn.

Short row 4 (RS): DS, (k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L)*2, k4, DS, k4, turn. (130, 130, 132, 132, 134 sts)

Short row 5 (WS): DS, (p to marker, sm, p2, sm)*2, p9, DS, p4, turn.

Short row 6 (RS): DS, (k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L)*2, k9, DS, k4, turn. (134, 134, 136, 136, 138 sts)

Short row 7 (WS): DS, (p to marker, sm, p2, sm)x*2, p14, DS, p4, turn.

Short row 8 (RS): DS, (k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L)*2, k14, DS, k4, turn. (138, 138, 140, 140, 142 sts)

Sizes S and M ONLY:

Short row 9 (WS): DS, (p to marker, sm, p2, sm)*2, p19, DS, p1, sm, p2, sm, p2, turn.

Short row 10 (RS): DS, (k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L)*3, k19, DS, k1, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L, k2, turn. (146 sts)

Short row 11 (WS): DS, (p to marker, sm, p2, sm)*4, p2, DS, p2, turn.

Short row 12 (RS): DS, (k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L)x4, k2, DS, k2, turn. (154 sts)

Short row 13 (WS): DS, (p to marker, sm, p2, sm)*4, p5, DS, p2, turn.

Short row 14 (RS): DS, (k to marker, sm, k2, sm)*4, k5, DS, k2, turn. (154 sts)

Short row 15 (WS): DS, (p to marker, sm, p2, sm)*4, p7, DS, p3, turn.

Short row 16 (RS): DS, (k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L)*4, k7, DS, k3, turn. (162 sts)

Short row 17 (WS): DS, (p to marker, sm, p2, sm)*4, p11, DS, p3, turn.

Short row 18 (RS): DS, (k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L)*4, k11, DS, k3, turn. (170 sts)

Short row 19 (WS): DS, (p to marker, sm, p2, sm)*4, p15, DS, p4, turn.

Short row 20 (RS): DS, (k to marker, sm, k2, sm)*4, k15, DS, k16, DS, pm to indicate beg of round. (170 sts)

Sizes L, XL, 2XL ONLY:

Short row 9 (WS): DS, (p to marker, sm, p2, sm)*2, p19, DS, p1, sm, p2, sm, p2, turn.

Short row 10 (RS): DS, k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, k to marker, sm, k2, sm, M1L, k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, k19, DS, k1, sm, k2, sm, M1L, k2, turn. (144, 144, 146 sts)

Short row 11(WS): DS, (p to marker, sm, p2, sm)*4, p2, DS, p2, turn.

Short row 12 (RS): DS, (k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L)*4, k2, DS, k2, turn. (152, 152, 154 sts)

Short row 13 (WS): DS, (p to marker, sm, p2, sm)*4, p5, DS, p2, turn.

Short row 14 (RS): DS, (k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, k to marker, sm, k2, sm, M1L)*2, k5, DS, k2, turn. (156, 156, 158 sts)

Short row 15 (WS): DS, (p to marker, sm, p2, sm)*4, p8, DS, p3, turn.

Short row 16 (RS): DS, (k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L)x4, k8, DS, k3, turn. (164, 164, 166 sts)

Short row 17 (WS): DS, (p to marker, sm, p2, sm)*4, p12, DS, p3, turn.

Short row 18 (RS): DS, (k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, k to marker, sm, k2, sm, M1L)*2, k12, DS, k3, turn. (168, 168, 170 sts)

Short row 19 (WS): DS, (p to marker, sm, p2, sm)*4, p16, DS, p4, turn.

Short row 20 (RS): DS, (k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L)*4, k16, DS, k17(17, 18), DS, pm to indicate beg of round. (176, 176, 178 sts)

Work in round from here.

Yoke (Raglan)

Change to 5 mm/ US 8 circular needle , (80 -100) cm/ (32- 40)'' length.

Size S ONLY

Rnd 21: (k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L)*4, k to end (178 sts)

Rnd 22: k to end

Rnd 23: rep rnd 21 (186 sts)

Rnds 24-25: k to end

Rnds 26-55: rep rnds 21-25 *6 (282 sts)

Rnds 56-58: rep rnds 21-23 (298 sts)

Size M ONLY

Rnd 21: k to end.

Rnd 22: (k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L)*4, k to end (178 sts).

Rnds 23-54: rep rnds 21-22 *16 (306 sts).

Rnd 55: k to end.

Rnd 56: (k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, k to marker, sm, k2, sm, M1L)*2, k to end (310 sts).

Rnds 57-60: rep rnds 55-56 *2 (318 sts).

Size L ONLY

Rnd 21: k to end

Rnd 22: (k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, k to marker, sm, k2, sm, M1L)*2, k to end (180 sts)

Rnd 23: k to end

Rnd 24: (k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L)*4, k to end (188 sts)

Rnds 25-28: rep rnds 21-24 (200 sts)

Rnds 29-60: rep rnds 23-24 *16 (328 sts)

Rnds 61-62: k to end

Size XL ONLY

Rnd 21: k to end

Rnd 22: (k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, k to marker, sm, k2, sm, M1L)*2, k to end (180 sts)

Rnd 23: k to end

Rnd 24: (k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L)*4, k to end (188 sts)

Rnds 25-40: rep rnds 21-24 *4 (236 sts)

Rnds 41-64: rep rnds 23-24 *12 (332 sts)

Size 2XL ONLY

Rnd 21: k to end

Rnd 22: (k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, k to marker, sm, k2, sm, M1L)*2, k to end (182 sts)

Rnd 23: k to end

Rnd 24: (k to marker, M1R, sm, k2, sm, M1L)*4, k to end (190 sts)

Rnd 25-48: rep rnds 21-24 *6 (262 sts)

Rnd 49-70: rep rnds 23-24 *11 (350 sts)

All sizes:

Measure length from Set-up rnd of back neck to bottom. Length should be 23 (24, 24.5, 25.5, 28) cm / 9 (9½, 9¾, 10, 11)". If it is shorter work a couple of rnds more in St st to desired length.

Separate body and sleeves

Next rnd: k to marker, rm, k1, place next 63 (65, 65, 63, 65) sts on holder or waste yarn (remove markers), BLCO on RH needle 5 (7, 11, 17, 18) sts for underarm, then k1, rm, k to next marker, rm, k1, place next 63 (65, 65, 63, 65) sts on holder or waste yarn (remove markers), BLCO on RH needle 5 (7, 11, 17, 18) sts for underarm, then k1, rm, k to end. (182, 202, 220, 240, 256 sts)

Body

Continue straight in St st until body length from underarm measures 32.5 (32.5, 32.5, 33, 33)cm / 12¾ (12¾, 12¾, 13, 13)''.

Change to 4 mm/ US 6 circular needle , (80 -100) cm/ (32- 40)'' length.

Work in 1x1 Rib for 5 cm/2''.

Bind off.

Both Sleeves

Transfer sleeve sts from holder/waste yarn to 5 mm/ US 8 circular needle, (40) cm/ (14)'' length, remove waste yarn. Pick up 5 (7, 11, 17, 18) sts along underarms:

- pick up 1st before underarm, pick up 5 (7, 11, 17, 18) sts along underarm, pick up 1st after underarm. (70, 74, 78, 82, 85 sts).

All sizes:

Rnd 1: k 62 (64, 64, 62, 64) sts, k2tog, k 2 (3, 5, 8, 9) sts, PM to indicate beg of rnd. (69, 73, 77, 81, 84 sts)

Rnd 2: k 3 (4, 6, 9, 9 sts), k2tog, k to end. (68, 72, 76, 80, 83 sts)

Size S ONLY

Rnds 3-8: work in St st.

Rnd 9: k1, k2tog, k to end of rnd (67 sts).

Rnds 10-12: work in St st.

Rnd 13: k till 2 last sts, k2tog (66 sts).

Rnds 14-93: rep rnds 6-13 *10 (46 sts).

Rnds 94-100: work in St st.

Size M ONLY

Rnds 3-12: work in St st.

Rnd 13: k1, k2tog, k to end of rnd (71 sts).

Rnds 14-15: work in St st.

Rnd 16: k till last 2 sts, k2tog (70 sts).

Rnds 17-88: rep rnds 11-16 *12 (46 sts).

Rnds 89-100: work in St st.

Size L ONLY

Rnds 3-6: work in St st.

Rnd 7: k1, k2tog, k to end (75 sts).

Rnds 8-9: work in St st.

Rnd 10: k till last 2 sts, k2tog (74 sts).

Rnds 11-94: rep rnds 5-10 *14 (46 sts).

Rnds 95-100: work in St st.

Size XL ONLY

Rnds 3-4: work in St st.

Rnd 5: k1, k2tog, k to end of rnd (79 sts).

Rnds 6-7: work in St st.

Rnd 8: k till last 2 sts, k2tog (78 sts).

Rnds 9-98: rep rnds 3-8 *15 (48 sts).

Rnds 99-100: work in St st.

Size 2XL ONLY

Rnd 3-15: work in St st.

Rnd 16: k1, k2tog, k to end (82 sts).

Rnd 17: work in St st.

Rnd 18: k till last 2 sts, k2tog (81 sts).

Rnds 19-82: rep rnds 15-18 *16 (49 sts).

Rnds 83-84: rep rnds 15-16 (48 sts).


Rnds 85-100: work in St st.

All size:

Change to 4 mm/ US 6 double pointed needles or 4 mm/ US 6 circular needle, (80 -100) cm/ (32- 40)'' length to work in Magic loop method. Work in 1x1 Rib till sleeve from underarm measures 47 cm / 18½''. Bind off.

Embroidery

Using yarn B embroider the letter with tapestry needle as shown according to Diagram 1.



Before starting to embroider, pm to indicate the center of the sweater and count about 20 rows down from the neckline. This will be the top edge of the letter. To embroider from bottom to top, count 53 rows more down. This will be the bottom edge of the letter.



If you would like to embroider any other letter, print it out, cut it out, attach it to the sweater and, using a contrasting thread and a tapestry needle, mark the borders of the letter along the contour. And then embroider in the same way with yarn B, duplicating the loops, as shown in the examples below.


Finished measurements.

Body circumference: 101 (113, 122, 133, 142)cm / 40 (44½, 48, 52½, 56)''

Length: 60.5 (61, 62, 63.5, 65.5)cm / 23¾ (24, 24½, 25, 25¾)''

Shoulder circumference: 37.5 (39.5, 42, 44, 46.5)cm / 14¾ (15½, 16½, 17¼, 18¼)''

Wrist circumference: 25.5 (25.5, 25.5, 26.5, 26.5)cm / 10 (10, 10, 10¼, 10¼)''



FINISHING

Hand wash in lukewarm water. Dry flat.

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Embroidery - How to Duplicate stitch.

1. Thread a tapestry needle with a length of your contrast yarn
Insert the needle from the wrong-side to the right side under the selected «V» stitch. Pull yarn through the base.



2. Put needle through both «legs» of above stitch.
Pull through, but don't pull too tight.



3. Go back down at the bottom in the same space where the needle came up





You can move from bottom to top:



You can also move from top to bottom:
