Shawl Collar Wrap in Wendy Cairn Aran

Suitable for any Wendy Aran, yarn amounts may vary.

Materials and Measurements

Measurement excluding collar	Width 165 x 89	cm
	Length 65 x 35	ins
Wendy Cairn Aran 100g	7	balls
1- 5mm (UK6- US8) Circular Knitting needle.

IMPORTANT

Use only the Wendy yarn specified. We cannot accept responsibility for an imperfect item if any other brand is used. It is essential to work to the tension stated. The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

ABBREVIATIONS

cm - centimetres; **ins** - inches; **K**- knit; **P**- purl; **rs** - right side; **st(s)** - stitch(es); **ws** - wrong side; **rept** - repeat; **alt**- alternate; **cont** - continue; **sl** - slip; **Pull up loop** - insert right-hand needle upwards under the 2 strands in front of the slipped sts, K the next st, then lift the 2 strands off over this st.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS

Wrap and turn on a Knit st

- Keep yarn at back of work, slip the next stitch purlwise from the left needle to the right needle, bring the yarn forward as if to purl. Slip the stitch from the right needle back to the left needle then bring the yarn to the back of the work as if to knit. Turn your work and rib the next row.

Wrap and turn on a Purl st

- Keep yarn at front of work, slip the next stitch purlwise from the left needle to the right needle, bring the yarn back as if to knit. Slip the stitch from the right needle back to the left needle then bring the yarn to the front of the work as if to purl. Turn your work and rib the next row.

Knitting the wrapped stitch together with the yarn

wrapping it - Pick up the wrap with the right needle from front to back. Then insert the right needle into the stitch that is wrapped. Knit the wrap and the stitch together.

Purling the wrapped stitch together with the yarn

wrapping it - Pick up the wrap with the right needle from back to front. Place the

wrap onto the left needle. Purl together the wrap and the stitch that is wrapped.

TENSION

It is important to check your tension before commencing the project. 14sts and 30 rows to 10cm, 4ins over patt on 5mm needles. If there are too many stitches to 10cm, then your tension is tight and you will need to change your needle to a larger size. If there are too few stitches to 10cm, then your tension is loose and you will need to change your needle to a smaller size.

SHAWL COLLAR WRAP

Using 5mm circular needle, cast on 227 sts. Work in rows.

1st row - (ws) K1, P3, * K3, P3, rept from * to last st, K1

2nd row - P1, K3, * P3, K3, rept from * to last st, P1.

These 2 rows form rib. Repeat these two rows 12 times more, then work 1st row once.

Commence Pattern

1st row - (rs) K1, P3, * keeping yarn at front of work, sl 3 sts purlwise, P3, rept from * to last st, K1.

2nd row - P1, K3, * keeping

yarn at back of work, sl 3 sts purlwise, K3, rept from * to last st, P1.

3rd row - K1, P3, * K3, P3, rept from * to last st, K1.

4th row - P1, K3, * P3, K3, rept from * to last st, P1.

5th row - K5, * pull up loop (see abbreviations), K5, rept from * to end.

6th row - As 3rd row.

7th row - P1, * keeping yarn at front, sl 3 sts purlwise, P3, rept from * to last 4 sts, sl 3 purlwise, P1.

8th row - K1, * keeping yarn at back, sl 3 sts purlwise, K3, rept from * to last 4 sts, sl 3 purlwise, K1.

9th row - As 4th row.

10th row - As 3rd row.

11th row - K2, * pull up loop (see abbreviations), K5, rept from * to last 3 sts, pull up loop, K2.

12th row - As 4th row.

These 12 rows form the pattern. Repeat these 12 rows until work measures approximately 89cm, 35ins from cast on edge, finishing on a 6th or 12th row.

Commence collar

Next row - Work 2nd row as given for rib.

Next row - Work 1st row as given for rib.

Keeping all rib sts as now set throughout, continue as follows:-

Next row - Rib 200 sts,

wrap next st (see special instructions) and turn.

Next row - Rib 184 sts, wrap next st and turn.

Next row - Rib to wrapped st, rib this st together with the yarn wrapping it (see special instructions), wrap next st and turn.

Next row - Rib to wrapped st, rib this st together with the yarn wrapping it, wrap next st and turn.

Continue as now set, so that as each row is worked, one more stitch is worked at each turn.

Work 52 rows. You will now have worked across all stitches.

Keeping rib sts correct, cast off.

CUFFS

Place markers at side (row end) edges, 15cm, 16ins up from top of rib, and down from commencement of collar.

Pick up and Knit 96 sts between markers, work in K3, P3 rib for 27 rows.

Cast off in rib.

MAKING UP

Join work at cuffs for 28cm, 11ins by top sewing.



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
