

THE WHISKY SOUR SHIRT FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

SIZES: 1 (2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9)

Choose a size that allows for an intended positive ease of 2 to 6" / 5 to 15 cm around the chest.



A- CHEST CIRCUMFERENCE

33 (36¼, 39¾, 44¼, 48½, 52, 55¾, 60, 64)"
82.5 (91, 99.5, 111, 121.5, 130, 139.5, 150, 160.5) CM

B- RAGLAN DEPTH

10 (10½, 11¼, 12, 12¾, 13¼, 13¼, 14, 14¼)"
25 (26.5, 28, 30, 31.5, 33, 33, 34.5, 35.5) CM

C- UPPER ARM CIRCUMFERENCE

13½ (14¼, 15½, 16½, 17¾, 18½, 20¼, 21½, 22¼)"
33.5 (36, 39, 41, 44, 46.5, 50.5, 53.5, 56) CM

D- BODY LENGTH

13 (13, 13½, 14, 14½, 15, 15½, 16, 16½)"
33 (33, 34.5, 35.5, 37, 38, 39.5, 40.5, 42) CM

E- SLEEVE LENGTH

5½ (5½, 6, 6, 6, 6, 6¾, 6¾, 6¾)"

SUPPLIES

YARN

WEIGHT: SPORT

686 (784, 919, 1037, 1178, 1325, 1486, 1634, 1772) YD

627 (717, 840, 948, 1077, 1212, 1359, 1494, 1620) M

3 (3, 3, 4, 4, 5, 5, 5, 6) SKEINS OF COTTON LINO FROM THE WANDERING FLOCK

Sample shown in Cotton Lino from The Wandering Flock (35% Organic Cotton, 30% Mulberry Silk, 20% Linen, 15% Alpaca; 328 yd / 300 m per 100 g skein), in the "Burnt Sienna" colourway.

Max is wearing a **SIZE 4** and is 5'11" / 180.5 cm with a 38" / 96.5 cm chest circumference.

NEEDLES

MAIN NEEDLES: CIRCULAR, US 5 / 3.75 MM, OR SIZE NEEDED TO MATCH GAUGE

DETAILS NEEDLES: CIRCULAR, US 3 / 3.25 MM, OR 0.5 MM SMALLER THAN MAIN NEEDLES

Double-pointed needles in the same two sizes for the sleeves, if you're not using the magic-loop method. The cast-on and collar are best worked with circular needles at least 47" / 120 cm in length.

GAUGE

19 STITCHES AND 26 ROWS = 4" / 10 CM IN PATTERN, WORKED FLAT, BLOCKED

Pattern for gauge (cast on a multiple of 2 stitches)

ROW 1: K to end.

ROW 2: [K1, p1] to end.

ROW 3: K to end.

ROW 4: [P1, k1] to end.

NOTIONS

STITCH MARKERS (8), STITCH HOLDERS OR WASTE YARN, TAPESTRY NEEDLE, 15MM BUTTONS (5)

THE WHISKY SOUR SHIRT INSTRUCTIONS

THE *WHISKY SOUR* IS KNITTED FLAT WITH RAGLAN SLEEVES. FIRST, A FAUX “DOUBLE STOCKINETTE” COLLAR IS KNITTED IN THE ROUND FROM AN INVISIBLE CAST-ON. SHORT ROWS ARE WORKED INTO THE COLLAR AND AT THE START OF THE BODY TO LENGTHEN THE BACK. THE BUTTON BAND IS ADDED LAST BY PICKING UP STITCHES ALONG THE FRONT EDGE.

COLLAR

With details needles, CO 158 (170, 174, 174, 174, 178, 178, 182, 182) sts using the Turkish cast-on. Join to work in the rnd. Pm to indicate BOR.

SETUP RND: K79 (85, 87, 87, 87, 89, 89, 91, 91), pm to indicate middle, k to end, sm.

RND 1: K to end, sm.

Work **RND 1** until collar measures 2¼" / 5.5 cm from cast-on edge.

COLLAR SHAPING

In the following section, you will be working back and forth using German short rows to add some length to the back of the collar.

FIRST HALF

SHORT ROW 1 (RS): K60 (64, 66, 66, 66, 67, 67, 69, 69), turn.

SHORT ROW 2 (WS): Make a ds, p40 (42, 44, 44, 44, 44, 44, 46, 46), turn.

SHORT ROW 3: Make a ds, k to 2 sts before ds from previous row, turn.

SHORT ROW 4: Make a ds, p to 2 sts before ds from previous row, turn.

SHORT ROWS 5-10: Work **SHORT ROWS 3** and **4** a further 3 times.

Resolve the doubled stitches in the next round by knitting both legs together as a single stitch.

SHORT ROW 11 (RS): Make a ds, k to middle m, sm.

SECOND HALF

You will now repeat the same instructions for the second half of the stitches to extend the inside of the collar by the same length.

Work **SHORT ROWS 1** to **10** one more time.

SHORT ROW 11 (RS): Make a ds, k to end, sm.

NEXT RND: K to end, sm.

You will now rearrange the stitches to close the collar opening by slipping them on another pair of needles. Distribute the stitches on your needles so that half the stitches are on the front needle, and half on the back needle, as if to work a three-needle bind-off. Use the middle marker to guide you.

Using main needles and another cable, remove m, *sl1 from the back needle to the main needles, sl1 from the front needle to the main needles*; repeat *-* to end. Remove middle m.

THE WHISKY SOUR SHIRT INSTRUCTIONS

In the next setup row, you will close the collar by working together one stitch from the front of the collar with one stitch from the back. At the same time, you will be placing markers to define the raglan lines and, for most sizes, increasing or decreasing stitches by omitting a "p2tog" or by working a "p3tog" instead.

SIZE 1 ONLY

SETUP ROW (RS, dec): K2tog, p2tog × 8, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 9, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog, [**p3tog**, p2tog × 4] 4 times, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 9, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 8, k2tog. *81 sts dec'd*

SIZE 2 ONLY

SETUP ROW (RS, dec): K2tog, p2tog × 10, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 9, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 25, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 9, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 10, k2tog. *85 sts dec'd*

SIZE 3 ONLY

SETUP ROW (RS, dec): K2tog, p2tog × 10, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 9, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, **p2**, p2tog × 25, **p2**, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 9, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 10, k2tog. *85 sts dec'd*

SIZE 4 ONLY

SETUP ROW (RS, dec): K2tog, p2tog × 12, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 5, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 31, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 5, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 12, k2tog. *87 sts dec'd*

SIZE 5 ONLY

SETUP ROW (RS, dec): K2tog, **p2**, p2tog × 10, **p2**, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 5, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 7, [**p2**, p2tog × 5] 4 times, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 5, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, **p2**, p2tog × 10, **p2**, k2tog. *79 sts dec'd*

SIZE 6 ONLY

SETUP ROW (RS, dec): K2tog, [**p2**, p2tog × 2] 4 times, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 5, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, [p2tog × 5, **p2**] 5 times, p2tog × 2, **p2**, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 5, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, [**p2**, p2tog × 2] 4 times, k2tog. *75 sts dec'd*

SIZE 7 ONLY

SETUP ROW (RS, dec): K2tog, p2tog, [**p2**, p2tog × 3] 3 times, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, **p2**, p2tog, **p2**, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, [**p2**, p2tog × 6] 4 times, **p2**, p2tog × 5, **p2**, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, **p2**, p2tog, **p2**, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, [**p2**, p2tog × 3] 3 times, p2tog, k2tog. *73 sts dec'd*

THE WHISKY SOUR SHIRT INSTRUCTIONS

SIZE 8 ONLY

SETUP ROW (RS, dec): K2tog, p2tog × 3, [p2, p2tog] 5 times, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2, p2tog, p2, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 5, [p2, p2tog × 3] 8 times, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2, p2tog, p2, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 3, [p2, p2tog] 5 times, k2tog. *69 sts dec'd*

SIZE 9 ONLY

SETUP ROW (RS, dec): K2tog, [p2, p2tog] 6 times, p2tog × 2, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 3, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 4, [p2, p2tog] 14 times, p2tog, x 3, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 3, pm, k2tog × 2, p2tog, k2tog × 2, pm, p2tog × 2, [p2, p2tog] 6 times, k2tog. *65 sts dec'd*

YOU SHOULD HAVE 77 (85, 89, 87, 95, 103, 105, 113, 117) STS ON YOUR NEEDLES, DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS: 9 (11, 11, 13, 15, 17, 17, 19, 21) STS FOR EACH FRONT PANEL, 21 (25, 29, 31, 35, 39, 41, 45, 49) STS FOR THE BACK, 9 (9, 9, 5, 5, 5, 5, 3) STS FOR EACH SLEEVE AND 5 STS PER RAGLAN LINE.

BACK SHAPING

In the following section, you will be working back and forth using German short rows to add some length to the back of the shirt. Resolve the doubled stitches by knitting both legs together as a single stitch.

SHORT ROW 1 (WS): *[P1, k1] to 1 st before m, p1, sm, p2, k1, p2, sm*; repeat *-* 3 more times, p1, turn.

SHORT ROW 2 (RS): Make a ds, m1r, sm, k2, p1, k2, sm, m1l, [k to m, m1r, sm, k2, p1, k2, sm, m1l] 3 times, k1, turn. *8 sts inc'd*

SHORT ROW 3: Make a ds, [p1, k1] to 1 st before m, p1, sm, p2, k1, p2, sm, *[p1, k1] to 1 st before m, p1, sm, p2, k1, p2, sm*; repeat *-* twice more, [p1, k1] to 1 st before ds from previous row, p1, resolve the ds, p1, turn.

SHORT ROW 4: Make a ds, [k to m, m1r, sm, k2, p1, k2, sm, m1l] 4 times, k to ds from previous row, resolve the ds, k1, turn. *8 sts inc'd*

SHORT ROWS 5-12: Work **SHORT ROWS 3** and **4** a further 4 times. *32 sts inc'd*

SHORT ROW 13: Make a ds, [p1, k1] to 1 st before m, p1, sm, p2, k1, p2, sm, *[p1, k1] to 1 st before m, p1, sm, p2, k1, p2, sm*; repeat *-* twice more, [p1, k1] to 1 st before ds from previous row, p1, resolve the ds, [p1, k1] to last st, p1.

THE WHISKY SOUR SHIRT INSTRUCTIONS

SHORT ROW 14: [K to m, m1r, sm, k2, p1, k2, sm, m1l] 4 times, k to ds from previous row, resolve the ds, k to end. *8 sts inc'd*

YOU SHOULD HAVE 133 (141, 145, 143, 151, 159, 161, 169, 173) STS ON YOUR NEEDLES, DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS: 16 (18, 18, 20, 22, 24, 24, 26, 28) STS FOR EACH FRONT PANEL, 35 (39, 43, 45, 49, 53, 55, 59, 63) STS FOR THE BACK, 23 (23, 23, 19, 19, 19, 19, 19, 17) STS FOR EACH SLEEVE AND 5 STS PER RAGLAN LINE.

RAGLAN

ROW 1 (WS): P1, *[p1, k1] to 1 st before m, p1, sm, p2, k1, p2, sm*; repeat *-* 3 more times, [p1, k1] to last 2 sts, p2.

ROW 2 (RS): [K to m, m1r, sm, k2, p1, k2, sm, m1l] 4 times, k to end. *8 sts inc'd*

ROW 3: *[P1, k1] to 1 st before m, p1, sm, p2, k1, p2, sm*; repeat *-* 3 more times, [p1, k1] to last st, p1.

ROW 4: Work **ROW 2**. *8 sts inc'd*

Work **ROWS 1** to **4** a further 4 (5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 14, 15, 16) times. *64 (80, 96, 128, 144, 160, 224, 240, 256) sts inc'd*

Work **ROWS 1** and **2** once more. *8 sts inc'd*

YOU SHOULD HAVE 221 (245, 265, 295, 319, 343, 409, 433, 453) STS ON YOUR NEEDLES, DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS: 27 (31, 33, 39, 43, 47, 55, 59, 63) STS FOR EACH FRONT PANEL, 57 (65, 73, 83, 91, 99, 117, 125, 133) STS FOR THE BACK, 45 (49, 53, 57, 61, 65, 81, 85, 87) STS FOR EACH SLEEVE AND 5 STS PER RAGLAN LINE.

SIZES 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 & 6 ONLY

ROW 1 (WS): *[P1, k1] to 1 st before m, p1, sm, p2, k1, p2, sm*; repeat *-* 3 more times, [p1, k1] to last st, p1.

ROW 2 (RS): *K to m, sm, k2, p1, k2, sm*; repeat *-* 3 more times, k to end.

ROW 3: P2, *[k1, p1] to 1 st before m, k1, sm, p2, k1, p2, sm*; repeat *-* 3 more times, [k1, p1] to last st, p1.

ROW 4: *K to m, m1r, sm, k2, p1, k2, sm, m1l*; repeat *-* 3 more times, k to end. *8 sts inc'd*

ROW 5: P1, *[k1, p1] to 1 st before m, k1, sm, p2, k1, p2, sm*; repeat *-* 3 more times, [k1, p1] to end.

ROW 6: Work **ROW 2**.

ROW 7: P1, *[p1, k1] to 1 st before m, p1, sm, p2, k1, p2, sm*; repeat *-* 3 more times, [p1, k1] to last 2 sts, p2.

ROW 8: Work **ROW 4**. *8 sts inc'd*

Work **ROWS 1** to **8** once more. *16 sts inc'd*

ALL SIZES RESUME

NEXT ROW (WS): *[P1, k1] to 1 st before m, p1, sm, p2, k1, p2, sm*; repeat *-* 3 more times, [p1, k1] to last st, p1.

YOU SHOULD HAVE 253 (277, 297, 327, 351, 375, 409, 433, 453) STS ON YOUR NEEDLES, DIVIDED AS FOLLOWS: 31 (35, 37, 43, 47, 51, 55, 59, 63) STS FOR EACH FRONT PANEL, 65 (73, 81, 91, 99, 107, 117, 125, 133) STS FOR THE BACK, 53 (57, 61, 65, 69, 73, 81, 85, 87) STS FOR EACH SLEEVE AND 5 STS PER RAGLAN LINE.

THE WHISKY SOUR SHIRT INSTRUCTIONS

SEPARATING BODY FROM SLEEVES

When separating body from sleeves, two stitches from each raglan line will be added to the sleeve stitches placed on hold. The remaining three stitches will be added to the body.

NEXT ROW (RS): K to m, rm, k3, place the next 2 sts on hold using waste yarn or a stitch holder, rm, place the next 53 (57, 61, 65, 69, 73, 81, 85, 87) sts for the first sleeve on hold, rm, place the next 2 sts on hold. Using the backwards loop method CO 7 (7, 9, 9, 11, 11, 11, 13, 15) sts, k3, rm, k to m, rm, k3, place the next 2 sts on hold using waste yarn or a stitch holder, rm, place the next 53 (57, 61, 65, 69, 73, 81, 85, 87) sts for the second sleeve on hold, rm, place the next 2 sts on hold. Using the backwards loop method CO 7 (7, 9, 9, 11, 11, 11, 13, 15) sts, k3, rm, k to end.

YOU SHOULD HAVE 153 (169, 185, 207, 227, 243, 261, 281, 301) STS ON YOUR NEEDLES.

BODY

ROW 1 (WS): P1, [p1, k1] to last 2 sts, p2.

ROW 2 (RS): K to end.

ROW 3: P1, [k1, p1] to end.

ROW 4: Work **ROW 2**.

Work **ROWS 1 to 4** until the shirt measures 12 (12, 12½, 13, 13½, 14, 14½, 15, 15½)" / 30.5 (30.5, 32, 33, 34.5, 35.5, 37, 38, 39.5) cm from the underarm, or 1" / 2.5 cm less than your desired finished length, ending after a **ROW 4**.

Work **ROW 1** once more.

BOTTOM BORDER

NEXT ROW (RS): K1, p to last st, k1.

Switch to detail needles.

ROW 1 (WS): P to end.

ROW 2 (RS): K to end.

Work **ROWS 1 and 2** until the border measures 2" / 5 cm.

BO all sts loosely. Break yarn, leaving a tail long enough to attach the bottom border (about three times the width of the shirt).

Fold the bottom border inside the shirt. Thread a tapestry needle with the yarn tail. Sew the bound-off edge to the first row of the bottom border.

THE WHISKY SOUR SHIRT INSTRUCTIONS

SHORT SLEEVES

Place the 57 (61, 65, 69, 73, 77, 85, 89, 91) held sts for one sleeve on the main needles. Pick up and k3 (3, 5, 5, 5, 5, 5, 7, 7) sts from the underarm starting in the middle of the cast-on edge from the body, k to end, pick up and k4 (4, 4, 4, 6, 6, 6, 6, 8) sts from the underarm. Pm to indicate BOR and join to work in the rnd.

YOU SHOULD HAVE 64 (68, 74, 78, 84, 88, 96, 102, 106) STS ON YOUR NEEDLES.

RND 1: [K1, p1] to end, sm.

RND 2: K to end, sm.

RND 3: [P1, k1] to end, sm.

RND 4: Work **RND 2**.

Work **RNDS 1** to **4** a total of 2 (2, 3, 3, 3, 3, 4, 4, 4) times.

Because an odd number of stitches was casted on for the underarm, the decreases are centered around the last stitch, not the marker.

RND 1: [K1, p1] to m, sm.

RND 2 (DEC): K2tog, k to last 3 sts, ssk, k1, sm. *2 sts dec'd*

RND 3: Work **RND 1**.

RND 4: K to end, sm.

RND 5: [P1, k1] to m, sm.

RND 6 (DEC): Work **RND 2**. *2 sts dec'd*

RND 7: Work **RND 5**.

RND 8: Work **RND 4**.

Work **RNDS 1** to **8** once more. *4 sts dec'd*

Work **RNDS 1** to **5**. *2 sts dec'd*

YOU SHOULD HAVE 54 (58, 64, 68, 74, 78, 86, 92, 96) STS ON YOUR NEEDLES.

CUFF

NEXT RND: P to end, sm.

Switch to detail needles.

RND 1: K to end, sm.

Work **RND 1** until the cuff measures 2" / 5 cm.

BO all sts loosely. Break the yarn, leaving a tail long enough to attach the cuff (about three times the circumference of the sleeve).

Fold the cuff inside the sleeve. Thread a tapestry needle with the yarn tail. Sew the bound-off edge to the first round of the cuff.

Work the second sleeve the same way.

THE WHISKY SOUR SHIRT INSTRUCTIONS

RIGHT FRONT BAND

When picking up stitches from the bottom border, pick up through the outside of the border only.

Using the detail needles and RS facing, pick up and knit 81 (84, 87, 92, 98, 102, 104, 110, 114) sts across the right front panel, or about 2 sts every 3 rows. Do not pick-up sts from the collar.

ROW 1 (WS): P to last st, sl1 wyif.

ROW 2 (RS): K to last st, sl1 wyib.

Work **ROWS 1** and **2** a total of 8 times.

Work **ROW 1** once more.

BO all sts loosely. Break yarn, leaving a tail long enough to attach the band (about three times the length of the band).

Fold the band towards the inside of the shirt. Thread a tapestry needle with the yarn tail. Sew the bound-off edge to the first row of the band.

For the bottom border, sew the bound-off edge of the band to the inside of the border to close the end.

Fold the top corner inside the band and sew it to the bound-off edge.

Sew the bottom end of the band to close it.

LEFT FRONT BAND

When picking up stitches from the bottom border, pick up through the outside of the border only.

Using the detail needles and RS facing, pick up and knit 81 (84, 87, 92, 98, 102, 104, 110, 114) sts across the left front panel, or about 2 sts every 3 rows. Do not pick-up sts from the collar.

ROW 1 (WS): P to last st, sl1 wyif.

ROW 2 (RS): K to last st, sl1 wyib.

Work **ROW 1** once more.

BUTTONHOLE ROW (RS): [K11 (12, 12, 13, 14, 15, 15, 16, 17), yo, k2tog] 5 times, k to last st, sl1 wyib.

Work **ROWS 1** and **2** a total of 4 times.

Work **ROW 1** once more.

Work **BUTTONHOLE ROW**.

Work **ROW 1** once more.

BO all sts loosely. Break yarn, leaving a tail long enough to attach the band (about three times the length of the band).

THE WHISKY SOUR SHIRT INSTRUCTIONS



Fold the band towards the inside of the shirt. Thread a tapestry needle with the yarn tail. Sew the bound-off edge to the first row of the band.

For the bottom border, sew the bound-off edge of the band to the inside of the border to close the end.


Fold the top corner inside the band and sew it to the bound-off edge.

Sew the bottom end of the band to close it.

FINISHING

Block to measurements. Weave in ends. Attach five buttons to the right front band.

THE WHISKY SOUR SHIRT ABBREVIATIONS



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BO bind off

BOR beginning of round

CO cast on

DEC('D) decrease(d)

DS doubled stitch: Slip the next stitch with yarn in front. Bring the yarn over the right needle to the back and pull on the slipped stitch to distort it. It will look as if there are two stitches instead of one, because the two legs of the stitch below will come up on the needle.

INC('D) increase(d)

K knit

K2TOG knit two stitches together

M marker

M1L make one left-leaning stitch

M1R make one right-leaning stitch

P purl

P2(3)TOG purl two (three) stitches together

PM place marker

RM remove marker

RND(S) round(s)

RS right side

SL slip purlwise

SM slip marker

SSK slip, slip, knit: Slip the next two stitches, knitwise, individually. Return them to the left needle without twisting and knit them together through the back loop.

ST(S) stitch(es)

WS wrong side

WYIB with yarn in back

WYIF with yarn in front

YO yarn over
