SKILL

Knitting

DIFFICULTY

Easy

SIZES

1 (2, 3)

Shown in size 1 with approximately 6½" of positive ease.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest: 38½ (57½, 76¾)"

Length: 21½ (23½, 25½)"

MATERIALS

[Universal Yarn Cotton Supreme](#) (100% cotton; 100g/180 yds)

- 610 Navy (A) – 2 (2, 3) skeins
- 608 Powder Blue (B) – 2 (2, 3) skeins
- 502 White (C) – 2 (3, 4) skeins

Needles: US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 24-40" circular (depending on size worked) and set of DPNs (or your preferred needle for knitting small circumferences) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle, stitch markers, stitch holders or waste yarn, spare US Size 7 circ ndl (for three-needle bind-off)

GAUGE

20 sts x 24 rows/rnds = 4" in Waves Patt, *after blocking*

Save time, check your gauge.

PATTERN NOTES

The perfect marriage of an undulating stitch pattern with our soft and luxuriant Cotton Supreme yarn, the Wind and Waves top evokes feelings of summery days spent on sandy beaches. Ideal for styling with a pair of shorts or your favorite skirt, this top is bound to become a staple piece in your warm-weather wardrobe.

This top is knit seamlessly in the round from the bottom up. The body features a wave lace pattern that is worked in a stripe sequence. Change the colors as indicated in the pattern. You may choose to weave in ends as you go to save time. The Front and Back are separated at the armholes and worked individually to the shoulders, which are joined using the three-needle bind-off. Stitches for the neck and armholes are picked up and worked in the round after finishing using a contrasting color.

This top is written with a sizing structure that allows for a generous fit across clustered sizing. Please choose a size that best meets the amount of positive ease required for the fit you prefer.

STITCH GUIDE

Waves

(multiple of 24 sts, knit in the rnd)

Rnds 1-5: Knit to end.

Rnd 6: K9, [yo k1] 7 times, yo, k8.

Rnd 7: [K2tog] 4 times, [k1, k1tbl] 8 times, [k2tog] 4 times.

Rnd 8: Purl to end.

Rep Rows 1-8 for patt.

Garter Waves

(multiple of 24 sts, knit in the rnd)

Rnd 1: Knit to end.

Rnd 2: Purl to end.

Rnds 3-4: Rep Rnds 1-2.

Rnd 5: Rep Rnd 1.

Rnd 6: P9, [yo, p1] 7 times, yo, p8.

Rnd 7: [K2tog] 4 times, [k1, k1tbl] 8 times, [k2tog] 4 times.

Rnd 8: Purl to end.

Rep Rnds 1-8 for patt.

Garter Waves

(multiple of 24 sts, knit flat)

Row 1 (RS): Knit to end.

Row 2 (WS): Knit to end.

Rows 3-4: Rep Rows 1-2.

Row 5: Rep Row 1.

Row 6: K8 [yo, k1] 7 times, yo, k9.

Row 7: [K2tog] 4 times, [k1, k1tbl] 8 times, [k2tog] 4 times.

Row 8: Knit to end.

Rep Rows 1-8 for patt.

PATTERN BEGINS

BODY

With color A, cast on 192 (288, 384) sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd, being careful not to twist. Work in garter stitch for 4 rows.

Waves Pattern Section 1

Note: These stitch patterns are also charted for your convenience. However, please be mindful to refer to written instructions below for color changes.

With color A, work Rnds 1-8 of Waves patt, 2 times. Pattern will be repeated 8 (12, 16) times across each rnd.

Break Color A, join Color B.

With Color B, work Rnds 1-8 of Waves patt, 1 time. Break Color B, join Color C.

With Color C, work Rnds 1-8 of Waves patt, 1 time. Break Color C, join color A.

With Color A, work Rnds 1-8 of Waves patt. 1 time. Break Color A, join Color C.

Garter Waves Section 1

With Color C, work Rnds 1-2 of Garter Waves. Join Color B, do not break color C.

With Color B, work Rnds 3-6 of Garter Waves. Break Color B, cont with color C only.

With Color C, work Rnds 7-8 of Garter Waves. Break Color C, join color A.

Waves Pattern Section 2

With Color A, work Rnds 1-8 of Waves patt, 1 time. Break Color A, join color B.

With Color B, work Rnds 1-8 of Waves patt, 1 time. Break Color B, join color A.

Garter Waves Section 2

With Color A, work Rnds 1-2 of Garter Waves. Join Color C, do not break color A.

With Color C, work Rnds 3-6 of Garter Waves. Break Color C.

Knit, Relax, Smile, Repeat!

With Color A, work Rnds 7-8 of Garter Waves.
Break Color A, join color B.

Waves Pattern Section 3

With Color B, work Rnds 1-8 of Waves patt, 1 time.
Break Color B, join color C.

Garter Waves Section 3

With Color C, work Rnds 1-2 of Garter Waves patt.
Join Color A, do not break color C.

With Color A, work Rnds 3-6 of Garter Waves.
Break Color A, cont with Color C only.

With Color C, work Rnds 7-8 of Garter Waves.
Break Color C, join Color B.

Waves Pattern Section 4

With Color B, work Rnds 1-8 of Waves patt, 1 time.
Join Color A, do not break Color B.

Separate Front and Back

Note 1: Continue in Garter Waves as est'd throughout the next section.

Note 2: You will now be working flat, back and forth in rows.

Row 1 (RS): With Color A, work Row 1 of Garter Waves over 96 (144, 192) Front sts - 4 (6, 8) reps of Garter Waves patt.

Place rem 96 (144, 192) Back sts on holder or waste yarn, remove m. Cont working with Front sts only.

Row 2 (WS): With Color A, work Row 2 of Garter Waves to end. Join Color B, do not break color A.

Rows 3-6: With Color B, work Rows 3-6 of Garter Waves to end.

Rows 7-8: With Color A, work Rows 7-8 of Garter Waves to end.

Break colors A and B, join color C.

Next Row (RS): With Color C, knit to end.

Next Row (WS): With Color C, purl to end.
Cont as est in St st until piece meas approx. 4 (5½, 7½)" from Front/Back separation, ending with a WS Row.

Shape Front Neck

Next Row (RS): Cont as est'd over 36 (57, 77) Left Front sts, bind off center 24 (30, 38) Neck sts, cont as est'd over 36 (57, 77) Right Front sts to end. Place Left Front sts on holder or waste yarn, cont with Right Front sts only.

Shape Right Front Neck

Next Row (WS): Purl to end.

Dec Row (RS): K1, ssk, cont as est'd to end - 1 st dec'd, 35 (56, 76) sts rem.

Even Row (WS): Purl to end.

Rep Dec Row and Even Row, 5 (7, 7) more times - 5 (7, 7) sts dec'd, 30 (49, 69) sts rem.

Cont working even as est'd in St st until piece meas approx. 7½ (9½, 11½)" from Front/Back separation, ending with a WS Row.

Place rem live sts on holder or waste yarn.

Shape Left Front Neck

Return held 36 (57, 77) Left Front sts to ndl, ready to work a WS Row.

Next Row (WS): Purl to end.

Dec Row (RS): Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 - 1 st dec'd, 35 (56, 76) sts rem.

Even Row (WS): Purl to end.

Rep Dec Row and Even Row, 5 (7, 7) more times - 5 (7, 7) sts dec'd, 30 (49, 69) sts rem.

Cont working even as est'd in St st until piece meas approx. 7½ (9½, 11½)" from Front/Back separation, ending with a WS Row.

Place rem live sts on holder or waste yarn.

BACK

Return held 96 (144, 192) Back sts to ndl, ready to work a RS Row.

Row 1 (RS): With Color A, work Row 1 of Garter Waves to end.

Row 2 (WS): With Color A, work Row 2 of Garter Waves to end. Join Color B, do not break color A.

Rows 3-6: With Color B, work Rows 3-6 of Garter Waves to end.

Rows 7-8: With Color A, work Rows 7-8 of Garter Waves to end.

Break colors A and B, join color C.

Next Row (RS): With Color C, knit to end.

Next Row (WS): With Color C, purl to end.

Cont as est in St st until piece meas approx. 4 (5½, 7½)" from Front/Back separation, ending with a WS Row.

Shape Back Neck

Next Row (RS): Cont as est'd over 36 (57, 77) Right Back sts, bind off center 24 (30, 38) neck sts, cont as est'd over 36 (57, 77) Left Back sts to end. Place Right Back sts on holder or waste yarn, cont with Left Back sts only.

Shape Left Back Neck

Next Row (WS): Purl to end.

Dec Row (RS): K1, ssk, cont as est'd to end - 1 st dec'd, 35 (56, 76) sts rem.

Even Row (WS): Purl to end.

Rep Dec Row and Even Row, 5 (7, 7) more times - 5 (7, 7) sts dec'd, 30 (49, 69) sts rem.

Cont working even as est'd in St st until piece meas approx. 7½ (9½, 11½)" from Front/Back separation, ending with a WS Row.

Place rem live sts on holder or waste yarn.

Shape Right Back Neck

Return held 36 (57, 77) Right Back sts to ndl, ready to work a WS Row.

Next Row (WS): Purl to end.

Dec Row (RS): Knit to last 3 sts, k2tog, k1 - 1 st dec'd, 35 (56, 76) sts rem.

Even Row (WS): Purl to end.

Rep Dec Row and Even Row, 5 (7, 7) more times - 5 (7, 7) sts dec'd, 30 (49, 69) sts rem.

Cont working even as est'd in St st until piece meas approx. 7½ (9½, 11½)" from Front/Back separation, ending with a WS Row.

Place rem live sts on holder or waste yarn.

rnd(s)	round(s)
RS	right side
ssk	slip next 2 sts individually knitwise, slip them back to left needle in this position, knit them together through the back loops (1 st dec'd)
St st	Stockinette stitch (knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows; in the rnd, knit every rnd)
st(s)	stitch(es)
tbl	through the back loop(s)
WS	wrong side
yo	yarn over

FINISHING

With RS facing and Color C, join Left Front and Left Back shoulder sts using the three-needle bind-off. Rep for Right Front and Right Back sts. Gently wash and block to finished measurements. Weave in any rem ends.

Neck Edging

With color A, and beg at Left Front shoulder, pick up and knit 56 (70, 78) sts around the Front neck opening, and 56 (70, 78) sts around the Back neck opening - 112 (140, 156) sts. PM and join to knit in the rnd.

Work 4 rnds in garter stitch. Bind off all sts loosely kwise.

Armhole Edging

With Color A, and beg at center of underarm, pick up and knit 72 (92, 112) sts around armhole. PM and join to knit in the rnd.

Knit 4 rows in garter stitch. Bind off all sts loosely kwise.

Rep for other armhole.






Waves (knit in the round)

- k2tog with color A, B, or C, k2tog


