Windswept

Hood

MATERIALS

3 balls of **Highland Wool** col. Cappuccino (04)
Approx: 413 meters / 451yards

Circular needles, 4mm / US 6, 80 cm / 32"
length.

Stitch markers
Tapestry needle
Stitch holders

YARN QUALITY

 **Highland Wool**, Hobbii
100 % wool
50 g (1.75 oz) = 175 m (191 yds)

GAUGE

22 sts x 37 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"
In Stockinette stitch

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Total Length: 67cm / 26.5"

Hood height: 43cm / 17.5"

Depth of Hood Opening: 23cm / 10"

PATTERN INFORMATION

The Windswept Hood draws on Scandinavian design efficiency, combining an elegant scarf with a protective head cover. The piece is worked flat from the rear of the hood to the scarf ends, in classic all-over stockinette with wind swirl accents. Folded and seamed at the back, it features an all-over I-cord trim for a pretty and functional edge preventing the stitches from rolling.

Knit flat back and forth from the back of the hood to the opening, then to the end of each scarf. Knit using just one needle size.

The techniques used in the pattern include lace eyelets, i-cord edging, increases, decreases, and stockinette. The pattern contains chart instructions.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = approximately

Bo = bind off

Co = cast on

K = knit

K2tog = knit two stitches together

LN = left needle

M = marker

P = purl

Pm = place marker

Pssso = pass slipped stitch over

Pwise = purlwise

P2tog = purl 2 stitches together

Rem = remain

Rep = repeat

RN = right needle

RS = right side

Sl = slip

Slm = slip marker

Sl2-K1-P2sso = Slip 2 stitches knitwise from LN to RN, K1 pass the 2 slipped stitches over.

Ssk = slip, slip, knit

Ssp = slip, slip, purl

St(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side

Yb = yarn held in back

Yf = yarn held in front


Yo = yarn over

Increases

M1L (make one left leaning increase) = Insert the LN from front to back, under the bar between the Sts, lifting it onto the LN. Then knit this bar through the back loop.

M1R (make one right leaning increase) = Insert the LN from back to front, under the bar between the Sts, lifting it onto the LN. Then knit this bar through the front loop.

MEASUREMENTS



HOOD

With gauge sized needle and long tail method or your preferred method, Co 193 Sts. Turn work to WS and work the following row.

Set Up Row [WS]: Yf, Sl1 Pwise, Yb, K1, Yf, Sl1 Pwise, K31, Pm, P62, Pm, P1, Pm, P62, Pm, K31, Yf, Sl1 Pwise, Yb, K1, Yf, Sl1 Pwise. Turn.

Note: Sl all Sts Pwise unless otherwise instructed.

CHART INSTRUCTIONS

Work **Chart 1** from right to left starting at Row 1, Column 1, RS. **Note:** Sl all Sts Pwise.

All RS Rows: K1, Yf, Sl1, Yb, K1, work Appropriate Chart Row, Slm, K to next M, M1R, Slm, K1, Slm, M1L, K to next M, Slm Work Appropriate Chart Row, K1, Yf, Sl1, Yb, K1. Turn. 2 Sts inc on each RS Row.

All WS Rows: Yf, Sl1, Yb, K1, Yf, Sl1, Work Appropriate Chart Row, Slm, P31, Slm, P to last M, Slm, Work Appropriate Chart Row, Yf, Sl1, Yb, K1, Yf, Sl1.

WS: Purl

RS: Slip 2, k1, pss0

until 1 St Rem on LN before the M. Sl the 2 Sts on the RN back to the LN and work the left scarf 37 Sts starting on Row 1, Column 1 of Chart.

LEFT SCARF

Chart 2 part 1 + 2

Work chart shown first from Rows 1-65, then work the next chart shown from Rows 66-130. Bo Rem Sts. Scarf measures approx. 67cm /26.5" from Co edge. Work right scarf.

RIGHT SCARF

Chart 2 part 1 + 2

With RS facing, place on hold 34 Sts back on gauge sized needle. Rejoin yarn, pick up and K3 Sts from the hood edge. 37 Sts total. Work the Left Scarf instructions starting on Row 2 (WS) of chart.




FINISHING FOR WRITTEN AND CHART INSTRUCTIONS

From the RS, fold the Co edge double mid back of hood and sew with grafting Sts. Weave in loose ends, block if necessary, wear with delight!
