





# Wings

“They planted fear, but we grew wings.” Inspired by the song *Sin Miedo* by Vivir Quintana, this sweater’s crystals represent the stars, each a woman whose life was tragically cut short. Wings is dedicated to the memory of all women who have been victims of femicide, emphasising the importance of awareness and remembrance.

## SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9)

Recommended ease: 4.5-9" / 11.5-23 cm of positive ease.

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Bust Circumference: 38.5 (41, 46, 48.75, 53.75) (59, 61.5, 66.5, 69)" / 96 (102, 115, 121, 134) (147, 153, 166, 173) cm.

Upper Arm Circumference: 15.5 (15.5, 16.75, 18, 19.25) (23, 23, 24.5, 24.5)" / 39.5 (39.5, 42.5, 45.5, 49) (58.5, 58.5, 62, 62) cm.

Length from Underarm to Hem: 12 (12.5, 13, 13.5, 14) (14.5, 15, 15.5, 16)" / 30.5 (32, 33, 34.5, 35.5) (37, 38, 39.5, 40.5) cm.

Sleeve Length: 16.5 (17, 17, 17.5, 17.5) (18, 18, 18.5, 18.5)" / 42 (43, 43, 44.5, 44.5) (45.5, 45.5, 47, 47) cm.

## MATERIALS

Yarn: 5 (5, 5, 6, 7) (8, 8, 9, 10) skeins of Sensai by Ito (60% mohair, 40% silk, 262 yds / 240 m - 20 g), colourway Charcoal.

Or approx. 1050 (1106, 1312, 1477, 1661) (1919, 2025, 2281, 2434) yds / 961 (1012, 1200, 1351, 1519) (1755, 1852, 2086, 2226) m of lace-weight silk mohair.

Needles: US 1 / 2.25 mm 24" / 60 cm circular needles and set of DPNs. US 1.5 / 2.5 mm 16" / 40 cm and 32" / 80 cm circular needles. US 5 / 3.75 mm spare needle, any length.

Notions: Size 14 / 0.5 mm crochet hook, or other preferred beading method. Removable stitch markers, stitch holders or waste yarn, tapestry needle, 3 mm beads.

## GAUGE

25 sts x 40 rows to 4" / 10 cm on US 1.5 / 2.5 mm

needles in lace path, after blocking.

## CROCHET HOOK BEADING DIRECTIONS

Beads are placed while knitting.

## DIRECTIONS

This pullover is worked top down with raglan shaping. The sleeves are worked straight and gathered at the cuff. The neck is finished with an i-cord bind-off and picked up to work the collar. Beads are placed while knitting by using a crochet hook.

## RAGLAN

With US 1.5 / 2.5 mm needles, CO 116 (132, 148, 148, 164) (180, 196, 212, 228) sts using the Long-Tail CO Method. Pl BOR m and join for working in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts.

SET-UP RND 1: K20 (24, 28, 28, 32) (32, 36, 40, 44), PM, k1, PM, k16 (16, 16, 16, 16) (24, 24, 24, 24), PM, k1, PM, k40 (48, 56, 56, 64) (64, 72, 80, 88), PM, k1, PM, k16 (16, 16, 16, 16) (24, 24, 24, 24), PM, k1, PM, k20 (24, 28, 28, 32) (32, 36, 40, 44). BOR is at centre back.

SET-UP RND 2: P to end.

Work back neck shaping as follows:

SHORT ROW 1 (RS): K to 4 (4, 5, 5, 6) (6, 6, 7, 8) sts past 4th m, SMs as you get to them, tw.

SHORT ROW 2 (WS): MDS, k to BOR m, SMs as you get to them, SM, k to 4 (4, 5, 5, 6) (6, 6, 7, 8) sts past 4th m, SMs as you get to them, tw.

SHORT ROW 3: MDS, k to 8 sts bef prev DS, SMs as you get to them, tw.

SHORT ROW 4: MDS, k to 8 sts bef prev DS, SMs as you get to them, tw.

SHORT ROW 5: MDS, k to 10 sts bef prev DS, SMs as you get to them, tw.

SHORT ROW 6: MDS, k to 10 sts bef prev DS, SMs as you get to them, tw.

NEXT RND: P to BOR m, SM, k to BOR working all DS as p2tog.





**NEXT RND:** Rem BOR m, k to 1st m, replace this m with BOR m. The BOR is now at back right raglan.

#### Raglan Increases

**RND 1 (INC):** K1, SM, m1l, work chart A, m1r, SM, k1, SM, m1l, work chart, m1r, SM, k1, SM, m1l, work chart, m1r. (8 sts inc'd)

**RND 2:** Work chart, SMS as you get to them.

Rep Rnds 1–2 until you've worked Chart A 3 (3, 4, 4, 5) (6, 6, 6, 6) times. Work Chart A once more, ending after rnd 15 (15, 7, 15, 7) (7, 7, 15, 15).

[372 (388, 436, 468, 516) (596, 612, 660, 676) sts total: 104 (112, 128, 136, 152) (168, 176, 192, 200) sts for back, 104 (112, 128, 136, 152) (168, 176, 192, 200) sts for front, 80 (80, 88, 96, 104) (128, 128, 136, 136) sts for each sleeve and 4 raglan sts]

Separate sleeves from body as follows:

**NEXT RND:** \*Place sleeve sts plus 2 raglan sts onto stitch holder; CO 16 sts for underarm\* placing BOR m in centre of CO sts to mark new BOR. K across front, work \*-\* once more, placing m in centre of CO sts to mark side, k to end. [82 (82, 90, 98, 106) (130, 130, 138, 138) sts held for each sleeve, and 240 (256, 288, 304, 336) (368, 384, 416, 432) sts for body]

#### BODY

Work even following Chart B, starting on Rnd 1 (1, 9, 1, 9) (9, 9, 1, 1) until the work measures 10 (10.5, 11, 11.5, 12) (12.5, 13, 13.5, 14)" / 25.5 (26.5, 28, 29, 30.5) (32, 33, 34.5, 35.5) cm from the underarm.

Change to US 1 / 2.25 mm needles.

Work hem shaping as follows:

**SHORT ROW 1 (RS):** (K1, p1) twice, k1, tw.

**SHORT ROW 2 (WS):** MDS, cont in 1 x 1 rib patt to 5 sts past side m, SMS as you get to them, tw.

**SHORT ROW 3:** MDS, cont in 1 x 1 rib patt to 6 sts bef prev DS, SMS as you get to them, tw.

**SHORT ROW 4:** MDS, cont in 1 x 1 rib patt to 6 sts bef prev DS, SMS as you get to them, tw.  
Rep Rows 3–4, 2 more times.

**NEXT ROW (RS):** Cont in 1 x 1 rib patt, resolve DS as k2tog or p2tog to cont in 1 x 1 rib patt.

**RND 1:** Cont in 1 x 1 rib patt, resolve DS as k2tog or p2tog to cont in 1 x 1 rib patt.

**RND 2:** \*K1, p1\*, rep \*-\* to end.

Rep Rnd 2 for 1 x 1 rib until it measures 2" / 5 cm.

BO loosely using the Suspended BO Method.

#### SLEEVES

Place held sts onto US 1.5 / 2.5 mm 16" / 40 cm circular needles or DPNs.

Starting at the centre of underarm, pick up and k 7 sts, k around sleeve sts, pick up and k 7 sts. [96 (96, 104, 112, 120) (144, 144, 152, 152) sts] Place a BOR m and join for working in the rnd.

Work even following Chart B until the sleeve measures 15.5 (16, 16, 16.5, 16.5) (17, 17, 17.5, 17.5)" / 39.5 (40.5, 40.5, 42, 42) (43, 43, 44, 44) cm from the underarm or desired length, ending after either Rnd 7 or Rnd 15 of Chart B.

Change to US 1 / 2.25 mm needles.

Sizes 1, 2, 5, 6 and 7 only

**RND 1:** \*K1, p2tog\*, rep \*-\* to end. [32 (32, -, -, 40) (48, 48, -, -) sts dec'd]

Sizes 3, 8 and 9 only

**RND 1:** \*K1, p2tog\*, rep \*-\* to last 2 sts, k1, p1, [- (-, 34, -, -) (-, -, 50, 50) sts dec'd]

Size 4 only

**RND 1:** \*K1, p2tog\*, rep \*-\* to last 4 sts, k1, p3tog. (38 sts dec'd)

[64 (64, 70, 74, 80) (96, 96, 102, 102) sts]

**RND 2:** \*K1, p1\*, rep \*-\* to end.

Rep Rnd 2 until cuff measures 1" / 2.5 cm.

BO loosely using Suspended BO Method.

WINGS

COLLAR

With US 1 / 2.25 mm needles, pick up and k 116 (132, 148, 148, 164) (180, 196, 212, 228) sts starting at the centre back. Join to work in the rnd.

Work 1-Cord BO as follows:

ROW 1 (RS): CO 4 sts to RHN, tw.

ROW 2 (WS): \*K3, k2togtbl, sl 4 sts from RHN back to LHN,\* rep \*-\* until 4 sts rem.

BO rem sts and seam both ends of the 1-Cord BO together.

Using US 5 / 3.75 mm spare needles and the Cable CO Method, CO 4 sts.

ROW 1 (RS): With US 1 / 2.25 mm needles, pick up and k 98 (112, 126, 126, 140) (154, 168, 182, 196) sts along 1-cord edge starting at the centre front. Tw.

ROW 2 (WS): P to end.

Work increase section as follows:

ROW 3 (RS): P2, k5 (6, 7, 7, 8) (9, 10, 11, 12), PM, mll, \*k7 (8, 9, 9, 10) (11, 12, 13, 14), PM, mll\* rep \*-\* 5 more times, \*\*k7 (8, 9, 9, 10) (11, 12, 13, 14), mll, PM\*\* rep \*\*\*-\*\* 5 more times, k5 (6, 7, 7, 8) (9, 10, 11, 12), p2. (13 sts inc'd)

ROW 4 (WS): P to end.

ROW 5: K to end.

ROW 6: P to end.

Rep Rows 5-6, 3 more times.

Rep Rows 3-6 until collar measures 3.5" / 9 cm.

Purl 4 rows.

BO all sts.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block to measurements.

- knit
- yo
- ssk
- k2tog
- B knit and bead
- A CDD
- no stitch

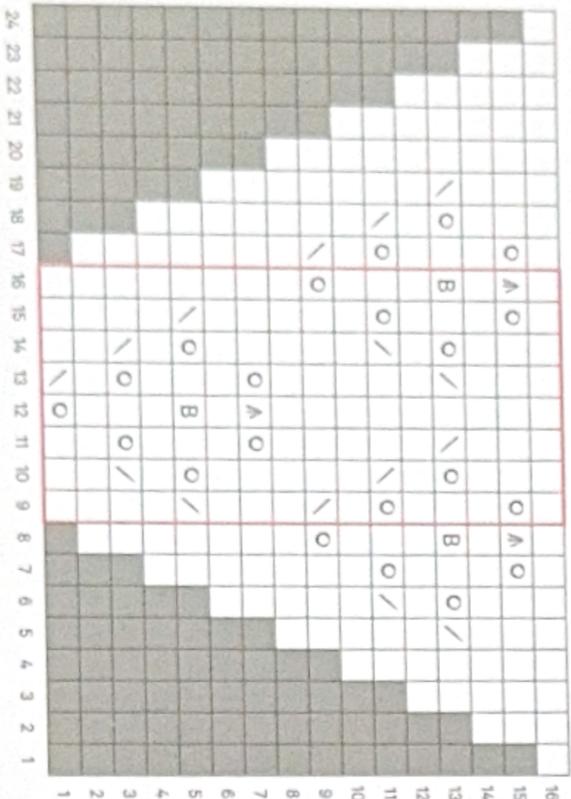
