SIZES

XS / S / M / L / XL / 2XL

COLORS

COLOR A: 500 / 500 / 600 / 650 / 700 / 750 gr

COLOR B: 100 gr

COLOR C: 100 gr

The amount of yarn might vary. Make sure that you have some extra.

GAUGE

10 x 10cm (4" x 4") = 13sts x 18rows, in the round using 6.0mm needles.

The needle size is only a guide. Change the size if needed to reach the correct gauge.

PATTERN

This sweater is worked bottom up in the round to the underarm, the sleeves are worked separately, and then all parts are joined together on one needle to continue the yoke up.

YARN SUGGESTIONS

Bulky (7 wpi - 12 ply),

Rauma Garn Vams - 100% Wool, 91 yd (83 m) - 50 gr (1.76 oz.),

Istex Alafoss Lopi - 100% Wool - Icelandic, 109 yd (100 m) - 100 gr (3.53 oz.),

Hillesvåg Ullvarefabrikk Troll - 100% Wool, 125 yd (114 m) - 100 gr (3.53 oz.).

TOOLS

4.5 mm (US7): circular needle 40-60 cm / 16-24", double-pointed needles for neck rib, bottom rib, and for sleeve rib.

6 mm (US10): circular needle 20-60-100 cm / 8-24-40", for body and sleeves.

Removable stitch markers, stitch holder or waste yarn.

ABBREVIATIONS

st(s) – stitch(es),

k – knit stitch, **p** – purl stitch

BOR - beginning of round

MEASUREMENTS IN CM / INCHES

SLEEVES

With smaller needle and **COLOR B** needles cast on 34 / 34 / 36 / 36 / 42 / 42 sts, set marker (BOR), work 5 / 5 / 5 / 6 / 6 / 6 cm - 2 / 2 / 2 / 2.5 / 2.5 / 2.5" in (k1, p1) rib.

Work 1k row, simultaneously change to a bigger needle.

Next row evenly increase 2 / 2 / 6 / 6 / 6 / 4 sts = 36 / 36 / 42 / 42 / 48 / 48 sts.

Work **CHART 1**.

When complete, continue with **COLOR A**.

Do 2 increases along the BOR (1k, 1 increase, knit until 1sts left, 1 increase, 1k) 7 / 7 / 6 / 6 / 5 / 5 times every 8 / 8 / 10 / 10 / 10 / 10 th round = 50 / 50 / 54 / 54 / 58 / 58 sts.

Work until next sleeve length:

Women: 45 / 46 / 47 / 48 / 49 / 50 cm - 17.7 / 18.1 / 18.5 / 18.9 / 19.3 / 19.7";

Men: 49 / 50 / 51 / 52 / 53 / 54 cm - 19.3 / 19.7 / 20.1 / 20.5 / 20.8 / 21.2"

or desired length.

Place middle 8 / 8 / 9 / 9 / 10 / 10 sts of sleeve on stitch holder.

42 / 42 / 45 / 45 / 48 / 48 sts left on sleeve.

Put piece aside and knit another sleeve.

BODY

With smaller needle and **COLOR B** needles cast on 126 / 132 / 138 / 144 / 150 / 156 sts. Set marker (BOR), work 5 / 5 / 5 / 6 / 6 / 6 cm - 2 / 2 / 2 / 2.5 / 2.5 / 2.5" in (k1, p1) rib.


Work 1k row, simultaneously change to a bigger needle.

Work **CHART 1**.

Continue with **COLOR A** until reach body length:

Women: 40 / 41 / 42 / 43 / 44 / 45 cm - 15.7 / 16.1 / 16.5 / 16.9 / 17.3 / 17.7";

Men: 42 / 43 / 44 / 45 / 46 / 47 cm - 16.5 / 16.9 / 17.3 / 17.7 / 18.1 / 18.5"; or desired length.



The way to put aside the middle stitches and join sleeves and body.

YOKE

Place 8 / 8 / 9 / 9 / 10 / 10 sts after the BOR on the stitch holder or waste thread, join and knit across the sleeve, knit across 55 / 58 / 60 / 63 / 65 / 68 sts of the body, place 8 / 8 / 9 / 9 / 10 / 10 sts on the stitch holder or waste thread, join and knit across the sleeve, knit across 55 / 58 / 60 / 63 / 65 / 68 sts of the body. Place marker (BOR).

Assembled yoke = 194 / 200 / 210 / 216 / 226 / 232 sts.

Work 1k round with **COLOR A**, simultaneously decrease evenly 2 / 0 / 2 / 0 / 2 / 0 sts = 192 / 200 / 208 / 216 / 224 / 232 sts.

Work pattern **CHART 2**.

When **CHART 2** is complete = 72 / 75 / 78 / 81 / 84 / 87 sts on needles.

NECK RIB


With smaller needles and **COLOR A** work 5 cm (2") in (1k, 1p) rib. Bind off loosely.

ASSEMBLING

Graft underarm seams together using a tapestry needle, weave all thread ends.

Rinse in lukewarm water and dry off on a flat surface.


