MAGNOLIA IS AN ELEGANT AND SOFT SWEATER WITH A RELAXED FIT, ROUND YOKE AND A PRETTY LACE PATTERN. THE SWEATER IS WORKED SEAMLESSLY IN THE ROUND IN ONE PIECE

SIZES

xxs (xs) s (m) l (xl) 2xl (3xl)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest circumference:

88 (92) 96 (100) 104 (110) 122 (130) cm / 35.25 (36.75) 38.5 (40) 41,5 (43.25) 48 (51) inches

Length from armhole to bottom hem:

40 cm / 15.75 inches

Sleeve length from cuff to armhole:

46 cm / 18 inches

Upper sleeve circumference:

34 (35) 37 (38) 40 (41) 46 (49) cm / 13.5 (14) 14.75 (15.25) 16 (16.25) 18 (19.25) inches

MATERIALS

CAMILLA VAD LAMBSWOOL (New Zealand Lambswool, 100% wool, 450m / 492 yds per 100 g)
250 (250) 300 (300) 350 (350) 350 (400) g
colorway 9 (Rose)

Isager Silk Mohair (70% kid mohair, 30% silk,
212 m / 232 yds per 25 g)

125 (150) 150 (150) 175 (175) 175 (200) g
colorway 0

NEEDLES

Circular needles 3.5 mm + 4.0 mm / US 4 + US 6 in suitable lengths

GAUGE

20 sts x 30 rows = 10 x 10 cm / 4 x 4 inches on 4.0 mm /US 6 needles in stockinette stitch, after blocking.

PLEASE NOTE

The sweater is worked with two strands of yarn held together throughout – one strand of each yarn. You work from the top down in the round. It is recommended to tighten the increases quite a bit to avoid holes.

NUPP

Knit into the front and the back of next st a total of 3 times = 6 sts worked in the same st. Pass 5th, 4th, 3rd, , 2nd and 1st st over the 6th st.

DECREASES (sleeves)

After marker: k2tog

Before marker: ssk (slip, slip, knit - slip the next 2 sts knitwise one at a time, slip them back to the left needle, k2tog tbl)

INCREASES

Pick up the strand between the sts and knit it tbl. Make sure to not stagger the increases of the yoke. This is done by shifting the placement of the increases in correlation to the previous increase rnd. This is very important for the finished look

HOW TO TURN

In this pattern German short rows are used. Work to the point where you need to turn. Turn work. Slip the first st (the last st worked) pwise with the yarn in front of the work. Bring the yarn up over the needle and over the last st worked. Pull slightly on the yarn to create a

“double stitch”. Continue working as per the directions.

When you come back to the “double stitch” just work the 2 loops together as 1 stitch (a purl or a knit according to the directions)

Directions

NECK

Cast on **96 (100) 100 (100) 100 (100) 108 (108)** sts loosely on **3.5 mm / US 4** needle with one strand of each yarn held together. PM to indicate BOR. Join to start working in the round, and work in twisted rib; * k1 tbl, p1 * to end of rnd. Work in established twisted rib pattern until work measures **5 cm / 2 inches**. Change to **4.0 mm / US 6** needle. Now continue in st st and at the same time, work short rows (please see the instructions in the pattern techniques section above) to shape the neckline;

K 18 (20) 20 (20) 20 (20) 20 (20), turn, p to **18 (20) 20 (20) 20 (20) 20 (20)** sts after M, turn, k to 4 sts after last turn, turn, p to 4 sts after last turn, turn. Cont working short rows by turning 4 sts after last turn on both sides, until there are 6 turns on each side. After the last turn, k to M.

YOKE

K 1 rnd, in which you inc **0 (0) 4 (8) 12 (16) 12 (20)** sts evenly spaced on the rnd (please see the instructions for increases in the pattern techniques section above) = **96 (100) 104 (108) 112 (116) 120 (128)** sts.

K 3 (3) 3 (3) 3 (3) 3 (4) rnds.

Inc rnd 1: Work * k4, inc1 *, repeat from * to * to end of rnd = **120 (125) 130 (135) 140 (145) 150 (160)** sts.

K 4 (5) 6 (7) 5 (5) 6 (6) rnds.

Inc rnd 2: **24 (25) 26 (27) 28 (29) 30 (32)** sts evenly spaced on the rnd (every 5 sts but shifted in correlation to the previous inc-rnd): *K2, make inc, k3* = **144 (150) 156 (162) 168 (174) 180 (192)** sts.

K 5 (6) 7 (8) 9 (9) 9 (10) rnds.

Inc rnd 3: Inc **24 (25) 26 (27) 28 (29) 30 (32)** sts evenly spaced on the rnd (every 6 sts but shifted in

correlation to the previous inc-rnd) *K4, make inc, k2* = **168 (175) 182 (189) 196 (203) 210 (224)** sts.

K 5 (6) 7 (8) 9 (9) 9 (10) rnds.

Inc rnd 4: Inc **24 (25) 26 (27) 28 (29) 30 (32)** sts evenly spaced on the rnd (every 7 sts but shifted in correlation to the previous inc-rnd) *K1, make inc, k6* = **192 (200) 208 (216) 224 (232) 240 (256)** sts.

K 5 (6) 7 (8) 9 (9) 9 (10) rnds.

Inc rnd 5: Inc **24 (25) 26 (27) 28 (29) 30 (32)** sts evenly spaced on the rnd (every 8 sts but shifted in correlation to the previous inc-rnd) *K3, make inc, k5* = **216 (225) 234 (243) 252 (261) 270 (288)** sts.

K 5 (6) 7 (8) 9 (9) 9 (10) rnds.

Inc rnd 6: Inc **24 (25) 26 (27) 28 (29) 30 (32)** sts evenly spaced on the rnd (every 9 sts but shifted in correlation to the previous inc-rnd) *K8, make inc, k1* = **240 (250) 260 (270) 280 (290) 300 (320)** sts.

K5 (6) 7 (8) 9 (9) 9 (10) rnds.

Inc rnd 7: Inc **24 (25) 26 (27) 28 (29) 30 (32)** sts evenly spaced on the rnd (every 10 sts but shifted in correlation to the previous inc-rnd) *K5, make inc, k5* = **264 (275) 286 (297) 308 (319) 330 (352)** sts.

Size xxs-xl: **K 3 (3) 4 (5) 6 (6)** rnds, then, k 1 rnd on which you regulate the st count to **268 (280) 288 (300) 308 (320)** sts.

Size 2xl-3xl: **K 7 (8)** rnds, Inc **30 (32)** sts evenly spaced on the rnd (every 11 sts but shifted in correlation to the previous inc-rnd): *K2, make inc, k9* = **360 (384)** sts.

DIVIDE THE WORK FOR BODY AND SLEEVES

K 39 (41) 42 (44) 45 (48) 53 (57), place **56 (58) 60**

(62) 64 (66) 74 (78) sts on a spare needle, cast on 10 (10) 12 (12) 14 16 (18 (18) sts, k 78 (82) 84 (88) 90 (96) 106 (114), place 56 (58) 60 (62) 64 (66) 74 (78) sts on a spare needle, cast on 10 (10) 12 (12) 14 16 (18 (18) sts, k 39 (41) 42 (44) 45 (48) 53 (57) = 176 (184) 192 (200) 208 (224) 248 (264) sts on the needle.

BODY

Work in the rnd in st st until piece measures 16 cm / 6.25 in (measured from armhole). **Note! If you wish to make your sweater shorter or longer you can regulate the length here by making it longer or shorter before the lace pattern. The lace measures 16 cm / 6.25 in.** Remove BOR M, k 44 (46) 48 (50) 52 (56) 62 (66), PM to indicate new BOR.

LACE

The lace repeat has 16 sts and is worked a number of times across the rnd as described in the pattern.

LACE PATTERN RND 1: K 4 (6) 0 (2) 4 (0) 2 (2), work the lace pattern repeat (see below) 5 (5) 6 (6) 6 (7) 7 (8) times, k 8 (12) 0 (4) 8 (0) 4 (4), work lace pattern 5 (5) 6 (6) 6 (7) 7 (8) times, k 4 (6) 0 (2) 4 (0) 2 (2).

Continue in established way until you have worked a total of 16 rnds of the lace pattern.

LACE PATTERN RND 17: * p1, k1tbl * 2 (3) 0 (1) 2 (0) 1 (1) times, work lace pattern 5 (5) 6 (6) 6 (7) 7 (8) times, * p1, k1tbl * 4 (6) 0 (2) 4 (0) 2 (2) times, work lace pattern 5 (5) 6 (6) 6 (7) 7 (8) times, * p1, k1tbl * 2 (3) 0 (1) 2 (0) 1 (1) times.

Continue in established way until all rows of the lace pattern repeat have been worked. Then work in twisted rib across all sts until work measures 40 cm / 15.75 inches or desired length. Bind off in rib.

LACE PATTERN

Rnd 1: K8, p1, k7

Rnd 2 AND ALL EVEN NUMBERED RNDs:

Work as they appear, knit the yarn over and nupps on rnd 20, purl the nupps on rnd 16 and 24

Rnd 3: K8, p1, k7

Rnd 5: K6, k2tog, yo, p1, yo, ssk, 5r

Rnd 7: K5, k2tog, yo, k1, p1, k1, yo, ssk, k4

Rnd 9: K4, k2tog, yo, k2, p1, k2, yo, ssk, k3

Rnd 11: K3, k2tog, yo, k3, p1, k3, yo, ssk, k2

Rnd 13: K2, k2tog, k4, yo, p1, yo, k4, ssk, k1

Rnd 15: K1, k2tog, k4, yo, k1, 1 nupp, k1, yo, k4, ssk

Rnd 17: P1, k3, k2tog, yo, k2, p1, k2, yo, ssk, k3

Rnd 19: P1, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, 1 nupp, k1, p1, k1, 1 nupp, k1, yo, ssk, k2

Rnd 21: P1, yo, k1, ssk, k4, p1, k4, k2tog, k1, yo

Rnd 23: P1, k1, yo, ssk, k4, 1 nupp, k4, k2tog, yo, k1

Rnd 25: P1, k2, yo, k3, ssk, p1, k2tog, k3, yo, k2

Rnd 27: P1, k3, yo, k2, ssk, p1, k2tog, k2, yo, k3

Rnd 29: P1, yo, k5, ssk, p1, k2tog, k5, yo

Rnd 31: P1, k1, yo, k4, ssk, p1, k2tog, k4, yo, k1

Rnd 33: P1, k2, yo, ssk, k3, p1, k3, k2tog, yo, k2

Rnd 35: P1, k3, yo, ssk, k2, p1, k2, k2tog, yo, k3

Rnd 37: P1, yo, k4, ssk, k1, p1, k1, k2tog, k4, yo

Rnd 39: P1, k1tbl, yo, k4, ssk, p1, k2tog, k4, yo, k1tbl

Rnd 41: P1, k1tbl, p1, yo, ssk, k3, p1, k3, k2tog, yo, p1, k1tbl

Rnd 43: P1, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, yo, ssk, k2, p1, k2, k2tog, yo, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl

Rnd 45: P1, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, p1, yo, ssk, k1, p1, k1, k2tog, yo, p1, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl

Rnd 47: P1, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, yo, ssk, p1, k2tog, yo, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl

SLEEVES

With 4.0 mm / US 6 needle, pick up 12 (12) 14 (14) 16 (18) 20 (20) sts in the cast-on sts under the armholes; pick up 1 st before the cast-on sts, pick up 1 st in each of the cast-on sts, pick up 1 st after the cast-on sts = 68 (70) 74 (76) 80 (84) 94 (98) sts.

PM (M1) in the centre of the picked up sts. This marks the BOR.

Knit 3 rnds.

DECREASE RND: K2tog, k to end of rnd.

Work 2 rnds without dec.

DECREASE RND: K to the last 2 sts of the rnd, ssk

Work 2 rnds without dec.

Continue in this way by decreasing on each side of M every 3 rnds until there are **48 (48) 48 (48) 48 (48) 52 (56)** sts on the needle. Continue without dec. **AT THE SAME TIME**, when there are **54 (56) 60 (62) 66 (70) 80 (84)** sts on the needle, work lace pattern as for the body. **K 3 (4) 6 (7) 9 (11) 16 (18)**, PM (M2), work lace pattern 3 times, PM (M3), p1, k 2 (3) 5 (6) 8 (10) 15 (17) to BOR. On the following rnds, k to M2, slip M, work lace pattern 3 times, slip M, k to end of rnd. Make sure to cont to dec every 3 rnds.

Size xxs-xl: When 48 sts remain, cont working in

pattern around without dec. After all rnds of the pattern are worked, continue in twisted rib as the sts appear until sleeve measures **46 cm / 18 inches** or desired length. Bind off in rib. Make the other sleeve in the same way.

Size 2xl-3xl: When all rows of the lace pattern repeat have been worked, continue in twisted rib as the sts appear. **AT THE SAME TIME** continue to dec until there are **52 (56)** sts on the needle. Continue until sleeve measures **46 cm / 18 inches** or desired length. Bind off in rib. Make the other sleeve in the same way.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Wash the finished knitting and lay it flat to dry, while pulling slightly on the fabric to make the lace pattern pop.

MAGNOLIA SUMMER IS AN ELEGANT AND SOFT TOP WITH A RELAXED FIT, ROUND YOKE AND A PRETTY LACE PATTERN. THE TOP IS WORKED SEAMLESSLY IN THE ROUND IN ONE PIECE

SIZES

xs (s) m (l) xl

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Chest circumference:

88 (92) 96 (100) 104 (110) 122 (130) cm / 35.25 (36.75) 38.5 (40) 41,5 (43.25) 48 (51) in

Length from armhole to bottom hem:

35 cm / 14 inches

Sleeve length from cuff to armhole:

18 cm / 7 inches

Upper sleeve circumference:

34 (35) 37 (38) 40 (41) 46 (49) cm / 13.5 (14) 14.75 (15.25) 16 (16.25) 18 (19.25) in

MATERIALS

CAMILLA VAD LAMBSWOOL 9/3 (New Zealand Lambswool, 100% wool, 300m / 328 yds per 100 g)

250 (250) 300 (300) 350 (350) 400 (400) g colorway 28 (Dusty)

NEEDLES

Circular needles 3.5 mm + 4.0 mm / US 4 + US 6 in suitable lengths

GAUGE

20 sts x 30 rows = 10 x 10 cm / 4 x 4 inches on 4.0 mm /US 6 needles in stockinette stitch, after blocking.

PLEASE NOTE

The top is worked from the top down in the round. It is recommended to lighten the increases quite a bit to avoid holes.

NUPP

Knit into the front and the back of next st a total of 3 times = 6 sts worked in the same st. Pass 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th, and 6th st over the 1st st.

INCREASES

Pick up the strand between the sts and knit it tbl.
Make sure to not stagger the increases of the yoke.
This is done by shifting the placement of the increases in correlation to the previous increase rnd.
This is very important for the finished look

HOW TO TURN

In this pattern German short rows are used. Work to the point where you need to turn. Turn work. Slip the first st (the last st worked) pwise with the yarn in front of the work. Bring the yarn up over the needle and over the last st worked. Pull slightly on the yarn to create a “double stitch”. Continue working as per the directions. When you come back to the “double stitch” just work the 2 loops together as 1 stitch (a purl or a knit according to the directions)

Directions

NECK

Cast on **96 (100) 104 (108) 112 (116) 120 (128)** sts loosely on **3.5 mm / US 4** needle. PM to indicate BOR. Join to start working in the round, and work in twisted rib; * **k1 tbl, p1** * to end of rnd. Work in established twisted rib pattern until work measures **2 cm / 0,8 inches**. Change to **4.0 mm / US 6** needle. Now continue in st st and at the same time, work short rows (please see the instructions in the pattern techniques section above) to shape the neckline;

K 18 (20) 20 (20) 20 (20) 20 (20), turn, p to **18 (20) 20 (20) 20 (20) 20 (20)** sts after M, turn, k to 4 sts after last turn, turn, p to 4 sts after last turn, turn. Cont working short rows by turning 4 sts after last turn on both sides, until there are **6** turns on each side. After the last turn, k to M.

YOKE

K 3 (3) 3 (3) 3 (3) 3 (4) rnds.

Inc rnd 1: Work * **k4, inc1** *, repeat from * to * to end of rnd = **120 (125) 130 (135) 140 (145) 150 (160)** sts.

K 4 (5) 6 (7) 5 (5) 6 (6) rnds.

Inc rnd 2: Inc **24 (25) 26 (27) 28 (29) 30 (32)** sts evenly spaced on the rnd (every 5 sts but shifted in correlation to the previous inc-rnd): ***K2**, make inc, **k3*** = **144 (150) 156 (162) 168 (174) 180 (192)** sts.

K 5 (6) 7 (8) 9 (9) 9 (10) rnds.

Inc rnd 3: Inc **24 (25) 26 (27) 28 (29) 30 (32)** sts evenly spaced on the rnd (every 6 sts but shifted in correlation to the previous inc-rnd) ***K4**, make inc, **k2*** = **168 (175) 182 (189) 196 (203) 210 (224)**sts.

K 5 (6) 7 (8) 9 (9) 9 (10) rnds.

Inc rnd 4: Inc **24 (25) 26 (27) 28 (29) 30 (32)** sts evenly spaced on the rnd (every 7 sts but shifted in correlation to the previous inc-rnd) ***K1**, make inc,

k6* = **192 (200) 208 (216) 224 (232) 240 (256)** sts.

K 5 (6) 7 (8) 9 (9) 9 (10) rnds.

Inc rnd 5: Inc **24 (25) 26 (27) 28 (29) 30 (32)** sts evenly spaced on the rnd (every 8 sts but shifted in correlation to the previous inc-rnd) ***K3**, make inc, **k5*** = **216 (225) 234 (243) 252 (261) 270 (288)** sts.

K 5 (6) 7 (8) 9 (9) 9 (10) rnds.

Inc rnd 6: Inc **24 (25) 26 (27) 28 (29) 30 (32)** sts evenly spaced on the rnd (every 9 sts but shifted in correlation to the previous inc-rnd) ***K8**, make inc, **k1*** = **240 (250) 260 (270) 280 (290) 300 (320)** sts.

K 5 (6) 7 (8) 9 (9) 9 (10) rnds.

Inc rnd 7: Inc **24 (25) 26 (27) 28 (29) 30 (32)** sts evenly spaced on the rnd (every 10 sts but shifted in correlation to the previous inc-rnd) ***K5**, make inc, **k5*** = **264 (275) 286 (297) 308 (319) 330 (352)** sts.

K 5 (6) 7 (8) 9 (9) 9 (10) rnds.

Size xxs -xl:

K 1 rnd on which you regulate the st count to **268 (280) 288 (300) 308 (320)** sts.

Size 2xl-3xl: Inc **30 (32)** sts evenly spaced on the rnd (every 11 sts but shifted in correlation to the previous inc-rnd): ***K2**, make inc, **k9*** = **360 (384)** sts.

All sizes: **K 3** rnds

DIVIDE THE WORK FOR BODY AND SLEEVES

K 39 (41) 42 (44) 45 (48) 53 (57), place **56 (58) 60 (62) 64 (66) 74 (78)** sts on a spare needle, cast on **10 (10) 12 (12) 14 16 (18 (18) sts, k 78 (82) 84 (88) 90 (96) 106 (114)**, place **56 (58) 60 (62) 64 (66) 74 (78)** sts on a spare needle, cast on **10 (10) 12 (12) 14 16 (18 (18) sts, k 39 (41) 42 (44) 45 (48) 53 (57) = 176 (184) 192 (200) 208 (224) 248 (264)** sts on the needle.

BODY

Work in the rnd in st st until piece measures **10 cm / 4 in** (measured from armhole). Remove BOR M, k **44 (46) 48 (50) 52 (56) 62 (66)**, PM to indicate new BOR.

LACE

The lace repeat has **16 sts** and is worked a number of times across the rnd as described in the pattern.

LACE PATTERN RND 1: K **4 (6) 0 (2) 4**, work the lace pattern repeat (see below) **5 (5) 6 (6) 6** times, k **8 (12) 0 (4) 8**, work lace pattern **5 (5) 6 (6) 6** times, k **4 (6) 0 (2) 4**.

Continue in established way until you have worked a total of **16 rnds** of the lace pattern.

LACE PATTERN RND 17: * p1, k1tbl * **2 (3) 0 (1) 2** times, work lace pattern **5 (5) 6 (6) 6** times, * p1, k1tbl * **4 (6) 0 (2) 4** times, work lace pattern **5 (5) 6 (6) 6** times, * p1, k1tbl * **2 (3) 0 (1) 2** times.

Continue in established way until all rows of the lace pattern repeat have been worked. Then work in twisted rib across all sts until work measures **35 cm / 14 inches** or desired length. Bind off in rib.

LACE PATTERN

The lace repeat has **16 sts** and is worked a number of times across the rnd as described in the pattern.

LACE PATTERN RND 1: K **4 (6) 0 (2) 4 (0) 2 (2)**, work the lace pattern repeat (see below) **5 (5) 6 (6) 6 (7) 7 (8)** times, k **8 (12) 0 (4) 8 (0) 4 (4)**, work lace pattern **5 (5) 6 (6) 6 (7) 7 (8)** times, k **4 (6) 0 (2) 4 (0) 2 (2)**.

Continue in established way until you have worked a total of **16 rnds** of the lace pattern.

LACE PATTERN RND 17: * p1, k1tbl * **2 (3) 0 (1) 2 (0) 1 (1)** times, work lace pattern **5 (5) 6 (6) 6 (7) 7 (8)** times, * p1, k1tbl * **4 (6) 0 (2) 4 (0) 2 (2)** times, work lace pattern **5 (5) 6 (6) 6 (7) 7 (8)** times, * p1, k1tbl * **2 (3) 0 (1) 2 (0) 1 (1)** times.

Continue in established way until all rows of the lace pattern repeat have been worked. Then work in twisted rib across all sts until work measures **40 cm / 15.75 inches** or desired length. Bind off in rib.

LACE PATTERN

Rnd 1: K8, p1, k7

Rnd 2 AND ALL EVEN NUMBERED RNDs: Work as they appear, knit the yarn over and nupps on rnd **20**, purl the nupps on rnd **16** and **24**

Rnd 3: K8, p1, k7

Rnd 5: K6, k2tog, yo, p1, yo, ssk, 5r

Rnd 7: K5, k2tog, yo, k1, p1, k1, yo, ssk, k4

Rnd 9: K4, k2tog, yo, k2, p1, k2, yo, ssk, k3

Rnd 11: K3, k2tog, yo, k3, p1, k3, yo, ssk, k2

Rnd 13: K2, k2tog, k4, yo, p1, yo, k4, ssk, k1

Rnd 15: K1, k2tog, k4, yo, k1, 1 nupp, k1, yo, k4, ssk

Rnd 17: P1, k3, k2tog, yo, k2, p1, k2, yo, ssk, k3

Rnd 19: P1, k2, k2tog, yo, k1, 1 nupp, k1, p1, k1, 1 nupp, k1, yo, ssk, k2

Rnd 21: P1, yo, k1, ssk, k4, p1, k4, k2tog, k1, yo

Rnd 23: P1, k1, yo, ssk, k4, 1 nupp, k4, k2tog, yo, k1

Rnd 25: P1, k2, yo, k3, ssk, p1, k2tog, k3, yo, k2

Rnd 27: P1, k3, yo, k2, ssk, p1, k2tog, k2, yo, k3

Rnd 29: P1, yo, k5, ssk, p1, k2tog, k5, yo

Rnd 31: P1, k1, yo, k4, ssk, p1, k2tog, k4, yo, k1

Rnd 33: P1, k2, yo, ssk, k3, p1, k3, k2tog, yo, k2

Rnd 35: P1, k3, yo, ssk, k2, p1, k2, k2tog, yo, k3

Rnd 37: P1, yo, k4, ssk, k1, p1, k1, k2tog, k4, yo

Rnd 39: P1, k1tbl, yo, k4, ssk, p1, k2tog, k4, yo, k1tbl

Rnd 41: P1, k1tbl, p1, yo, ssk, k3, p1, k3, k2tog, yo, p1, k1tbl

Rnd 43: P1, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, yo, ssk, k2, p1, k2, k2tog, yo, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl

Rnd 45: P1, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, p1, yo, ssk, k1, p1, k1, k2tog, yo, p1, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl

Rnd 47: P1, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, yo, ssk, p1, k2tog, yo, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl, p1, k1tbl

SLEEVES

With **4.0 mm / US 6** needle, pick up **12 (12) 14 (14) 16 (18) 20 (20)** sts in the cast-on sts under the armholes; pick up 1 st before the cast-on sts, pick up 1 st in each of the cast-on sts, pick up 1 st after the cast-on sts = **68 (70) 74 (76) 80 (84) 94 (98)** sts.

PM (M1) in the centre of the picked up sts. This marks the BOR.

Knit in the round till sleeve measures 13 cm / 5.25 inches.


K 1 rnd, in which you dec 20 (22) 24 (24) 24 (24) 24 (24) sts evenly on the rnd (please see the instructions for increases in the pattern techniques section above) = 48 (48) 50 (52) 56 (60) 70 74 sts. Then work in

twisted rib * k1 tbl, p1 * until sleeve measures 18 cm / 7 inches. Bind off in rib. Make the other sleeve in the same way.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Wash the finished knitting and lay it flat to dry, while pulling slightly on the fabric to make the lace pattern pop.
