

# FROGGIE'S SWEATER



**FINISHED SIZE** To fit Froggy so please use a similar weight yarn to the yarn you've used for the frog's body and work to a similar gauge

**YARN** The shade numbers and names I used are written in *italic*:

Yarn **A** about 10 metres off-white or cream 4-ply/ fingering weight *Drops Alpaca shade 0100 Off-White*; Yarn **B** about 10 metres Off-White 4-ply/ fingering weight 7238 *Dark Olive Mixed*

**KNITTING NEEDLES** Pair size 3.50mm/ US 4 straight knitting needles

**TENSION** 15 rows and 16 stitches over 5cm with 3.50mm needles and 4-ply yarn



**Beginning at the Neck**

With yarn **A** cast on 26 sts for Neck Edge

**Row 1 RS) [K1, p1] across**

**Rows 2-9** Repeat last row eight times

**Row 10** Purl

Switch to yarn **B**

**Row 11 inc) K3, [kfb, k4] four times, kfb, k2 - 31sts**

**Row 12** Purl

Switch to yarn **A**

**Sleeves set-up**

**Row 13 inc) K5 (Right Back), kfb, k1, kfb, k2 (Right Sleeve), kfb, k1, kfb, k5 (Front), kfb, k1, kfb, k2 (Left Sleeve), kfb, k1, kfb, k5 (Left Back) - 39sts**

**Row 14** Purl

Switch to yarn **B**

**Row 15 inc) K6 (Right Back), kfb, k1, kfb, k4 (Right Sleeve), kfb, k1, kfb, k7 (Front), kfb, k1, kfb, k4 (Left Sleeve), kfb, k1, kfb, k6 (Left Back) - 47sts**

**Row 16** Purl

Switch to yarn **A**

**Row 17 inc) K7 (Right Back), kfb, k1, kfb, k6 (Right Sleeve), kfb, k1, kfb, k9 (Front), kfb, k1, kfb, k6 (Left Sleeve), kfb, k1, kfb, k7 (Left Back) - 55sts**

**Row 18** Purl

Switch to yarn **B**

**Row 19 inc) K8 (Right Back), kfb, k1, kfb, k8 (Right Sleeve), kfb, k1, kfb, k11 (Front), kfb, k1, kfb, k8 (Left Sleeve), kfb, k1, kfb, k8 (Left Back) - 63sts**

**Row 20** Purl

Switch to yarn **A**

**Row 21 inc) K9 (Right Back), kfb, k1, kfb, k10 (Right Sleeve), kfb, k1, kfb, k13 (Front), kfb, k1, kfb, k10 (Left Sleeve), kfb, k1, kfb, k9 (Left Back) - 71sts**

**Row 22** Purl

Cut yarn **A**, join on yarn **B**

**DIVIDE SLEEVES****Right Sleeve**

**Row 23** K12 (Right Back), k14 (Right Sleeve), Turn so purl side faces  
Continue to work on 14 Right Sleeve sts as follows:

**Row 24** P14

Cut yarn **B**, join on yarn **A**

**Rows 25-26** Work 2 rows stocking stitch on 14 right sleeve sts.

**Row 27** [K1, p1] across

**Row 28** dec) P2tog, [k1, p1] five times, k2tog - 12sts

Cast off in rib all 12 Right Sleeve Cuff sts.

RS facing, rejoin yarn **B** to remaining 57 stitches, continue as follows:

**Row 23** K19 (Front), k14 (Left Sleeve), Turn so purl side faces

Continue to work on 14 Left Sleeve sts as follows:

**Left Sleeve**

**Row 24** P14

Cut yarn **B**, join on yarn **A**

**Rows 25-26** Work 2 rows stocking stitch on 14 left sleeve sts.

**Row 27** [K1, p1] across

**Row 28** dec) P2tog, [k1, p1] five times, k2tog - 12sts

Cast off in rib all 12 Left Sleeve Cuff sts.

### Left Back

RS facing, rejoin yarn **B** to Left Back sts, continue as follows:

**Row 23** K12 (Left Back)

You'll now work to join Left Back; Front; Right Back as follows:

**Row 24 WS inc** P12 (Left Back); p19 (Front); p12 (Right Back) - 43sts

Cut Yarn **B**, join on yarn **A**

**Rows 25-26** Work 2 rows stocking stitch

**Row 27** [K1, p1] across to last st, k1

**Row 28** [P1, k1] across to last st, p1

**Row 29** dec) [K1, p1] five times, p2tog, [k1, p1] nine times, k1, k2tog, [p1, k1] five times- 41sts

Cast off in rib all 4i Waistband sts.

### Join Sleeves and Back Seam

Weave in all the loose ends.

WS facing, match the row ends that run from the Neck Cast-on edge to the Waist cast-off edge - match the striped pattern as accurately as you can and mattress stitch the seam from neck edge to waist edge.

Working on one sleeve at a time match the row ends that run from the Sleeve Cuff to where you divide for the sleeve the underarm split - match the striped pattern as accurately as you can and mattress stitch the seam from cuff edge to underarm split. Roll the neck over.
