You will need:

Yarn: *Yarn Art Baby Cotton* (50% cotton 50% acrylic, 165 m/50 g). This yarn is noticeably thinner than *Yarn Art Jeans* (yarn, that I usually use for all my projects). From *Jeans*, the rolls will turn out to be too rough and large.

401 warm white – 3 skeins, other shades by 1 skein: 400 - snow-white, 460 - black, 431 – light yellow, 432 – yellow, 436 – olive green, 440 - green, 421 – bright orange, 412- peach, 420 – coral, 423 – pink coral, 405 – beige, 402 - cream, 429 – terracotta, 408 – brown.

Yarn Art Baby Cotton Multicolor (50% cotton 50% acrylic, 165 m/50 g).

5216 – (mix of white+bright orange+red) – 1 skein, 5219 – (mix of light yellow+olive green+black) – 1 skein. If you cannot find this particular yarn, you can take 3 shades of a very thin thread separately and twist it together. The main thing is that the triple thread should be the same thickness as the main yarn.

2 mm crochet hook (for all details) and 1.75 mm crochet hook (for soy sauce only!).
Synthetic fiberfell, scissors, big eyed needle, hot glue gun, piece of hard plastic (piece of plastic paper folder or table place mat).

Stitch key:

AR – Adjustable Ring (Magic Ring)

ch – chain

sc – single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

dc - double crochet

sl st – slip stitch

inc – increase

dec – decrease

()*n – repeat combination in brackets n times

Simple sushi rolls with 1 ingredient (Maki)



Crochet all rice bases with warm white. Use a marker for easier rounds counting.

1. 6 sc in AR
2. inc*6=12 sc
3. (1 sc, inc)*6=18 sc
4. 1 sc, inc, (2 sc, inc)*5, 1 sc=24 sc
5. (3 sc, inc)*6=30 sc. Crochet 1 more sc after the last inc and finish with a sl st. Cut the yarn.



Make another circle in the same way, but do not cut the yarn.



6. sc 30 through the back loops only.

7-10. Crochet 4 rounds of 30 sc through the both loops. Finish with a sl st, leave a long end.



To make avocado roll thread the light yellow yarn into the needle and embroider a square with satin stitches.



Add an olive green line.

Embroider the same piece of avocado on the second circle with walls.



Sew both details together through the both loops of the last round of the walls and through the back loops of the flat circle. Stuff not too firmly while sewing.

Thread the light yellow yarn into the needle and make a few stitches through the roll in the center. Do not tighten, but just fix the flat shape of the round parts.



Crochet nori wrap with black yarn. Work turning rows with a turning ch in the beginning of every row. Chain 6+1, sc 6 in every row.



Crochet total 33 rows (or as many as needed to wrap the rice base).
Leave a long end.



You can sew or glue the nori wrap to the rice base. I liked to glue, then sew the short sides. With glue, the shape of the rolls is more even and clear. If sewing on nori, first sew the short sides of the nori, and then sew along the long sides with small stitches.



Such rolls can be made with any fillings to your taste: cucumber (436+440), salmon (5216), tuna (420).

Roll with caviar



Crochet a round roll with any filling, for example, with a cucumber. Moreover, the filling can be done only on one side.

Crochet caviar with bright orange yarn:

1. 6 sc in AR
 2. inc*6=12 sc
 3. (1 sc, inc)*6=18 sc
 4. 1 sc, inc, (2 sc, inc)*5, 1 sc=24 sc.
- Finish with a sl st, leave a long end.



Embroider caviar with a French knot, making 3-4 turns around the needle.





Watch a video on how to make a French knot here.



Fill the entire surface of the circle with such knots.



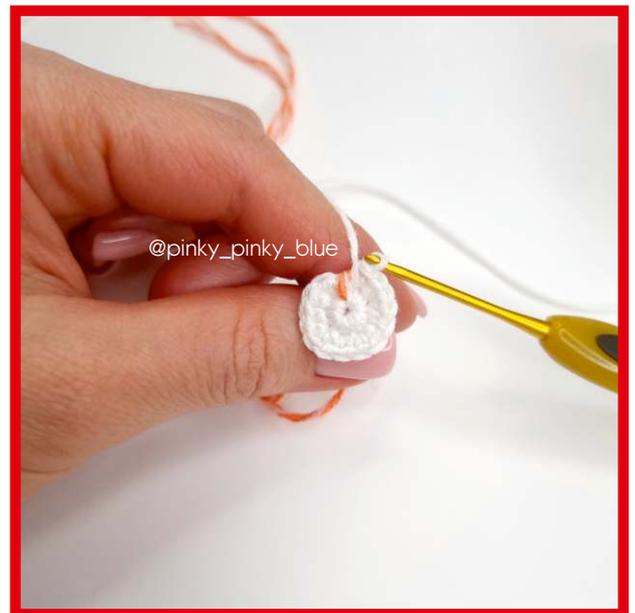
Glue on the side of the roll where there is no filling.

Nori wrapped square roll



1. 8 sc in AR



2. (3 sc in 1 st, 1 sc)*4=16 sc



3. 1 sc, (3 sc in 1 st, 3 sc)*3, 3 sc in 1 st, 2 sc=24 sc
4. 2 sc, (3 sc in 1 st, 5 sc)*3, 3 sc in 1 st, 3 sc=32 sc
5. 3 sc, (3 sc in 1 st, 7 sc)*3, 3 sc in 1 st, 4 sc=40 sc. Finish with a sl st, cut the yarn.

Make the same square, but do not cut the yarn.
6. 40 sc through the back loops



7-10. Make 4 rounds of 40 sc through both loops.
Finish with a sl st, leave a long end.



Embroider the filling, stepping back 2 rows from the edge on all sides. First, embroider a piece of avocado.

Add a piece of cucumber.

Then add a fish.



On the second part with sides, you need to embroider in a mirror image.



Sew both parts together: through the back loops of the square and through the both loops of the walls.

Stuff while sewing not too tight.



Sew several stitches through the center so that the square surfaces remain flat.

Crochet nori in the same way as for round rolls, but 38 rows.

Glue or sew the nori to the rice base.



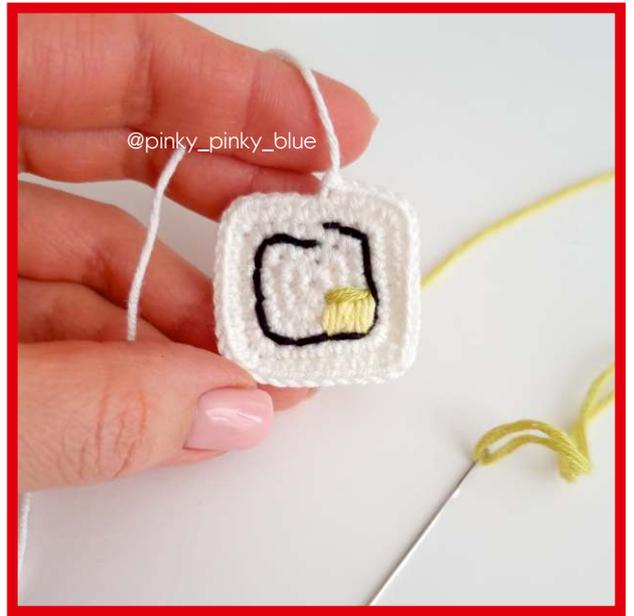
California roll

Crochet the rice base as in the previous description. Embroider nori with black yarn, stepping back 2 rows from the edge on all sides.

Embroider a slice of avocado in one corner.



In the other two add cucumber.



Fill the remaining space with crab: embroider small stitches with coral and pink-coral yarn.



On the detail with the sides embroider the filling in a mirror image.

Sew both pieces together as usually.



To imitate tobiko caviar, use multicolor yarn 5216 and crochet a strip like nori: 6 sc in width and 38 rows in height.



Sew or glue around the rice base.

Tempura roll

Crochet the base as in the previous version.
Embroider the filling: a piece of cucumber.



Embroider cream cheese with snow-white yarn



And a bigger piece of salmon.



Mirror embroider the filling on the second part.

Sew and stuff.



For tempura batter use multicolor yarn 5219.
Crochet a strip 6 sc wide and 38 rows high.



Glue or sew around the rice base.

Philadelphia roll

Crochet the base as in the previous version.
Embroider nori with black yarn, stepping back
2 rows from the edge of the square.



In the corners embroider pieces of avocado and
cucumber.



Fill the remaining space with cream cheese.



Repeat the filling on the second part in a mirror
image.



Sew and stuff.

Crochet salmon with bright orange yarn:

1. 3 sc in AR. Pull the ring and crochet turning rows with a turning ch in the beginning of every new row.



2. inc, 1 sc, inc=5 sc
3. inc, 3 sc, inc=7 sc

4. inc, 4 sc, dec=7 sc
5. dec, 4 sc, inc=7 sc

Crochet all even rows as the fourth, all odd ones as the fifth up to 23 rows.



- 24. dec, 3 sc, dec=5 sc
- 25. dec, 1 sc, dec=3 sc
- 26. 3 sc together (dec). Cut the yarn.

Back stitch with peach yarn every 2 rows.



Glue the slice of salmon on 3 sides.



Sesame roll

Crochet the base as in the previous version. Embroider the nori with black yarn, stepping back 2 rows from the edge of the square.



Embroider a piece of avocado and salmon.

In the other corner embroider a piece of cucumber.

Fill the remaining space with cream cheese.



Embroider the filling on the second part.



Sew and stuff.



Crochet the outer strip in warm white. Then embroider small stitches densely over the entire surface with creamy yarn.

Add sparser stitches in beige and black.



This one must be sewn along the long sides to the base through the front loops so that there is an impression of integrity.



Sushi with salmon

Crochet the rice base with warm white.
Chain 7. Crochet spiral rounds along the both sides
of the chain.

1. 6 sc, then 6 more sc along the bottom side of the
chain=12 sc



2. 1 sc, inc, 2 sc, inc, 7 sc=14 sc
3. 2 sc, inc, 3 sc, inc, 7 sc=16 sc
4. 3 sc, inc, 4 sc, inc, 7 sc=18 sc
5. 4 sc, inc, 5 sc, inc, 7 sc=20 sc
6. 5 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc, 7 sc=22 sc

7-10. 4 rounds of 22 sc. Cut the yarn.



Crochet the second half in the same way, leave
a long end.

Stuff and sew 2 halves together.



Crochet a slice of salmon with bright orange yarn:

1. 3 sc in AR



2. inc, 1 sc, inc=5 sc
3. inc, 3 sc, inc=7 sc
4. inc, 5 sc, inc=9 sc
5. inc, 7 sc, inc =11 sc

6. inc, 8 sc, dec=11 sc

7. dec, 8 sc, inc=11 sc

Crochet all even rows as the sixth, all odd ones as the seventh up to the 15th row .

16. dec, 7 sc, dec=9 sc
17. dec, 5 sc, dec=7 sc
18. dec, 3 sc, dec=5 sc
19. dec, 1 sc, dec=3 sc
20. 3 sc together (dec), cut the yarn.



Back stitch with peach yarn every 2 rows.



Glue on the top of the rice base.



Tuna sushi

Crochet the rice base in the same way. A slice of tuna is crocheted with coral yarn (420) in the same way as salmon, but without the embroidered lines.



Glue the finished slice of tuna on rice.



Shrimp sushi



Crochet the rice base in the same way. Crochet shrimp with warm white and peach yarn.

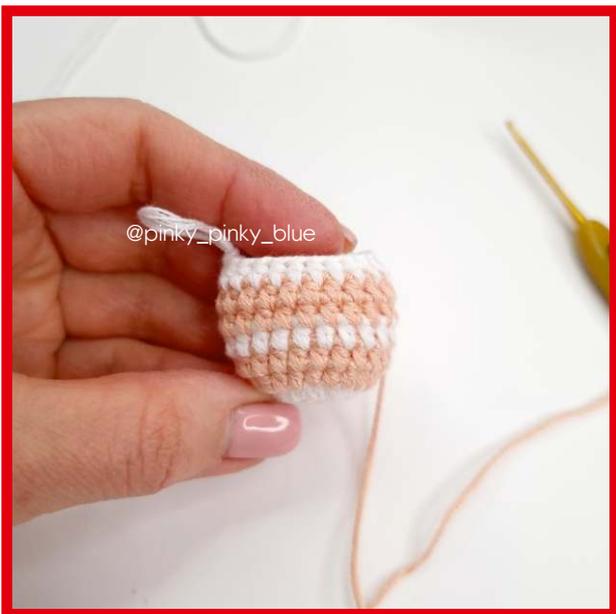
1. 10 sc in AR (white)
2. inc*10 (white)



3. 20 hdc (peach)



4. 20 hdc (peach). In this and the following rows of hdc, insert the hook not into the upper loops of the post of the previous row, but lower, between the posts of the previous row.



5. 20 hdc (white)
6-7. 20 hdc (peach)
8. 20 hdc (white)



9-10. 20 hdc (peach)
11. 20 hdc (white), cut the white yarn, leaving a long end.

12. hdc dec*10 (peach)

13-14. 10 sc (peach).

Do not cut the yarn, crochet a tail:
ch 5, 2 sc, 2 hdc, sl st.

Crochet the second half of the tail in the same way,
cut the yarn.

With the white yarn end, sl st in the center of
the shrimp from tail to head.

Glue the shrimp on the rice.



Egg sushi



Crochet the rice base in the same way. Crochet egg with yellow yarn:

Chain 15, crochet spiral rounds along the both sides of the chain:

1. 5 sc in the 1st loop, 12 sc, 5 sc in the last loop, 12 sc=34 sc

2. (1 sc, inc, 1 sc, inc, 13 sc)*2=38 sc

3. 2 sc, inc, 2 sc, inc, 15 sc, inc,
2 sc, inc, 13 sc=42 sc



4. 2 sc, inc, 4 sc, inc, 15 sc, inc,
4 sc, inc, 13 sc=46 sc



Do not cut the yarn, sl st around.



Then, without breaking the thread, crochet sl st in
the opposite direction between rows.

Glue the egg on the rice.



Crochet nori strip with black yarn - 1 row of 26 sc, leave a long end.

Wrap the sushi with a strip of nori, sew the ends on the underside.

Unagi (eel) sushi



Crochet the rice base in the same way. Crochet eel with beige and terracotta yarn.
Chain 15 with beige yarn, crochet on both sides of the chain:
1 sl st, 3 sc, 3 hdc, 6 dc.

8 dc in the last loop.



6 dc, 3 hdc, 3 sc, 1 sl st along the bottom side of the chain. Cut the yarn.



Attach the terracotta yarn and crochet, starting from the sharp end: 13 sc, (inc, 1 sc)*4, 4 hdc, 8 dc, 5 dc in 1 st on corner, 2 ch, sl st. Cut the yarn.

Glue the eel slice on the rice.



Crochet thin nori strip, wrap the sushi and sew the ends on the underside.

Pickled ginger

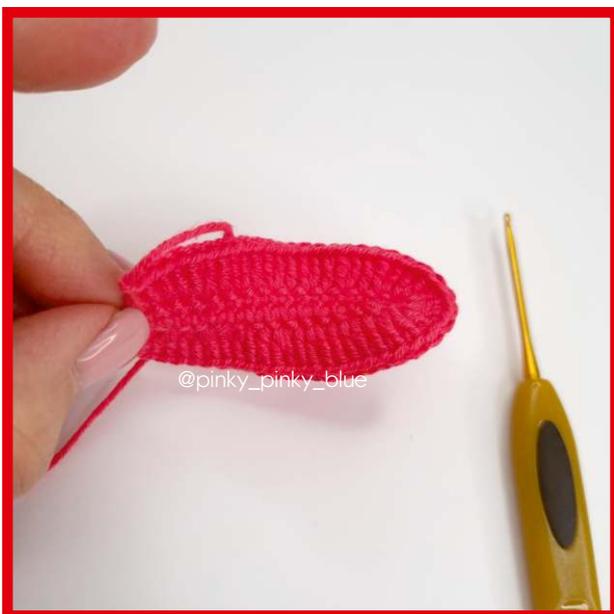
Crochet with pink-coral yarn.
Chain 15 loops. Crochet 13 sc along the chain,
5 dc in the last loop, 13 sc along the bottom side
of the chain.



Turn to the wrong side, crochet 2 turning chains.
Crochet along the straight part, alternating 1 dc
and 2 dc in one st.



Crochet 2 dc in every st along the
rounded part (5 times).



Then again alternate 1 and 2 dc in one st
along the straight part. Cut the yarn.



You can also make such ginger slices of different sizes changing the loops number of the starting chain, for example 12 loops instead of 15.



Wasabi



Crochet with olive green yarn.

1. 6 sc in AR
2. inc*6=12 sc
3. (1 sc, inc)*6=18 sc.

Finish circle with a sl st, do not cut the yarn.

Then crochet all rounds through the back loops, stuff while crocheting:

- 4-5. 2 rounds of 18 sc
6. (1 sc, dec)*6=12 sc
7. 12 sc
8. dec*6, do not cut the yarn.



Now crochet from top to bottom through the front loops: 4 dc in every st on first 2 rounds.



Next rounds crochet 3 dc in every st. Cut the yarn.



Soy sauce

Crochet bowl with snow white yarn:

1. 6 sc in AR
2. inc*6=12 sc
3. (1 sc, inc)*6=18 sc
4. 1 sc, inc, (2 sc, inc)*5, 1 sc=24 sc
5. (3 sc, inc)*6=30 sc.

Finish with a sl st, cut the yarn.

Crochet one more circle in the same way, leave a long end.



Glue them wrong sides to each other and sew over the edge with the end of the yarn. Set aside.

1. 6 sc in AR
 2. inc*6=12 sc
 3. (1 sc, inc)*6=18 sc
 4. 1 sc, inc, (2 sc, inc)*5, 1 sc=24 sc
 5. (3 sc, inc)*6=30 sc
 6. 2 sc, inc, (4 sc, inc)*5, 2 sc=36 sc
 7. (5 sc, inc)*6=42 sc
 8. 3 sc, inc, (6 sc, inc)*5, 3 sc=48 sc.
- Do not cut the yarn.

Glue the double circle right in center.



Continue crocheting the bowl:
9-12. 4 rounds of 48 sc. Do not cut the yarn.

Crochet soy sauce with brown yarn, but use a thinner hook than the main one, so that the circle is a little smaller due to the density of crocheting.

1. 6 sc in AR
 2. inc*6=12 sc
 3. (1 sc, inc)*6=18 sc
 4. 1 sc, inc, (2 sc, inc)*5, 1 sc=24 sc
 5. (3 sc, inc)*6=30 sc
 6. 2 sc, inc, (4 sc, inc)*5, 2 sc=36 sc
 7. (5 sc, inc)*6=42 sc
 8. 3 sc, inc, (6 sc, inc)*5, 3 sc=48 sc.
- Leave a long end.

Cut a circle from hard plastic with a slightly smaller diameter and glue it on the wrong side.

Sew the soy sauce to the white bowl with the end of the brown yarn through the back loops of both details. Stuff while sewing.



Continue crocheting with white yarn through the front loops of both details at once. Crochet 2 rounds of 48 sc.

Crochet 1 more round of sc, but insert the hook not into the upper loops of the previous round, but 1 round lower. Thus, a thick double edge is obtained at the bowl. Cut the yarn and fix the end.
