

Cannelloni sweater

SIZES 2XS/XS/S/M/L/XL/2XL/3XL/4XL

Finished chest circumference: 31.5/35/40.2/43.7/**49/53.4/57.7/62.1/67.4** in (80/89/102/111/**124/136/147/158/171** cm)

Sweater is designed to be worn with 2 - 6 in (5 - 15 cm) of positive ease in the bust.

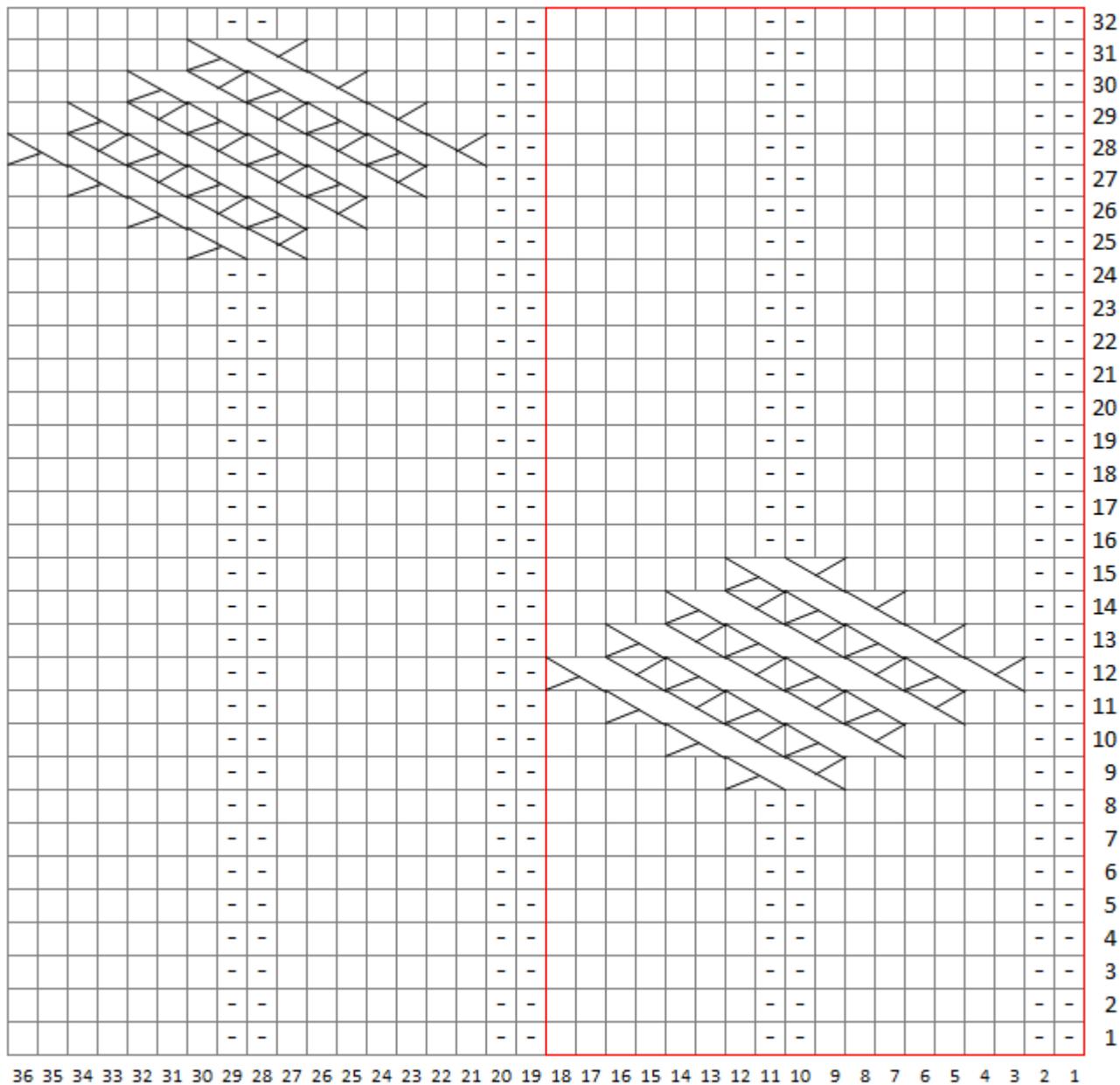
MATERIALS:

- US 7 and 8 (4.5 and 5 mm) circular needles long enough for 'magic loop'
- stitch markers
- tapestry needle
- cable needle
- scrap yarn

YARN: 810/900/970/1050/1145/1240/1335/1500/1600 yards of worsted weight yarn to obtain gauge, sample shown in Sandnes garn silk mohair(60% Mohair,25% Silk,15% Wool) and DROPS Safran(100% Cotton) both yarns held together

GAUGE: 18 sts x 22 rows=10 cm/4 inches in St st using larger needles after blocking

CHART



KEY TO CHART

- k on RS, p on WS
- p on RS, k on WS
- c4f on RS, c4fp on WS

DIRECTIONS

Using larger needle CO 28/28/28/32/32/32/32/36/36 sts.

Purl 1 row.

BACK

SHOULDER INCREASES

Row 1 (RS): k3, m1l, k to 3 sts before end, m1r, k3 (+2 sts)

NOTE: work first and last 3 sts rather loosely

Row 2 (WS): p3, m1lp, p to 3 sts before end, m1rp, p3 (+2 sts)

Continue to work this way for 18/22/28/30/36/40/44/48/54 more rows.

= 68/76/88/96/108/116/124/136/148 sts

Then work 24/26/28/30/32/34/36/38/40 rows in St st.

Place all sts onto scrap yarn. Cut yarn.

RIGHT FRONT

With RS facing pick up 22/26/32/35/40/45/49/53/59 sts (approximately 1st per 1 row) from right shoulder.



Next row WS: p2, [k2, p7]x1/1/2/2/2/3/3/3/4 times, k2, p9/13/10/13/18/14/18/22/19

Work in established pattern for 8/8/10/10/10/12/12/12/14 more rows.

Row 1 (RS): work in pattern to 2 sts before end, m1r, k2 (+1 st)

Row 2: knit knits, purl purls and increases

Repeat last 2 rows 4 times more and then work row1.

= 28/32/38/41/46/51/55/59/65 sts

Cut yarn and place all sts onto scrap yarn.

LEFT FRONT

With RS facing pick up 22/26/32/35/40/45/49/53/59 sts (approx. 1st per 1 row) from left shoulder.

Next row WS: p9/13/10/13/18/14/18/22/19, k2, [p7, k2]x1/1/2/2/2/3/3/3/4 times, p2

Work in established pattern for 8/8/10/10/10/12/12/12/14 more rows.

Row 1 (RS): k2, m1l, work in pattern to end (+1 st)

Row 2: knit knits, purl purls and increases

Repeat last 2 rows 4 times more and then work row1.

= 28/32/38/41/46/51/55/59/65 sts

Join fronts: With WS facing work over left front, CO 18 sts using backwardloop method, work over right front in pattern.

= 74/82/94/100/110/120/128/136/148 sts

Row 1: k9/13/10/13/18/14/18/22/19, pm, work chart 1,5/1,5/2/2/2/2,5/2,5/2,5/3 times, p2, pm, k to end

Note: working chart 1,5 times means to work 36 sts of the chart and then 18 sts in red square, same for 2,5 – work two times 36 sts and then 18.

Row 2: p9/13/10/13/18/14/18/22/19, sm, work in pattern to m, p to end

Continue to work this way for 34/38/42/46/50/54/60/66/72 more rows

BODY

Join back and front, CO 4/4/5/6/7/9/11/11/12 sts for each underarm (using backwardloop method). Place BOR m at the beginning of the front.

= 150/166/192/208/232/254/274/294/320 sts

Continue to work in the round in St st with stitch pattern on the front for 55/60/60/65/65/70/70/75/75 more rounds.

Next round: k to m, sm, [p2, k3, k2tog, k2]x 6/6/8/8/8/10/10/10/12 times, p2, sm, k to end

= 144/160/184/200/224/244/264/284/308 sts

Switch to smaller needles and work 20 rounds in 2x2 ribbing.

BO all sts in pattern.

SLEEVES (both the same)

With RS facing and using larger needles pick up 64/68/76/80/88/96/104/108/116 sts (approximately 3 sts per 4 rows) around arm opening and join to work in the round, pm in the middle of the underarm for BOR.

Decrease round: sm, k1, k2tog, k to 3 sts before m, ssk, k1

Work in St st for 78/78/80/80/82/84/86/90/92 rounds and repeat decrease round on every 5th round a total of 12/14/14/14/14/16/16/18/18 times.

= 40/40/48/52/60/64/72/72/80 sts

Switch to smaller needles and work 20 rounds in 2x2 ribbing.

BO all sts in pattern.

NECK

With RS facing, using smaller needles pick up 26/26/26/30/30/30/30/34/34 sts from the back neck edge, 16/18/18/18/18/20/20/20/22 sts (approximately 4 sts per 5 rows) from the left side neck edge, 18 sts from the front neck edge (2 from each purl line and 6 from each knit line) and 16/18/18/18/18/20/20/20/22 sts from the right side neck edge, join to work in the round.



= 76/80/80/84/84/88/88/92/96 sts

Work in 2x2 ribbing for 40 rounds.

BO all sts in pattern.

FINISHING

Weave in all yarn ends. Wet block the sweater.

ABBREVIATIONS

CO/BO – cast on/bind off

St(s) – stitch(es)

St st – stockinette stitch

k/p – knit/purl

p(s)m – place (slip) marker

m1l(p) – make one left, with left hand needle pick up bar between stitches from front to back and knit(purl) through the back loop

m1r(p) – make one right, with left hand needle pick up bar between stitches from back to front and knit(purl) through the front loop

k2tog – knit 2 sts together - right leaning decrease

ssk – slip, slip, knit – left leaning decrease

c4f – (Cable 4 front): Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold to front of work; k2 from left needle, k2 from cable needle

c4fp – (Cable 4 front purlwise): Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold to front of work; p2 from left needle, p2 from cable needle
