

CHERRY BOW ORNAMENT

Crochet pattern



• MY CROCHET WONDERS •

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Materials and tools:

Sport 5 ply cotton blend yarn (330 m/100 g)

Red – YarnArt Jeans 51

Pink – Alize Cotton Gold 518

Green - YarnArt Jeans 69

2 mm crochet hook.

Fiberfill.

Wire, diameter of 0.9-1 mm

Glue.

Clear crystal beads, diameter 6 mm.

Sewing needle, nylon (for sewing clear beads).

Yarn needle.

Abbreviations used (US):

mr – magic ring;

st(s) – stitch(es);

ch – chain;

slst – slip stitch;

sc – single crochet;

inc – increase;

dec – decrease;

hdc – half double crochet;

dc – double crochet;

tr – treble crochet;

dtr – double treble crochet;

BLO – work through the back loop only;

(sc, in) x n – repeat instructions in parenthesis the indicated number of times.

The height of the composition is about 15 cm.

Difficulty level: Easy

Cherry, make 2

Start with the cups, make 2

Work in spiral. Stuff as you go.

In red yarn.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr (6)

Rnd 2: 6 inc (12)

Rnd 3: (1 sc, inc) x 6 (18)

Rnd 4: sc in every st. (18)

Fasten off and weave in the yarn end on the first cup.

Repeat rounds 1 to 4 for the second cup, don't fasten off.



Insert the hook into the stitch from the wrong side of the first cup, then into the stitch of the second cup and make a slst through both layers, make 2 more slop stitches joining the stitches of both cups. Turn the joined cups with the right side facing up and start crocheting the 5th round from the first cup.



Rnd 5: in stitches of the first cup (4 sc, inc) x 3, in stitches of the second cup (4 sc, inc) x 3 (36)



Rnd 6-7 (2 rounds): sc in every st. (36)

Rnd 8: 7 sc, 2 dec, 14 sc, 2 dec, 7 sc (32)

Rnd 9: sc in every st. (32)

Rnd 10: 6 sc, 2 dec, 12 sc, 2 dec, 6 sc (28)

Rnd 11: sc in every st. (28)

Rnd 12: 5 sc, 2 dec, 10 sc, 2 dec, 5 sc (24)

Rnd 13: 4 sc, 2 dec, 8 sc, 2 dec, 4 sc (20)

Rnd 14: 3 sc, 2 dec, 6 sc, 2 dec, 3 sc (16)

Rnd 15: 2 sc, 2 dec, 4 sc, 2 dec, 2 sc (12)

Add more stuffing. Fasten off, leaving a yarn tail. Weave the yarn tail through the front loops and pull tight to close. To securely close the hole, thread the yarn through the tightened loops once more. Hide the yarn end on the inside.





Leaf, make 2

In green yarn ch23. Work around both sides of the chain.

Start working from the 2nd loop from the hook, 2 slst, sc, hdc, 2 dc, 4 tr, 5 dtr, 3 tr, dc, hdc, sc, slst into the last chain, ch1, slst in the same st. Continue into the unused loops on the opposite side of the chain: sc, hdc, dc, 3 tr, 5 dtr, 4 tr, 2 dc, dc, sc, 2 slst. Without cutting the yarn slip stitch all the leaf around.

Fasten off, leaving a yarn tail for sewing.



Bow

In pink yarn ch57. Work in turning rows.

Row 1: start with the 2nd loop from the hook, 4 slst, 20 hdc, 8 slst, 20 hdc, 4 slst, ch1, turn crocheting (56)

Rows 2-6 (5 rows): BLO 4 slst, 20 hdc, 8 slst, 20 hdc, 4 slst, ch1, turn crocheting (56)

Rows 7: BLO 4 slst, 20 hdc, 8 slst, 20 hdc, 4 slst (56)

Fasten off, leaving a tail for sewing.

Sew clear beads onto the ribbon.



Ribbon tails

In pink yarn ch28. Work in turning rows.

Row 1: start with the 3rd loop from the hook, 9 hdc, 8 slst, 9 hdc, ch2, turn crocheting (26)

Row 2: 2 hdc in one st., BLO (8 hdc 8 slst, 8 hdc), 2 hdc in one st., ch2, turn crocheting (28)

Row 3: 2 hdc in one st., BLO (9 hdc 8 slst, 9 hdc), 2 hdc in one st., ch2, turn crocheting (30)

Row 4: 2 hdc in one st., BLO (10 hdc 8 slst, 10 hdc), 2 hdc in one st., ch2, turn crocheting (32)

Fasten off and weave in the yarn end.



Loop

In pink yarn ch15. Work in turning rows.

Row 1: start with the 3rd loop from the hook, 13 hdc, ch2, turn crocheting (13)

Row 2: BLO hdc in every st. (13)

Fasten off, leaving a tail for sewing.



Assembly

Sew the loose ends of the bow. Weave in the yarn ends.

Insert the ribbon inside the bow and sew it. Weave in the yarn ends.

Place the loop around the middle and sew its ends on the back.




Take two pieces of wire approximately 15 cm long each. Apply a drop of glue to the end of the wire and wrap the wire with green yarn along its entire length. Secure the final wraps with glue. Since the stem seemed thin to me, I wrapped it with green yarn again.



Fold the two pieces together and wrap one end with green yarn for a length of 3 cm. in Secure the yarn ends. Sew on the leaves.



Make a hook at the free end of the wire and insert it into the berry after enlarging the hole with scissors. Turn the wire hook inside the berry. If unsure, use glue to secure the wire inside the cherry.



Sew the bow using sewing needle and nylon thread.



Cherry bow ornament is ready!
